Uxbridge walk (3)

A short walk of less than a mile that starts outside Uxbridge Underground station and takes in historic Windsor Street with a final loop around Rockingham recreation ground.

- 1 Start at Uxbridge Underground Station. This on the Piccadilly and Metropolitan Lines and was originally built identically to Cockfosters Station at the other end of the line. Head straight into Windsor Street, the oldest part of Uxbridge, past St Margaret's church.
- 2 At the end of the road cross over at the traffic light.
- 3 Walk across the roundabout. On your left you will pass a war memorial commemorating those lost from Uxbridge during both World Wars.
- 4 Cross Trumper Way and head down Cowley Road, turning right into Wellington Road.
- The Ivy Leaf Social club is on your right hand side. Cross the footbridge over Fray's River. Enter Rockingham Recreation Ground and turn left along the perimeter, following the man-made Fray's River which runs the mills at Little Britain, West Drayton.
- 6 You will come to a mini roundabout in the pathway; turn right and follow the pathway to the right around the perimiter of the park
- Exit Rockingham Recreation Ground at Fray's Waye.
