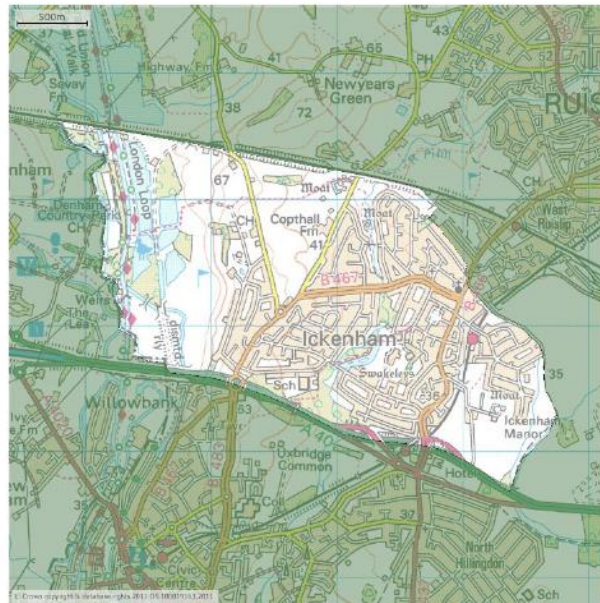

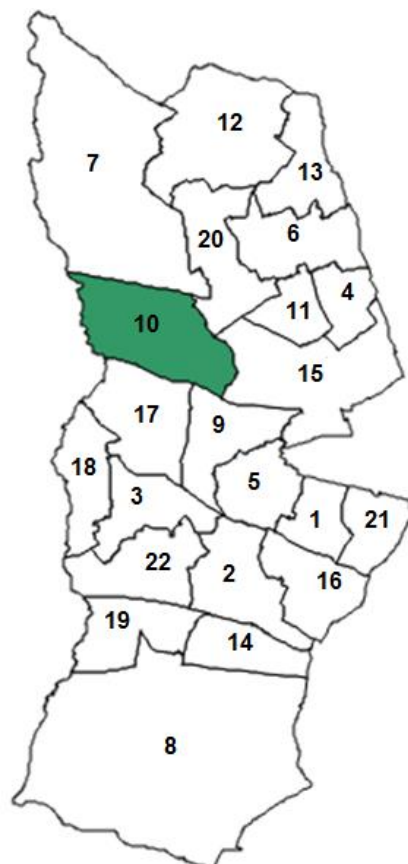

Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- **Population** – comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** – 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- **Age** – 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- **Ethnicity** - Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- **Religion¹** - the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian – 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim – 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu – 22,033 (8%) and Sikh – 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' – 46,492 (17%) and other – 23,303 (8.5%).

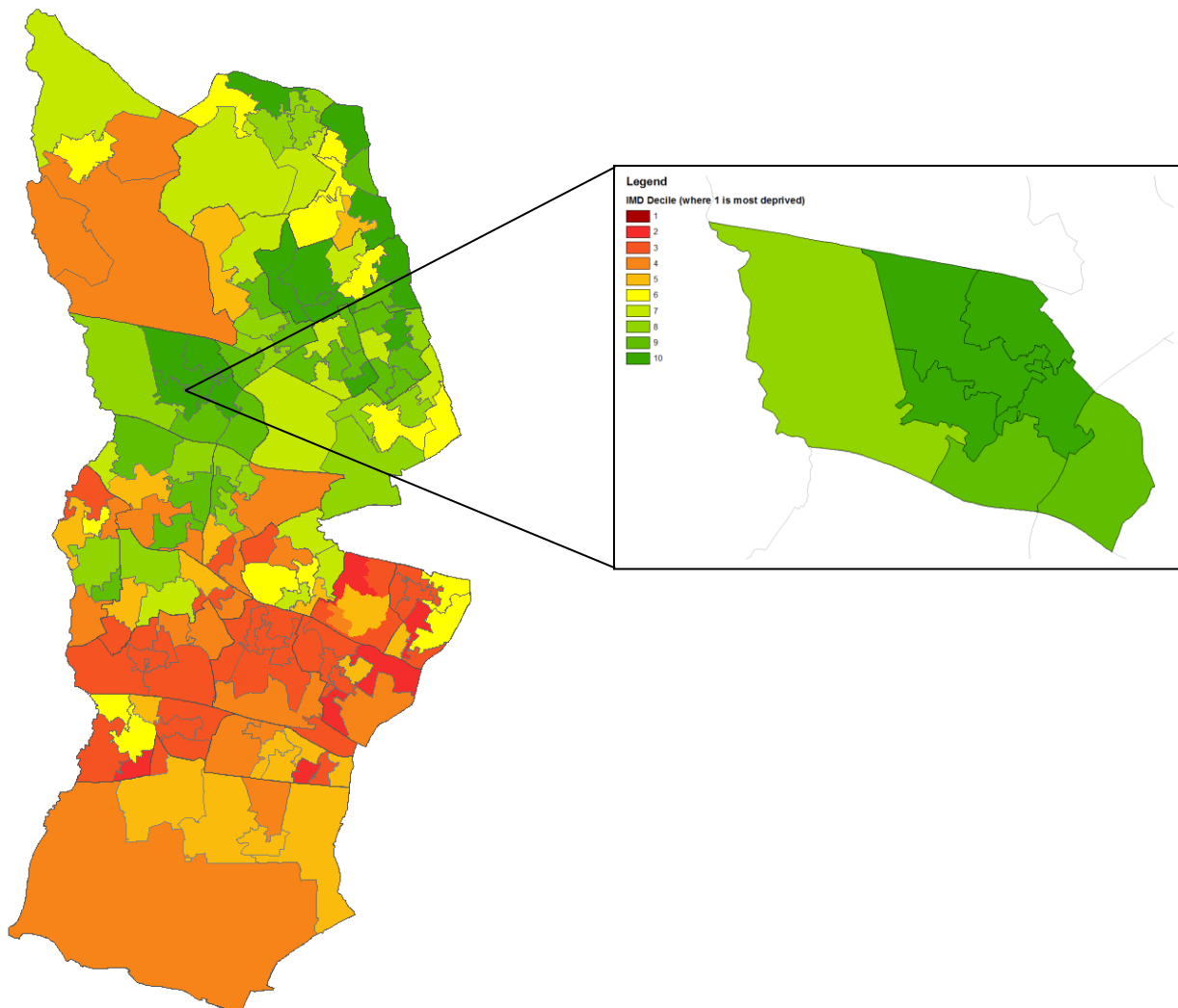
Ickenham Ward

Ickenham lies in the West of Hillingdon and is bordered by Harefield, West Ruislip, South Ruislip, Hillingdon East and Uxbridge North, as well as Buckinghamshire.

In 2017², Ickenham population is 10,972 residents, an increase of 5.6% since 2011 (10,387); this is below the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Ickenham is made up of 620.7 hectares (6.2 km^{sq}), with 17.7 people per hectare (1,768 per km^{sq}) making it one of the least densely populated ward in the borough. The average number of people per household in Ickenham is 2.7³.

Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Ickenham, which is made up of seven LSOA areas⁴.

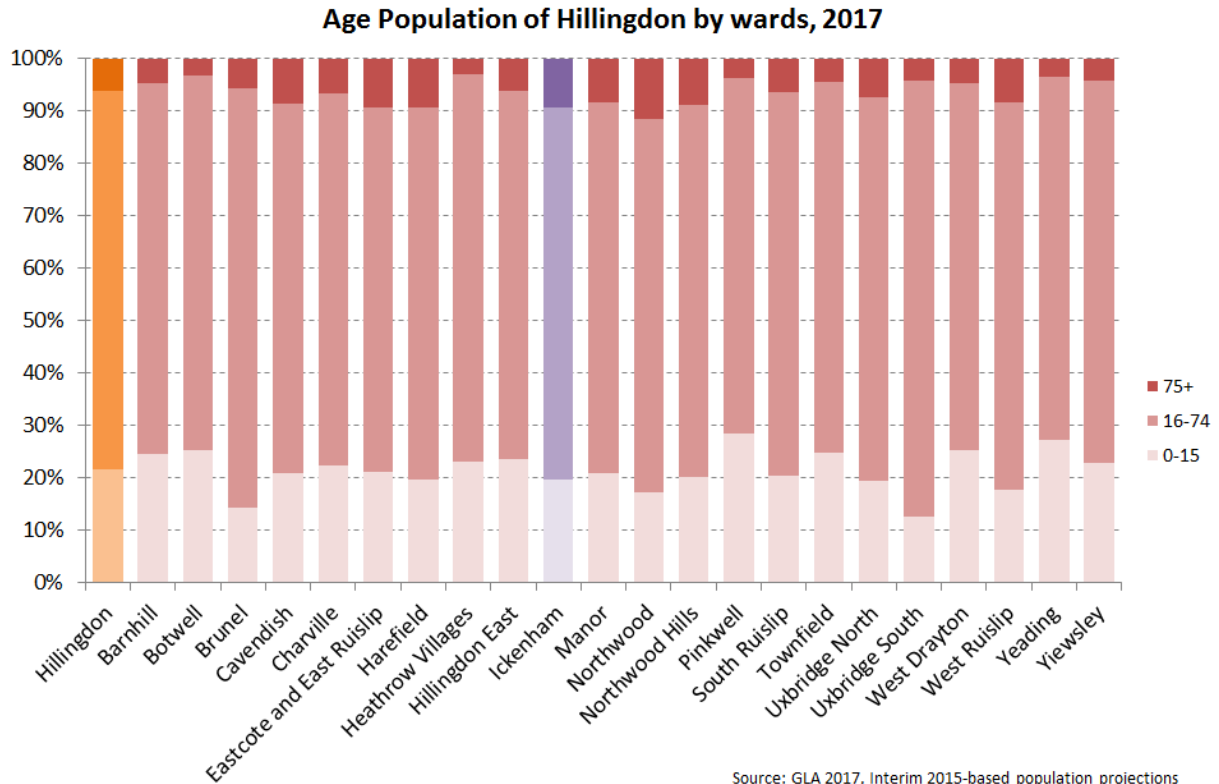

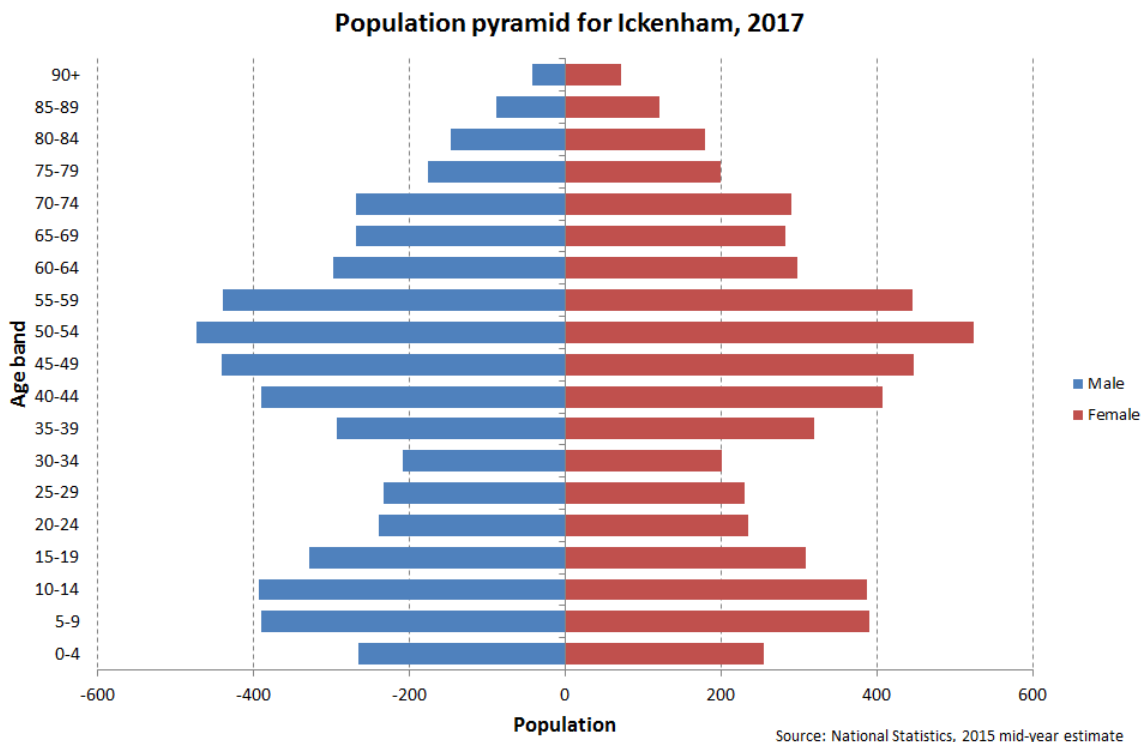

Ward Population:



The chart above shows that 19.8% of Ickenham’s residents are under the age of 16. 70.9% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 9.3% are over the age of 75.

