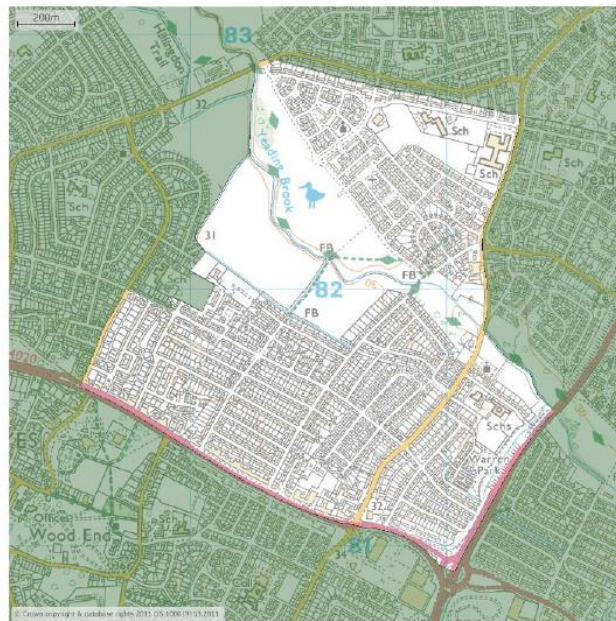

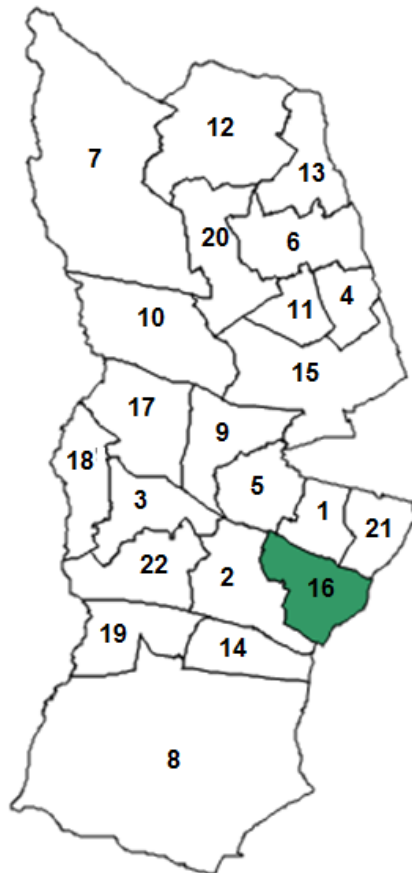

Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- **Population** – comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** – 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- **Age** – 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- **Ethnicity** - Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- **Religion¹** - the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian – 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim – 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu – 22,033 (8%) and Sikh – 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' – 46,492 (17%) and other – 23,303 (8.5%).

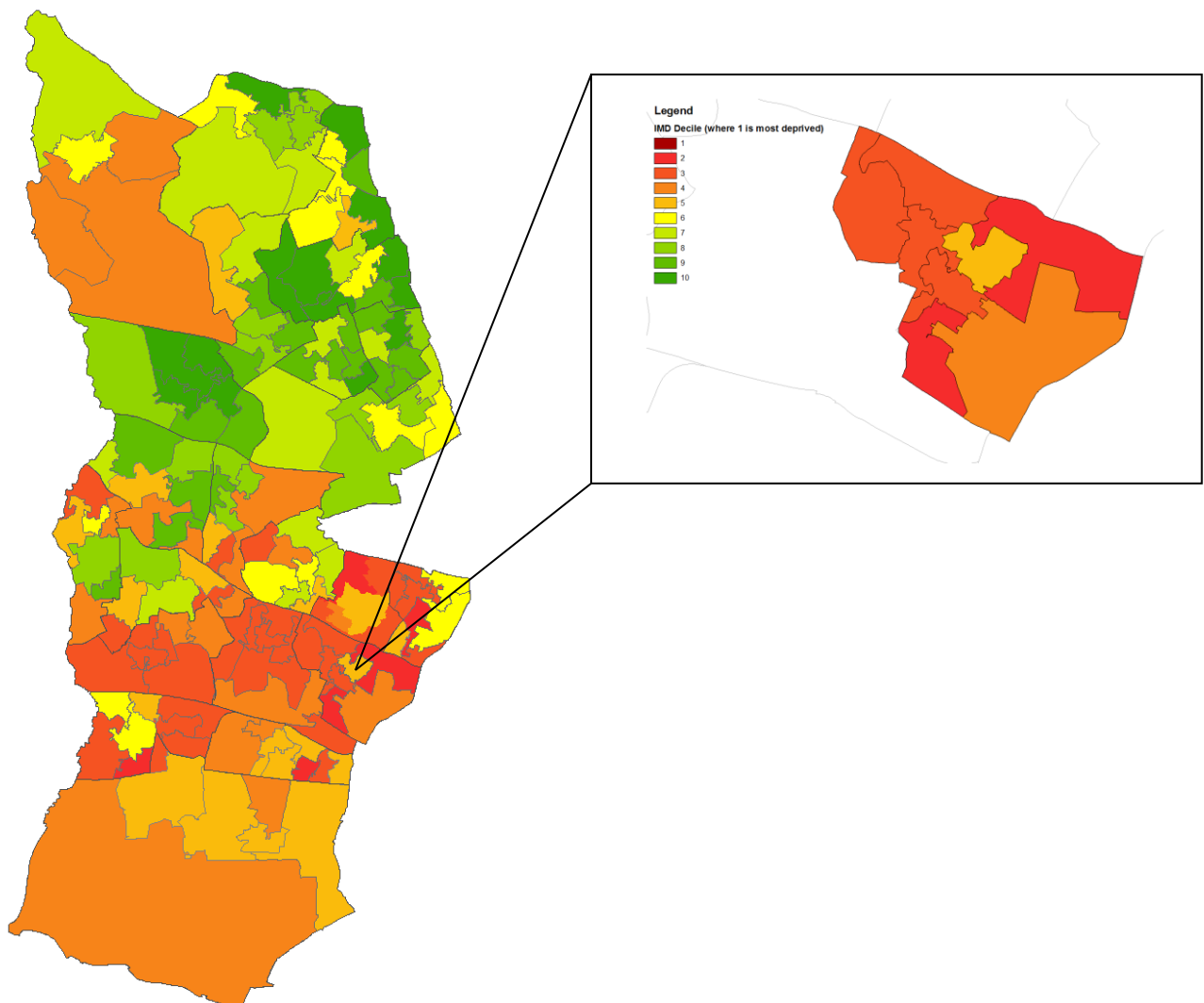
Townfield Ward

Townfield lies in the South East of Hillingdon and is bordered by Charville, Barnhill, Yeading, Botwell and Pinkwell as well as the London Borough of Ealing.

In 2017², Townfield population is 16,099 residents, an increase of 14.1% since 2011 (14,106); this is higher than the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Townfield is made up of 349.8 hectares (3.5 km^{sq}), with 46 people per hectare (4,602 per km^{sq}). The average number of people per household in Townfield is 3.2³.

Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Townfield, which is made up of eight LSOA areas, of which the areas in the north of the ward are considered more deprived⁴.

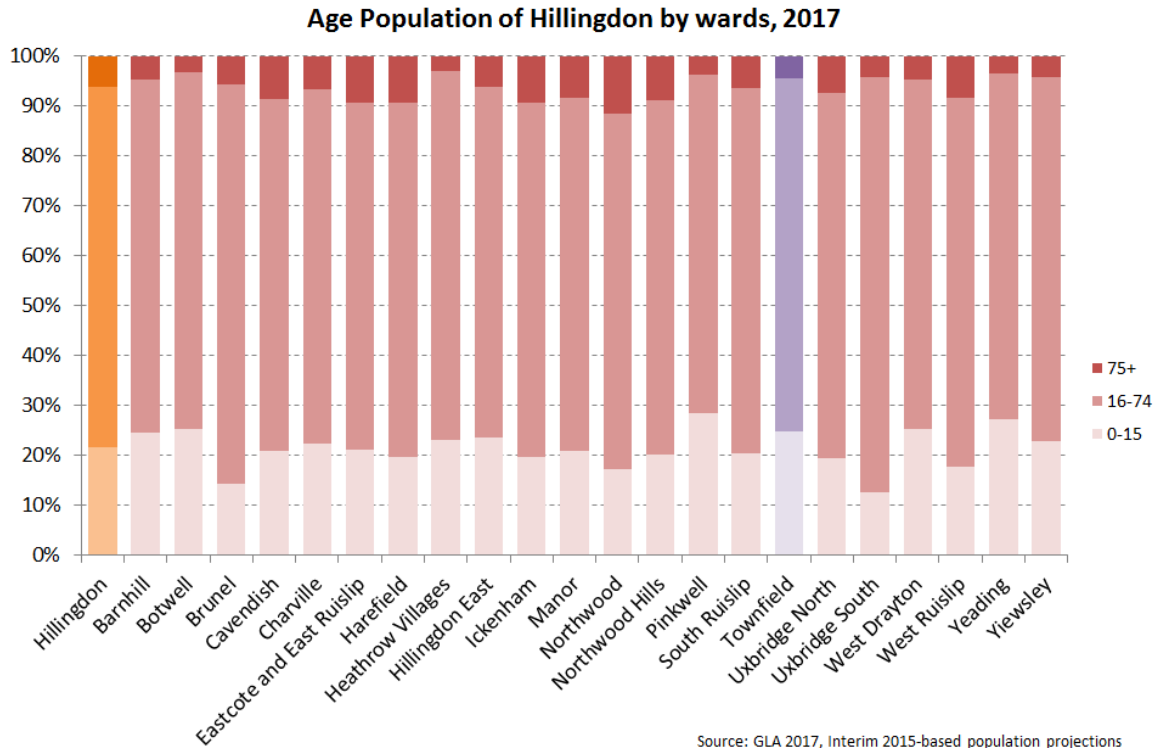

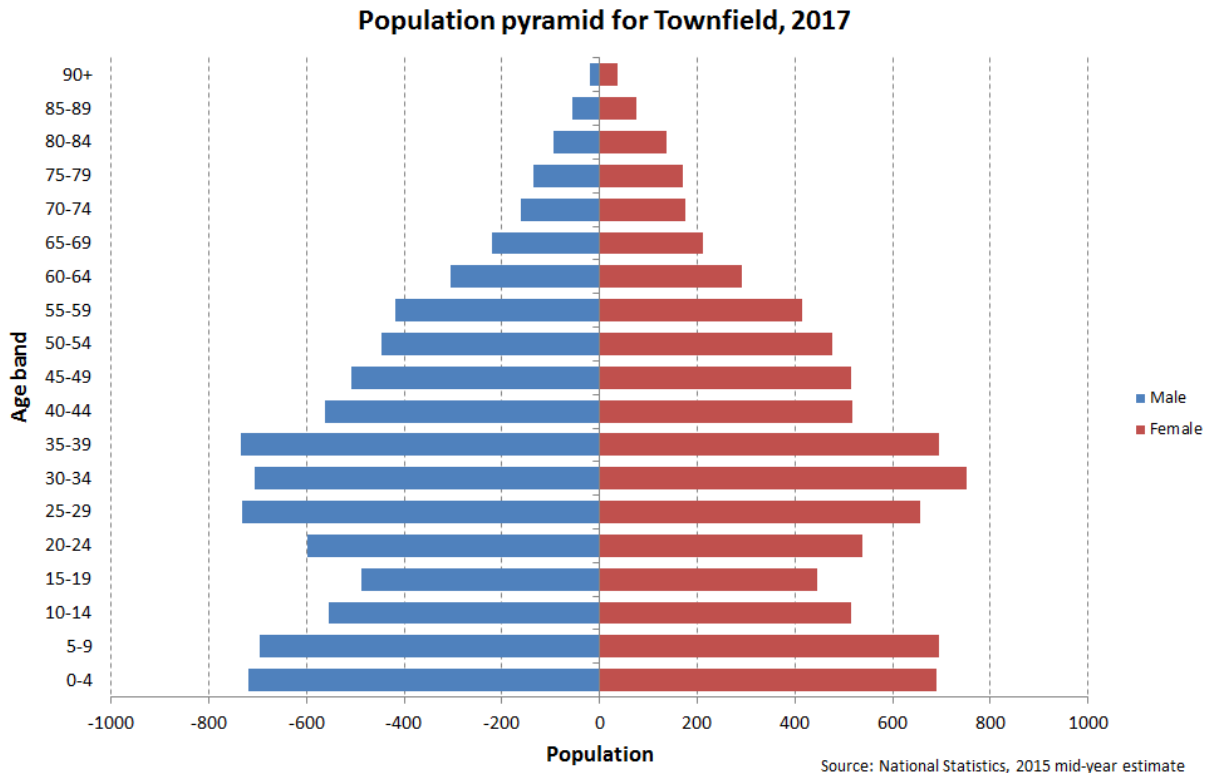

Ward Population:



The chart above shows that 24.8% of Townfield residents are under the age of 16. 70.7% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 4.5% are over the age of 75.

