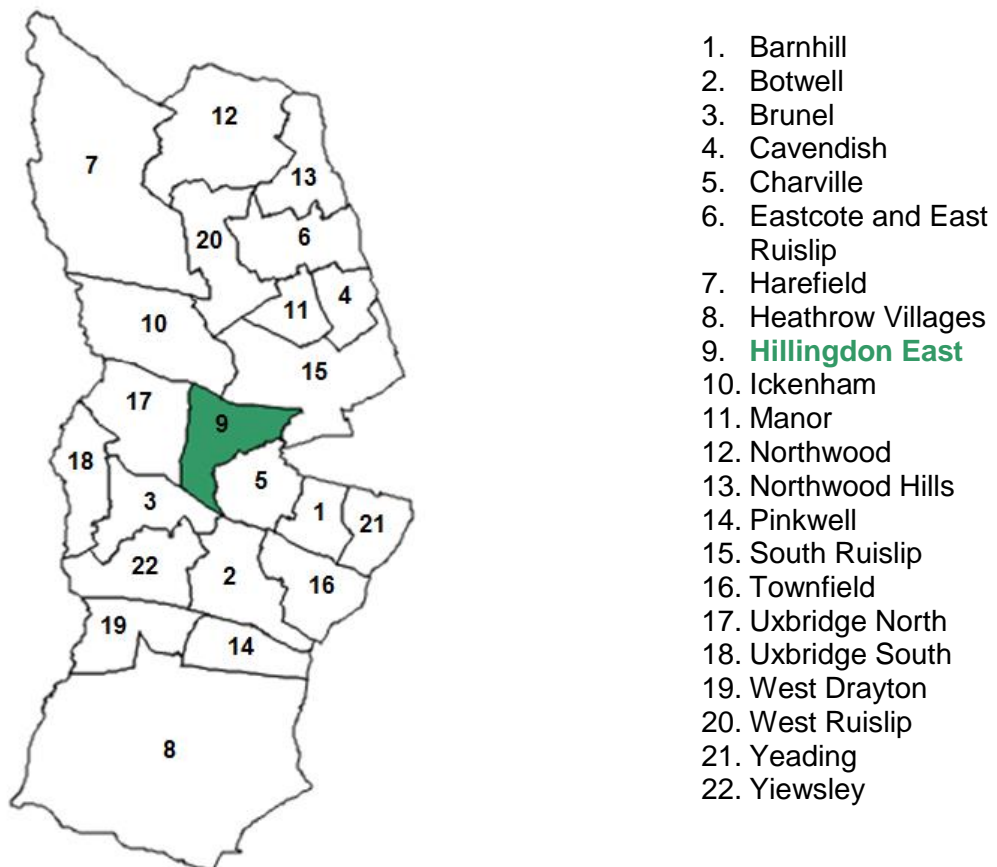

## Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- **Population** – comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** – 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- **Age** – 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- **Ethnicity** - Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- **Religion**<sup>1</sup> - the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian – 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim – 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu – 22,033 (8%) and Sikh – 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' – 46,492 (17%) and other – 23,303 (8.5%).

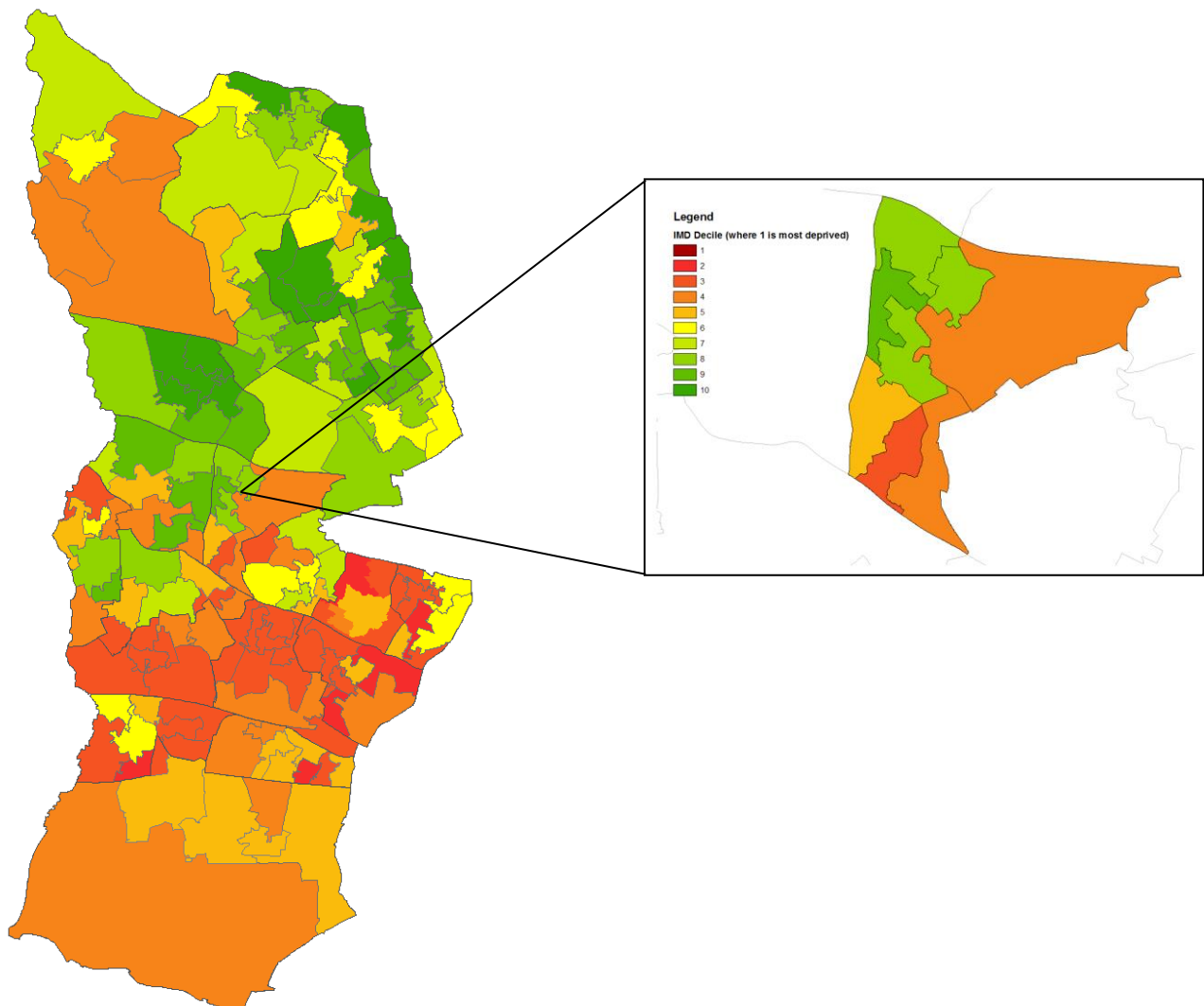
## Hillingdon East Ward

Hillingdon East lies in the centre of Hillingdon and is bordered by Ickenham, South Ruislip, Charville, Brunel and Uxbridge North.

In 2017<sup>2</sup>, Hillingdon East's **population** is 13,683 residents, an increase of 6.0% since 2011 (12,906); this is below the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Hillingdon East is made up of 359.4 hectares (3.6 km<sup>sq</sup>), with 38.1 people per hectare (3,591 per km<sup>sq</sup>). The average number of people per household in Hillingdon East is 2.9<sup>3</sup>.

## Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Hillingdon East, which is made up of eight LSOA areas<sup>4</sup>.

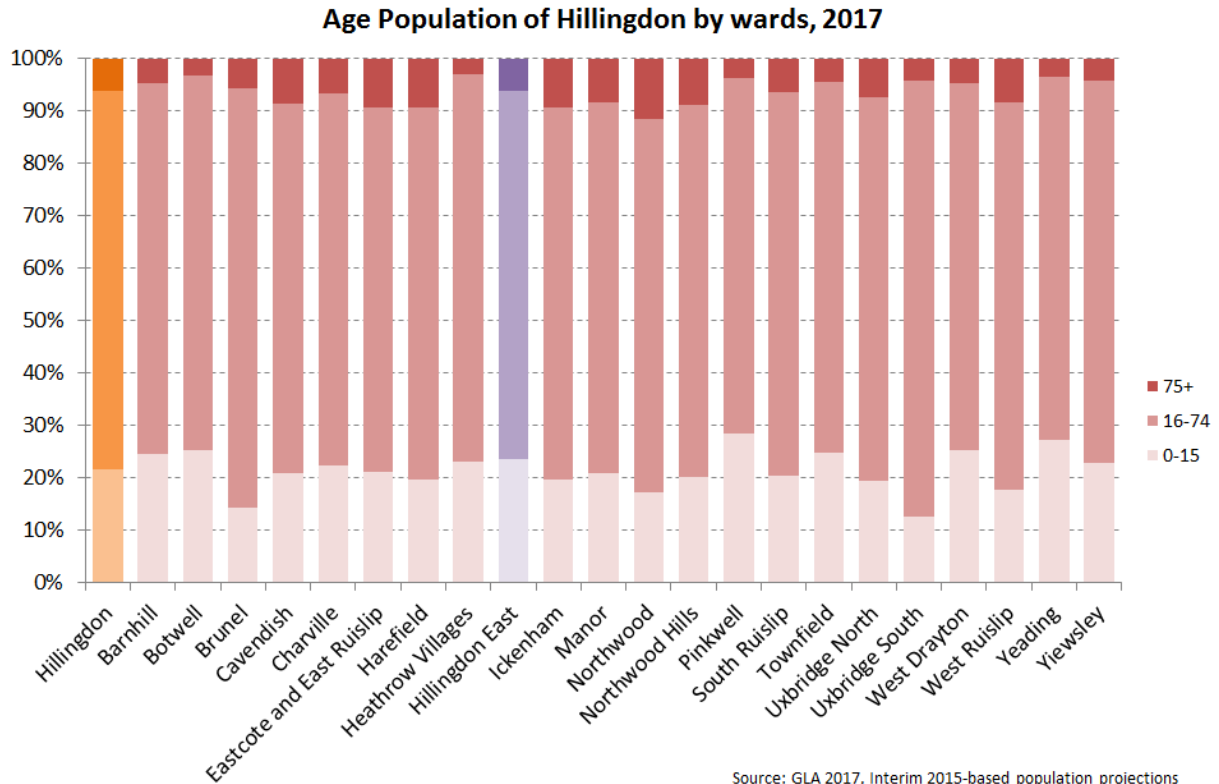

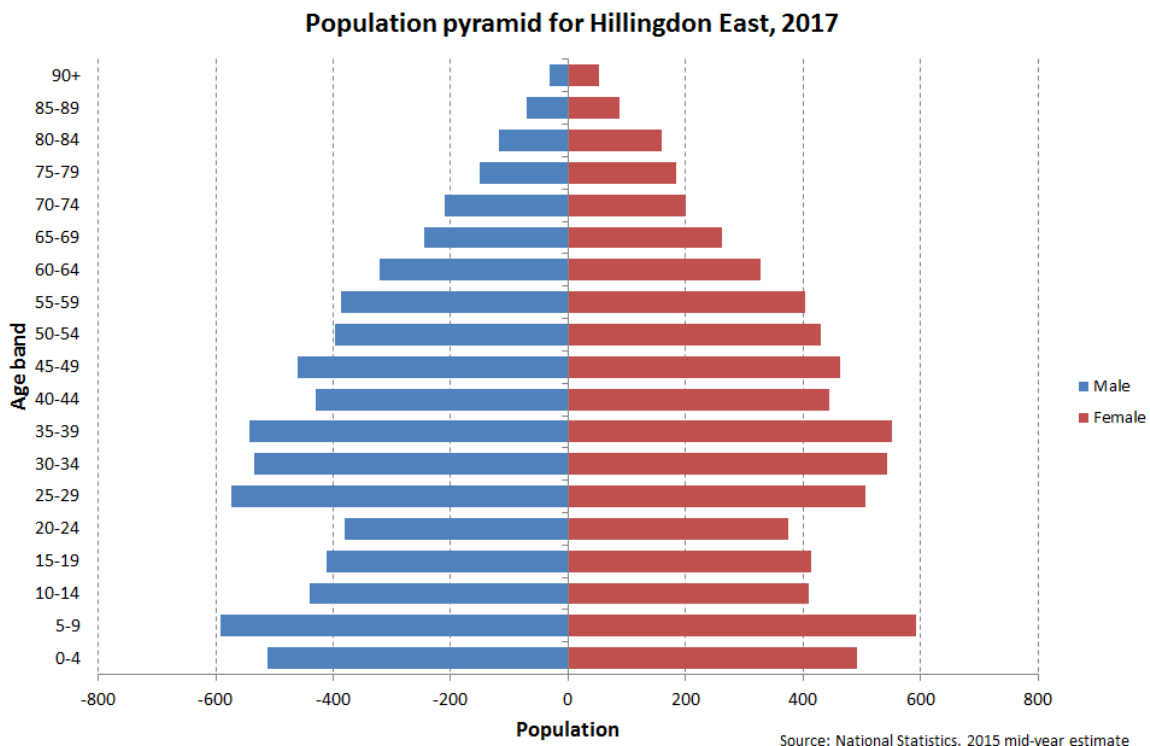

## Ward Population:



The chart above shows that 23.5% of Hillingdon East residents are under the age of 16. 70.3% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 6.2% are over the age of 75.