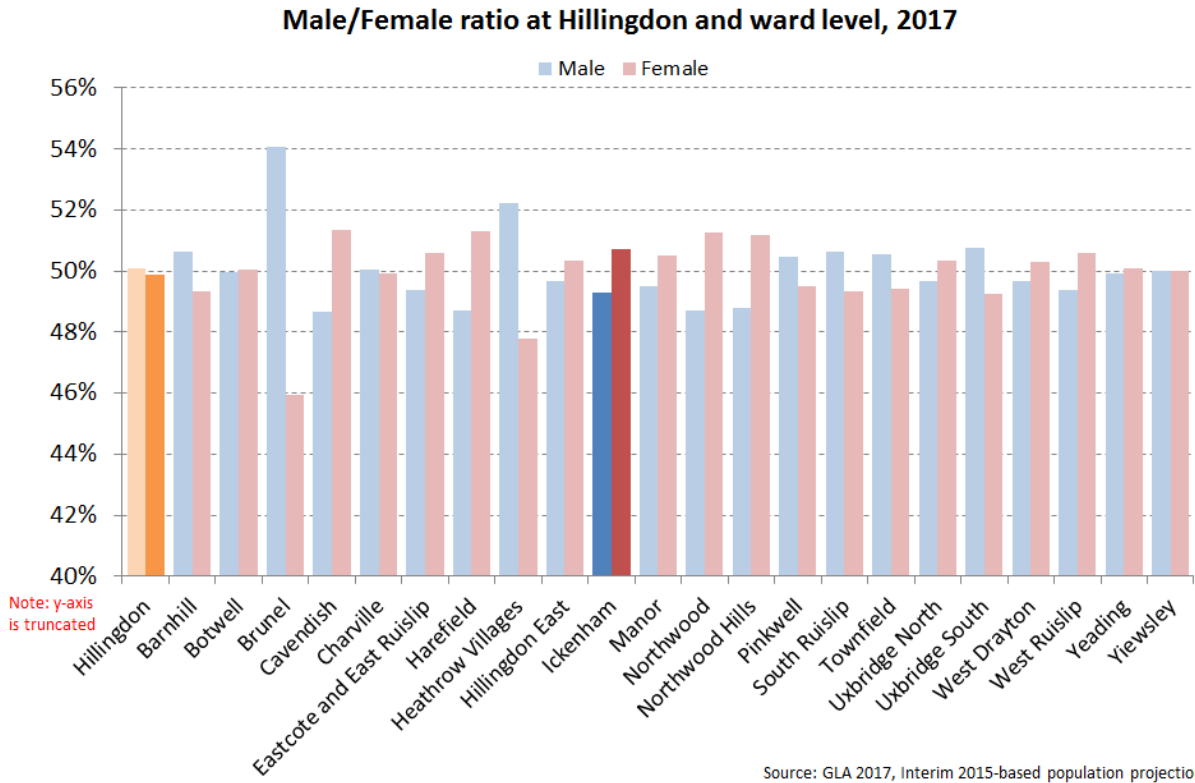
The chart below shows that in Ickenham, there are higher number males and females aged 50-54 years compared to other age groups.



Gender

The proportion of men to women in the ward is 49.3% to 50.7%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 48.7% to 51.3% male to female ratio in the ward.

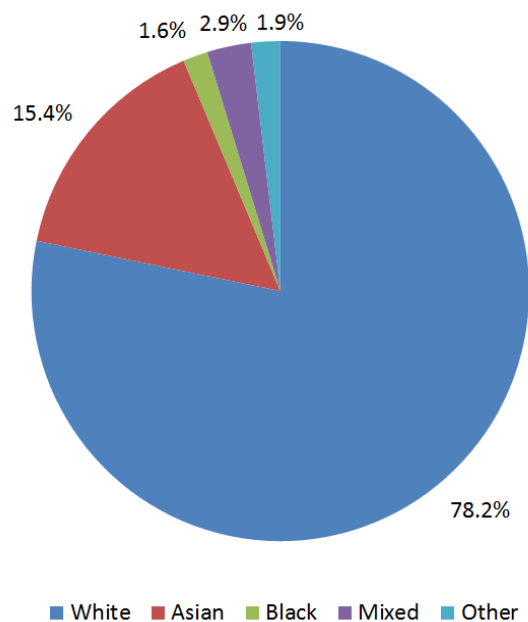
The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:



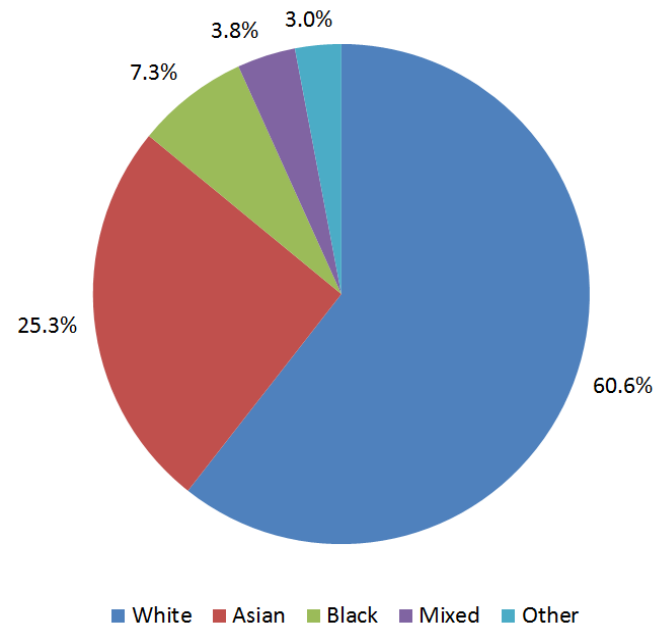
Ethnic make up 2011⁵

In the 2011 census, 78.2% of residents in the ward identify themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 2.9% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 15.4% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 1.6% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 1.9% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:



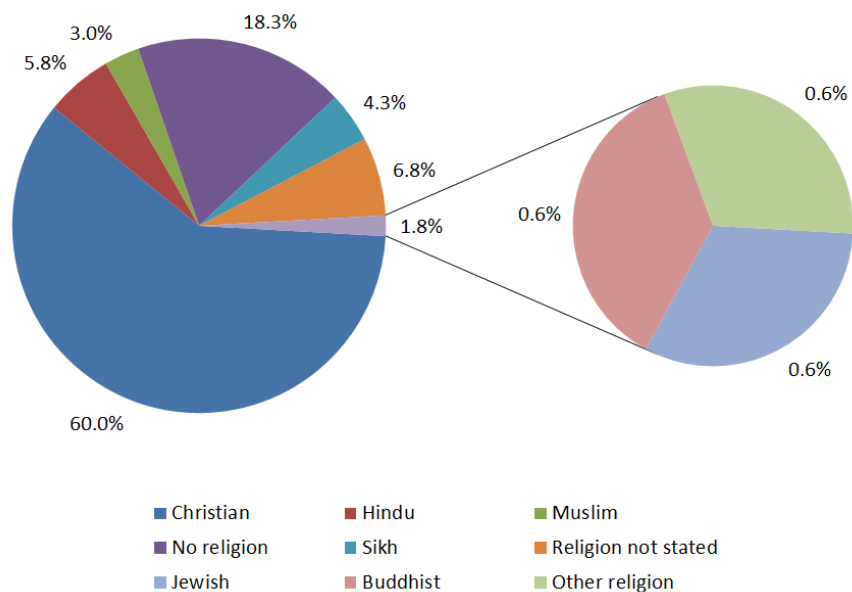

Religion⁶

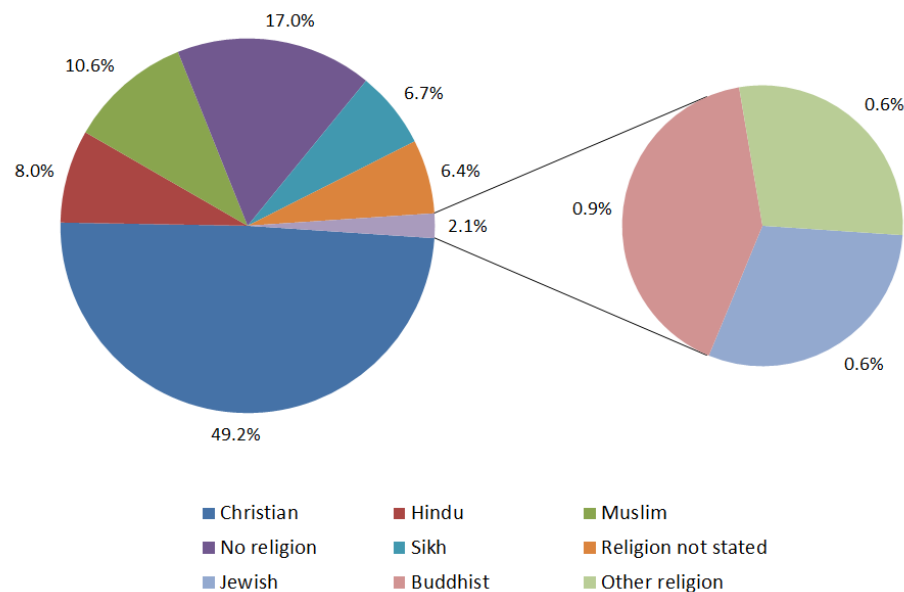
Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 60.0% from this faith. 5.8% are Hindu, 3.0% Muslim, 4.3% Sikh and 18.3% having no religion. 6.8% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary).

Ickenham, Religion 2011:



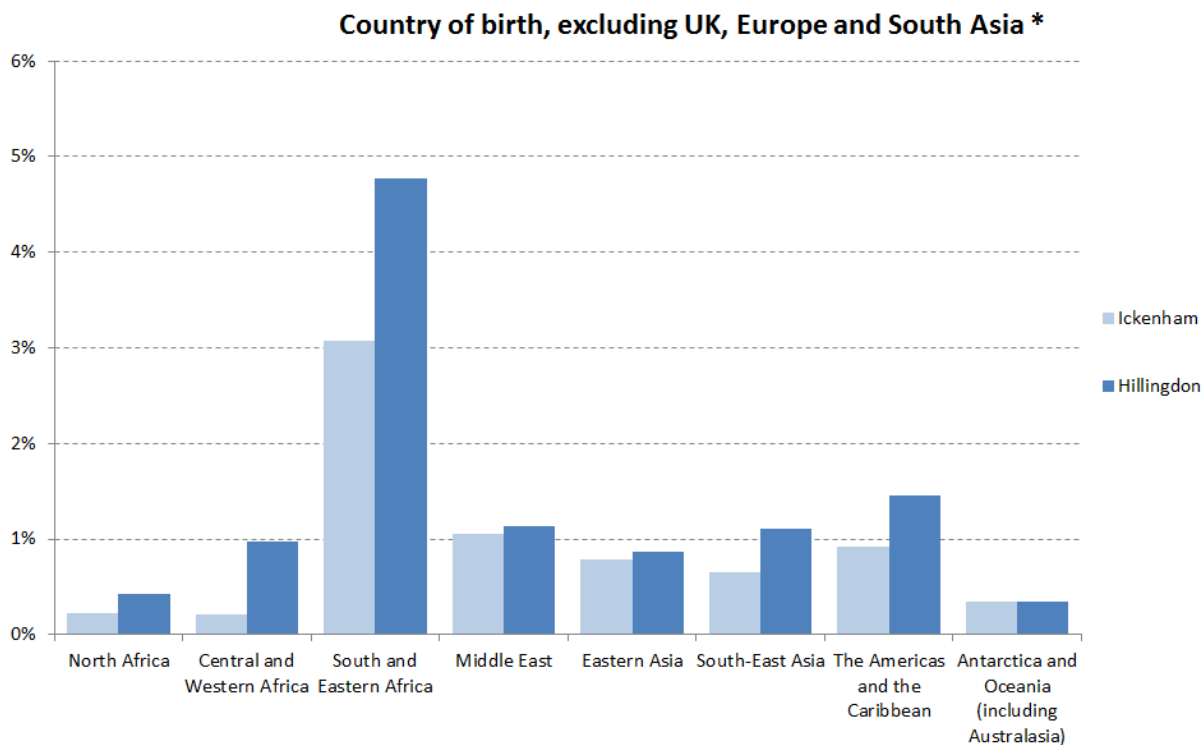
Hillingdon, Religion 2011:

Country of Birth⁷

Of those living in Ickenham, 88.6% were **born** in Europe (with 84.1% in the UK), 1.1% in the Middle East / Asia, 3.6% in Africa, and 1.3% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Ickenham, 15.9% were **born** outside of the UK (with 84.1% in the UK). In Ickenham, 45.4% were **born** outside of the UK (with 54.6% in the UK).

Ickenham has the highest number of residents stating they were born in Sri Lanka (14.9% of borough residents, 640); the ward has the second highest number of residents stating they were born in India (12% of borough residents, 1620).

The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 93.4% residents stating this at their main language. Of the remaining 6.6%, the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well', with 73 residents (11.0% of those where English is not their main language) stating they cannot speak English well or at all⁸.

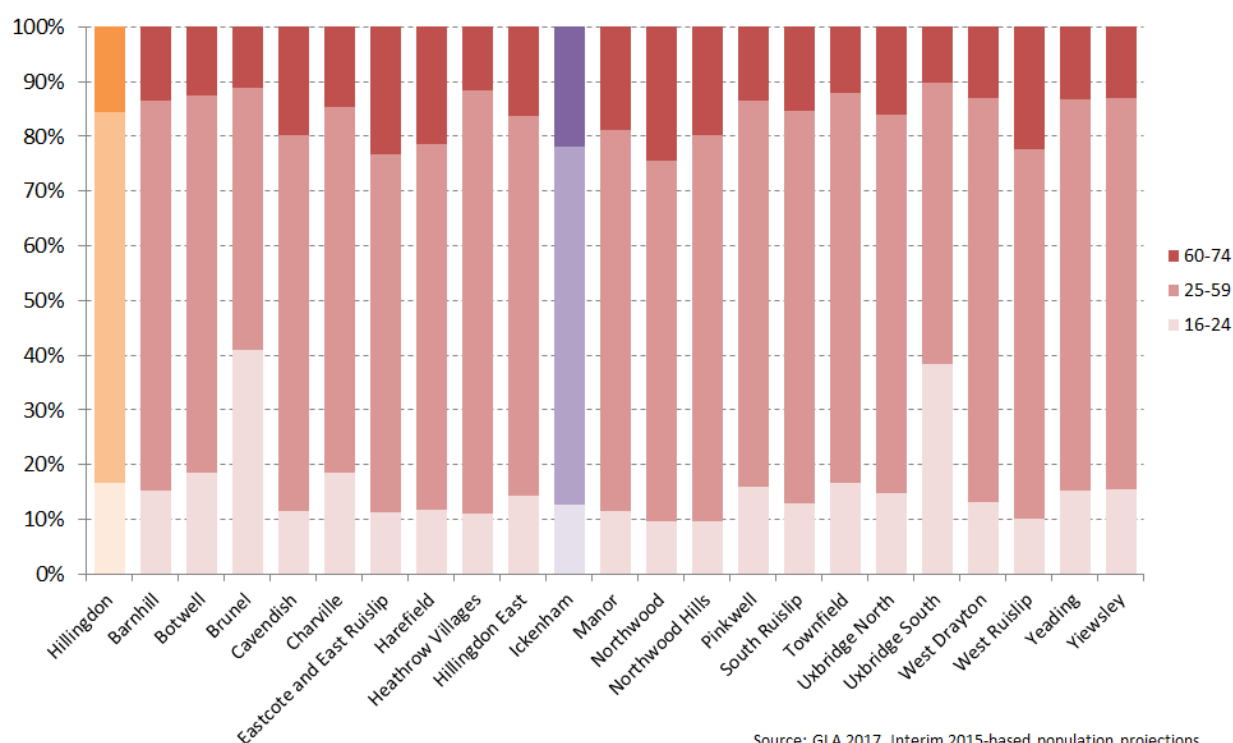
English is the most spoken language in the ward with 9,434 residents (93.4%) having it as their main language. Panjabi is the next most commonly spoken language within the ward with 1.2% (125), followed by Gujarati with 1.1% (112).