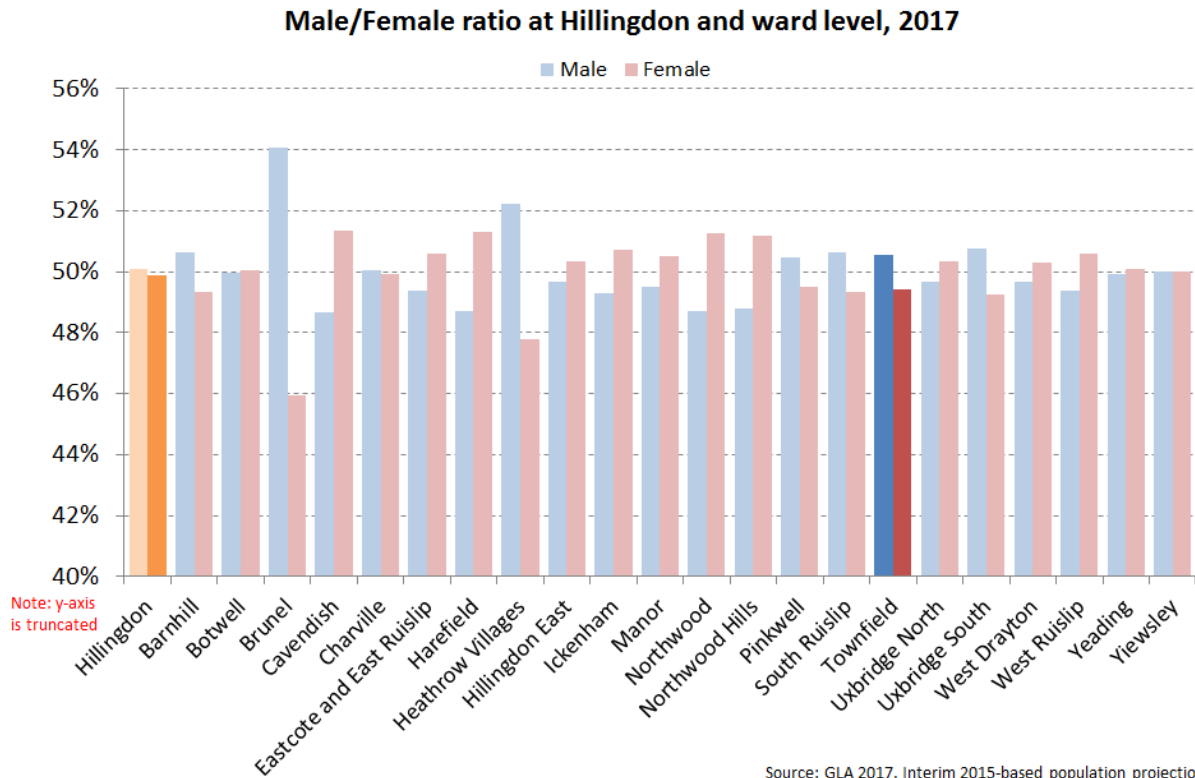
The chart below shows that in Townfield, there are higher numbers of males aged 35-39. However, the number of females is higher in the 30-34 age bracket compared to other age groups.



Gender

The proportion of men to women in the ward is 50.6% to 49.4%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 50.8% to 49.2% male to female ratio in the ward.

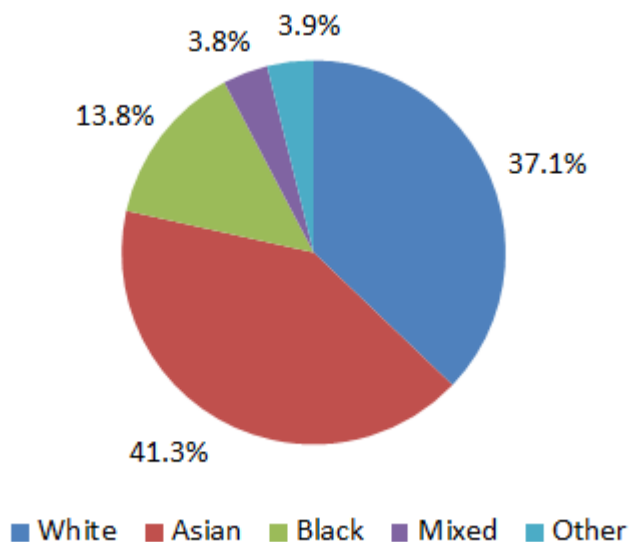
The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:



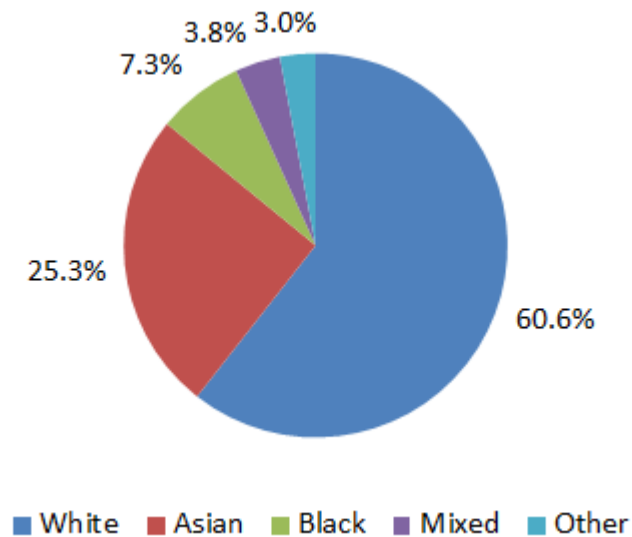
Ethnic make up 2011⁵

In the 2011 census, 37.1% of Townfield residents identified themselves in the 2011 census as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 3.8% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 41.3% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 13.8% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 3.9% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:



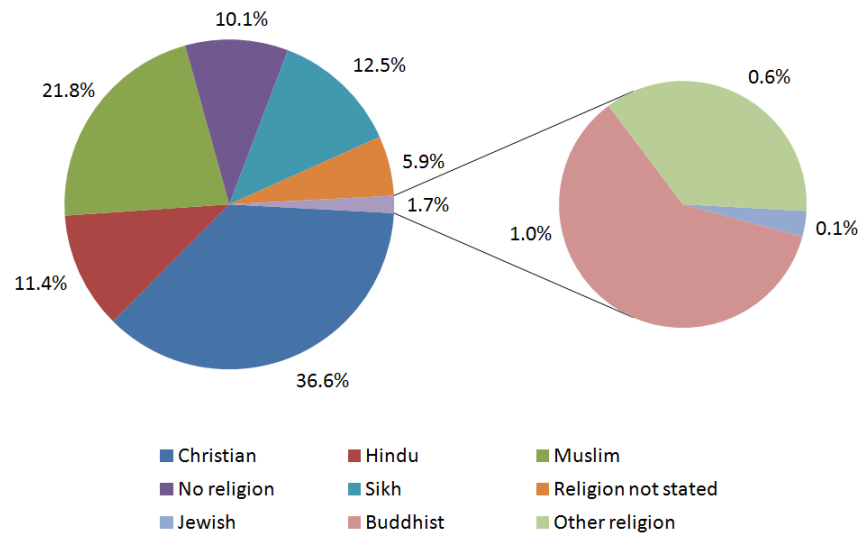

Religion⁶

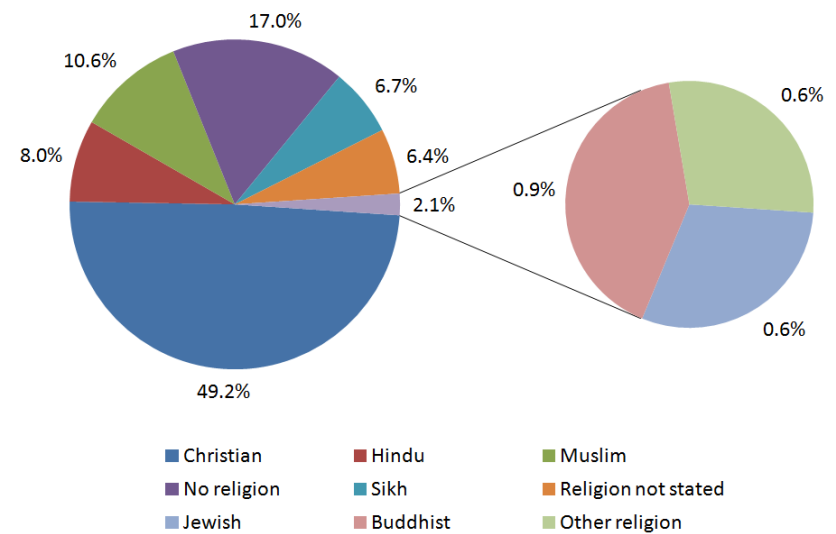
Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 36.6% from this faith. 11.4% are Hindu, 21.8% Muslim, 12.5% Sikh with 10.1% having no religion. 5.4% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary). According to Census figures Townfield has the highest number of residents stating their religion as Hinduism and the lowest number of residents in the Borough stating their religion as Christianity. Townfield also has the lowest number in the Borough of residents with no religion.

Townfield, Religion 2011:



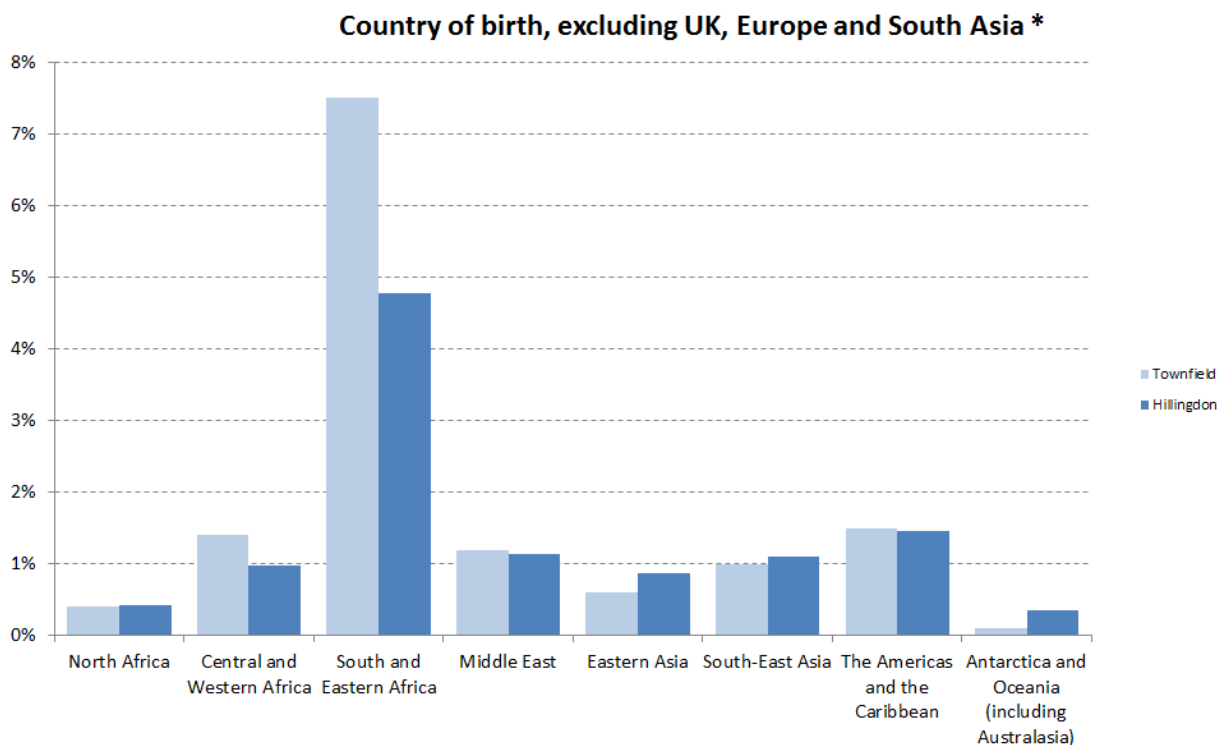
Hillingdon, Religion 2011:

Country of Birth⁷

Of those living in Townfield, 63.6% were **born** in Europe (with 55.3% in the UK), 25.4% in the Middle East / Asia, 9.4% in Africa, and 1.6% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Townfield, 44.7% were **born** outside of the UK (with 55.3% in the UK).

Townfield has the highest number of residents stating they were born in Lithuania (117 of total borough residents from that country, 12.7%), and the highest number who stated they were born in Pakistan (605 of total borough residents from that country, 12.5%).

The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 67.3% residents stating this as their main language; of the remaining 32.7%, the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well'. 932 residents (21.2% of those where English is not their main language) state that they cannot speak English well or at all⁸. Townfield has the highest proportion of people who cannot speak English well in the borough.

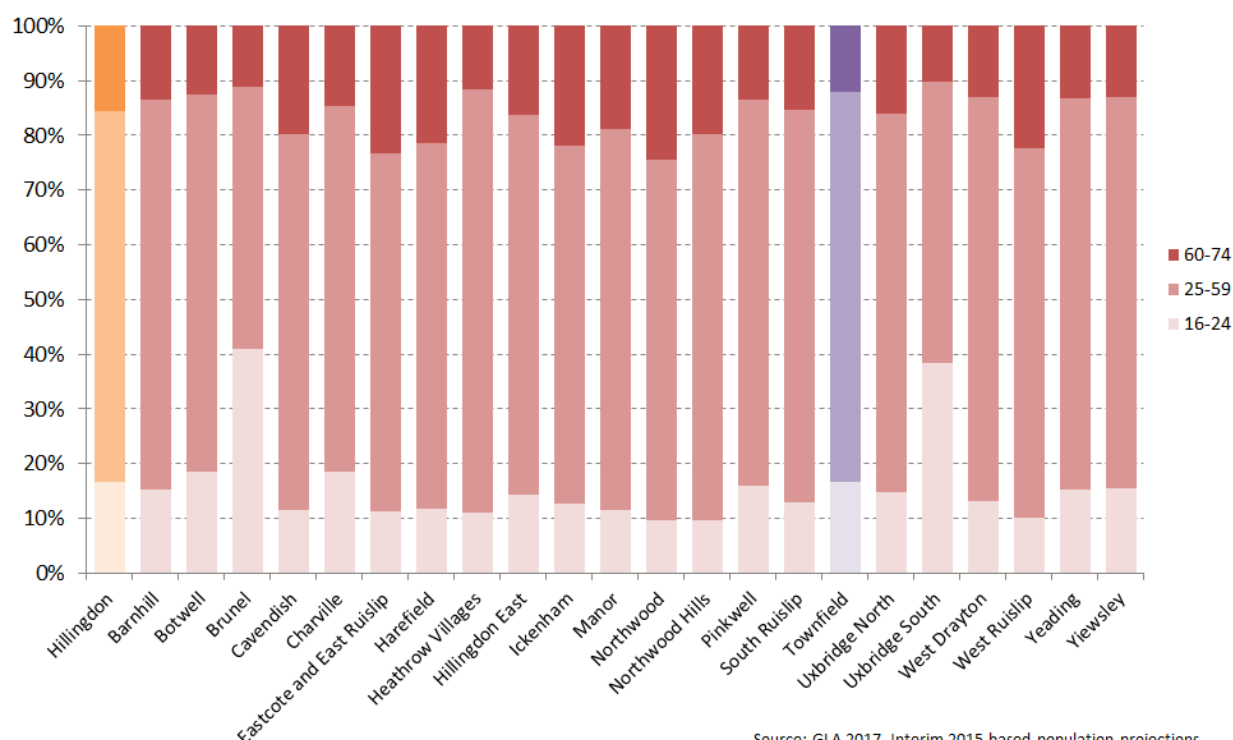
Apart from English the most spoken languages in the ward are Panjabi (spoken by 1,026 residents, 7.7%) and Urdu (spoken by 474 residents, 3.5%).