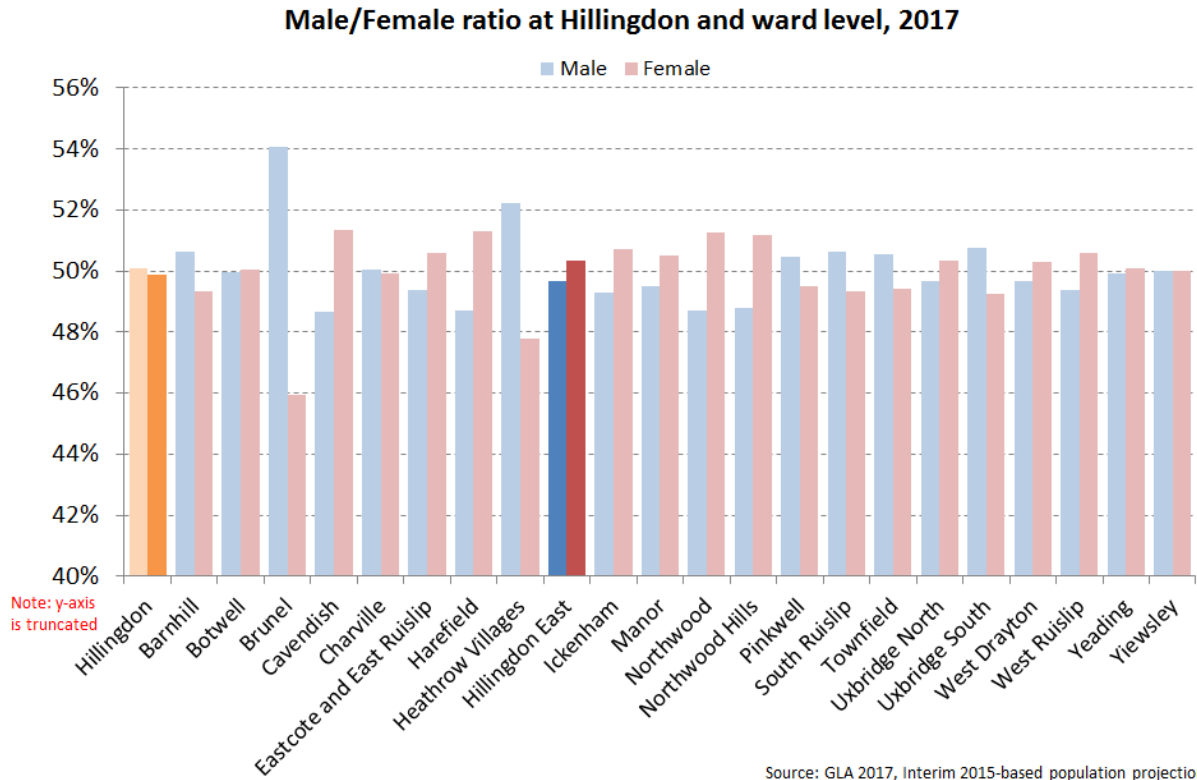
The chart below shows the highest number of males and females are aged 5-9 years in Hillingdon East. Hillingdon East's age profile is showing an increased proportion of a younger population.



## Gender

The proportion of **men to women** in the ward is 49.7% to 50.3%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 49.4% to 50.6% male to female ratio in the ward.

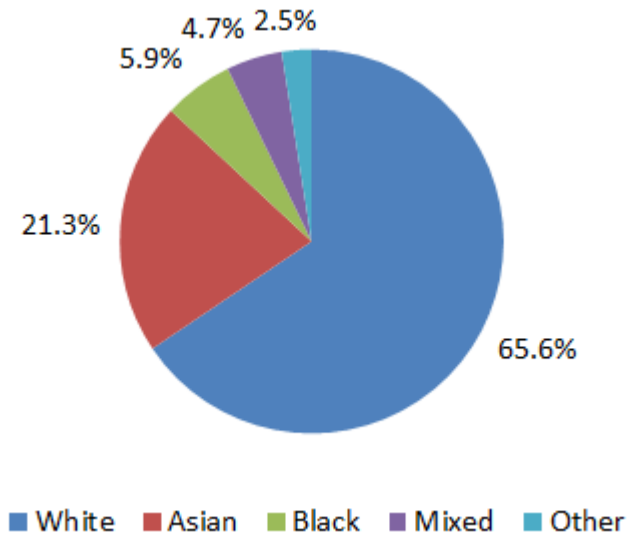
The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:



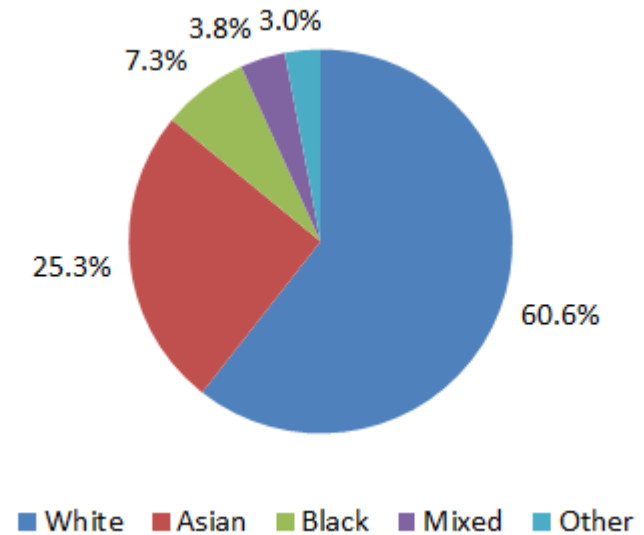
## Ethnic make up 2011<sup>5</sup>

In the 2011 census, 65.6% of residents in the ward identify themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 4.7% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 21.3% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 5.9% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 2.5% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

**Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:**



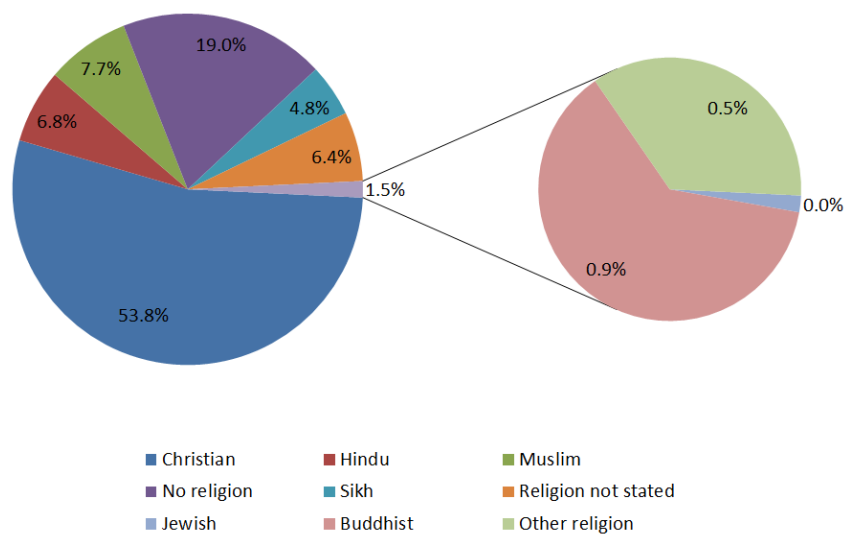

## Religion<sup>6</sup>

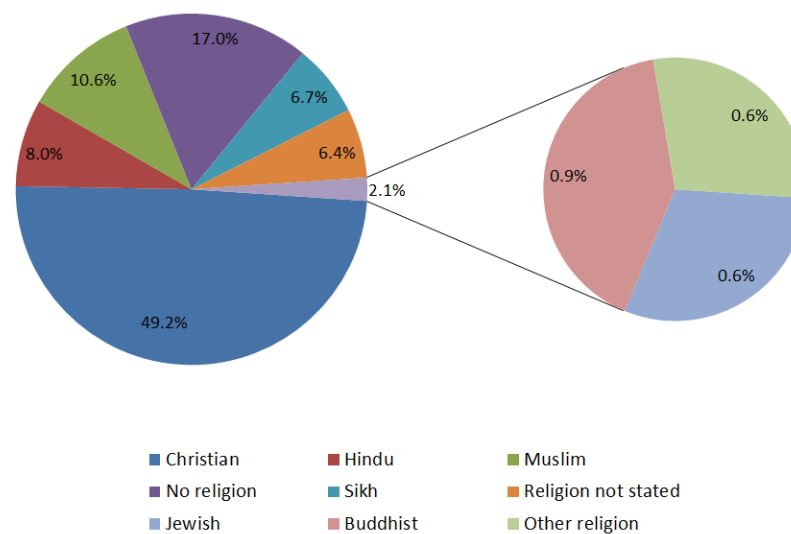
Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 53.8% from this faith. 6.8% are Hindu, 7.7% Muslim, 4.8% Sikh with 19.0% having no religion. 6.4% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary). 6.4% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary). According to the 2011 Census figures Hillingdon East has one of the highest number of residents stating their religion as Christianity or no religion.

**Hillingdon East, Religion 2011:**



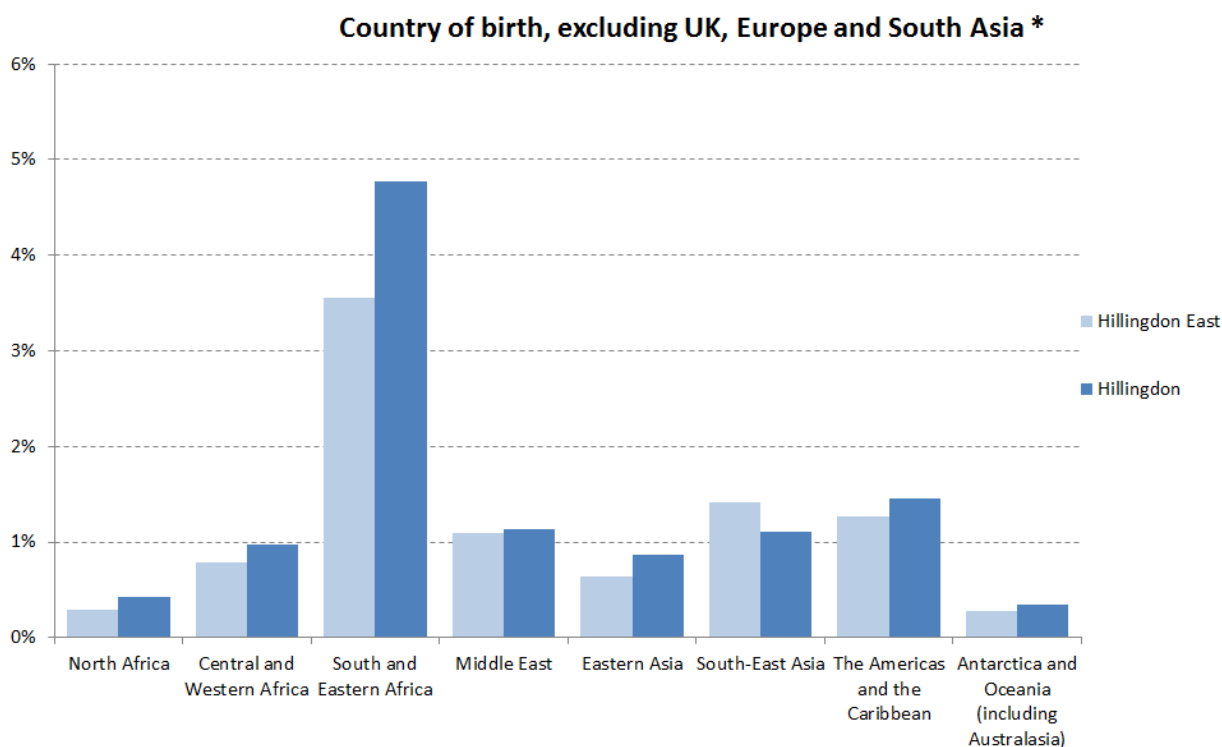
**Hillingdon, Religion 2011:**

## Country of Birth<sup>7</sup>

Of those living in Hillingdon East, 82.9% were **born** in Europe (with 76.7% in the UK), 1.1% in the Middle East / Asia, 4.7% in Africa, and 1.6% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Hillingdon East, 23.3% were **born** outside of the UK (with 76.7% in the UK).

The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 87.0% residents stating this at their main language. Of the remaining 13.0%, the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well', with 226 residents (14.1% of those where English is not their main language) stating they cannot speak English well or at all<sup>8</sup>.

Apart from English, the most spoken language in the ward is Panjabi with 222 (1.8%) residents stating this as their main language, followed by Polish with 144 (1.2%).