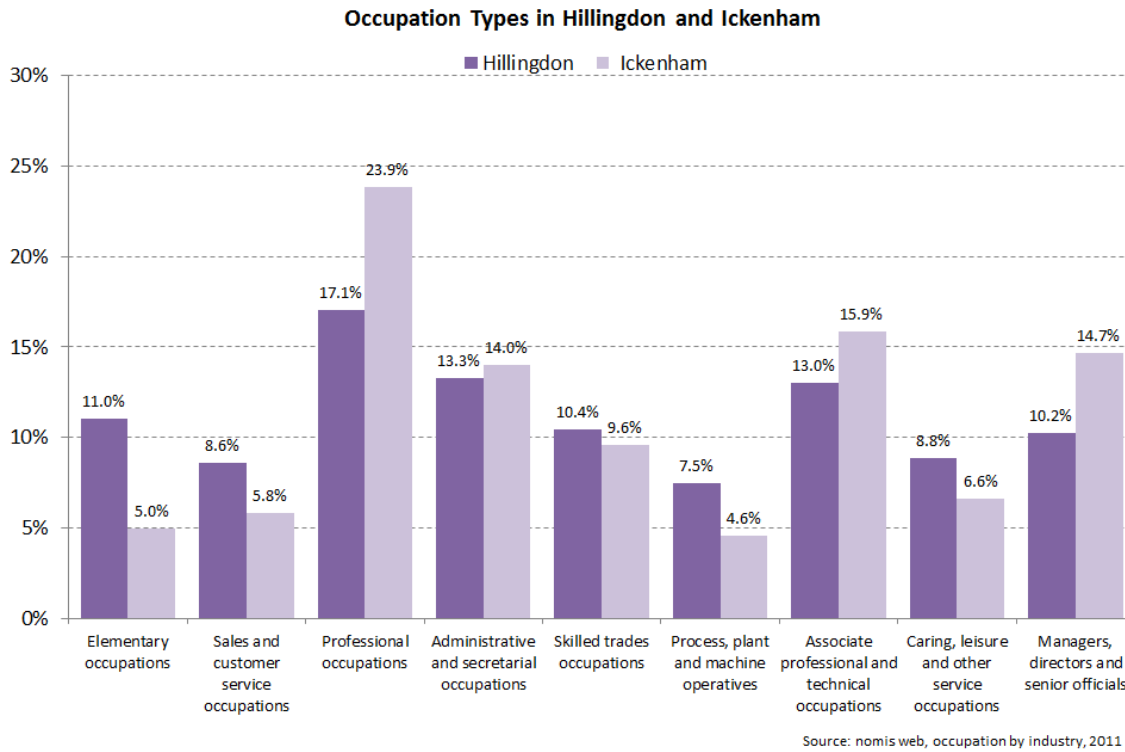
In Ickenham, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 12.8% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 65.3%, the remaining 21.9% are from the 60-74 age group.

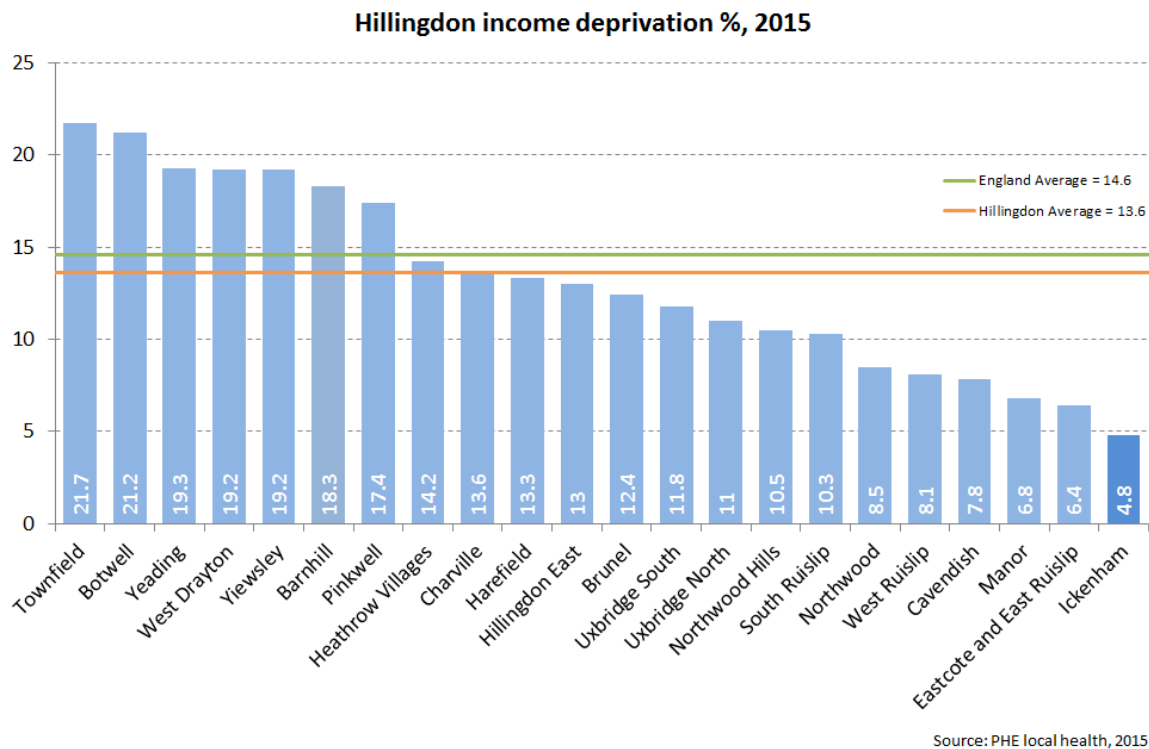
In Ickenham, 71.9% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:

The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Ickenham is 4.8%; making it the least deprived ward in the borough.

Households

In 2017, there were 4,127 households¹⁰ in Ickenham; an increase of 68 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**¹¹ within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 90.6%, with 9.4% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).

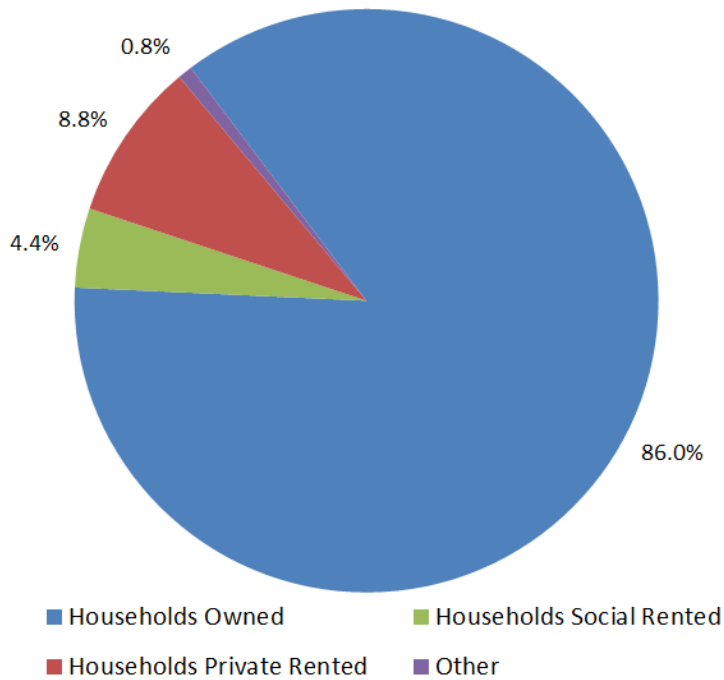

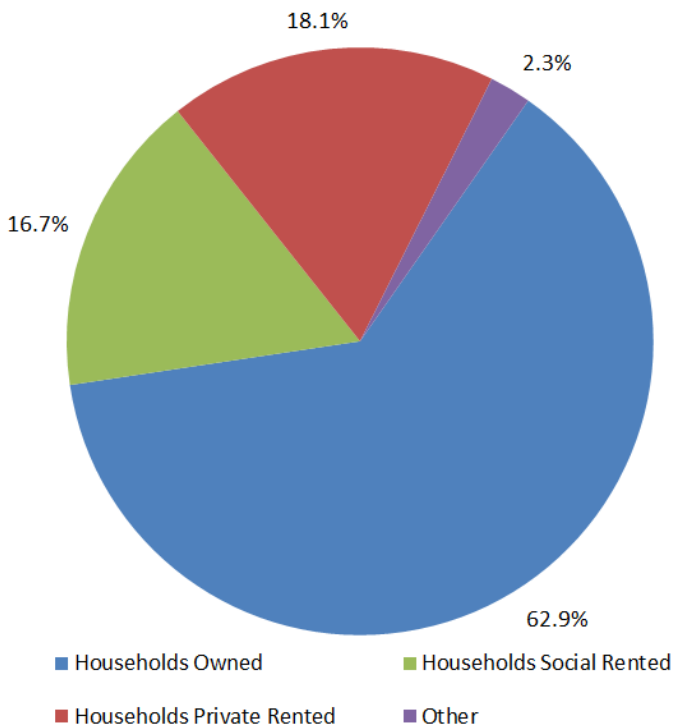

In Ickenham, 86.0% of ward residents own their own homes, followed by 8.8% of properties being privately rented, 4.4% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 0.8 other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.

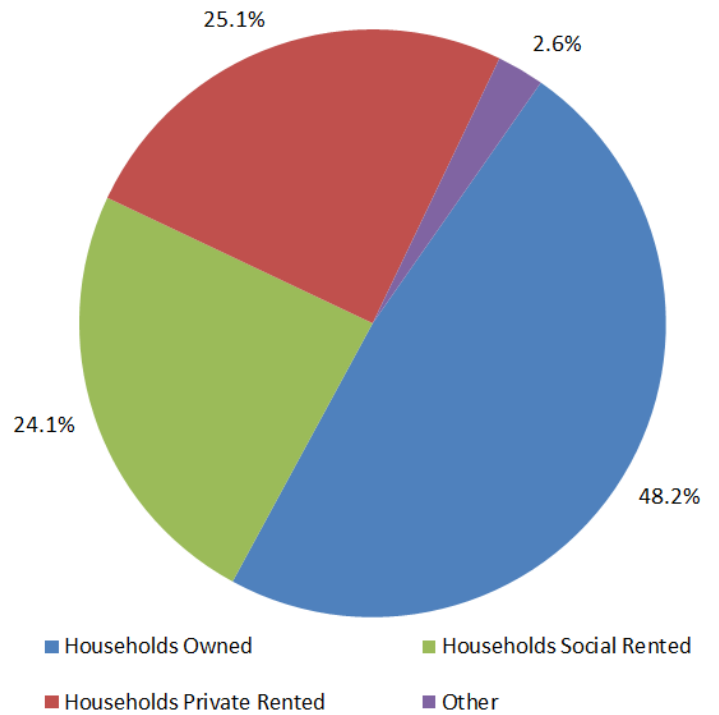
Household Type Ickenham



Household Type Hillingdon



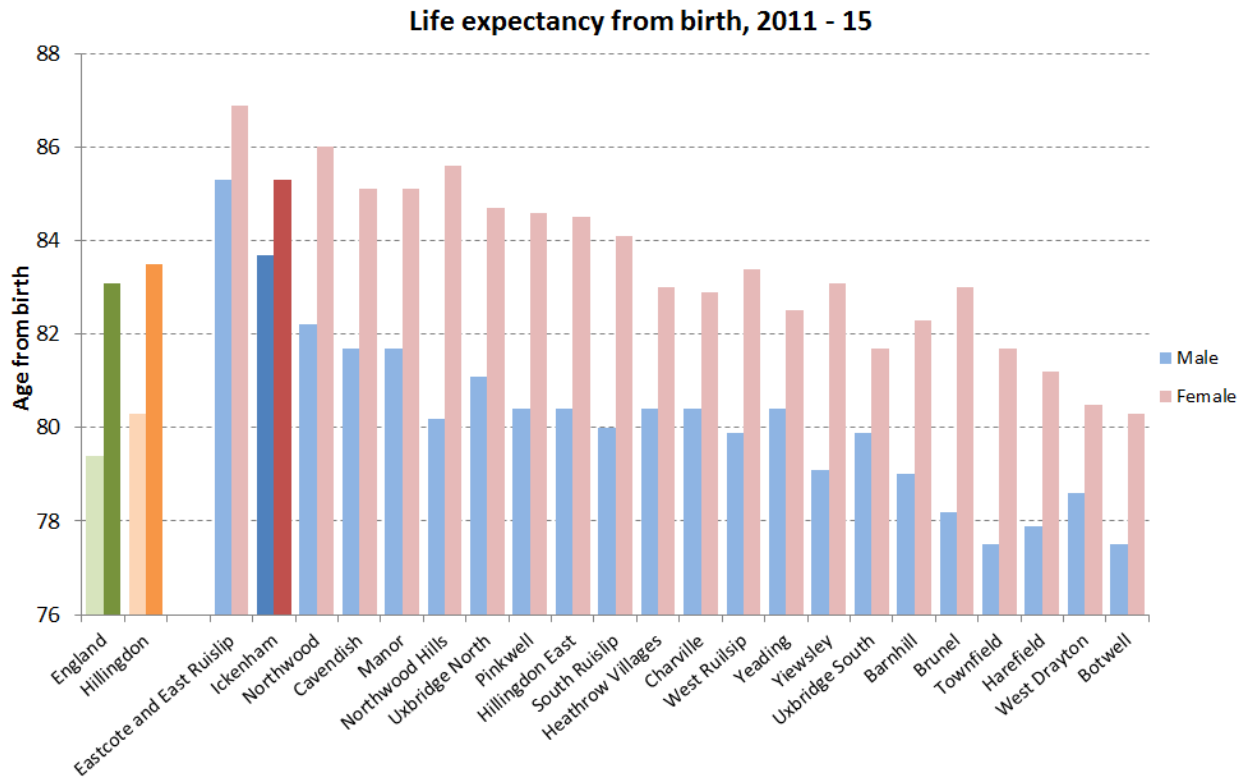
Household Type London

Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Ickenham, the life expectancy is estimated at 83.7 years for males and 85.3 years for females. This is above the averages for both Hillingdon and England.