In Townfield, the working age population of those aged 16-24 make up 16.7%, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 71.3% followed by 12.0% from the 60-74 age group.

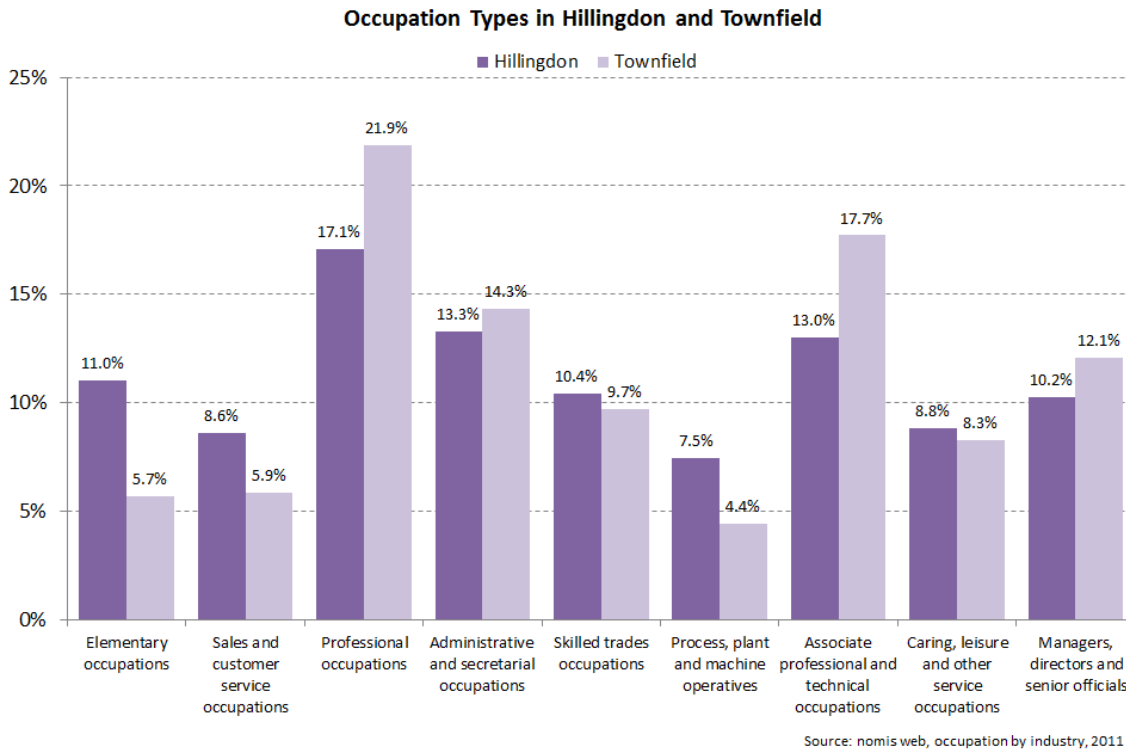

In Townfield, 67.9% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:

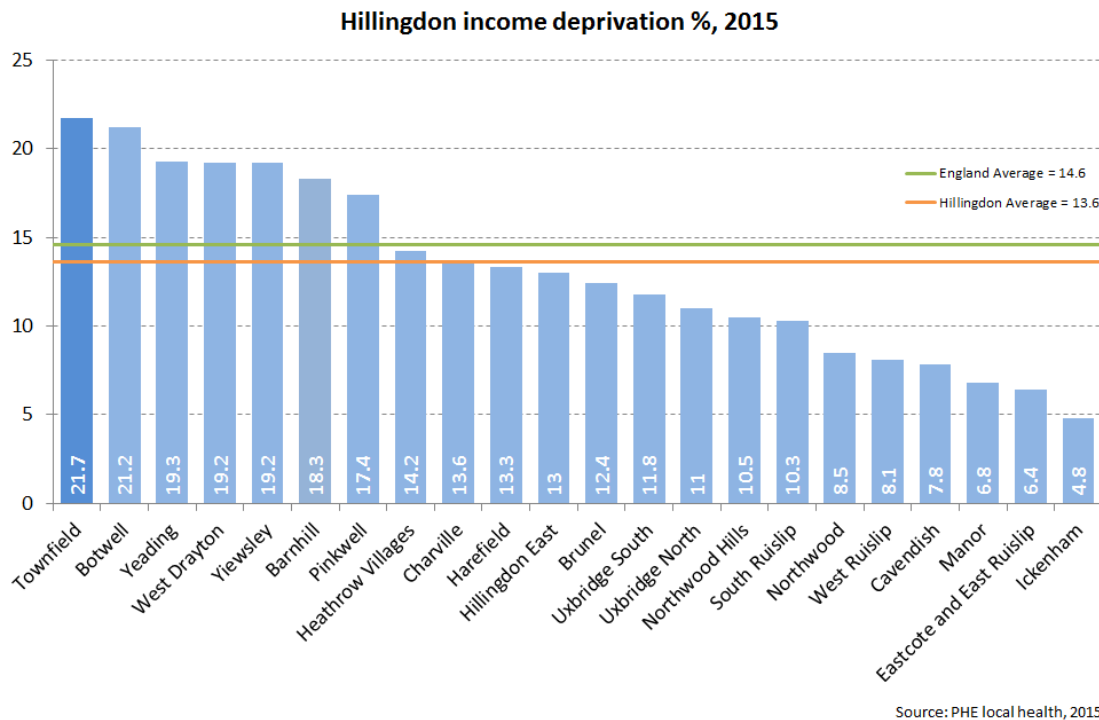

The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households. Townfield has the highest income deprivation (21.7%), higher than the Hillingdon (13.6%) and England (14.6%) average.

Households

In 2017, there were 5,282 households¹⁰ in Townfield; an increase of 526 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**¹¹ within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 67.4%, with 32.6% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).

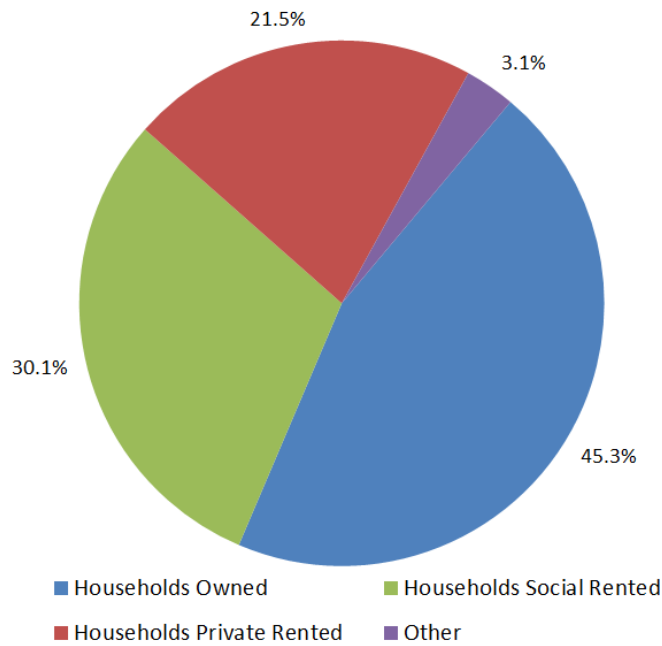

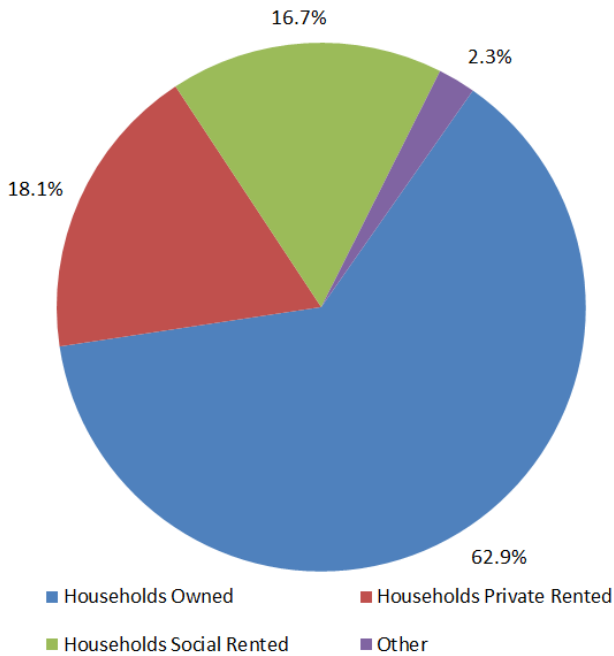

In Townfield, 45.3% of ward residents either own their own homes, followed by 21.5% of properties are privately rented, with 30.1% socially rented from the Council or other; the remaining residents make up 3.1% other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.

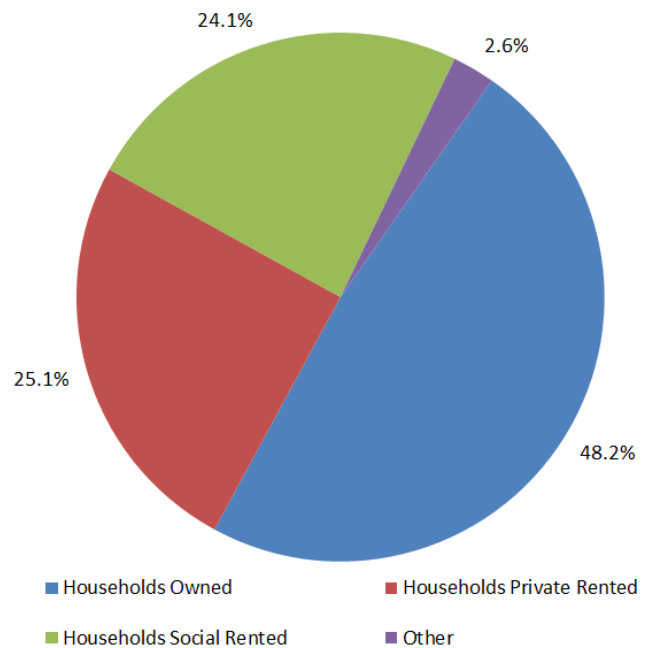
Household Type Townfield



Household Type Hillingdon



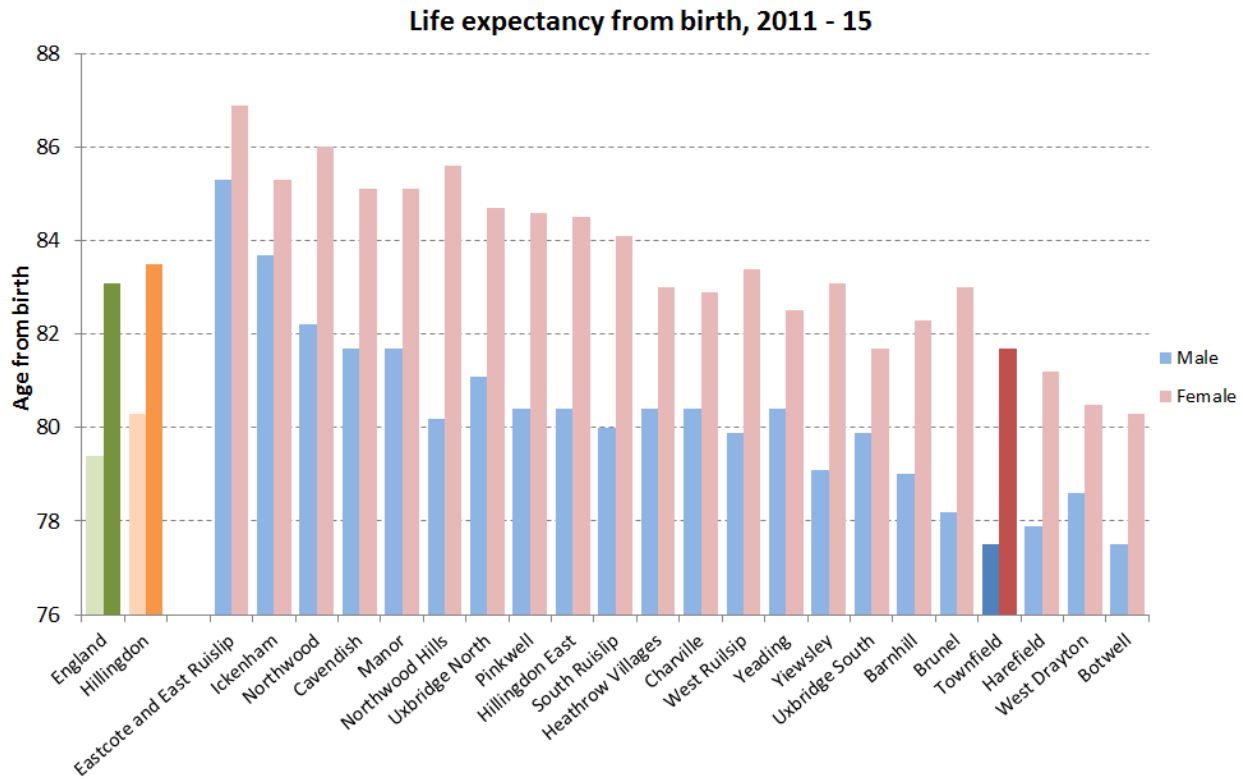
Household Type London

Life expectancy in the borough assesses the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Townfield, the life expectancy is estimated at 77.5 years for males and 81.7 years for females.