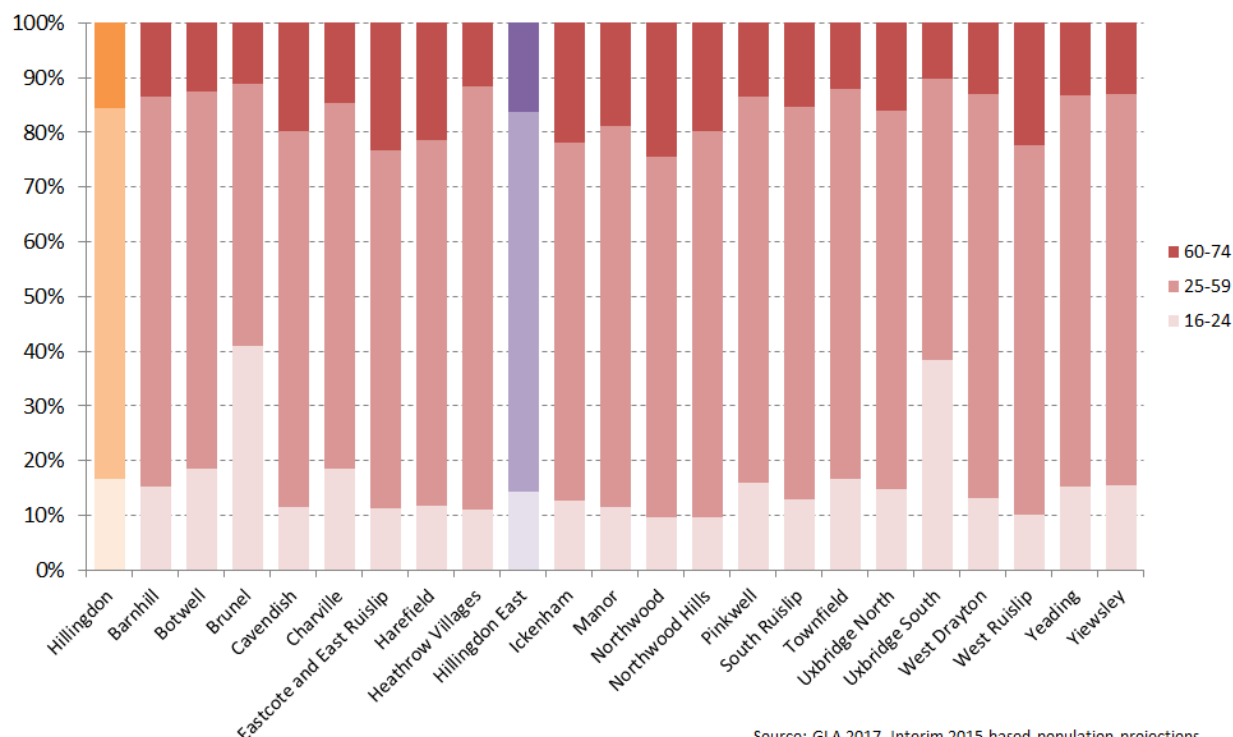

In Hillingdon East, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 14.4% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 69.3%, the remaining 16.3% are from the 60-74 age group.

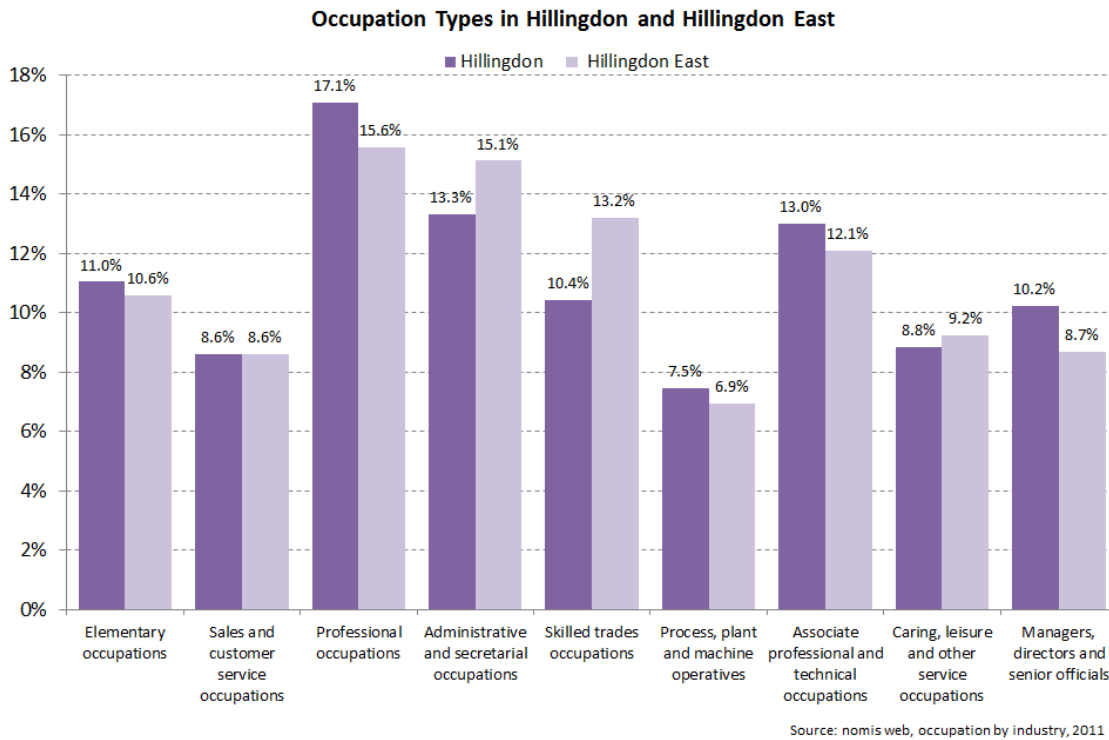
## Economic Data (statistics are for the age 16-74 group)

In Hillingdon East, 73.4% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:

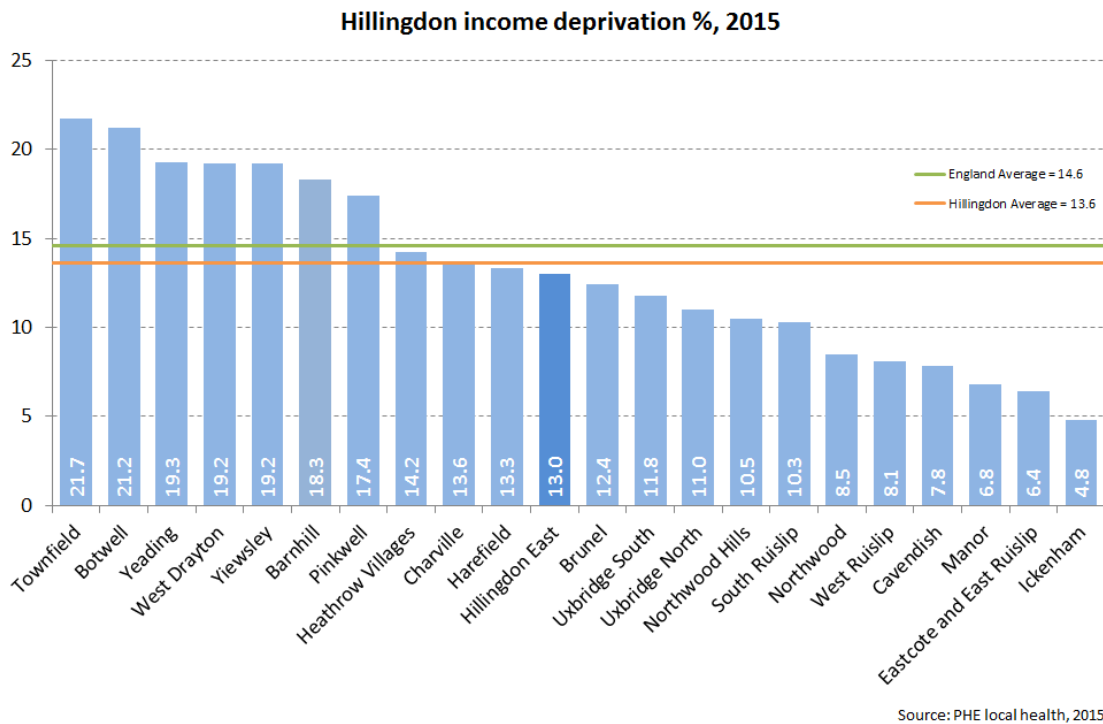

The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Hillingdon East is 13.0%, which is slightly lower than the Hillingdon average (13.6%).

## Households

In 2017, there were 4,764 households<sup>10</sup> in Hillingdon East; an increase of 103 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**<sup>11</sup> within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 85.3%, with 14.7% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).

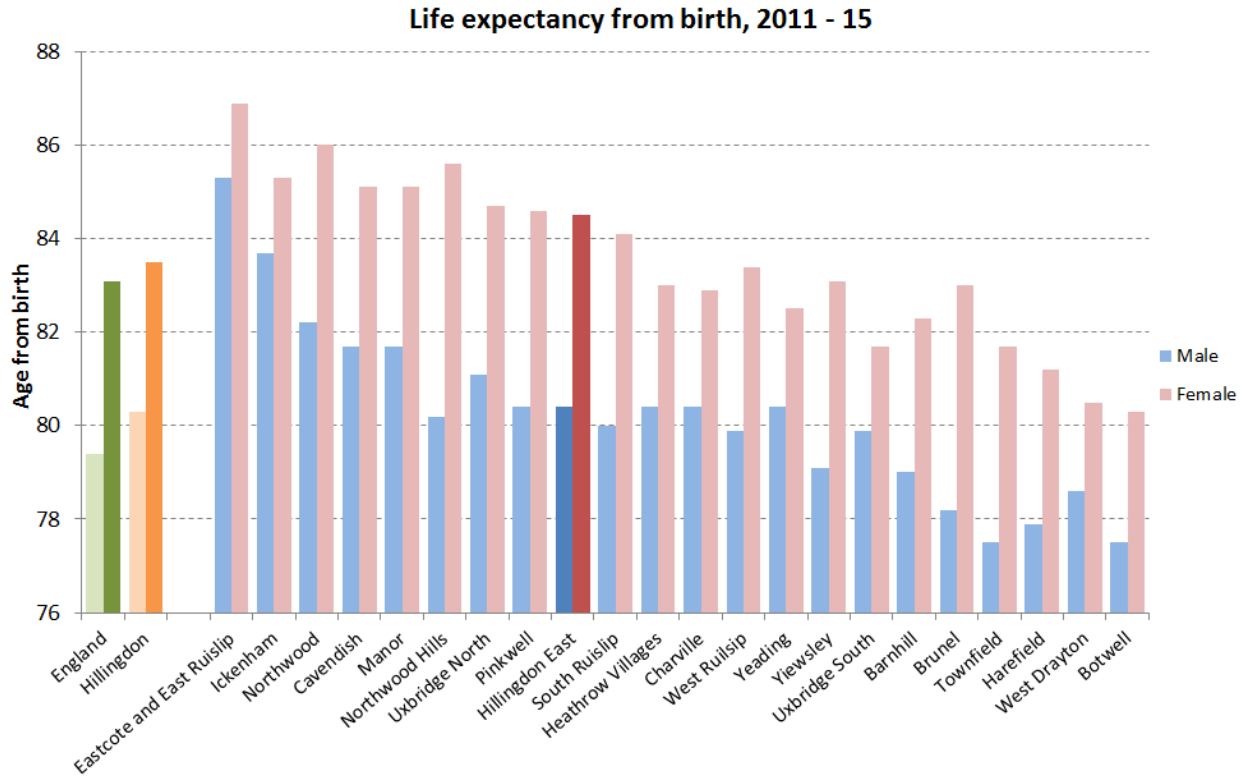
In Hillingdon East, 68.7% of ward residents own their own homes, followed by 14.6% of properties being privately rented, 14.8% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 1.9% other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.

## Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Hillingdon East, the life expectancy is estimated at 80.4 years for males and 84.5 years for females. This is similar to the averages for Hillingdon and England.



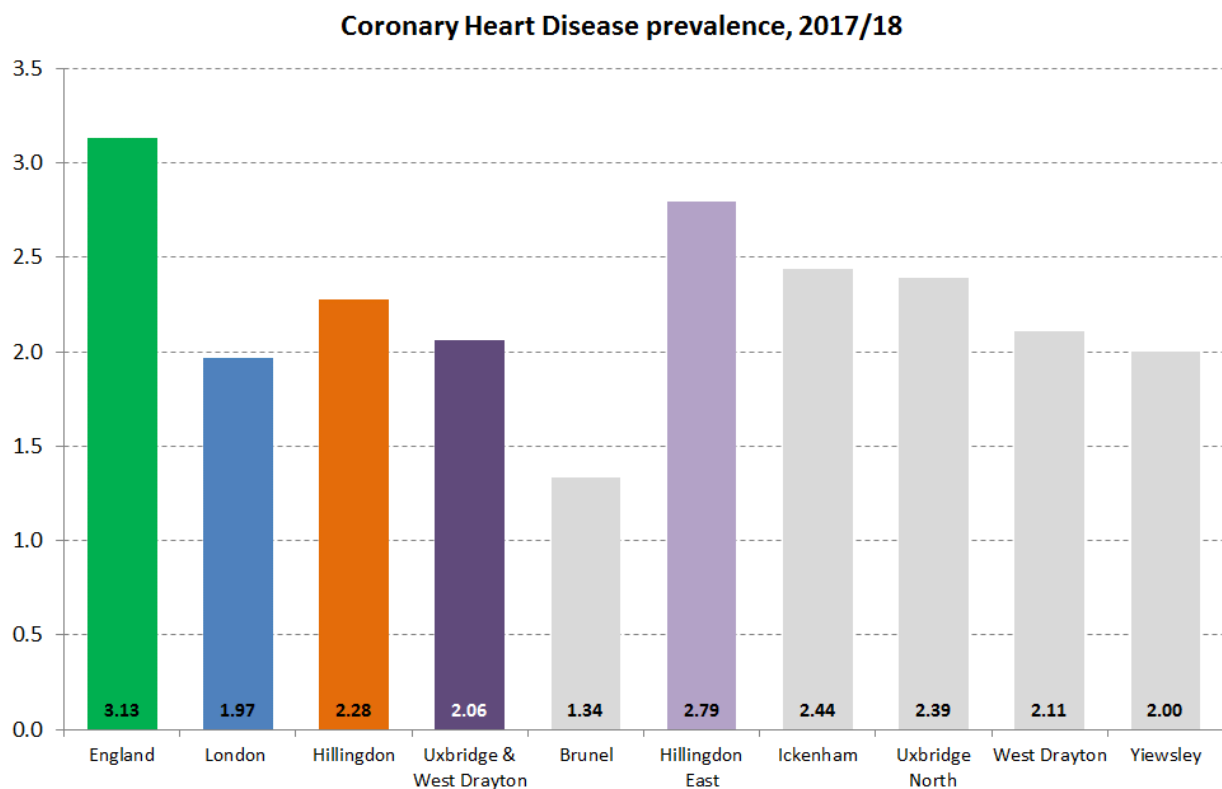
## Observed Prevalence<sup>12</sup>

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18 at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Hillingdon East ward contains one GP surgery (Hillingdon Health Centre).