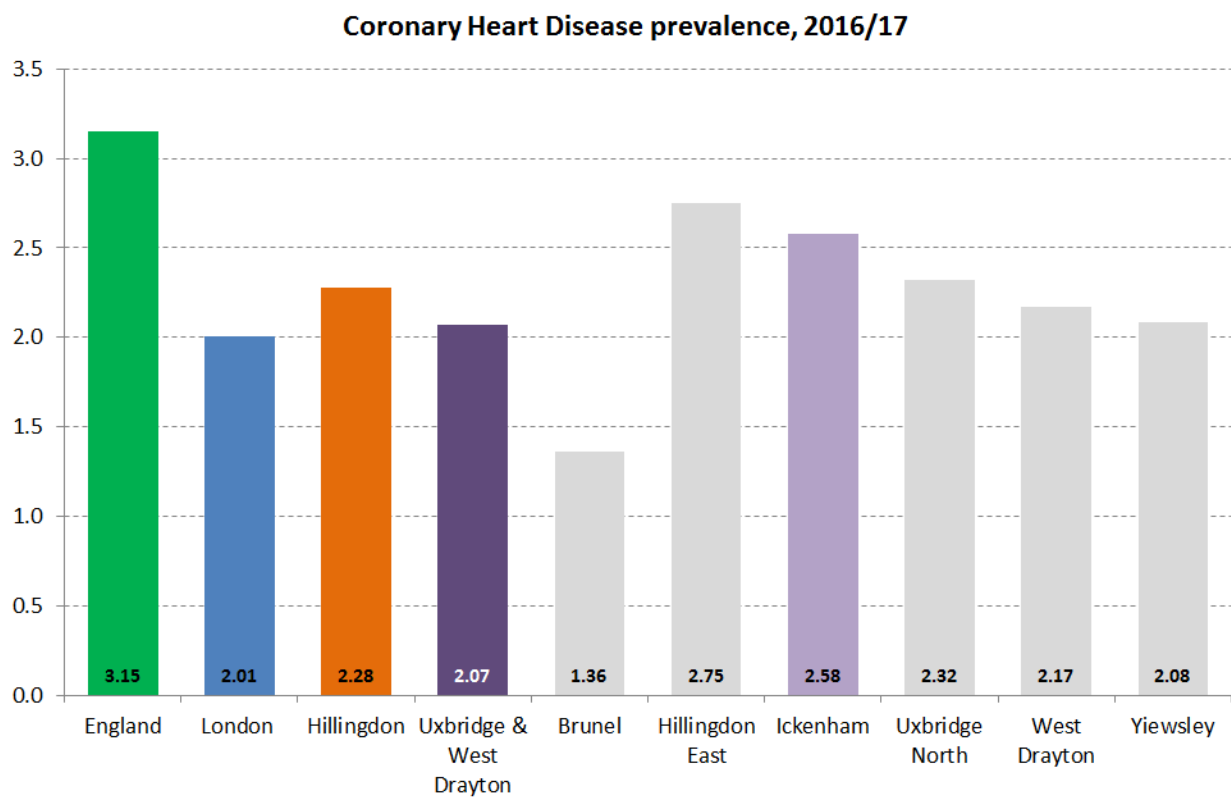
Observed Prevalence¹²

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2016/17, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Ickenham ward contains one GP surgery (Wallasey Medical Centre).