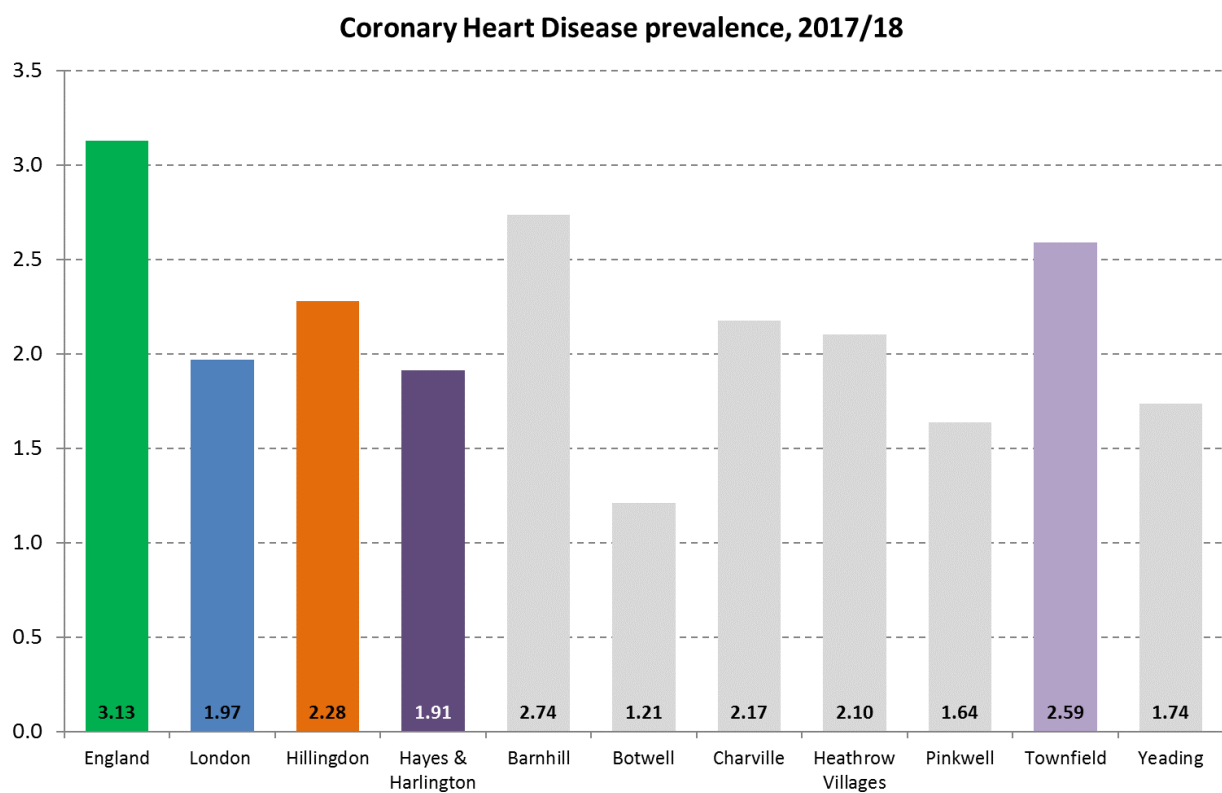
Observed Prevalence¹²

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Townfield ward contains 2 GP surgeries (Kincora Surgery and Townfield Doctor's Surgery).