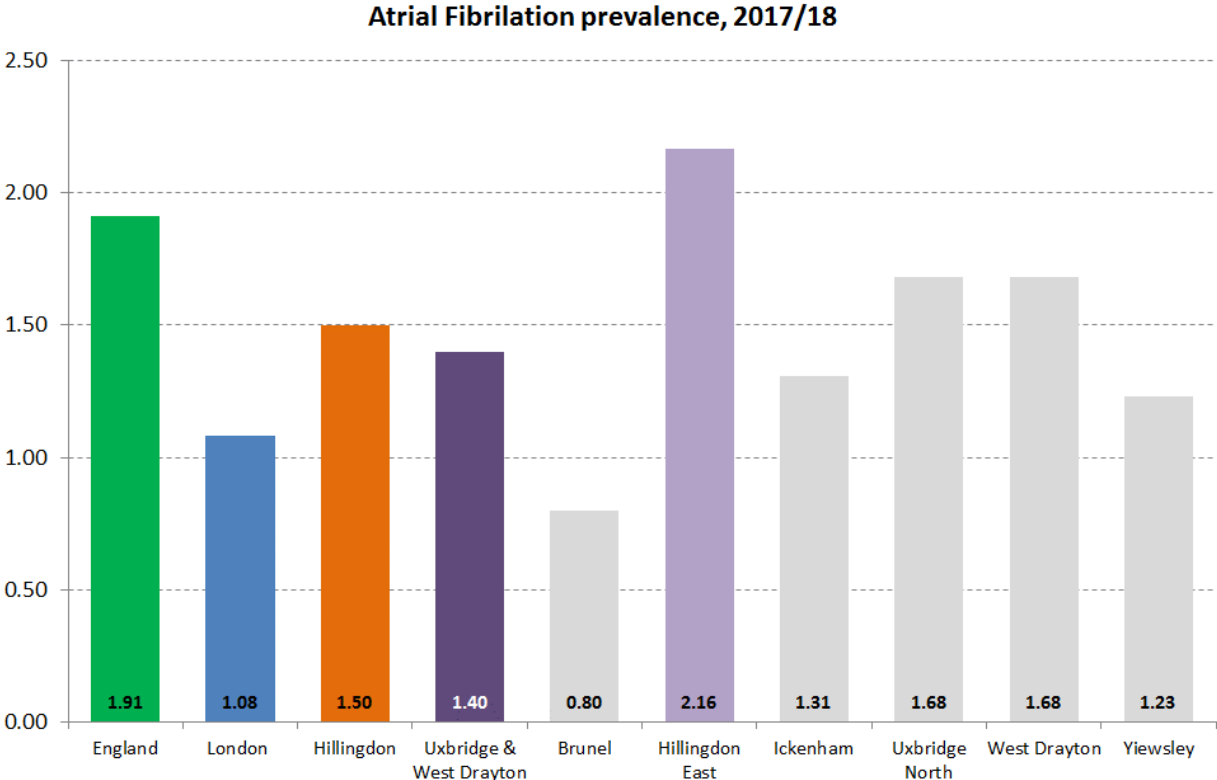
## Cardiovascular conditions

The prevalence of **coronary heart disease** within Hillingdon East is 2.79%; this is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:

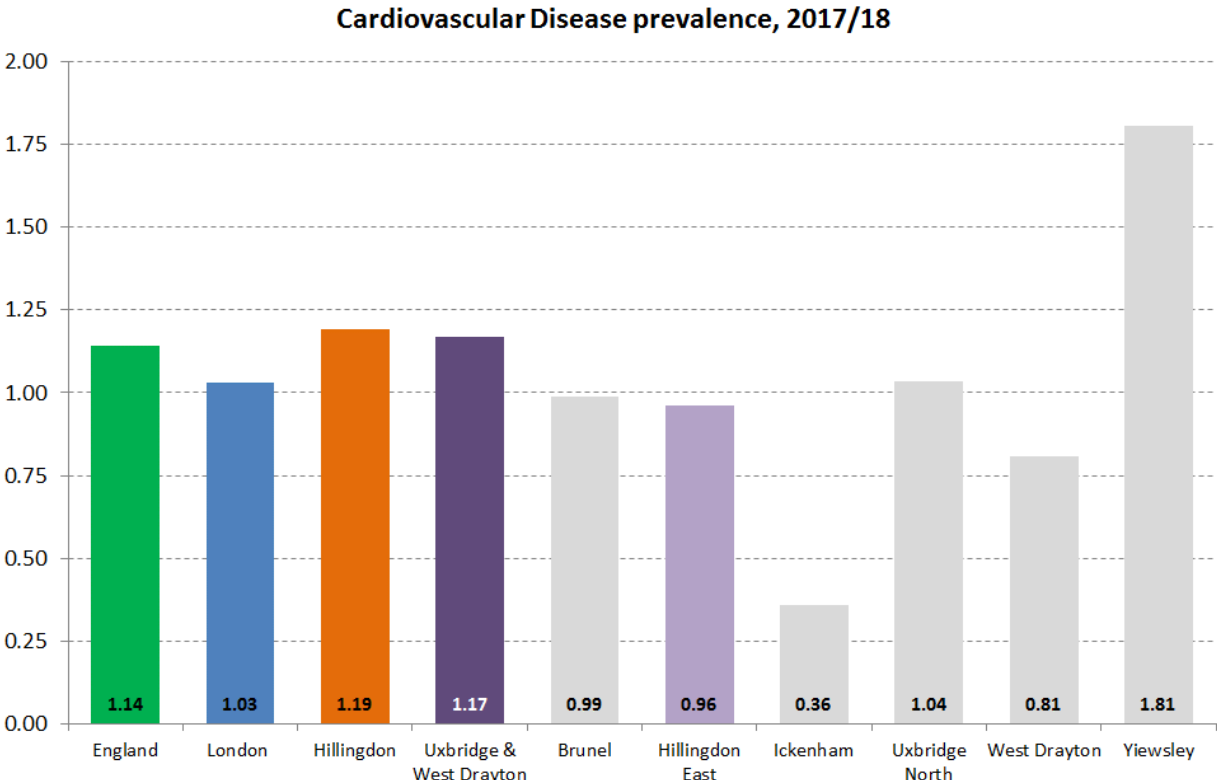

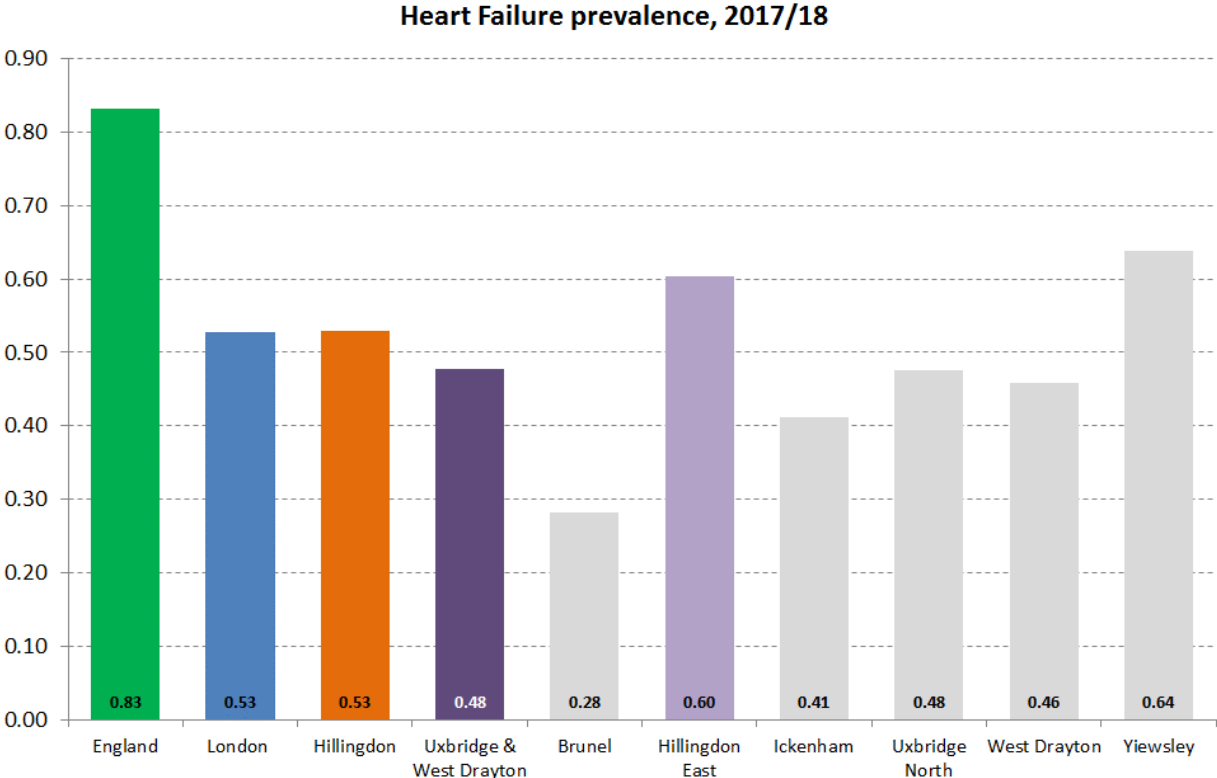

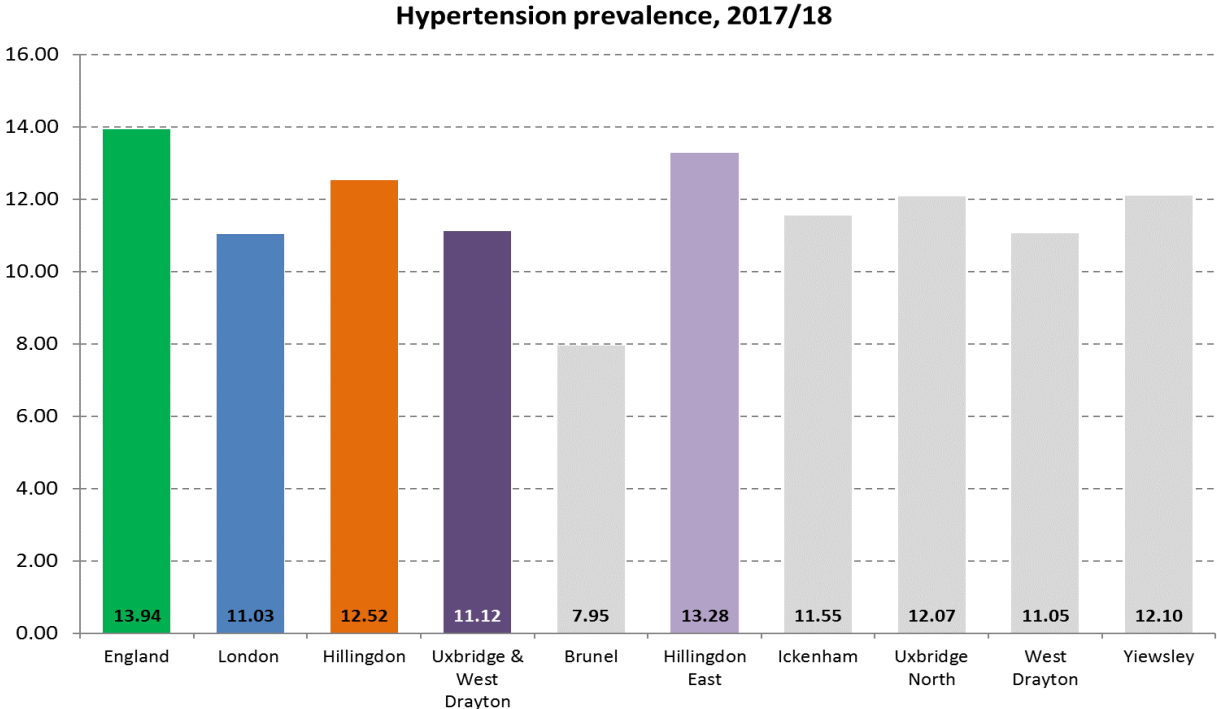

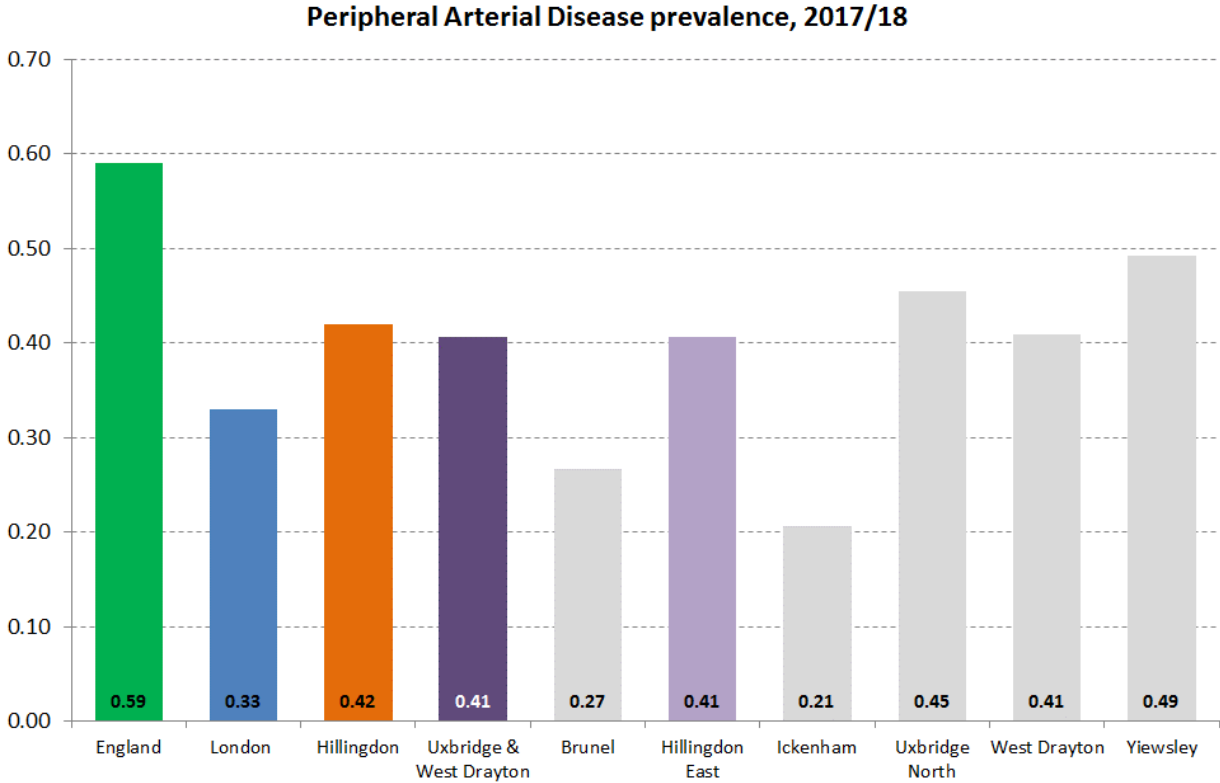


The prevalence of **hypertension** in Hillingdon East is 13.28%, which is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:

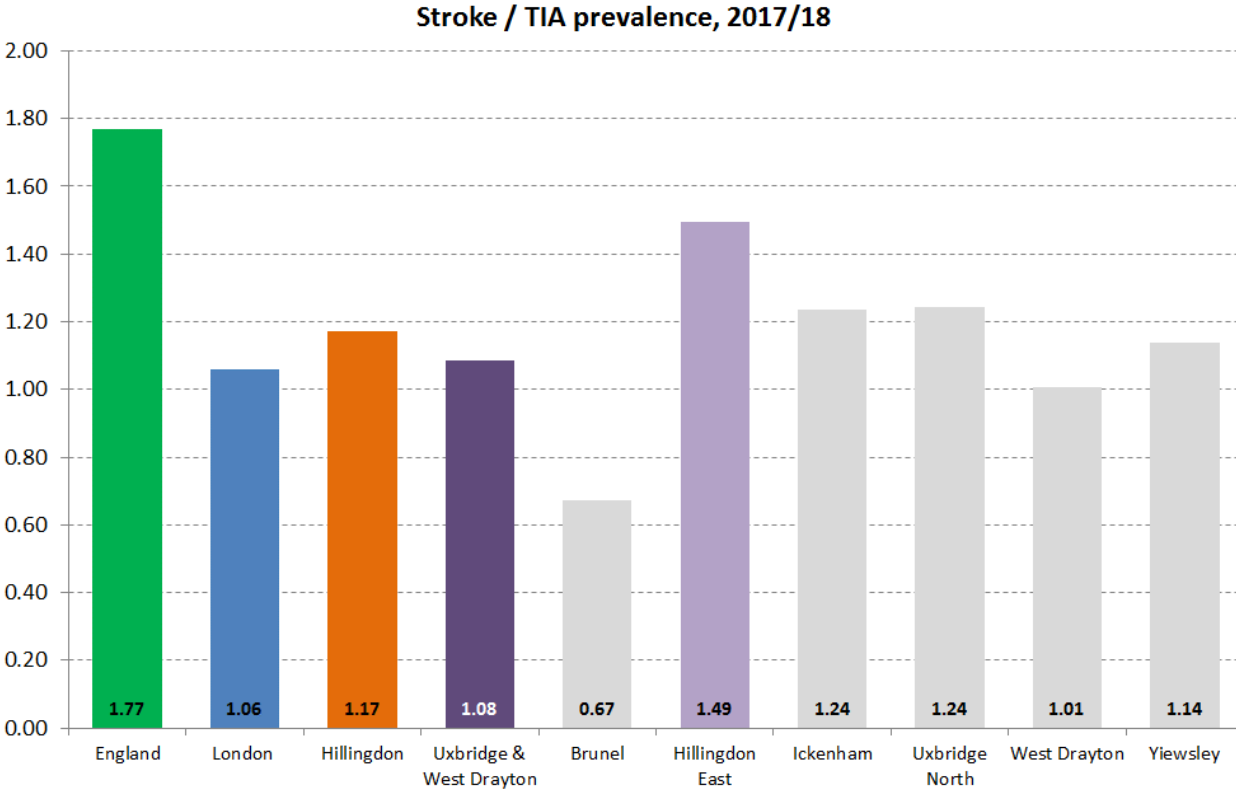

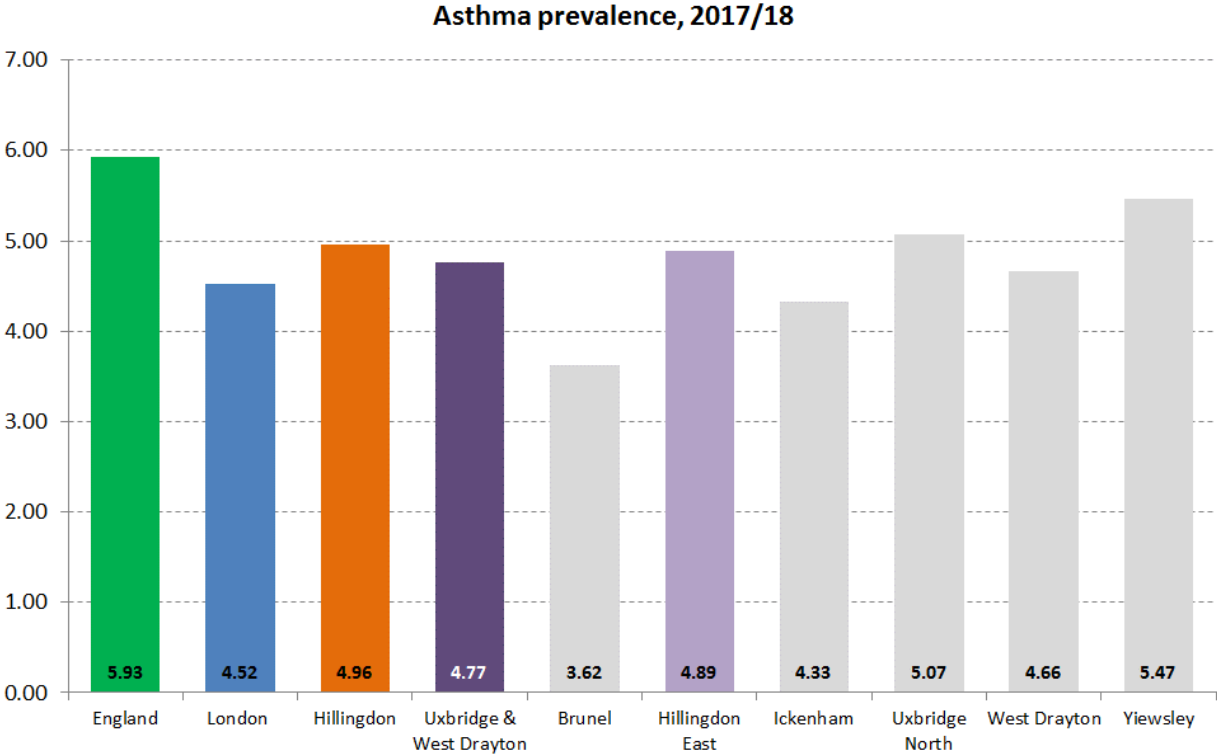


The prevalence of **stroke / transient ischaemic attack (TIA)** is 1.49%, which is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:



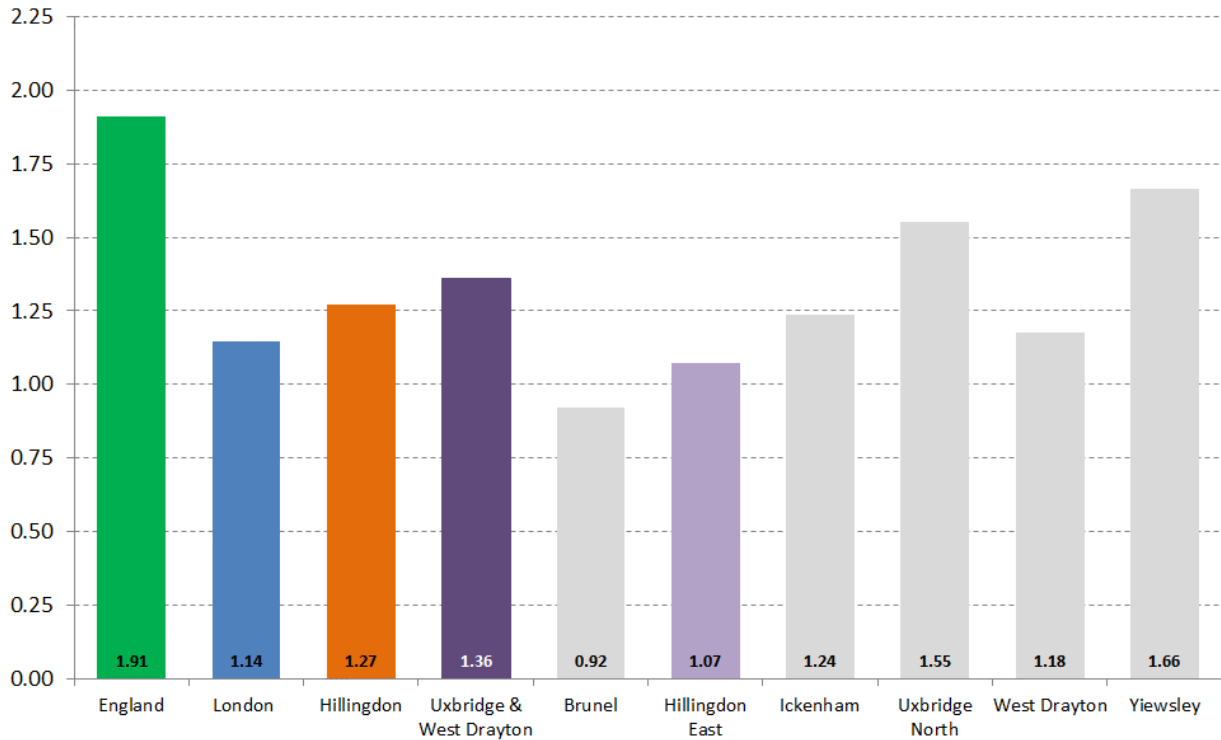

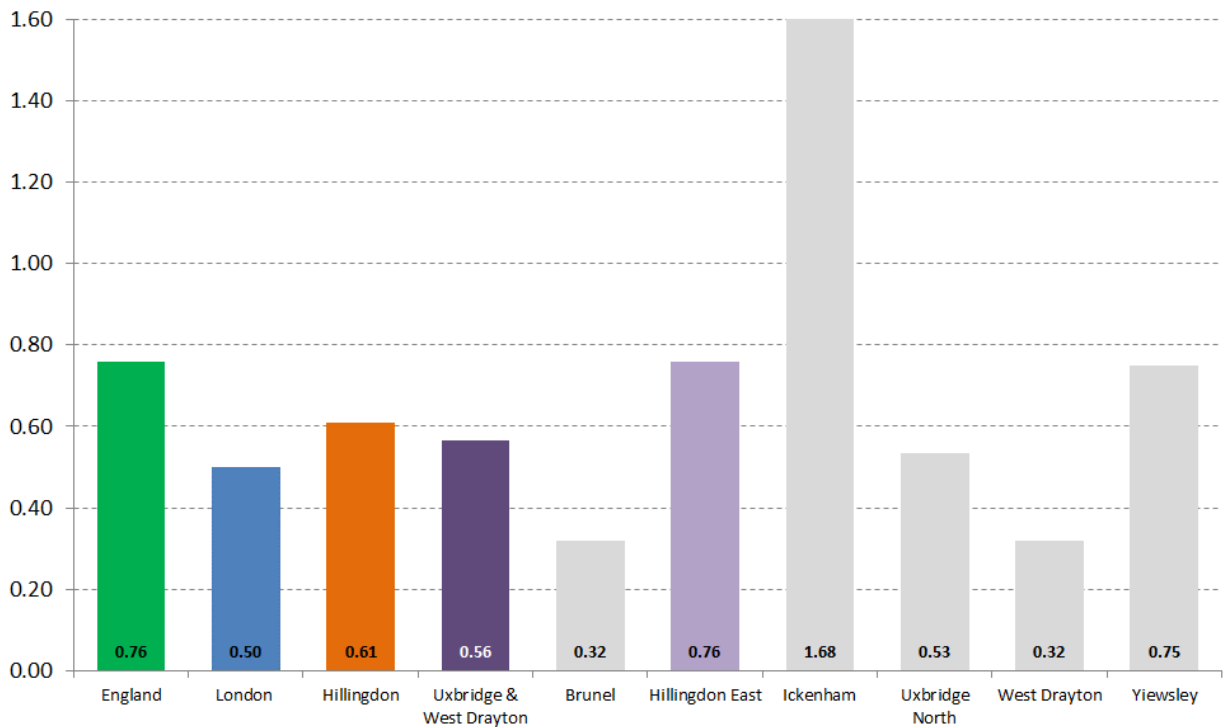
COPD prevalence, 2017/18

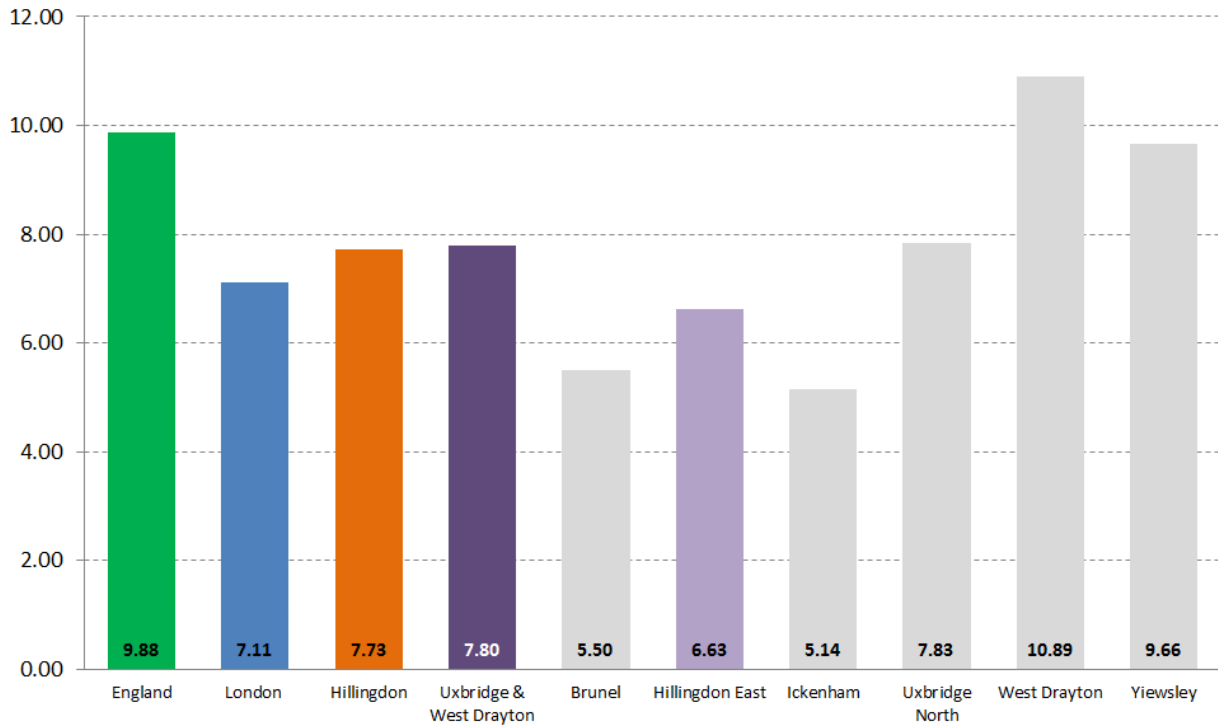

Dementia prevalence, 2017/18



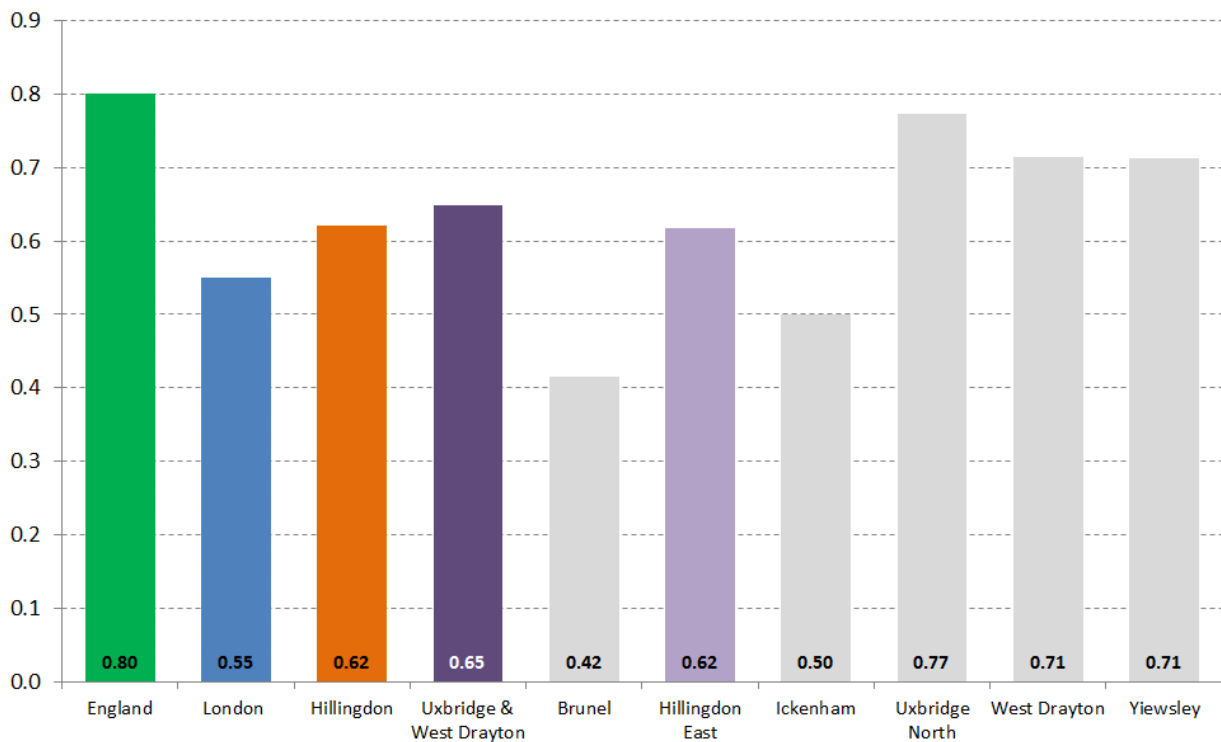

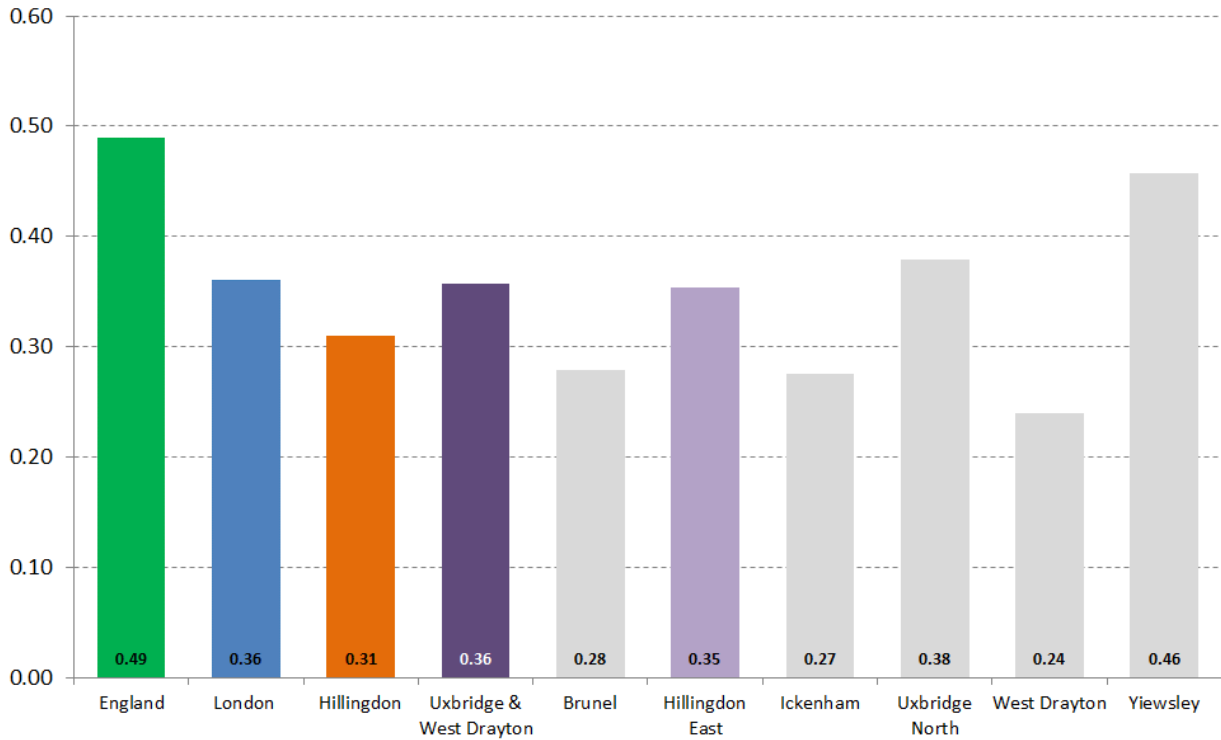
**Epilepsy prevalence, 2017/18**

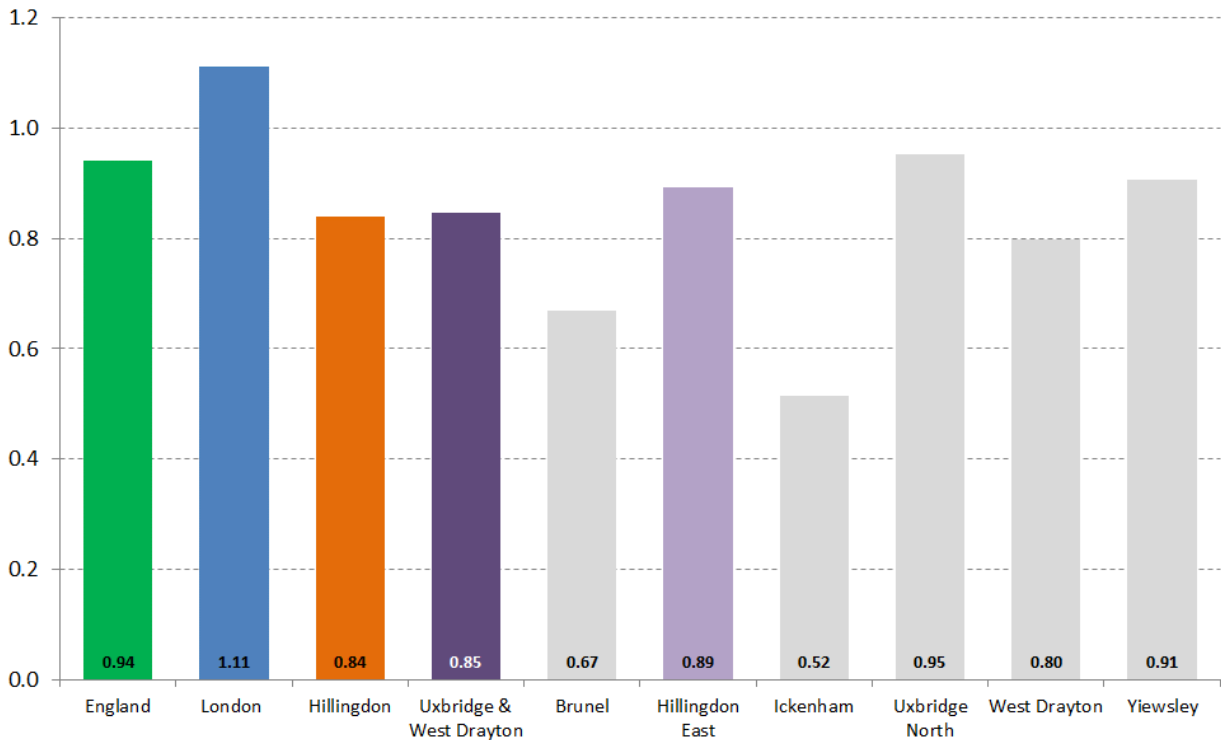

**Learning Disabilities prevalence, 2017/18**



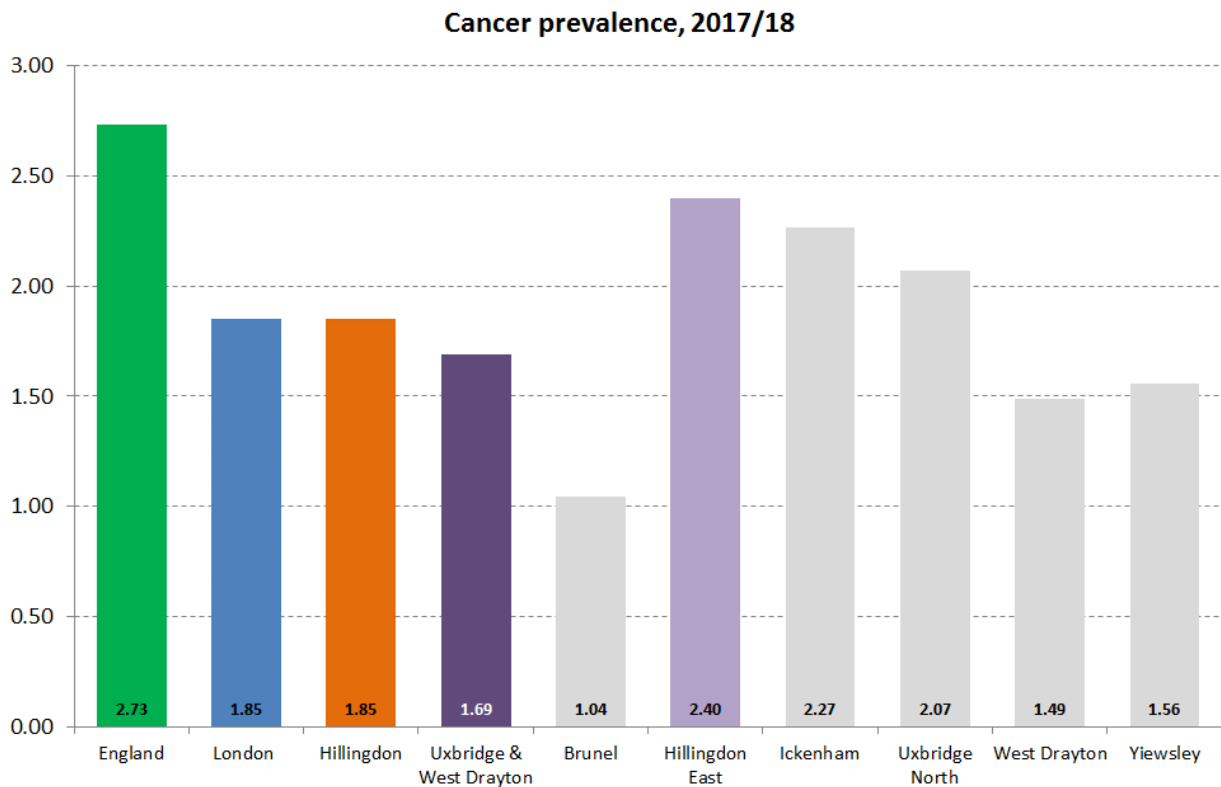

**Mental Health prevalence, 2017/18**

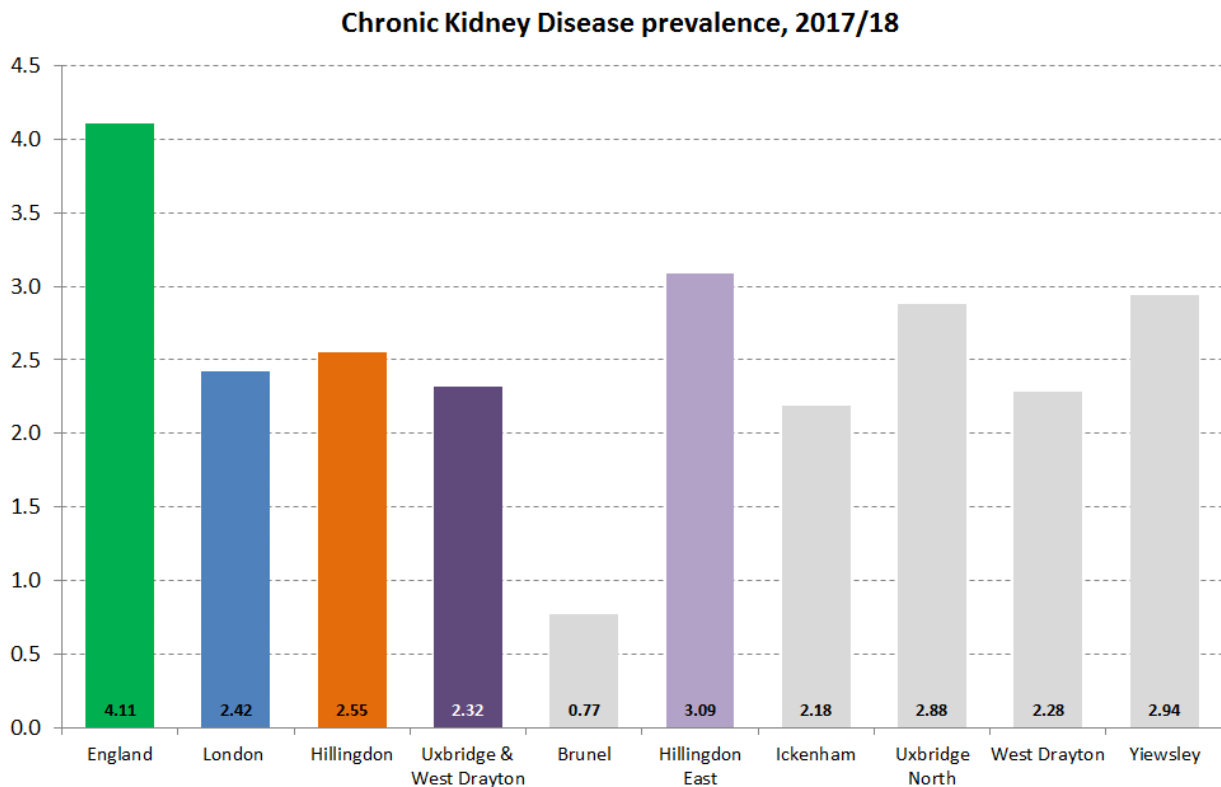