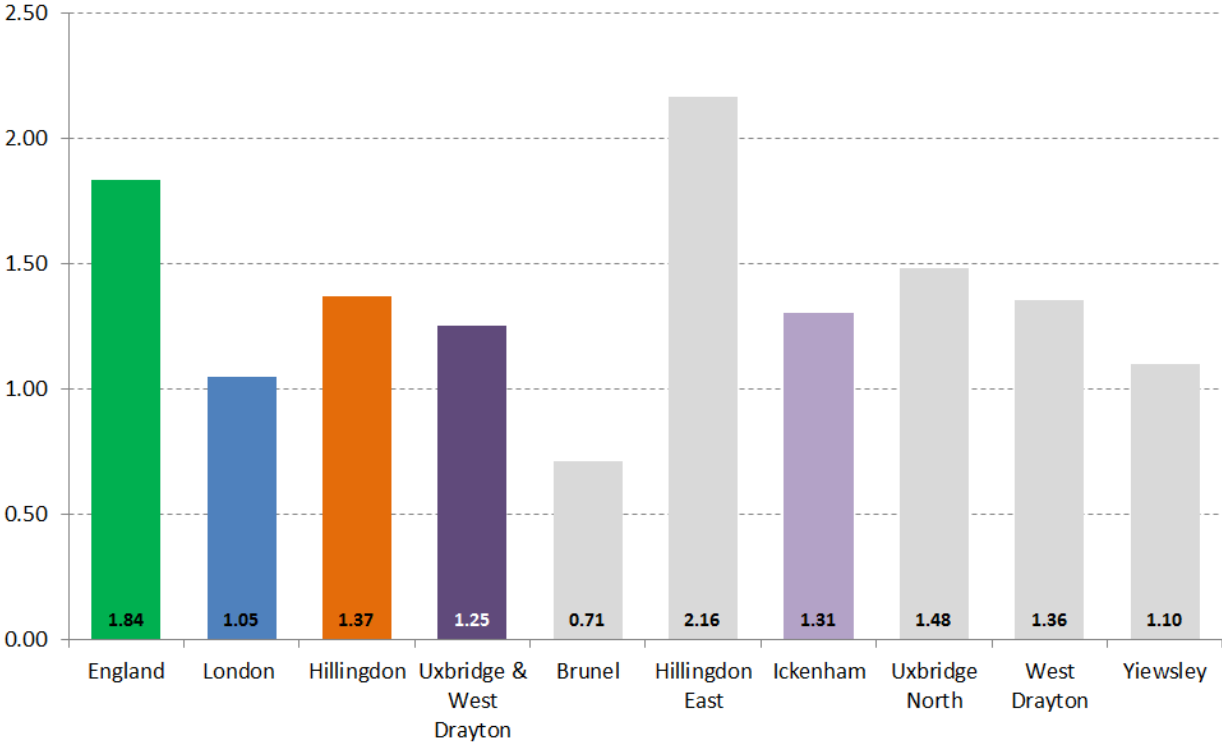

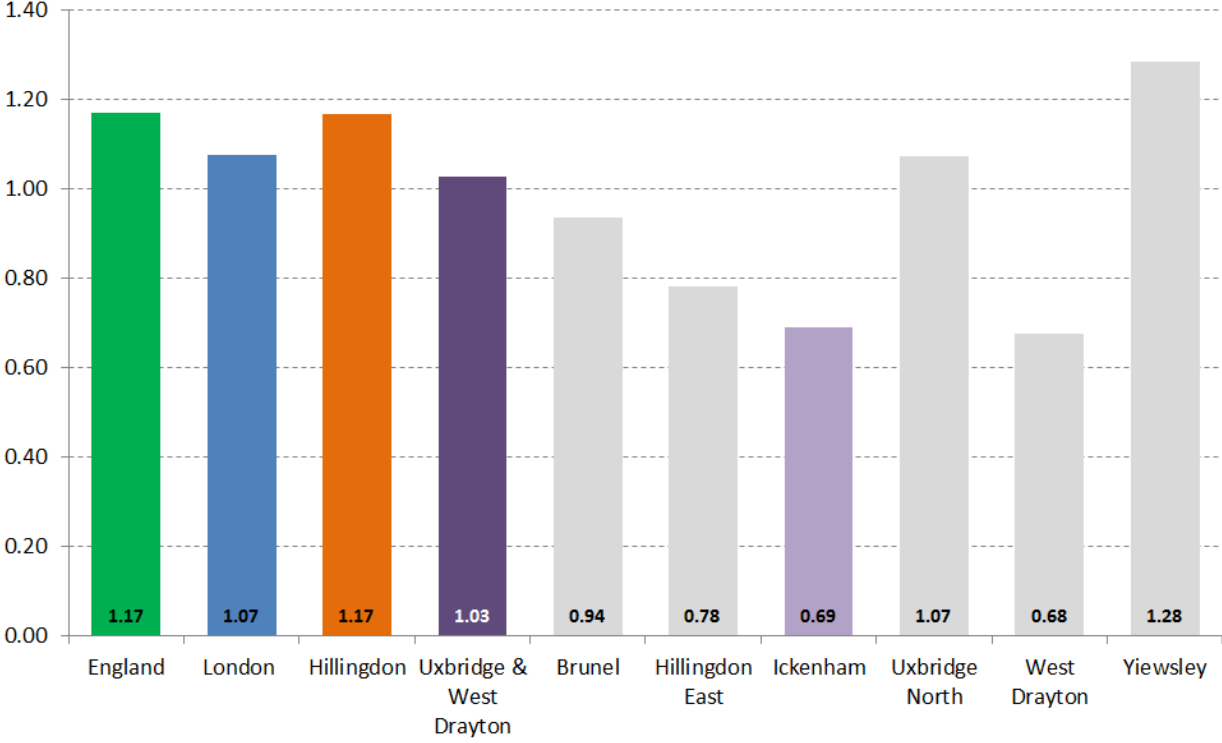

Atrial Fibrillation prevalence, 2016/17

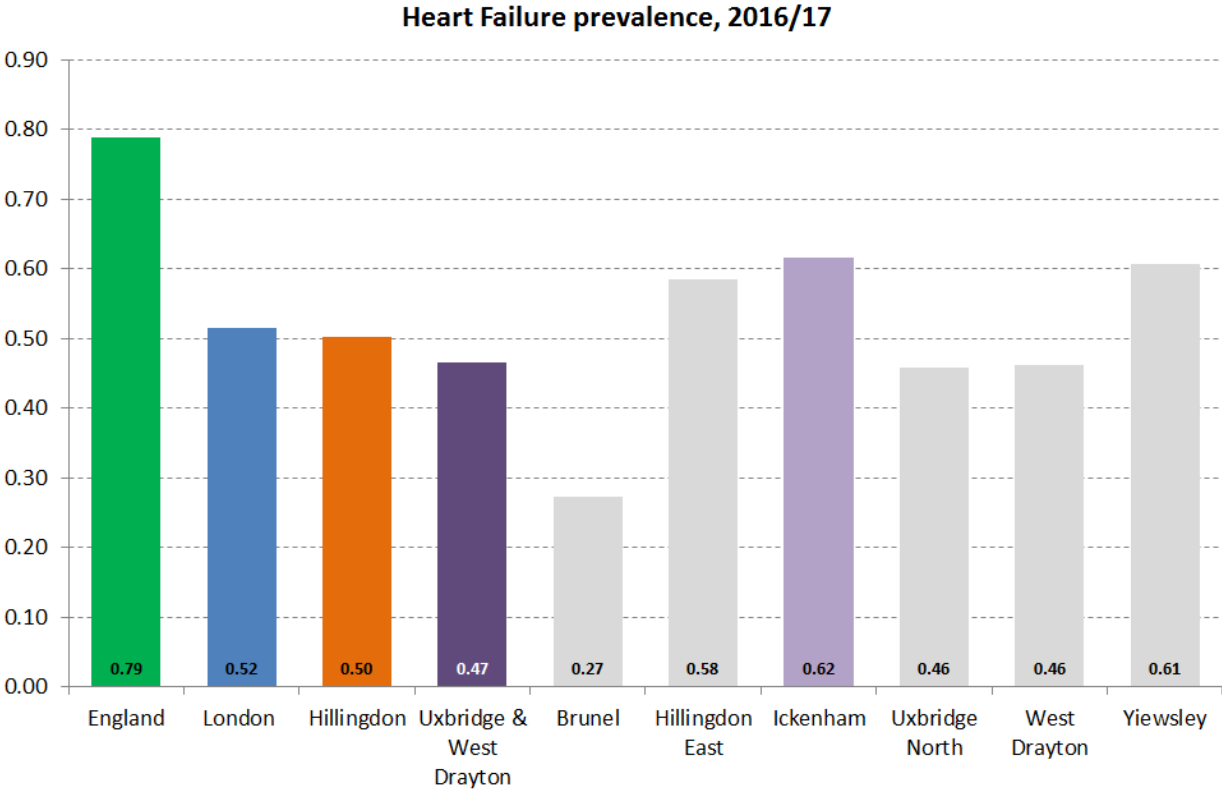

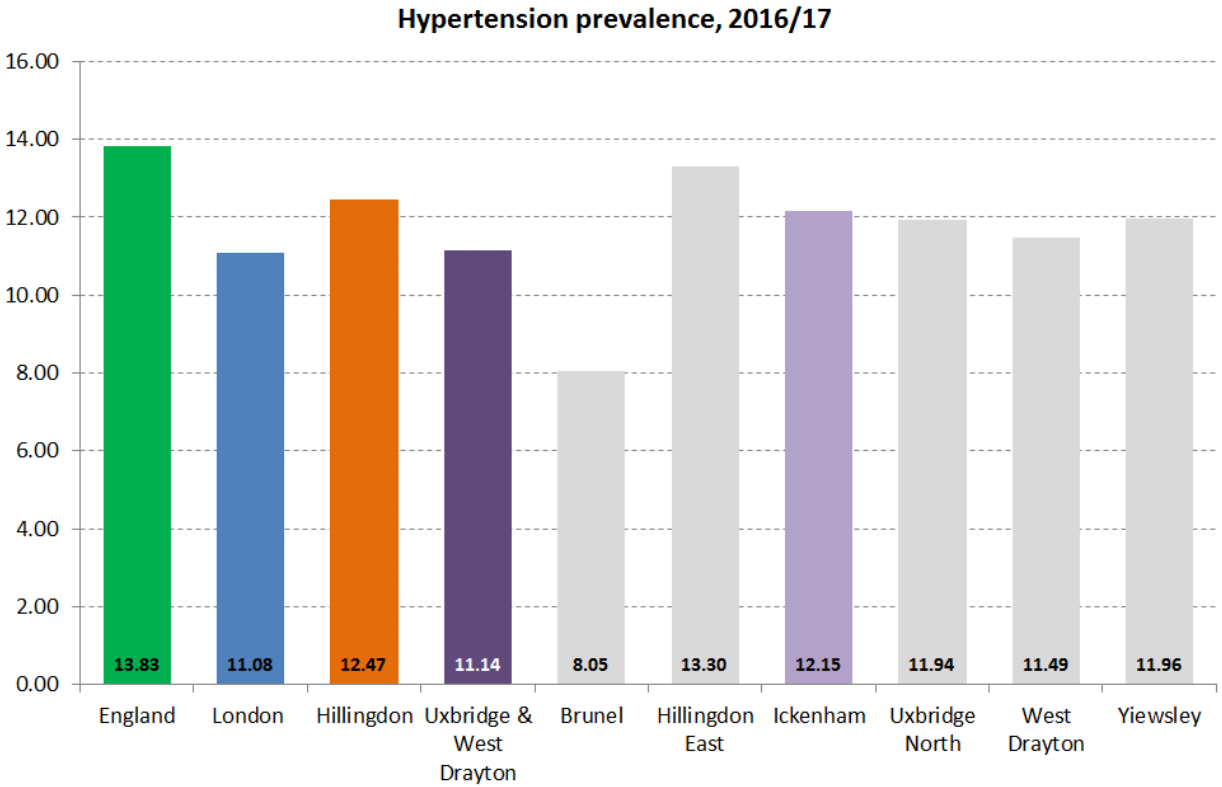
Cardiovascular Disease prevalence, 2016/17

