b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1) Any incidents of a criminal nature that may occur on the premises will be reported to the Police and logged in our own Incident report book.
- 2) CCTV is installed around the outside and throughout the premises which will observe both entrance and exit doors. Recordings will be stored for 31 days and made available upon request by the police.
- 3) CCTV Sign will be visible throughout the premises to deter any anti-social behaviour.
- 4) Managers to be visible during busy periods and at weekends to monitor behaviour of guest and limit excessive drinking.
- 5) Spiking awareness and Ask Angela Posters to be placed in both male and female toilets.
- 6) Security to be in place on such events where we expect an increased number of guests.
- 7) Staff to be regularly trained on Company Drug Awareness policy
- c) Public safety
- 1) Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place including fire extinguishers (foam, H20 and CO2), fire blanket, internally illuminated fire exit signs, numerous smoke detectors and emergency lighting which will be inspected monthly.
- 2) All emergency exits shall be always kept free from obstruction.
- 3) Wet floor Signs to be available throughout the premises and any spills to be cleaned as soon as possible.
- 4) CCTV to be installed throughout the premises for customer and staff Safety
- d) The prevention of public nuisance
- 1) All customers will be asked to leave quietly when leaving the premises
- 2) Garden Speakers to be turned down at 21:00 and any guest seeming to be to loud will be asked to keep it down by the manager on shift.
- 3)Clear and legible notices will be prominently displayed to remind customers to leave quietly and have regard to our neighbours.
- e) The protection of children from harm
- 1) The licensee and staff will ask persons who appear to be under the age of 25 for photographic ID which will be register as (ID Checked/Refused Sale)
- 2) All staff will be trained in underage sales prevention regularly, and their training to kept on-site, available upon request.
- 3) Under 18s will have to be accompanied by an adult after 20:00
- 4) Children under the age of 18 will not be allowed to play on any gaming machine that may be present on-site

5) Any guest caught purchasing alcohol for someone under the legal age will be asked to leave immediately, banned from the premises and reported to the police (if name is known)

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NOTES ON REGULATED ENTERTAINMENT

In terms of specific **regulated entertainments** please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman
 wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not
 exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or
 wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an
 indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.

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PAYMENT DETAILS

This fee must be paid to the authority. If you complete the application online, you must pay it by debit or credit card. Premises' licence fees are determined by the non-domestic rateable value of the premises. To find out a premises' non-domestic rateable value, go to the Valuation Office Agency website at http://www.voa.gov.uk/business_rates/index.htm.
