## If you are a victim of racial harassment

If you are experiencing threats of violence, actual violence, or criminal behaviour, you should call 999 and ask for the police.

We will investigate incidents of racial harassment on a confidential basis.

If you are a council tenant, you should contact your Tenancy Management Officer on 01895 556666.

If you live in the private sector you can contact the community safety team by calling 01895 556000.

With your consent, we will investigate your problem and attempt to bring about a solution. If this is not possible, or not what you wish, our officers will give appropriate advice and assistance on the courses of action, and support, available to you.