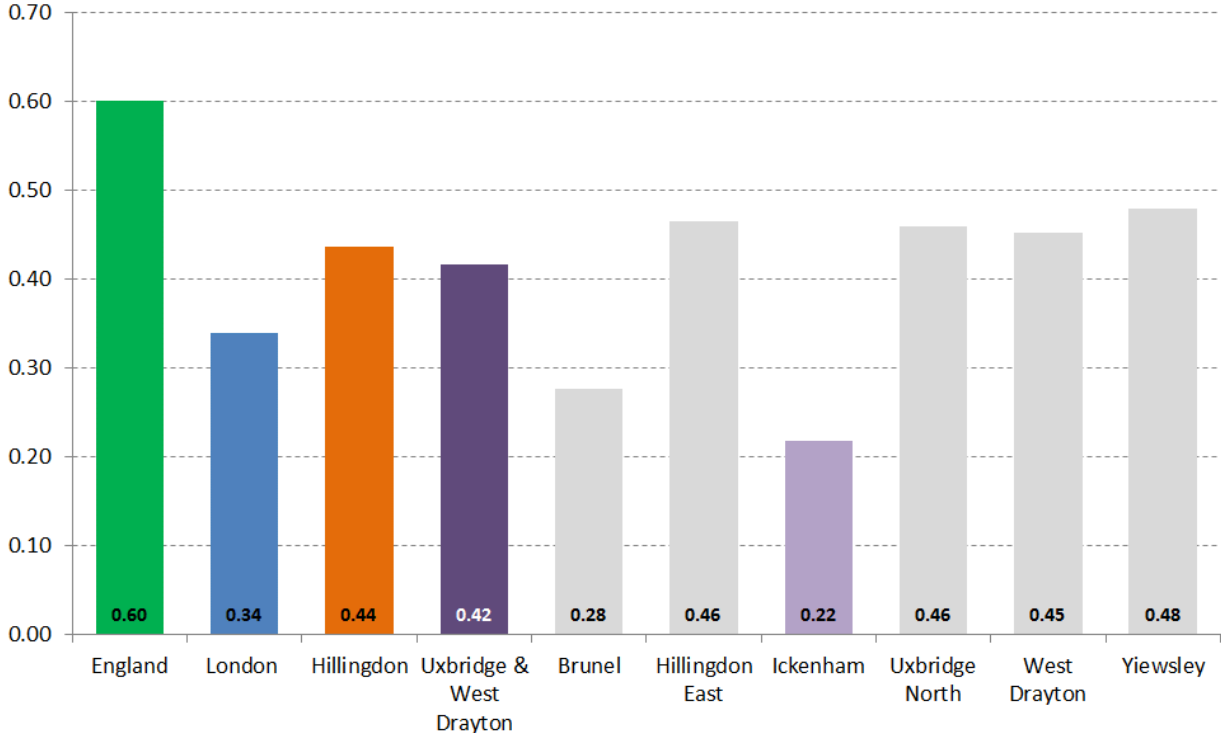

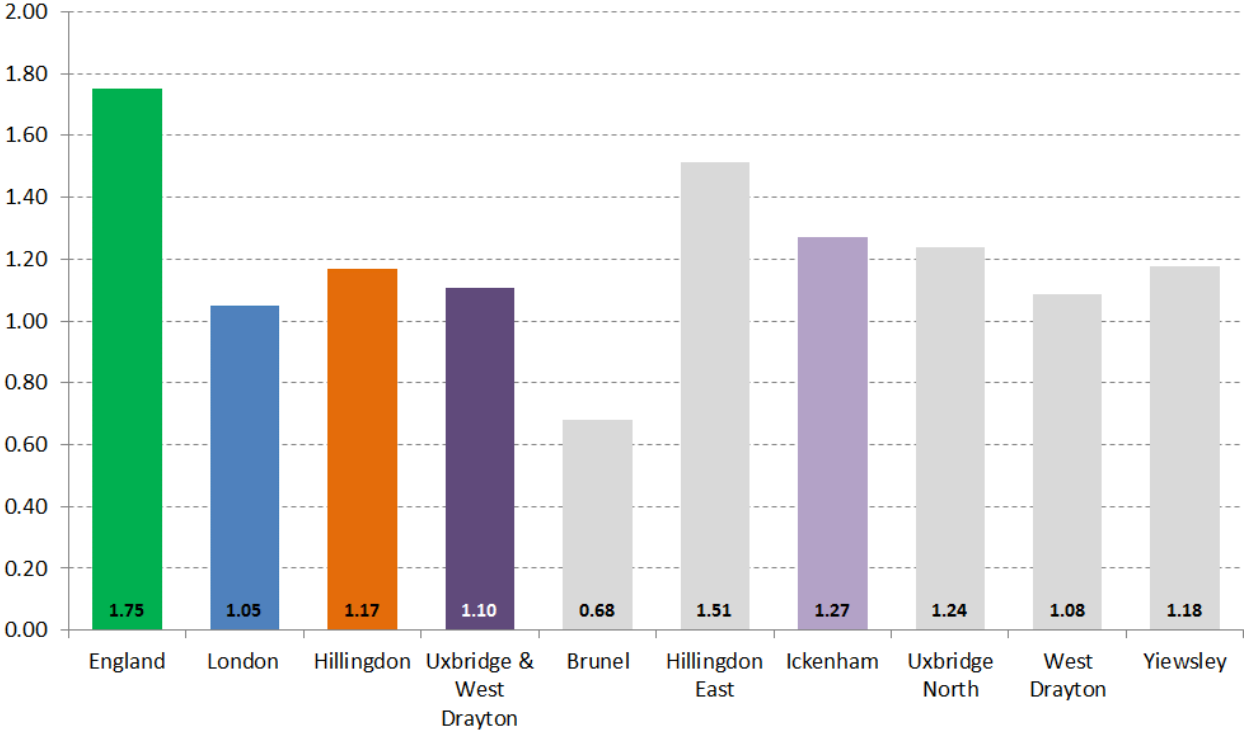

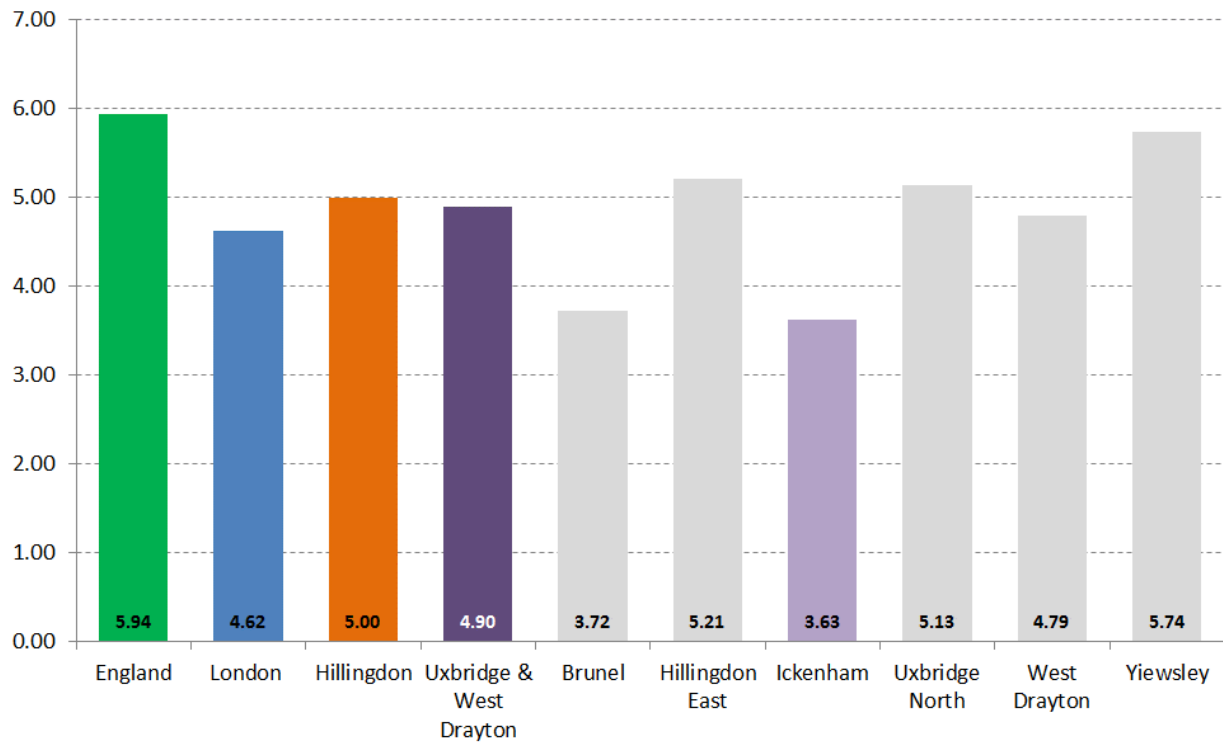
Stroke / TIA prevalence, 2016/17

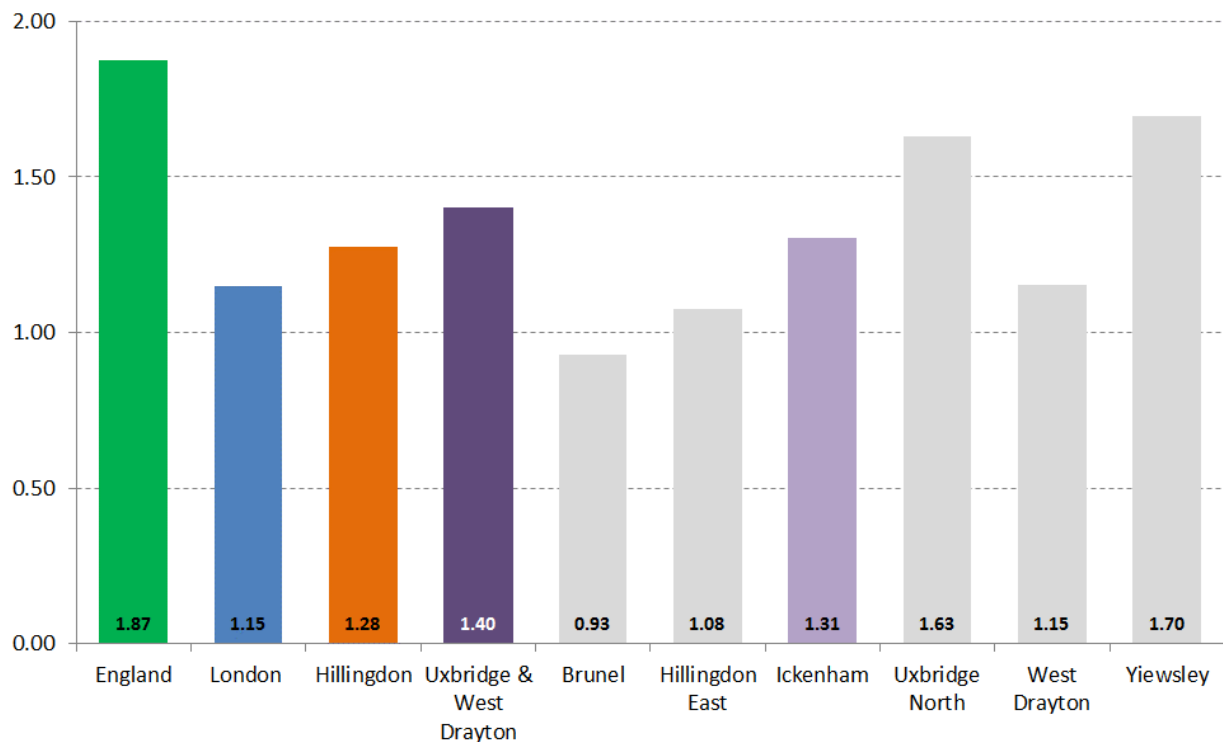

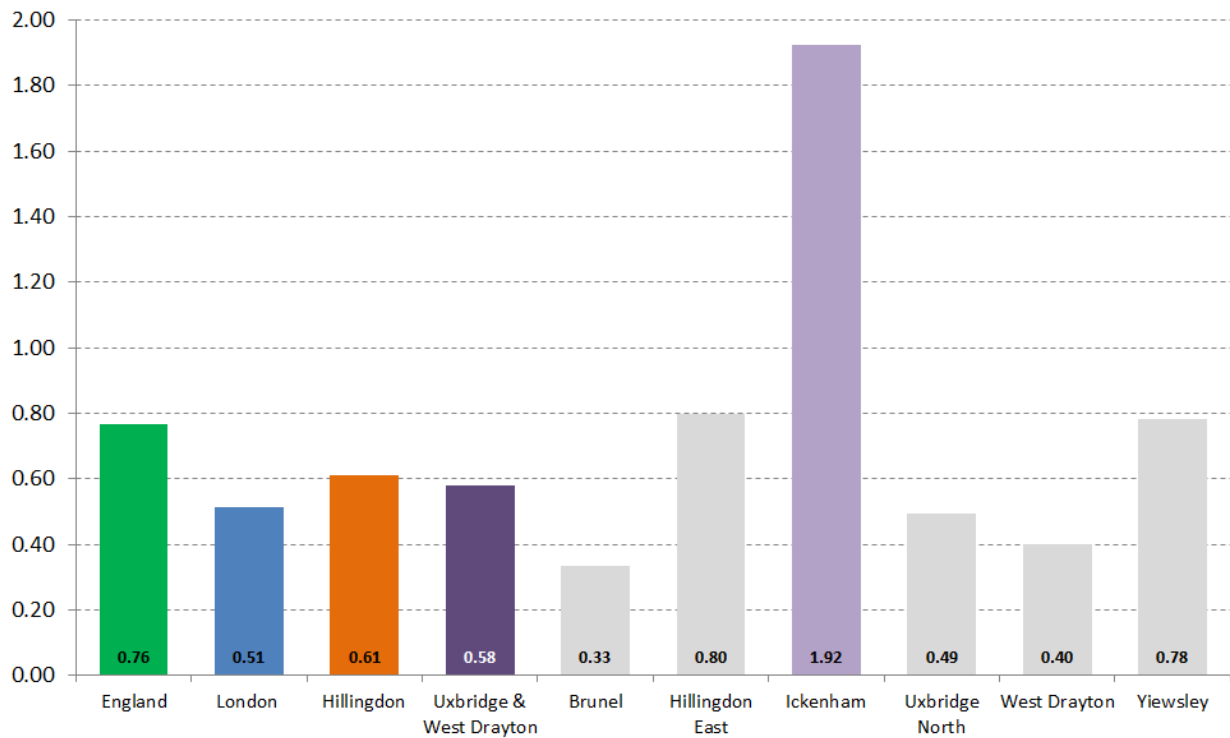
COPD prevalence, 2016/17

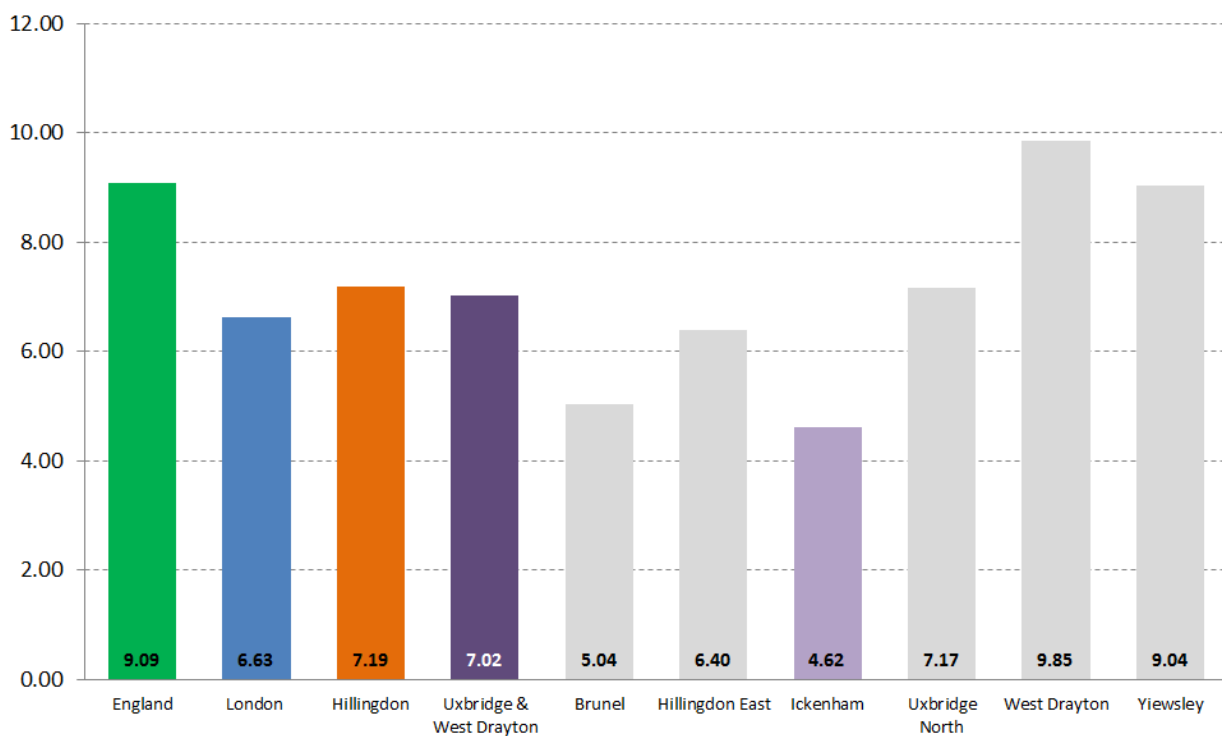

Dementia prevalence, 2016/17

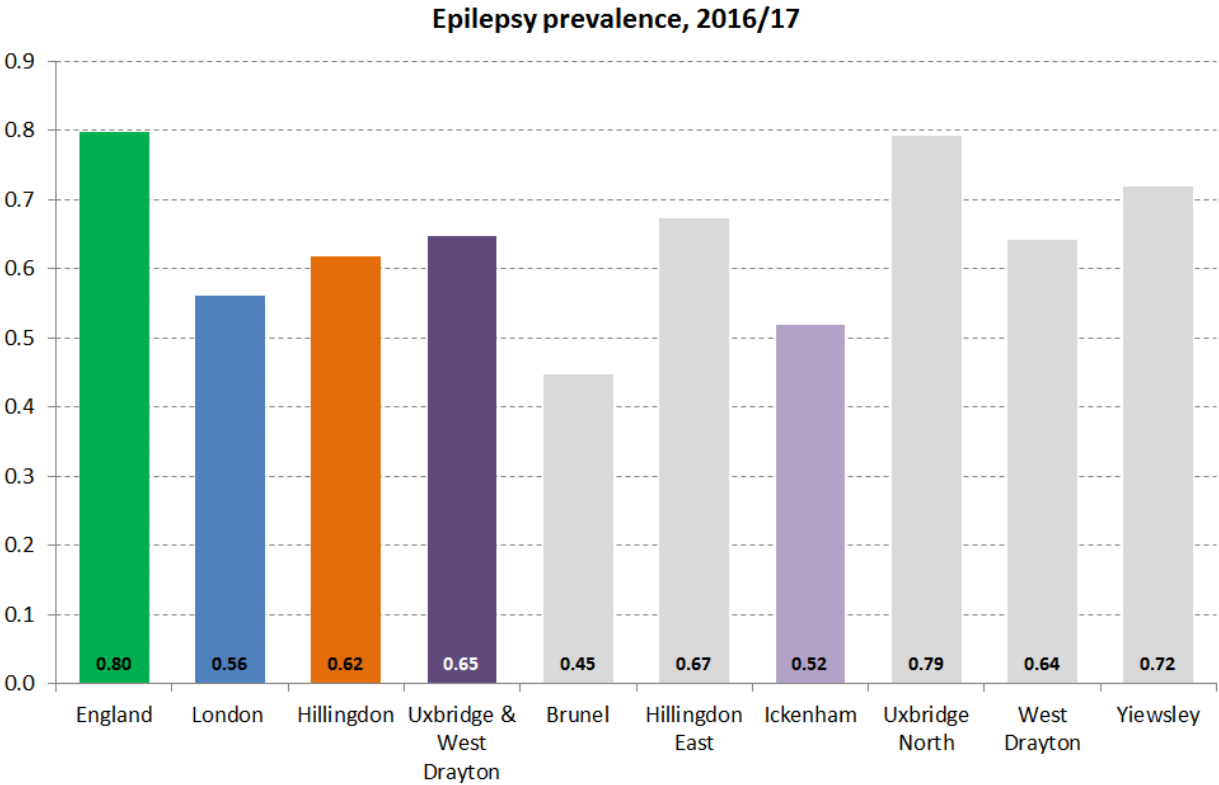

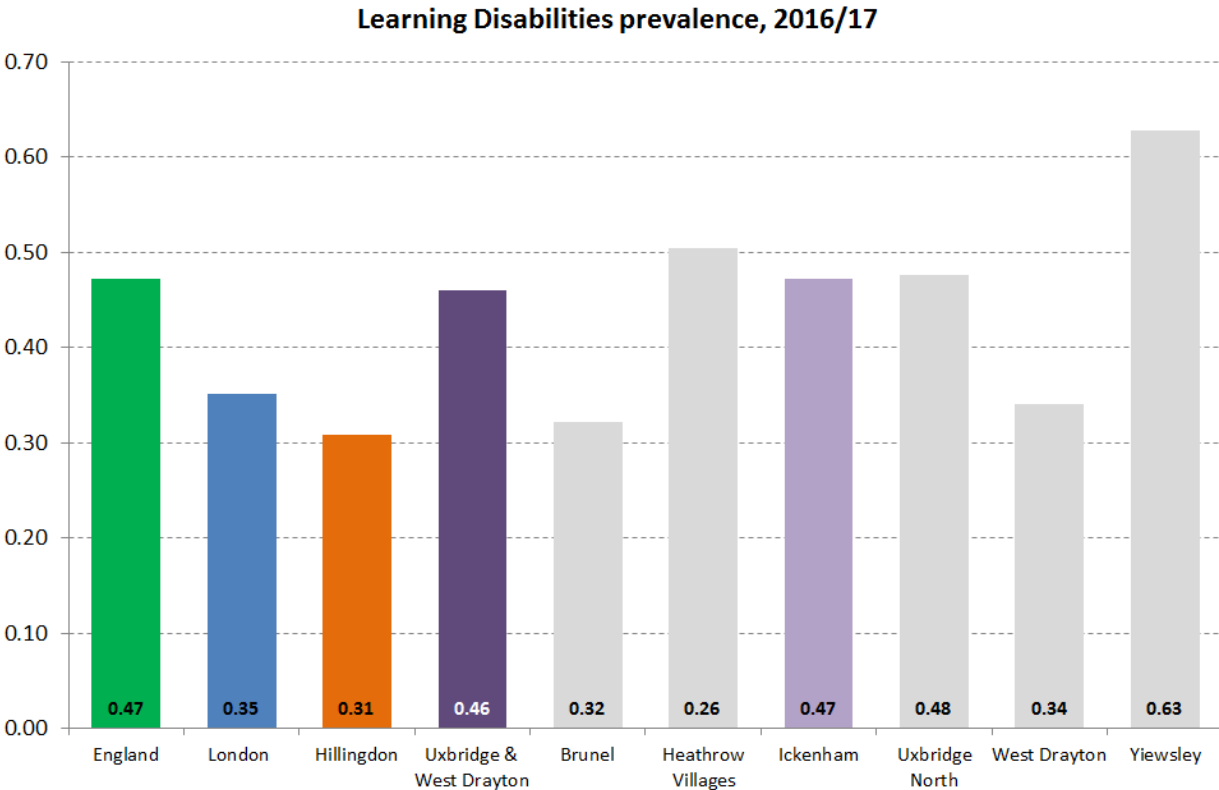
Depression prevalence, 2016/17

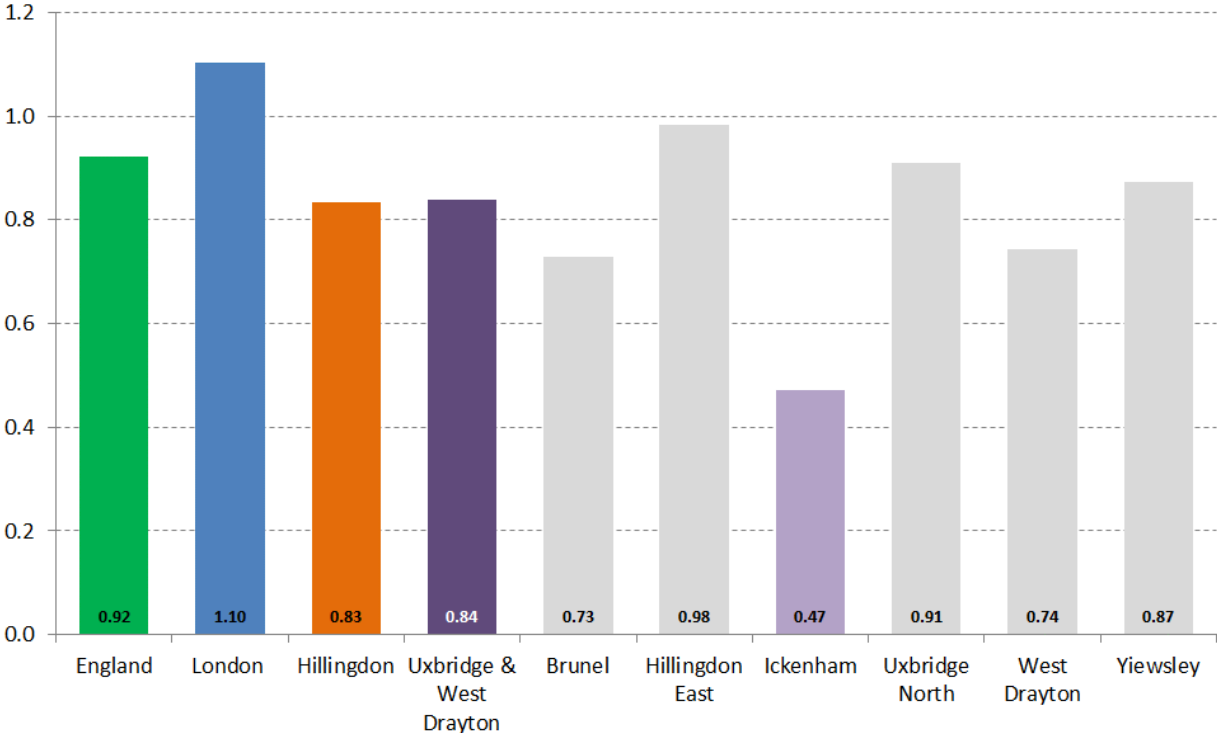

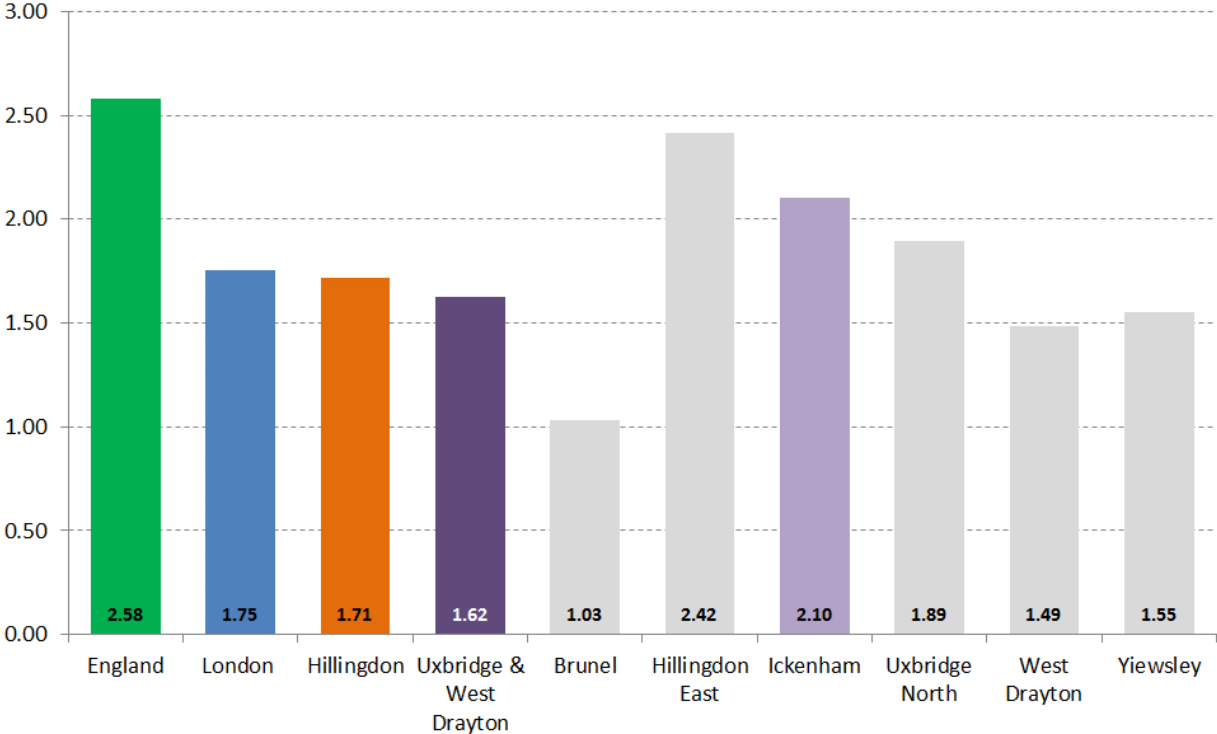