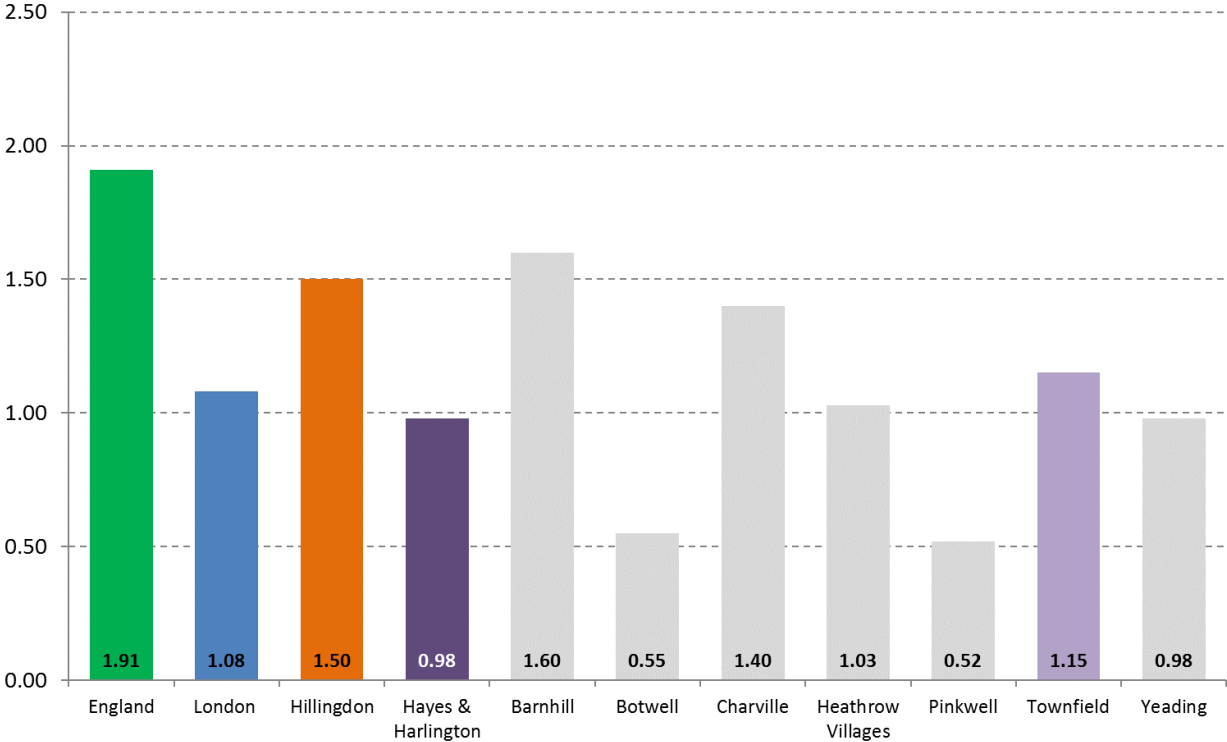

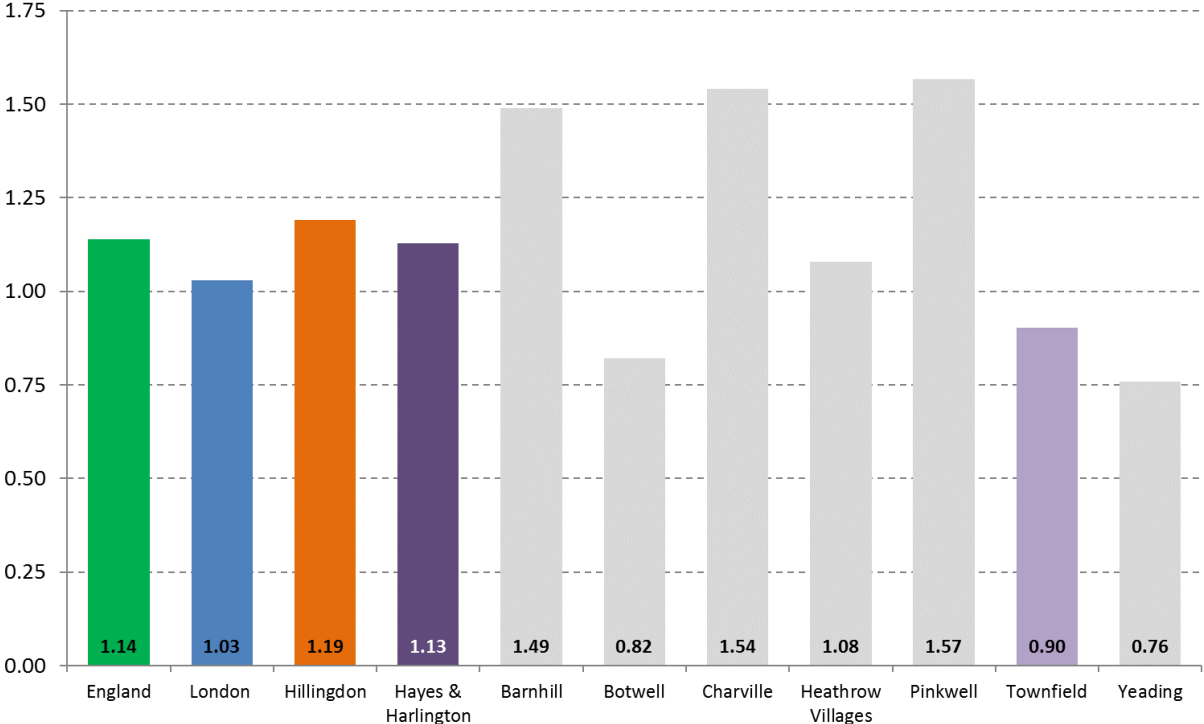

Atrial Fibrillation prevalence, 2017/18

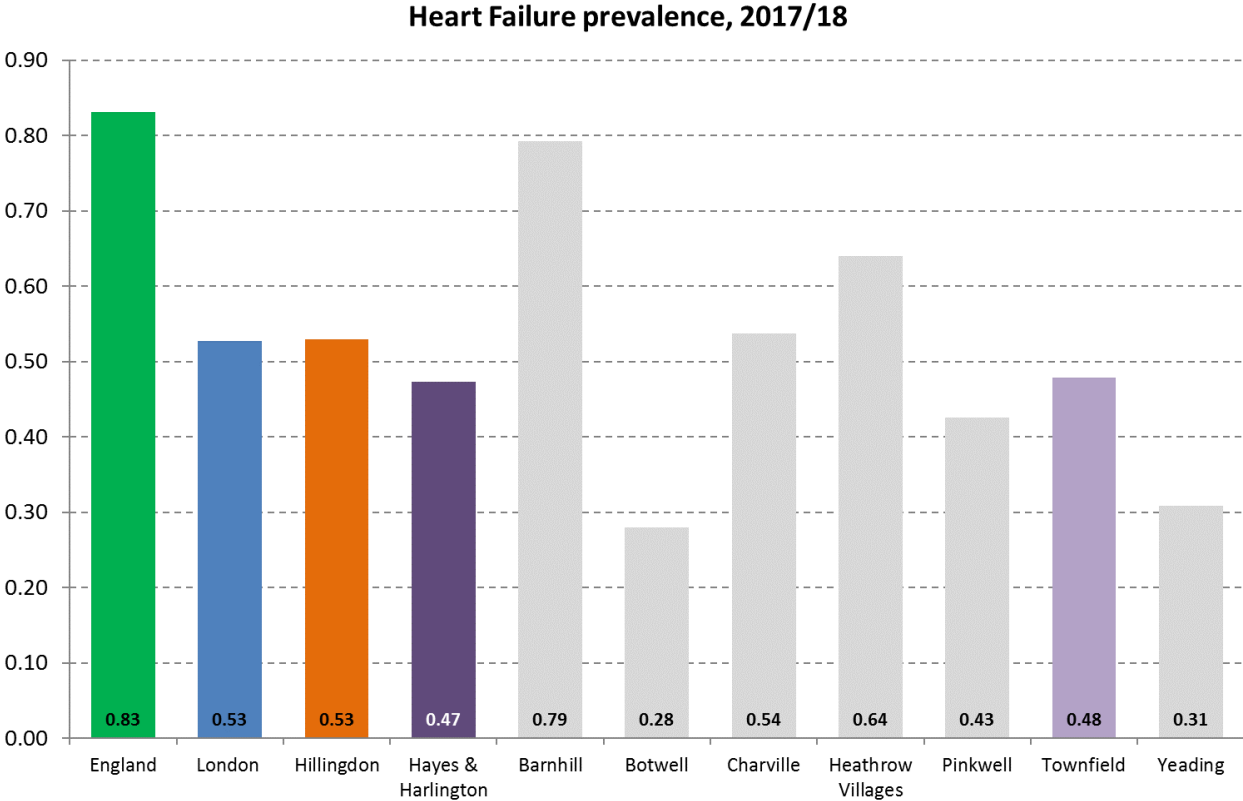

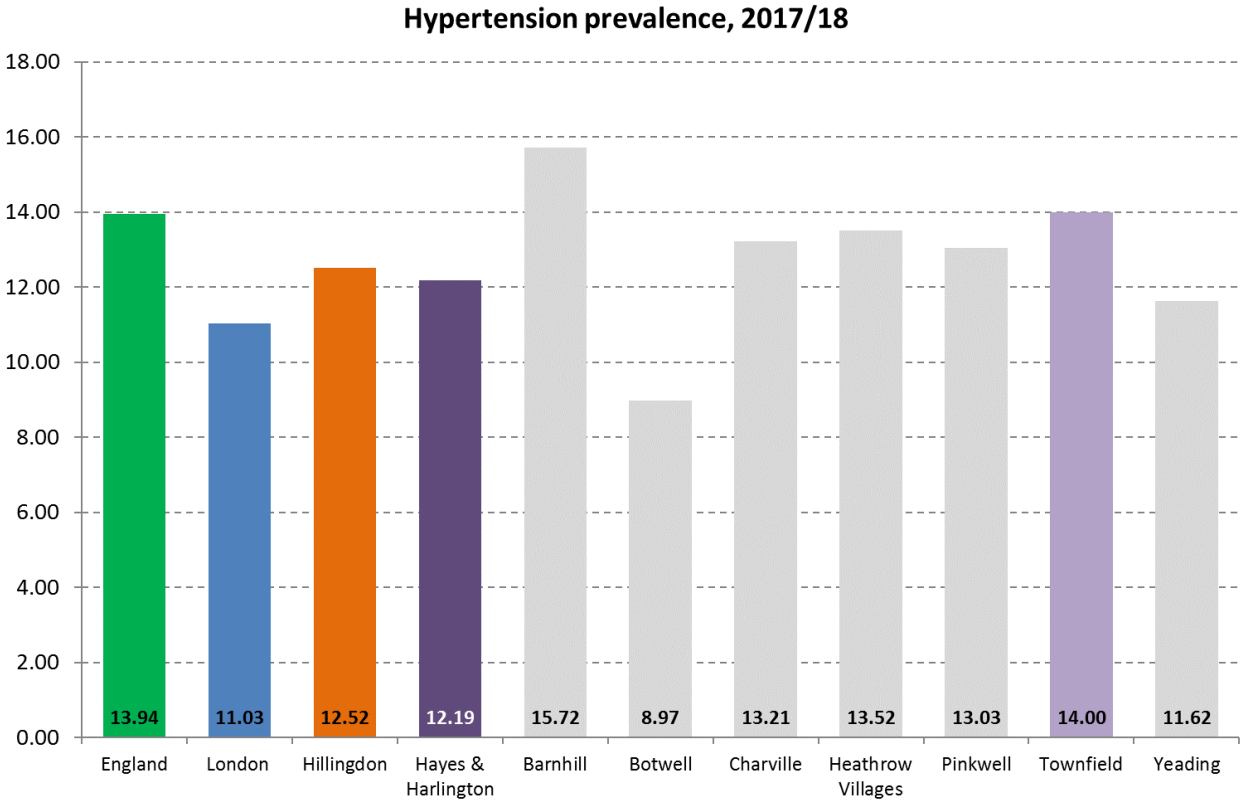
Cardiovascular Disease prevalence, 2017/18



