The David Brough Cycle Trail was created in appreciation of David's dedication and service to the London Borough of Hillingdon.

The majority of the cycle trail is undulating, apart from one steep slope, and is suitable for all terrain bikes and all abilities. A full circuit of the trail is approximately 2 kilometres long.

On your way around look out for the wide variety of wildlife, including:

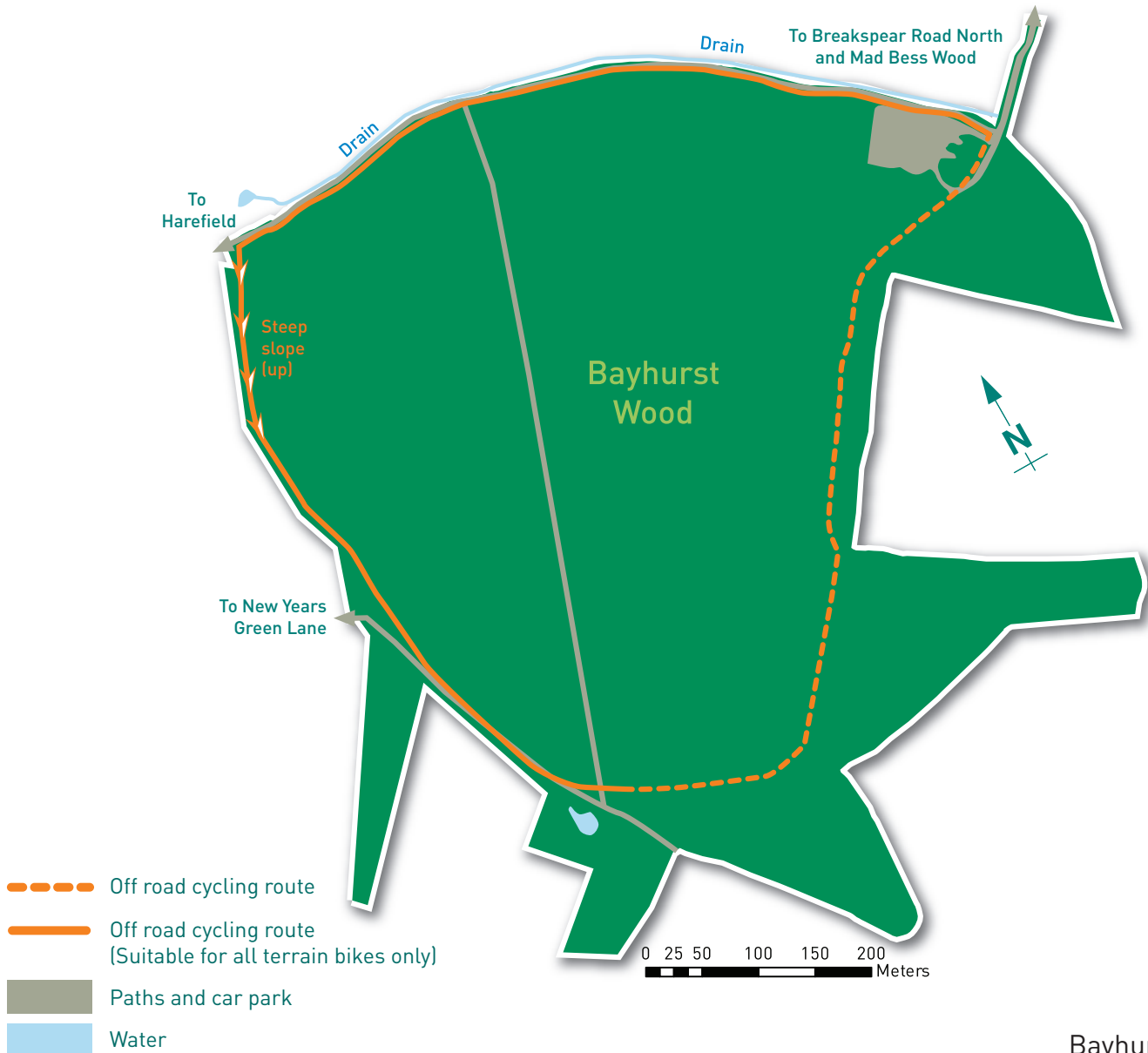
**Birds:** Jay, Greater Spotted, Woodpecker, Nuthatch, Treecreeper, Cuckoo, Blackcap

**Butterflies:** White Admiral, Orange Tip, Brimstone, Purple Hairstreak

**Mammals:** Grey Squirrel, Badger, Stoat, Weasel

**Trees:** Beech, Hornbeam, Oak

**Flowers:** Bluebell, Lesser Celandine, Herb Bennet