Mental Health prevalence, 2016/17

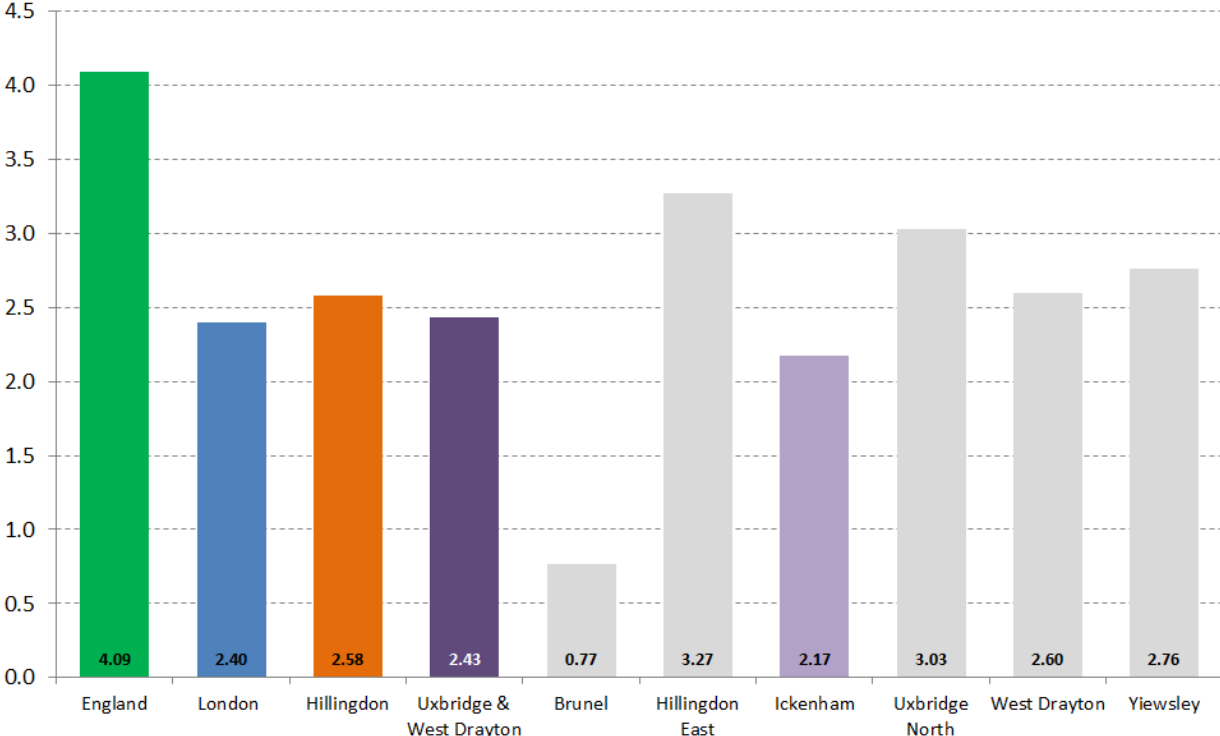

Cancer prevalence, 2016/17



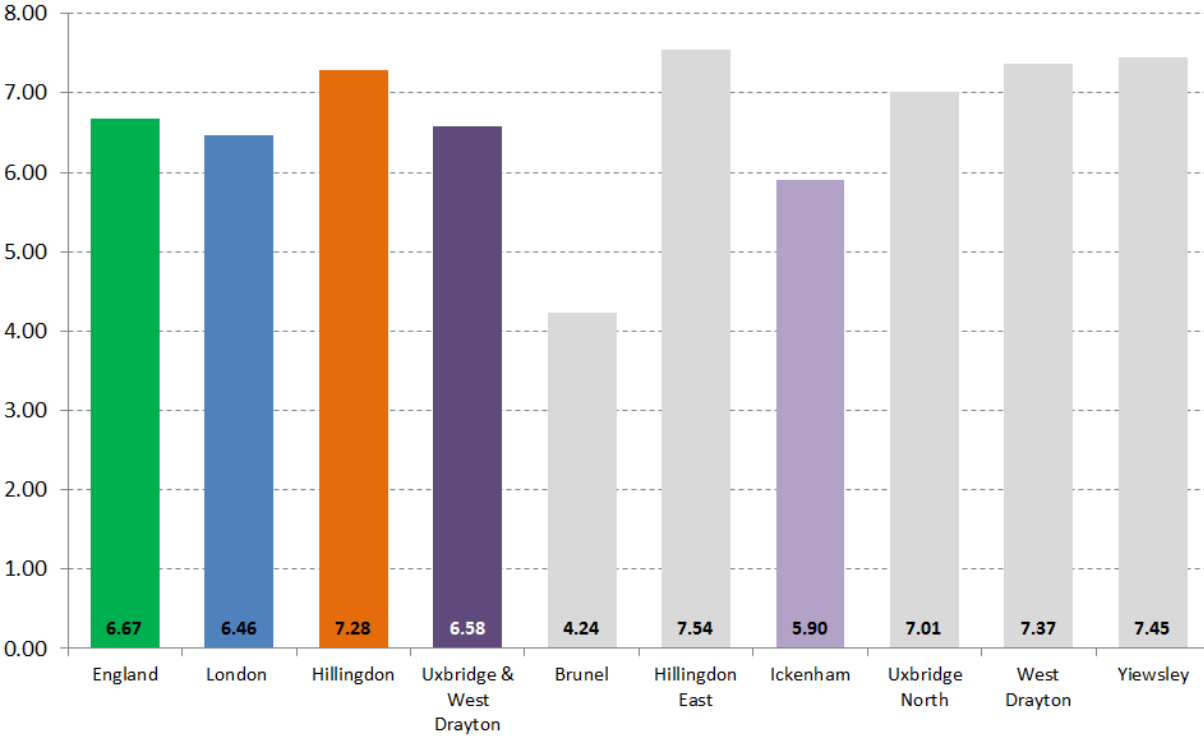

Chronic Kidney Disease prevalence, 2016/17



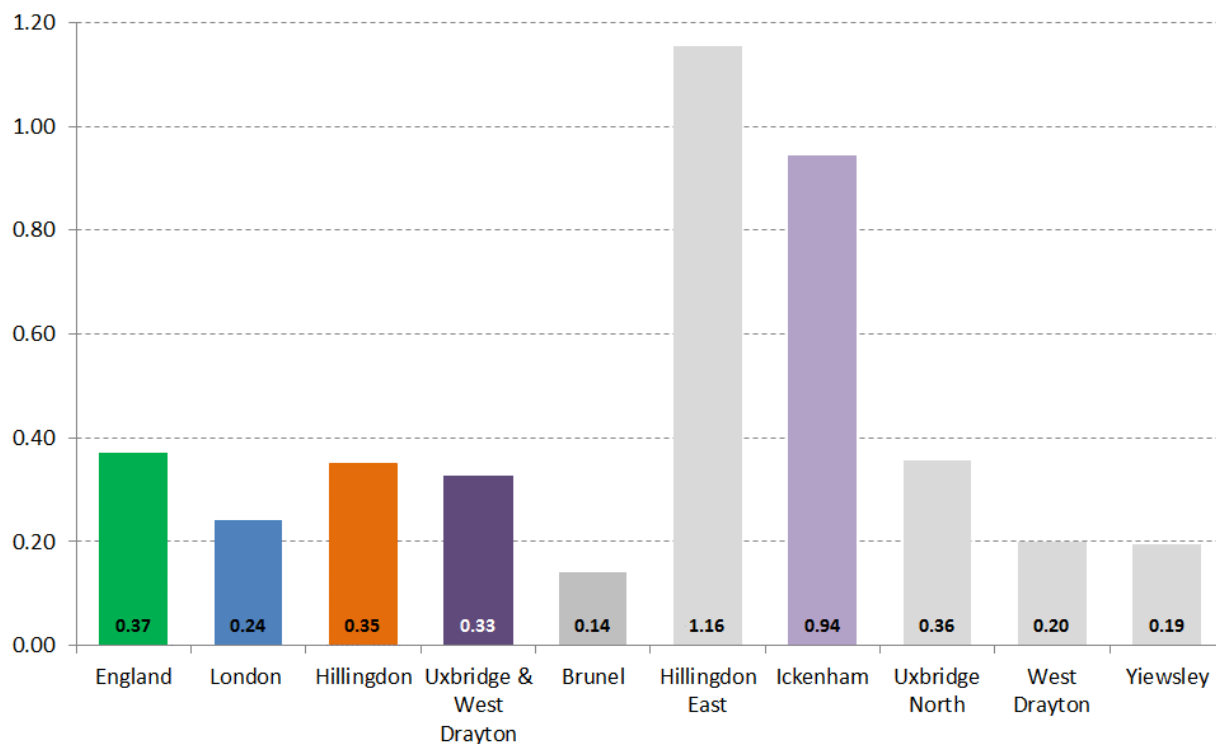

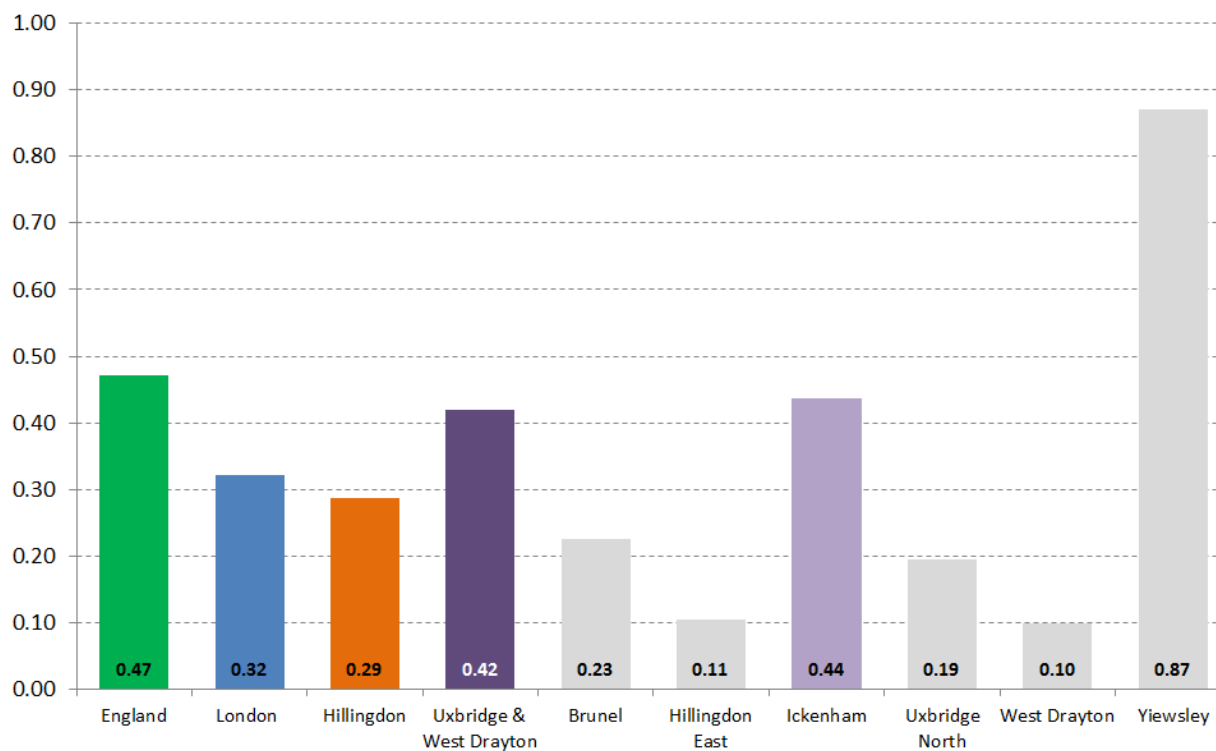
Palliative Care prevalence, 2016/17



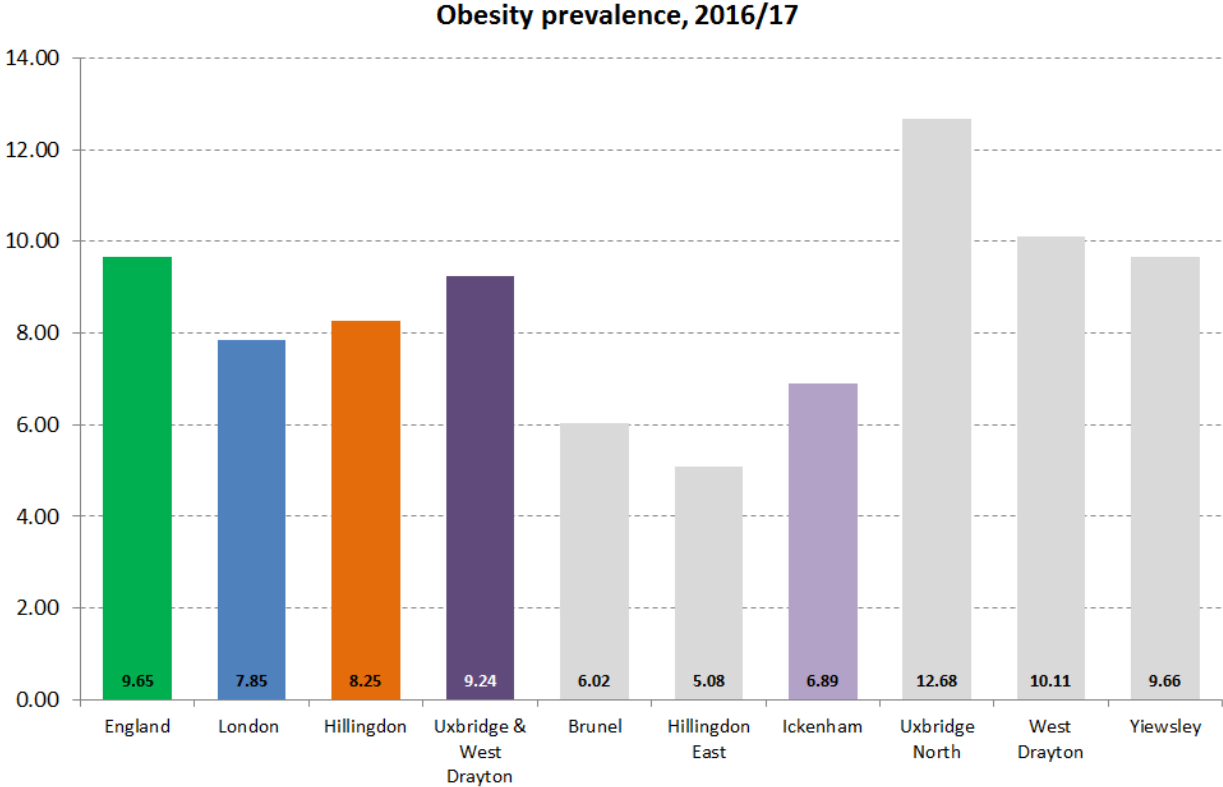

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.

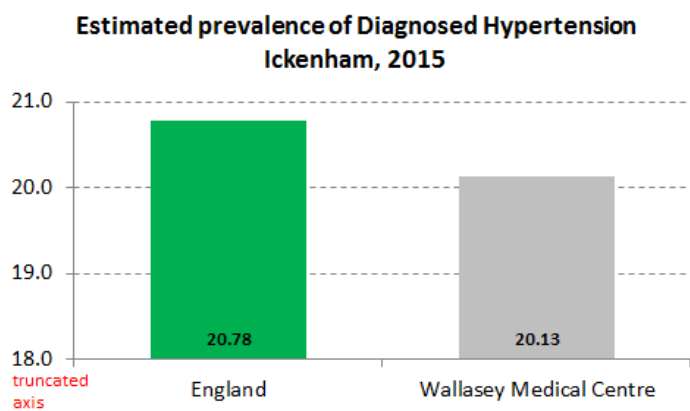

Estimated prevalence is available on a limited number of conditions; data is taken