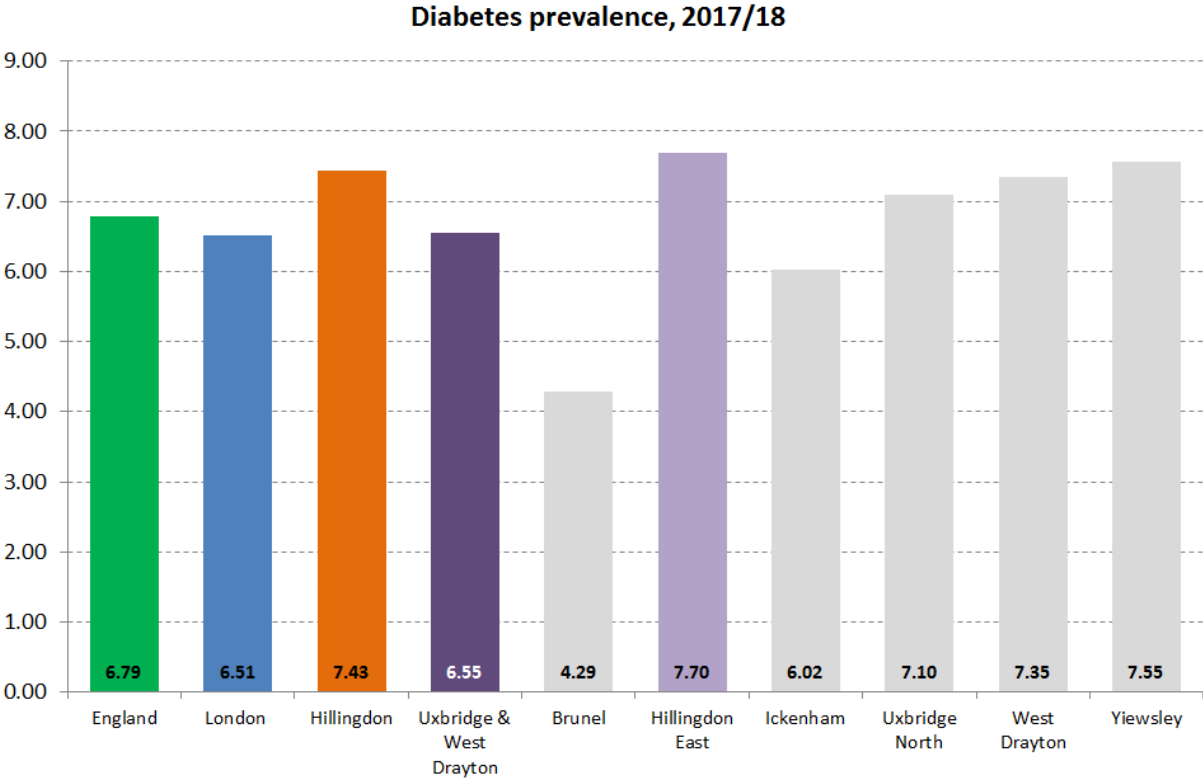

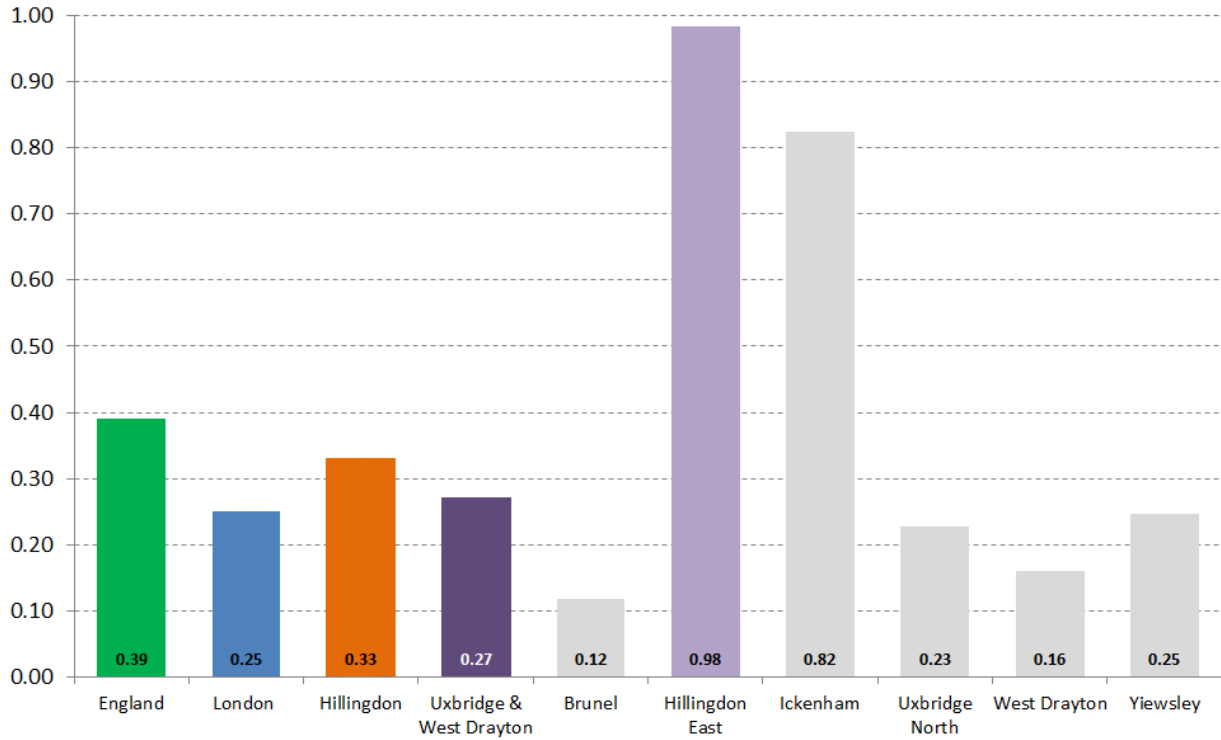

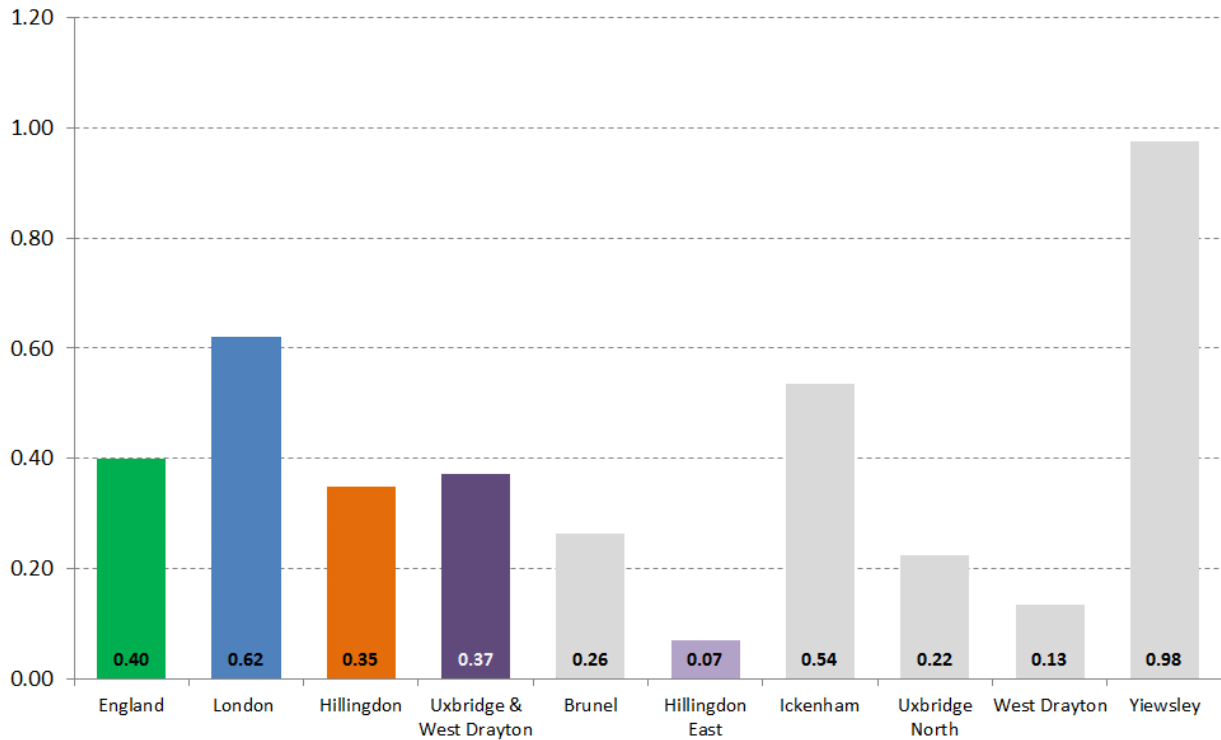
### Palliative Care prevalence, 2017/18

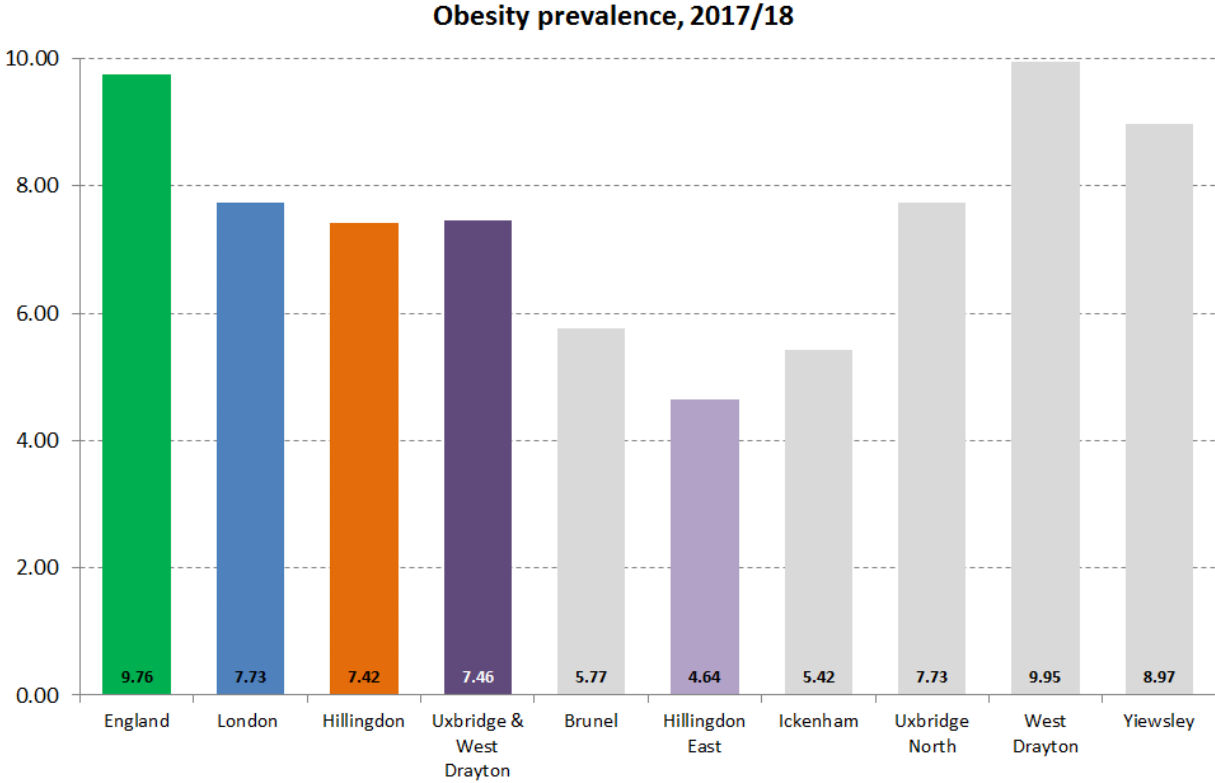

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.

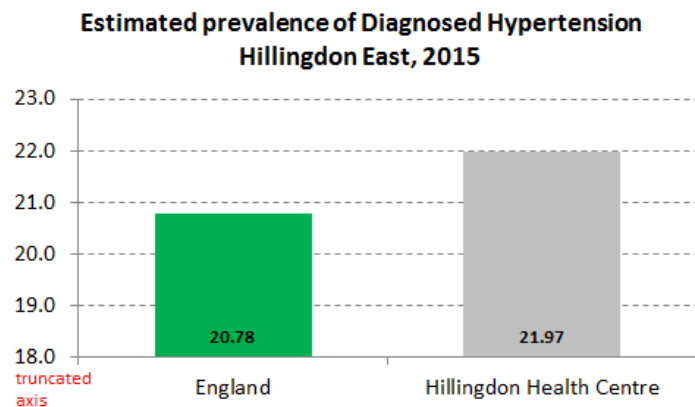

Estimated prevalence is available on a limited number of conditions; data is taken from the latest Disease & Risk Factor Prevalence profile on Fingertips, 2015 (<https://fingertips.phe.org.uk/profile/prevalence>).