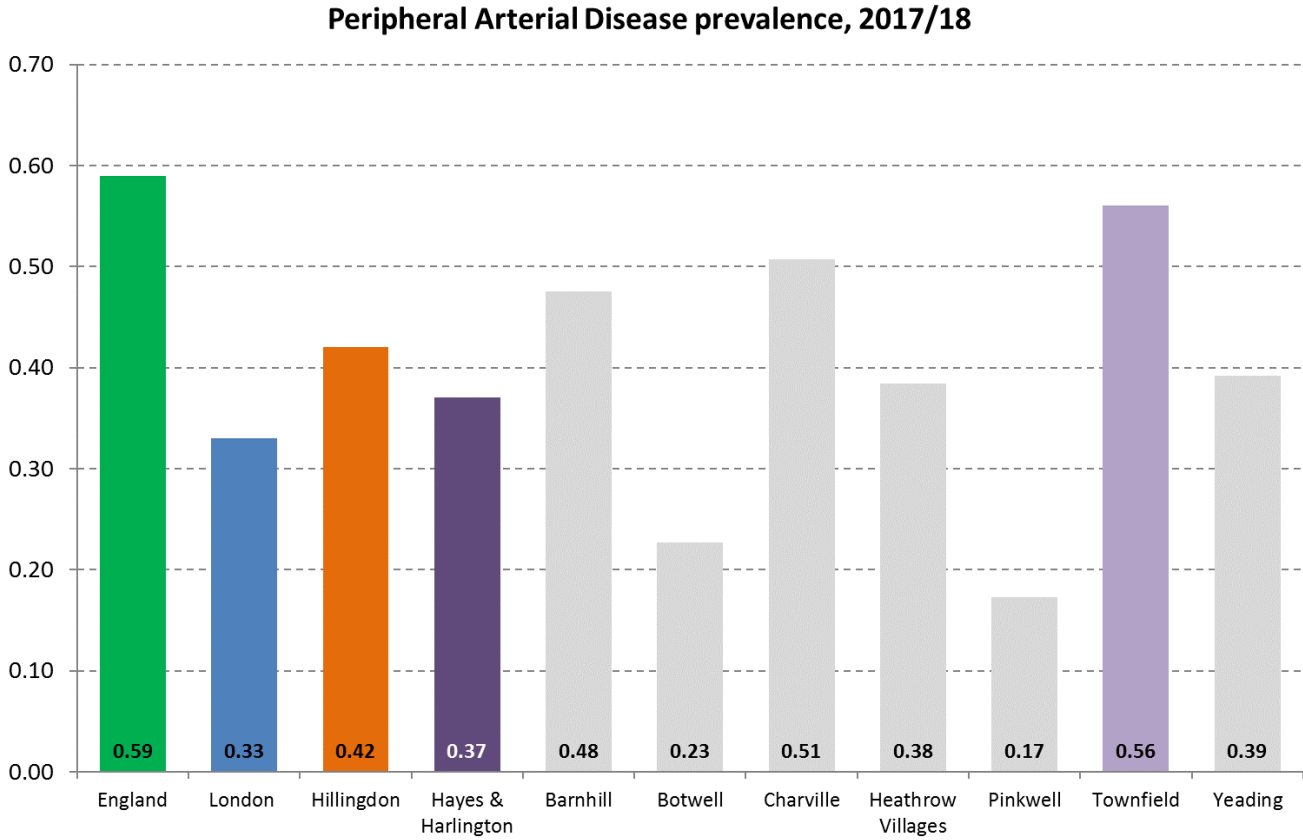

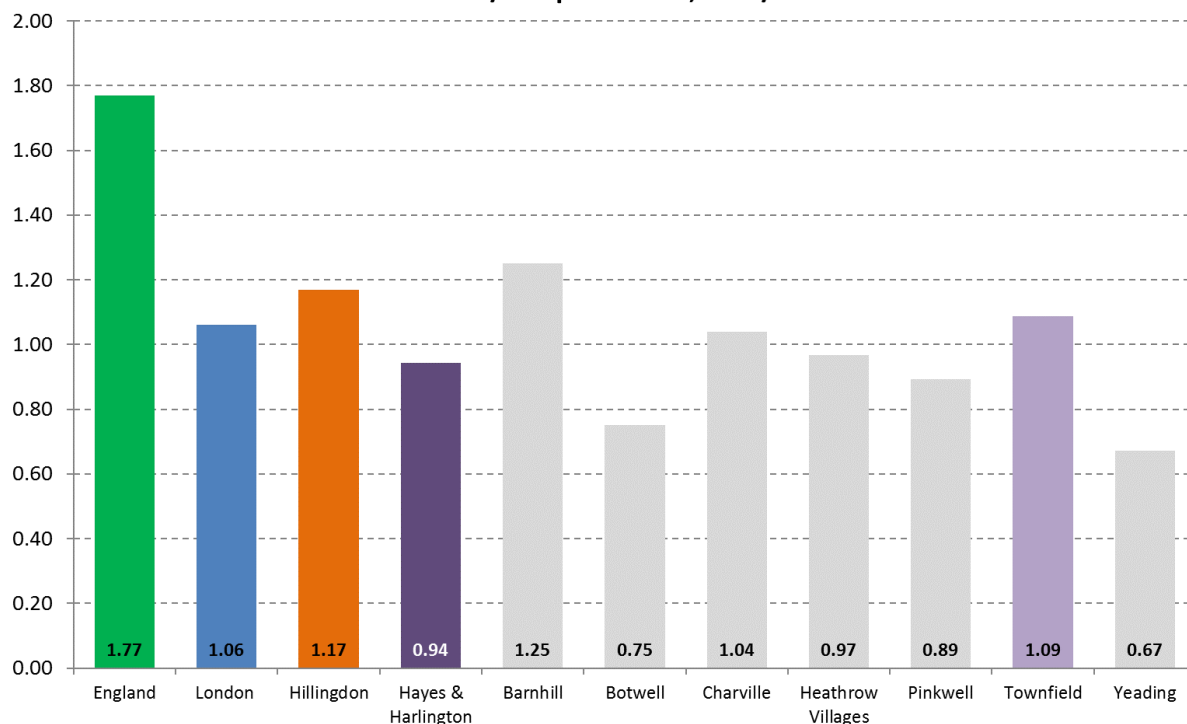

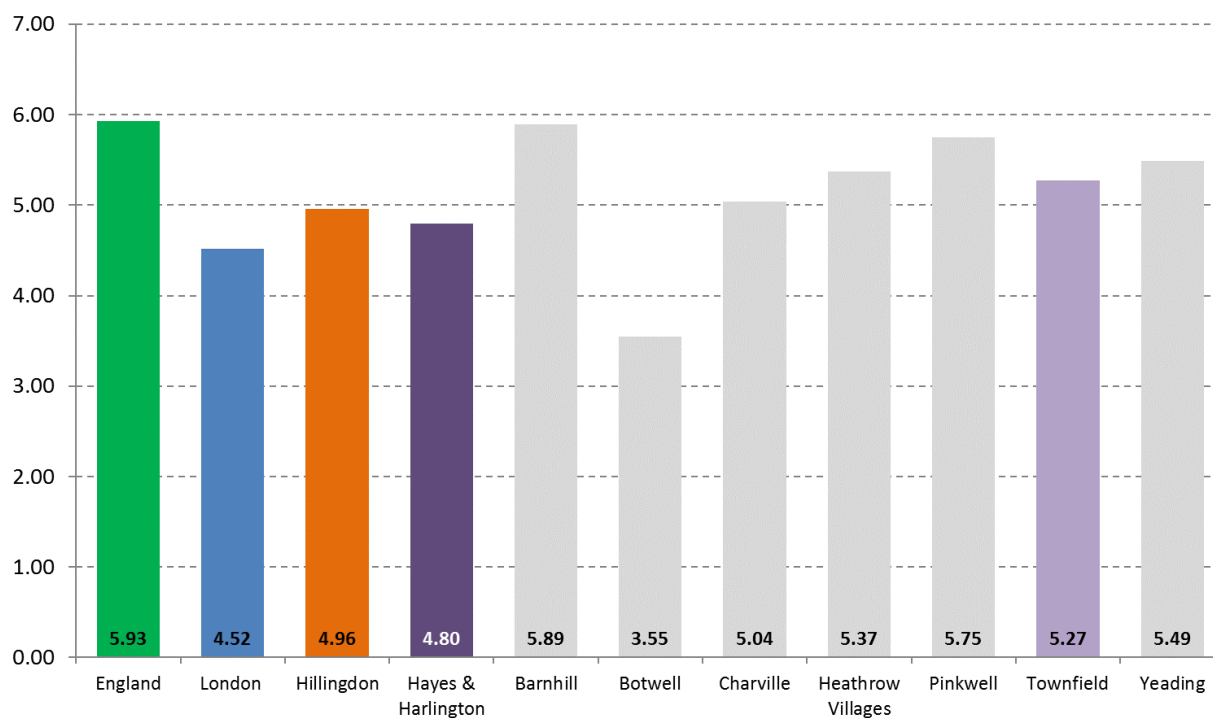
Stroke / TIA prevalence, 2017/18

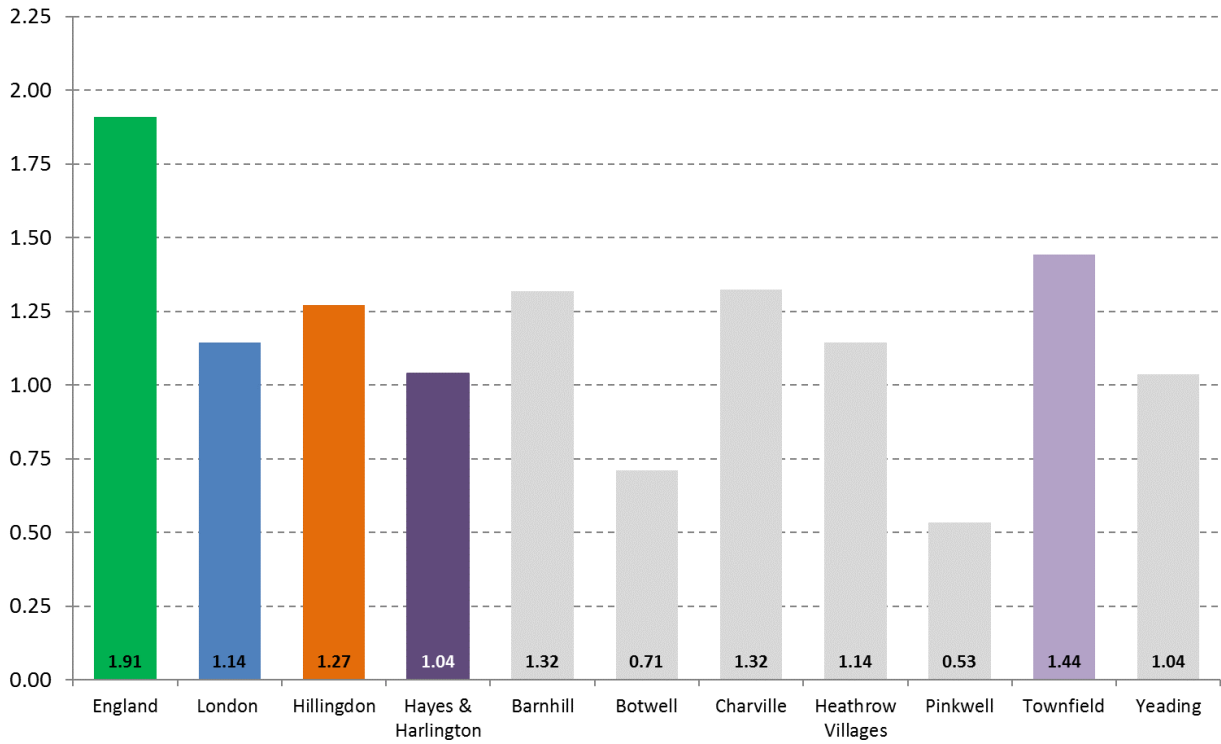

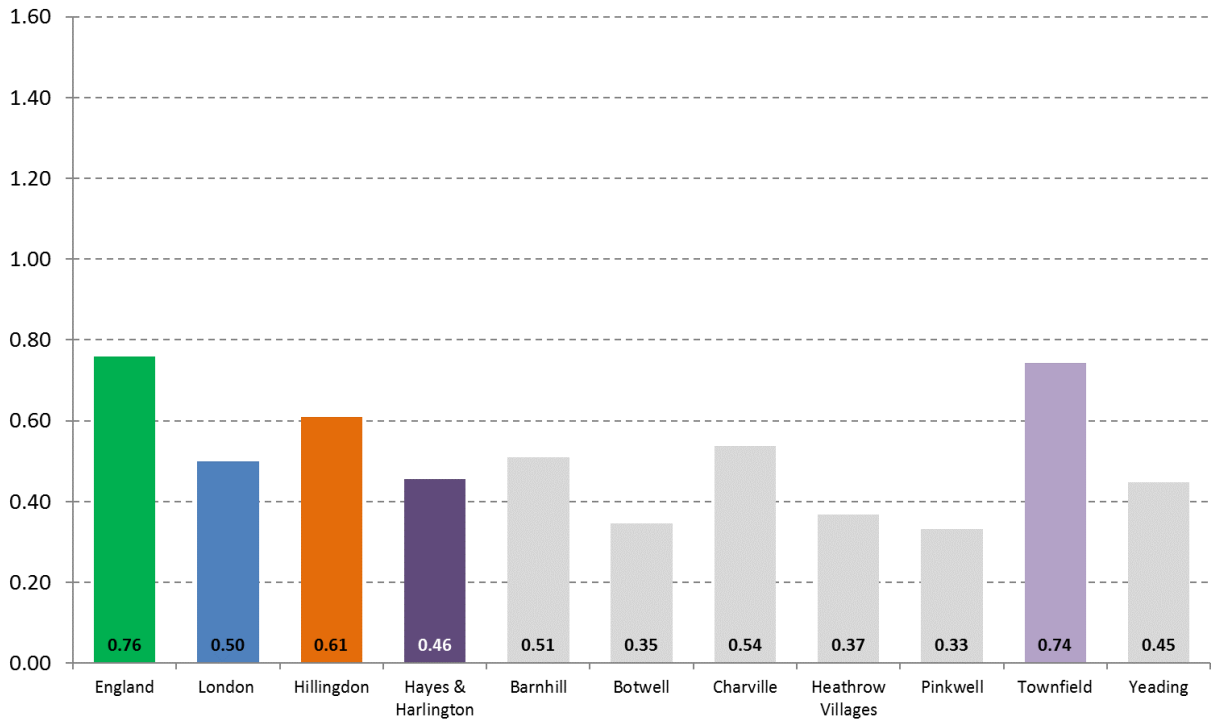
COPD prevalence, 2017/18



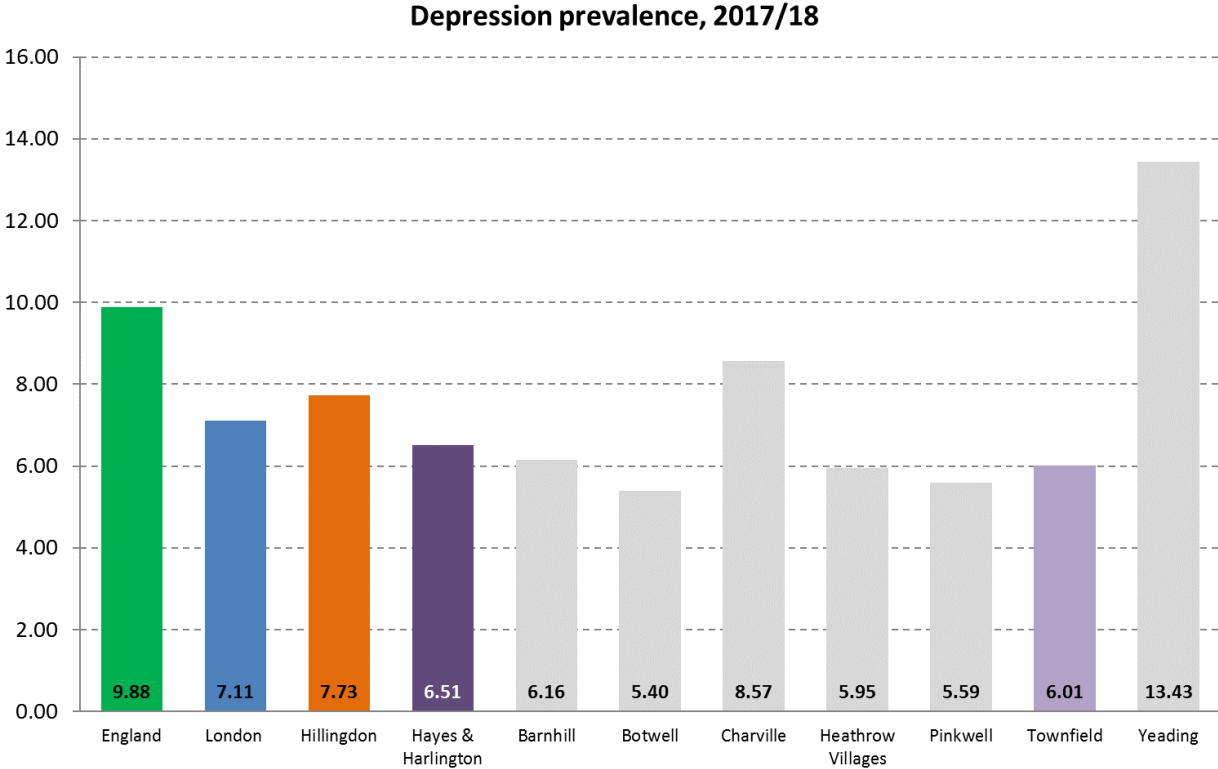

Dementia prevalence, 2017/18

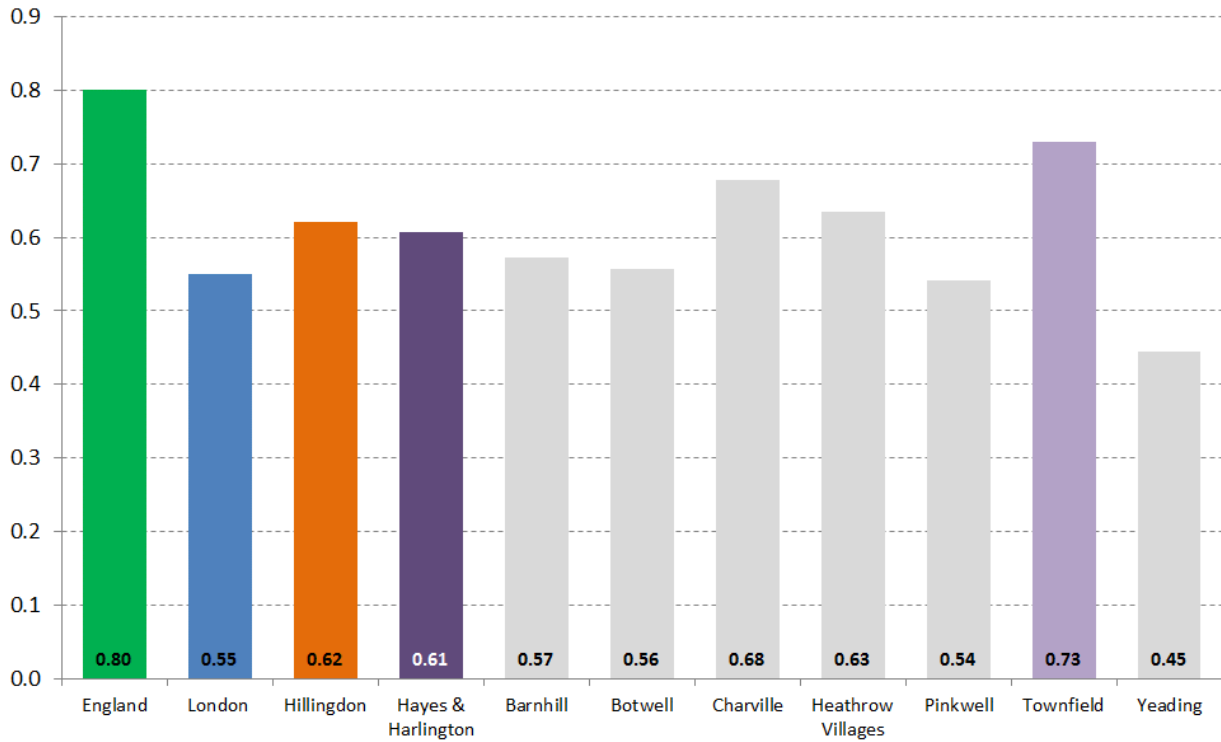

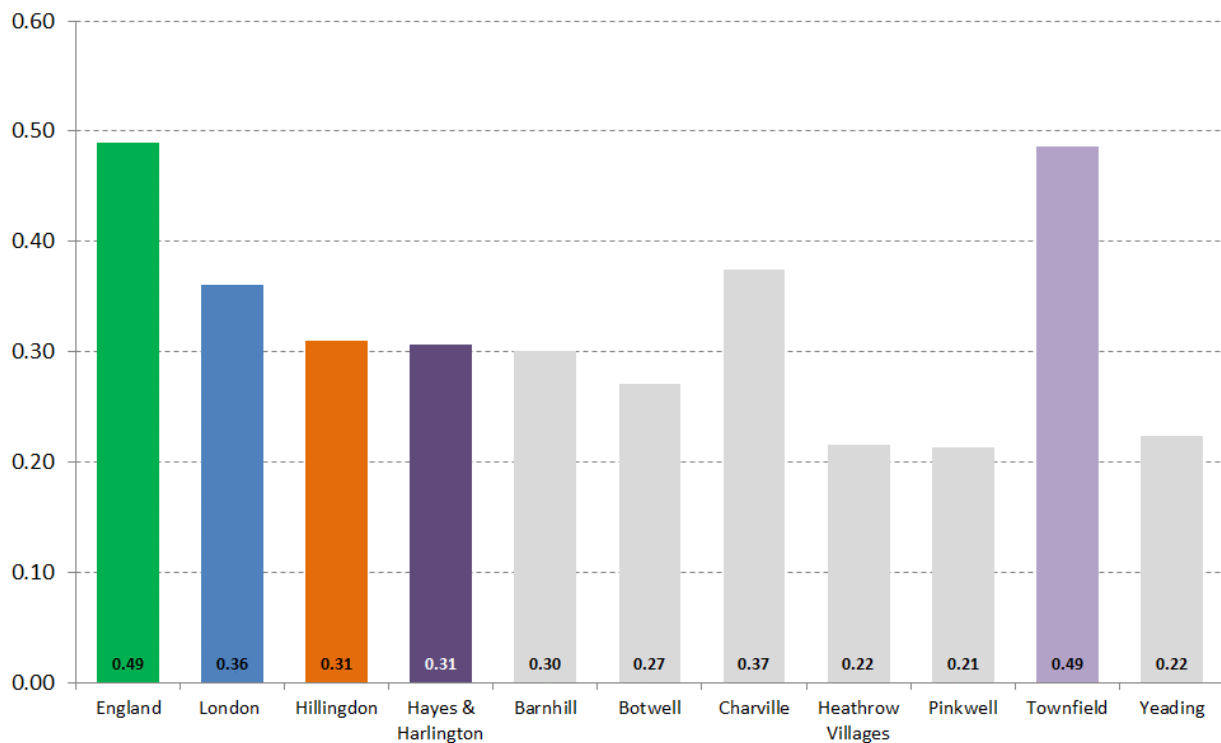

Epilepsy prevalence, 2017/18



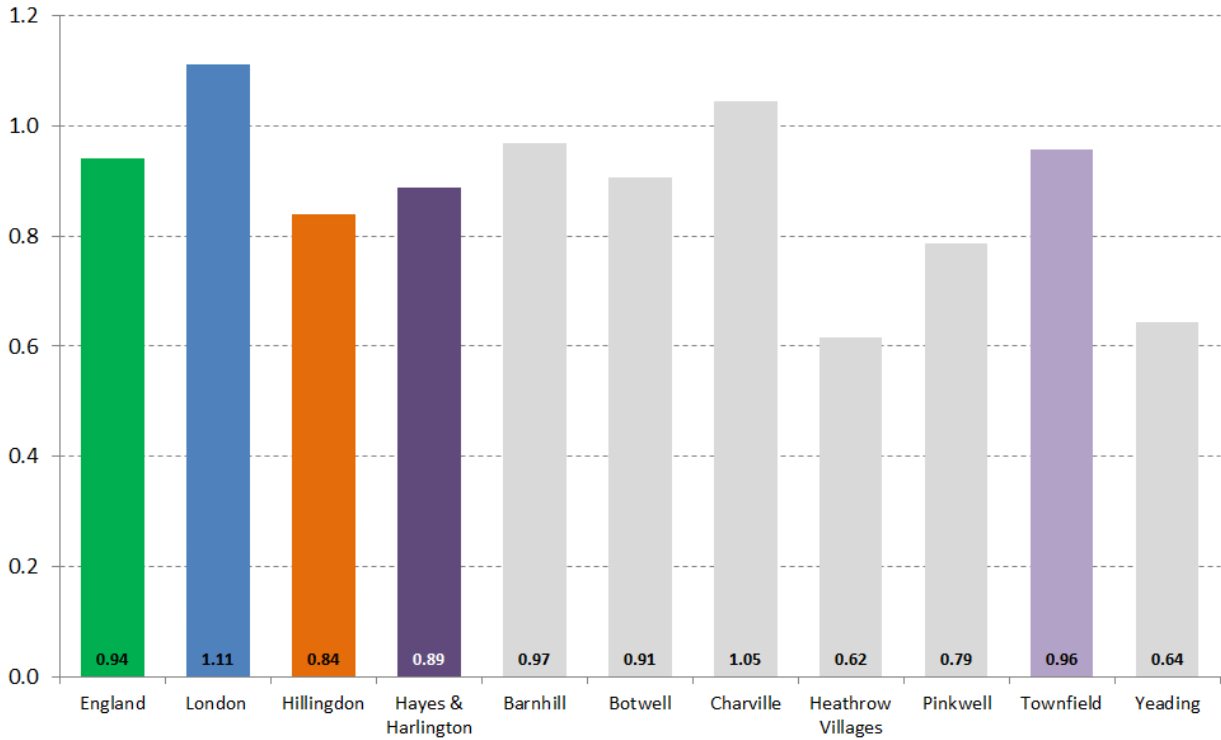

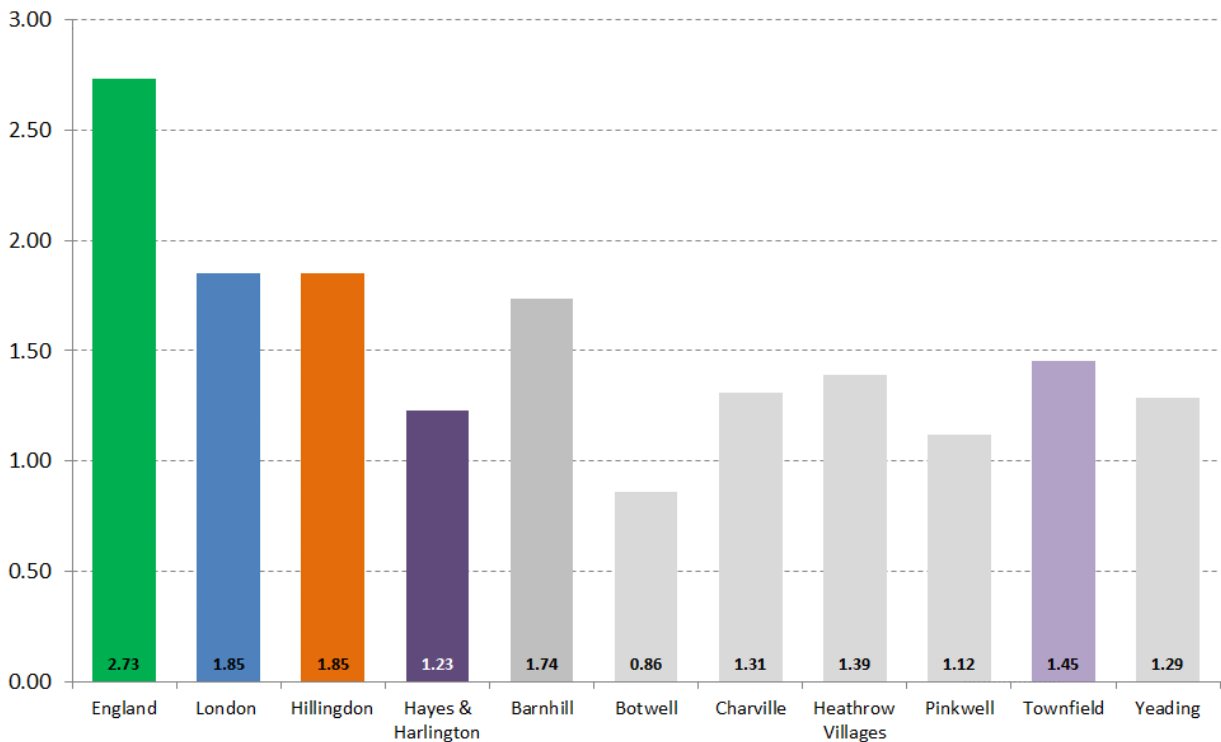
Mental Health prevalence, 2017/18