from the latest Disease & Risk Factor Prevalence profile on Fingertips, 2015 (<https://fingertips.phe.org.uk/profile/prevalence>).

Ickenham ward contains 1 GP surgery (Wallasey Medical Centre). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

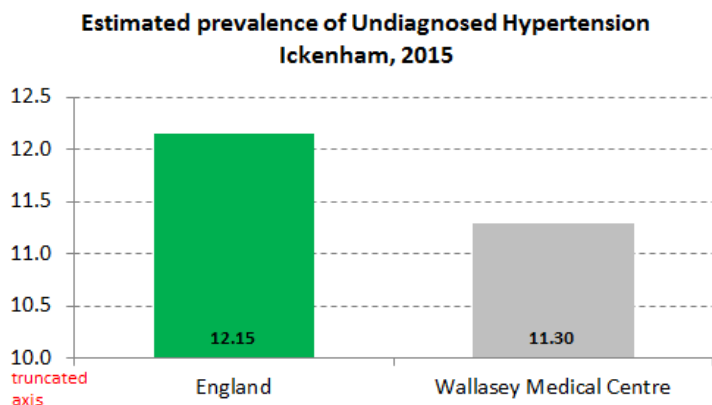

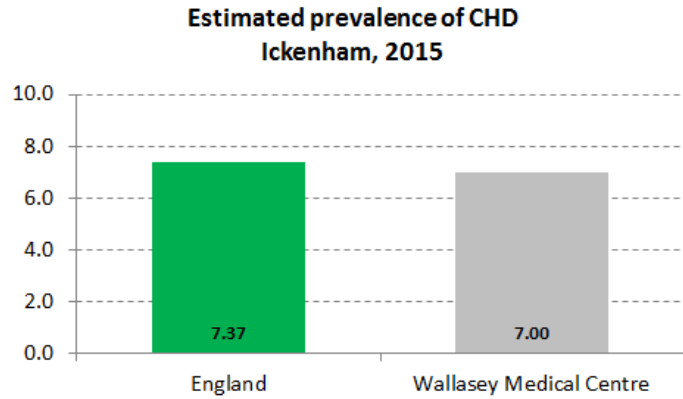

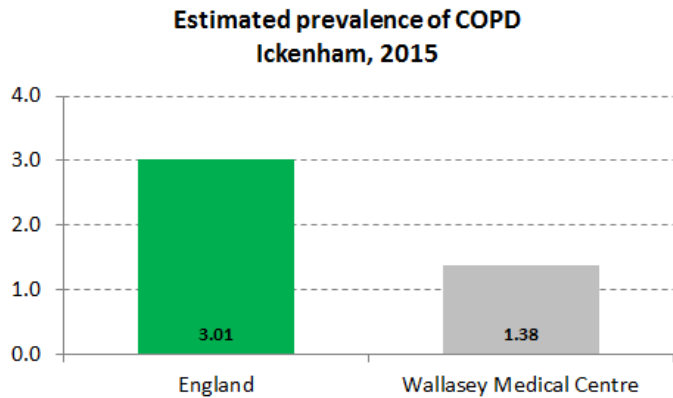

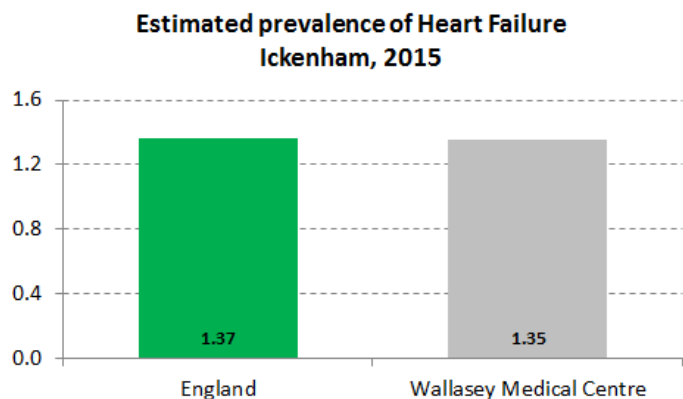

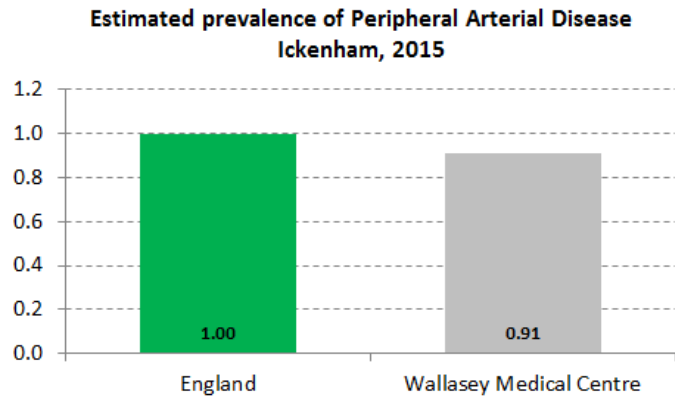

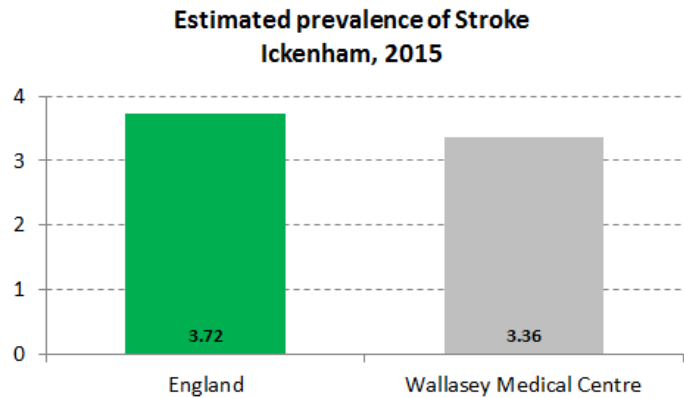

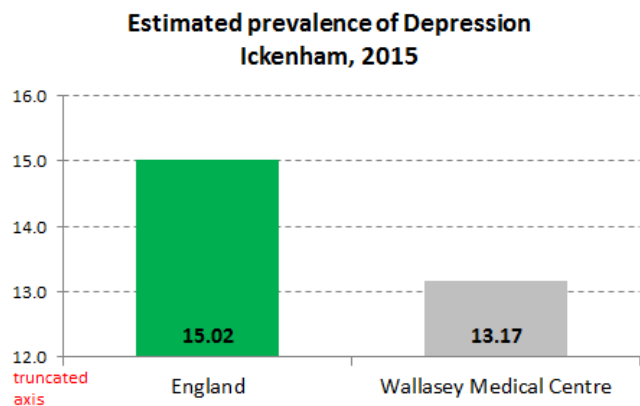