Hillingdon East ward contains 1 GP surgery (Hillingdon Health Centre). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

The estimated prevalence within Hillingdon East is higher than England.

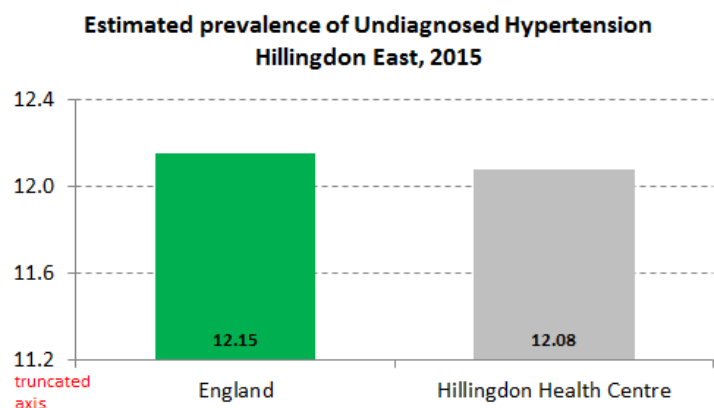

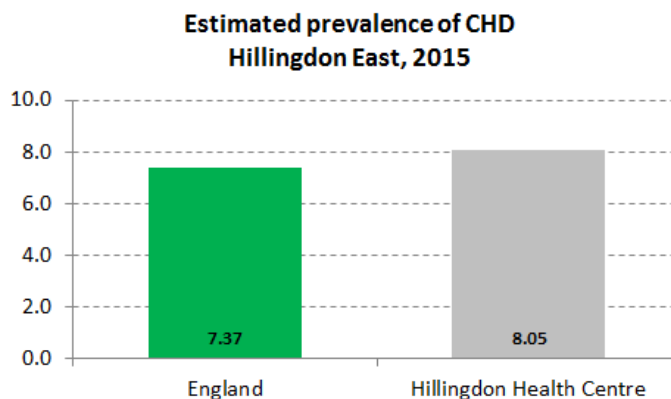

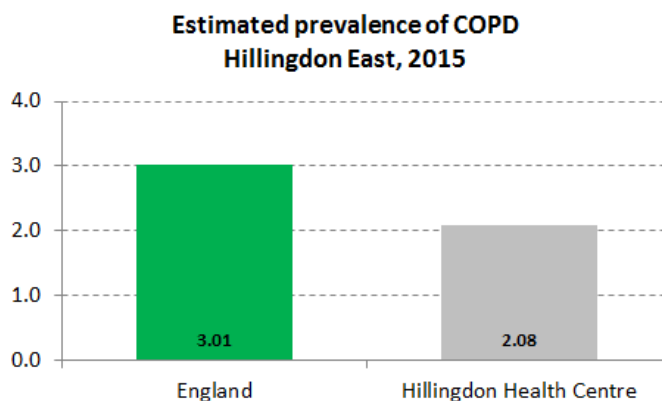

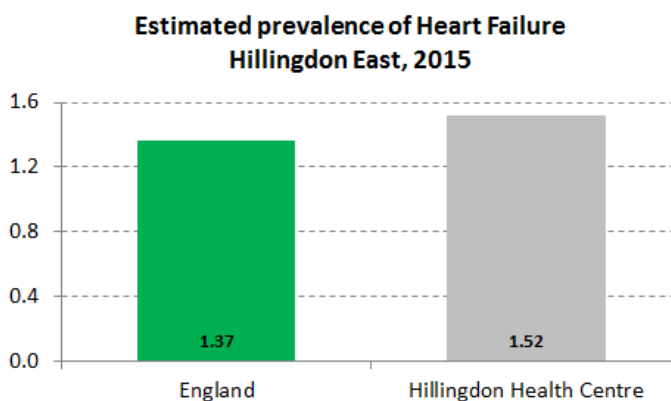

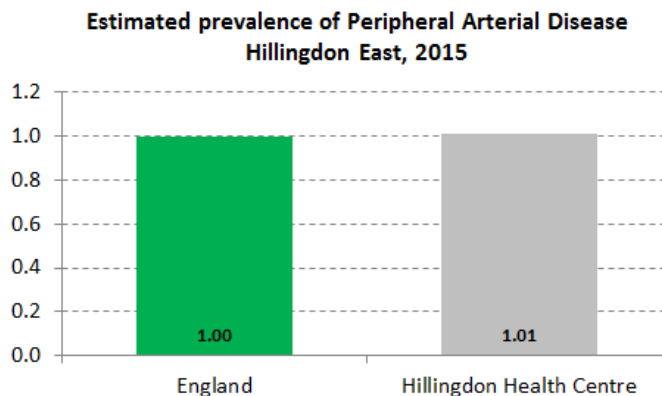

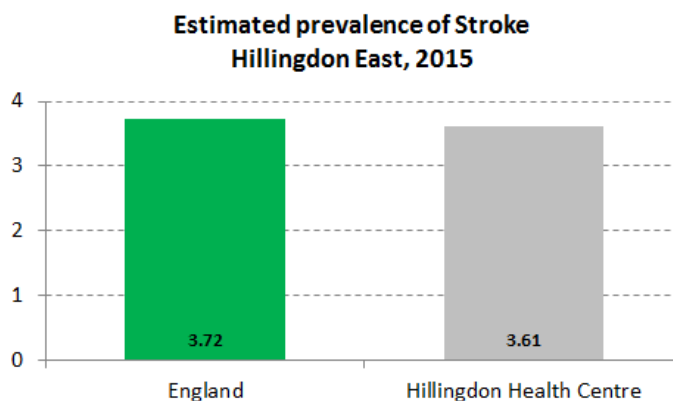

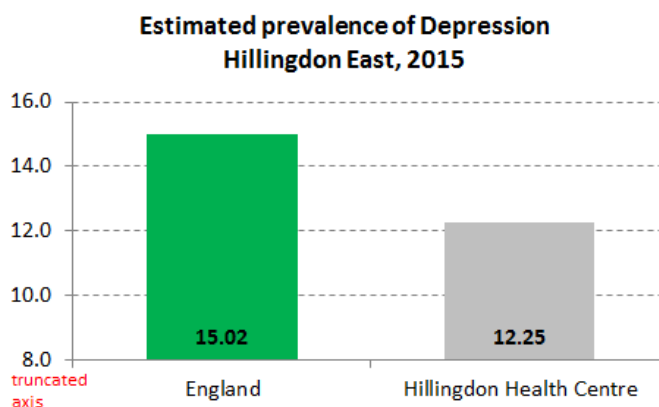
