

## NOTICE OF POLLING DISTRICT AND POLLING PLACES REVIEW

The London Borough of Hillingdon is conducting a review of polling districts and polling places in accordance with the requirements of the Representation of the People act 1983.

The Returning Officer has made comments on proposed polling stations and electors within the authority or within a parliamentary constituency which has any part in the authority are invited to make a representation. The authority would welcome any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability to make a representation or to comment on the authority's proposals, the Returning Officer's representations or any other matter.

Any persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