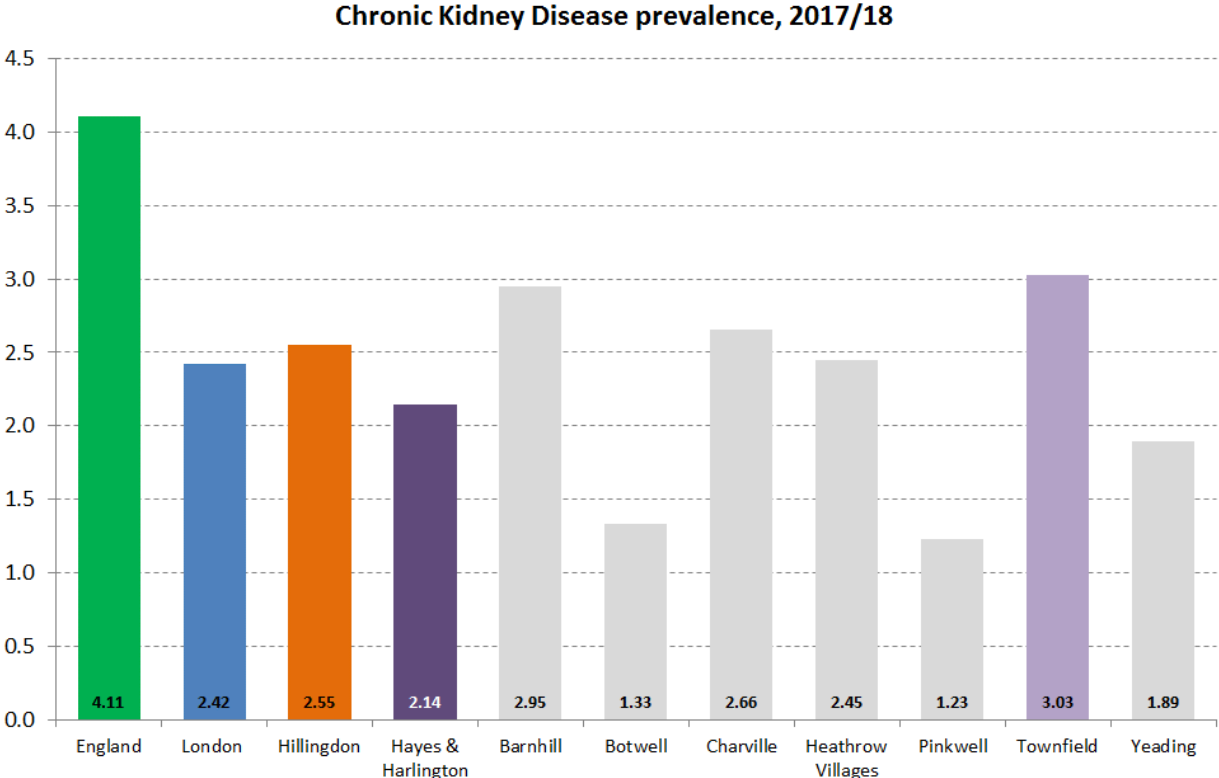

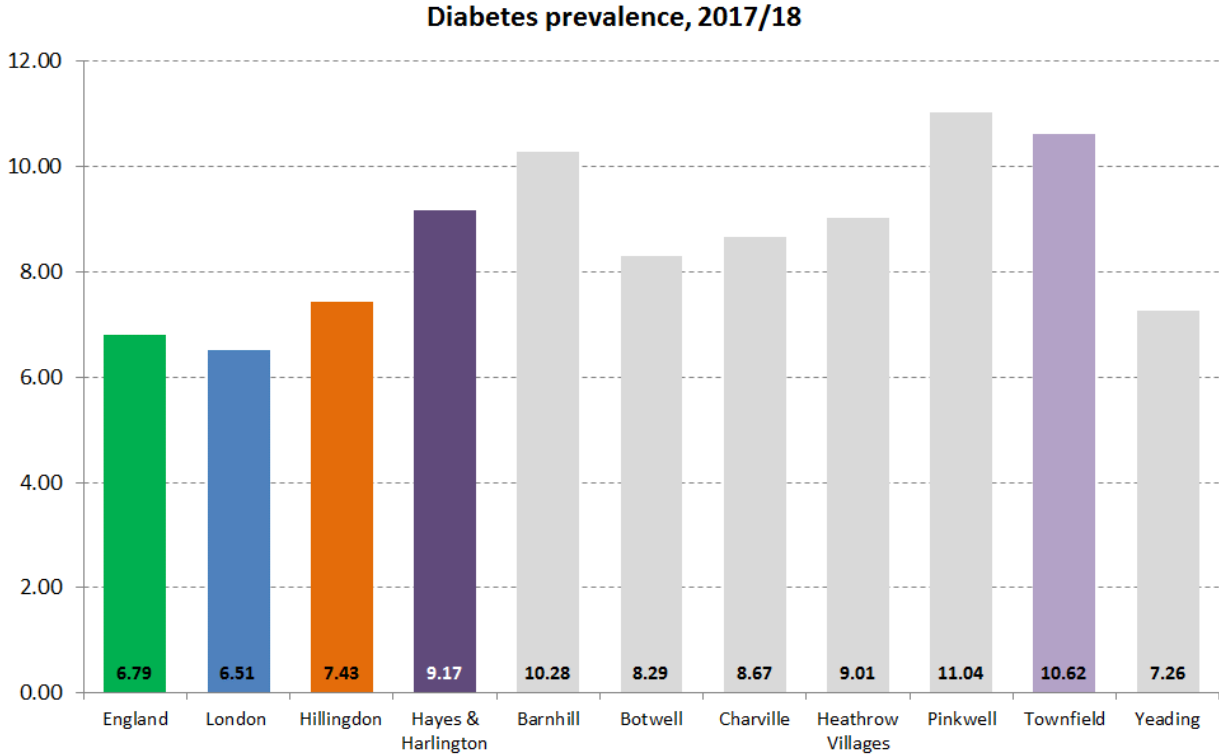
Cancer prevalence, 2017/18



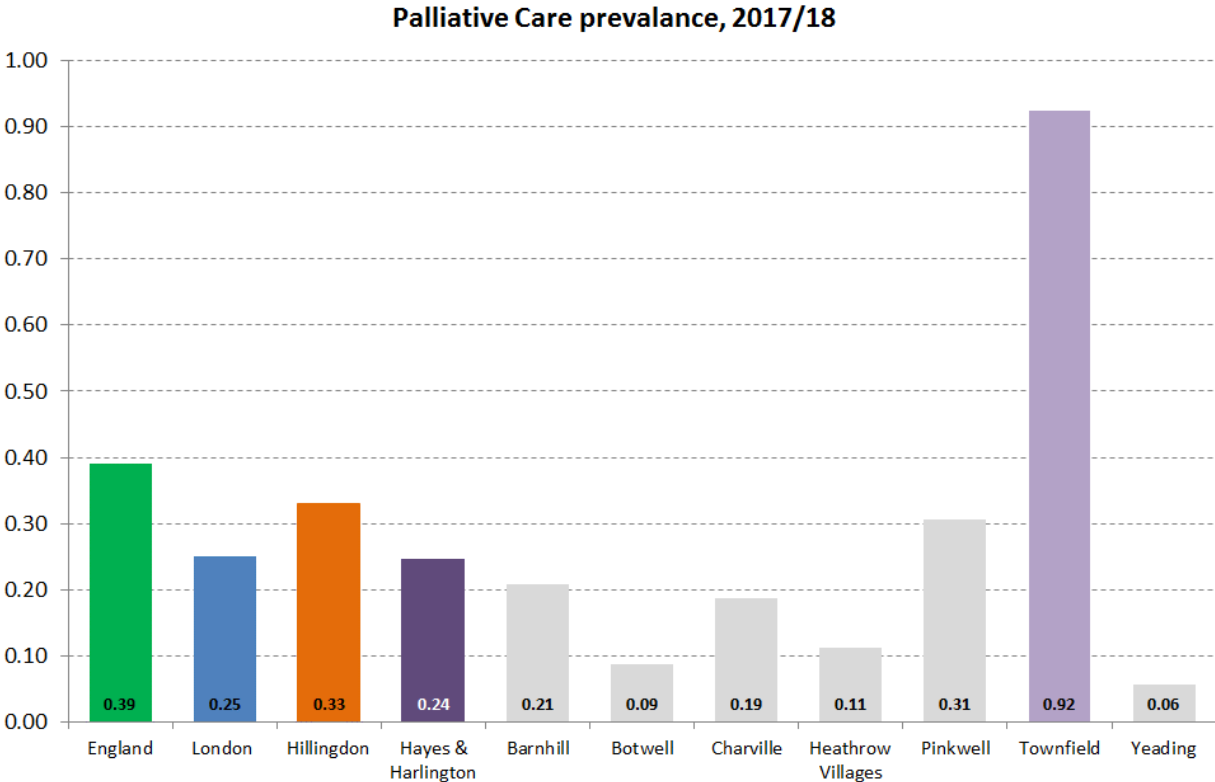

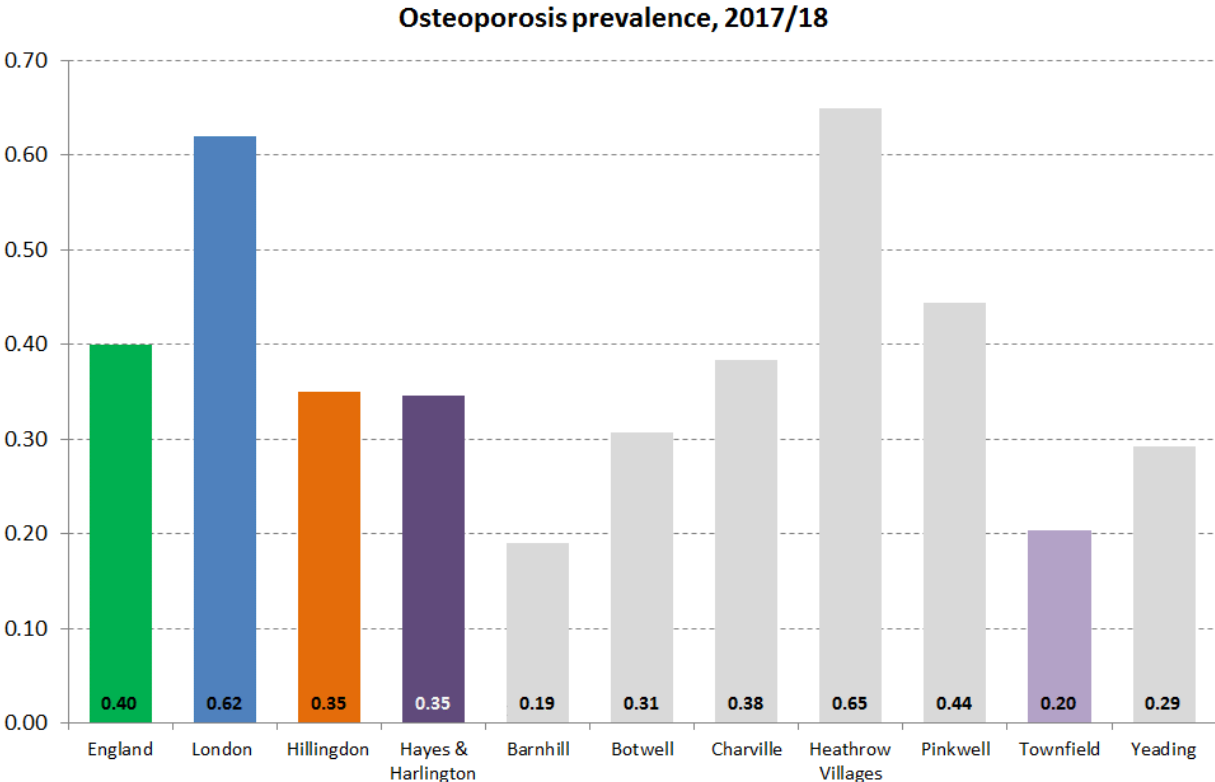

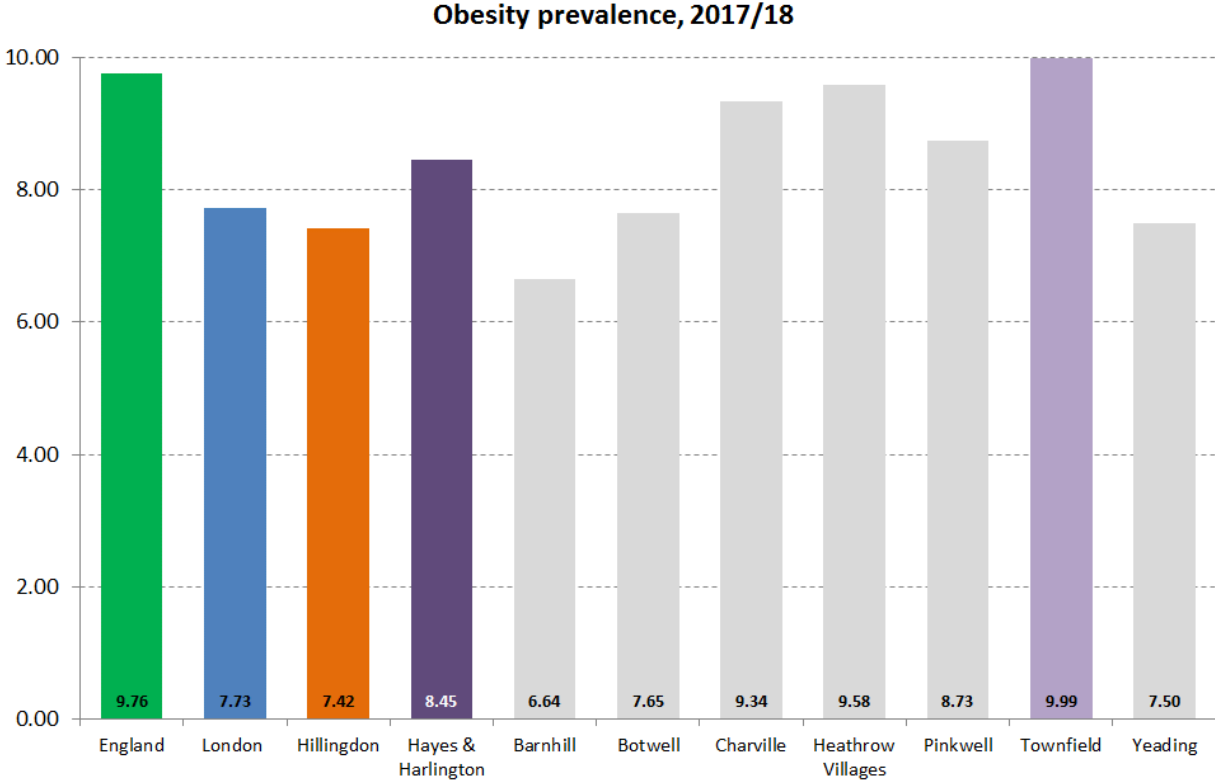

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.

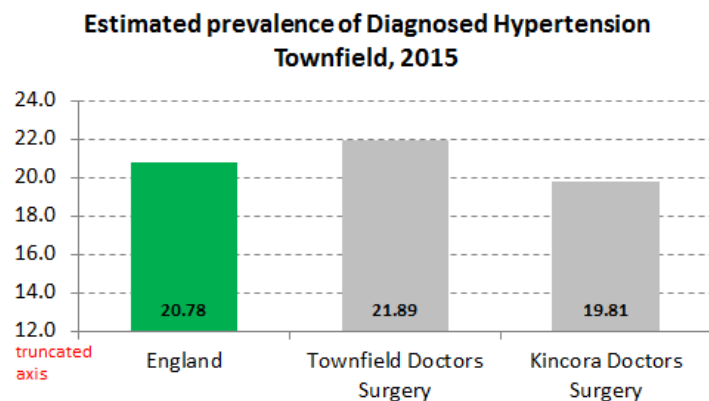
The graphs show estimated prevalence at England and GP level (data is not available at London, borough or locality level). Estimated prevalence is available on a limited number of conditions; data is taken from the latest Disease & Risk Factor Prevalence profile on Fingertips, 2015 (<https://fingertips.phe.org.uk/profile/prevalence>).

Townfield ward contains 2 GP surgeries (Townfield Doctors Surgery and Kincora Doctors Surgery). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

Townfield Doctors Surgery has the highest estimated prevalence of the 2 surgeries in the ward.

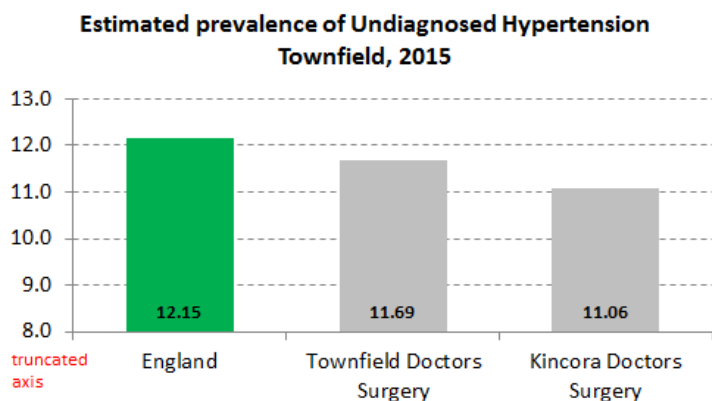

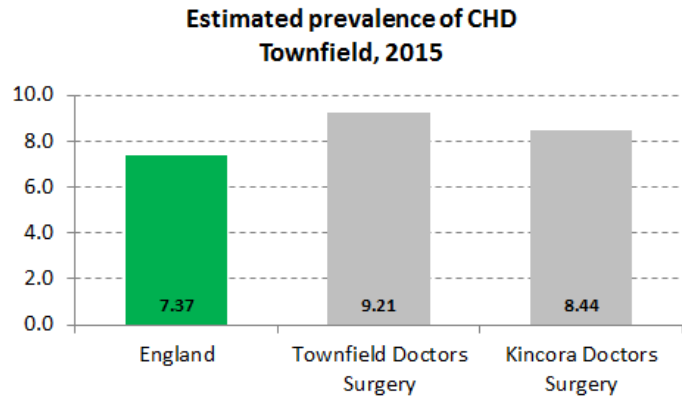

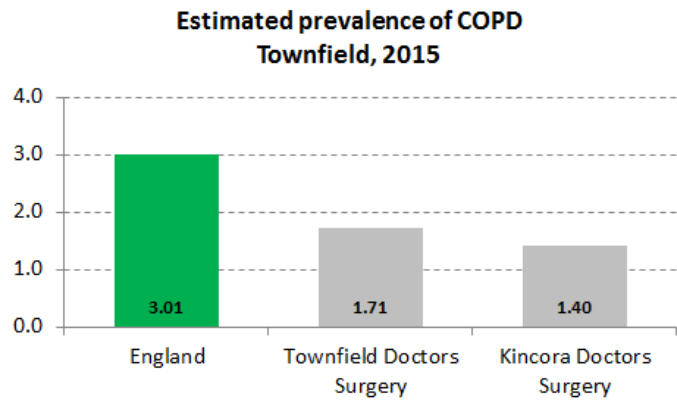

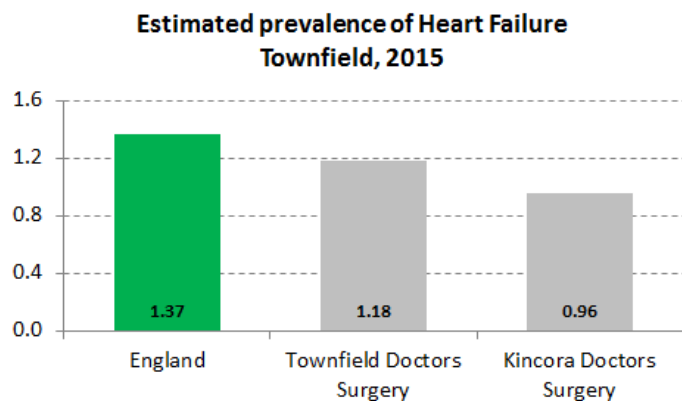

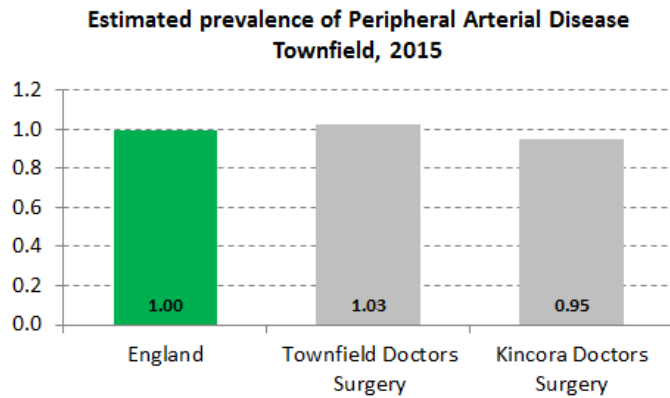

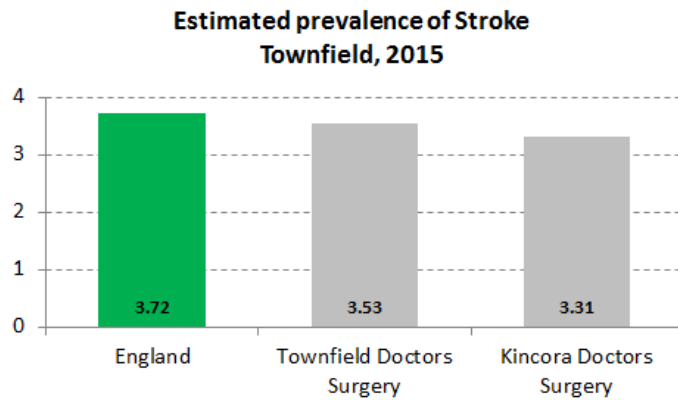

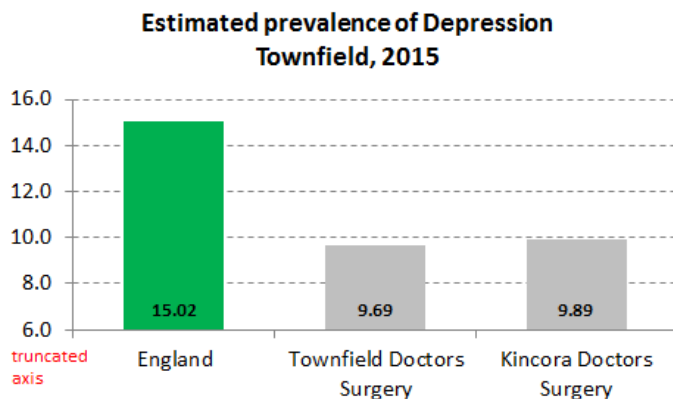
