

Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- Population comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- Age 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- Ethnicity Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- Religion¹ the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu 22,033 (8%) and Sikh 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' 46,492 (17%) and other 23,303 (8.5%).


Uxbridge South Ward

Uxbridge South lies in the West of Hillingdon and is bordered by Uxbridge North, Brunel ward and Yiewsley as well as the county of Buckinghamshire.

In 2017², Uxbridge South's population is 15,012 residents, an increase of 7.4% since 2011 (13,979); this is below the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Uxbridge South is made up of 311.7 hectares (3.1 km^{sq}), with 48.2 people per hectare (4,816 per km^{sq}). The average number of people per household in Uxbridge South is 2.5³.

Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Uxbridge South, which is made up of six LSOA areas⁴.





Ward Population:



The chart above shows that 12.6% of Uxbridge South residents are under the age of 16. 83.1% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 4.3% are over the age of 75.

The chart below shows higher number males and females aged 20-29 years in Uxbridge South compared to other age groups. This is due to the location of Brunel University in the neighbouring ward.




Gender

The proportion of **men to women** in the ward is 50.8% to 49.2%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 50.5% to 49.5% male to female ratio in the ward.

The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:


Male/Female ratio at Hillingdon and ward level, 2017




Ethnic make up 2011⁵

In the 2011 census, 62.1% of residents in the ward identify themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 4.3% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 22.6% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 7.3% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 3.7% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:





Religion⁶


Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 46.4% from this faith. 5% are Hindu, 13.4% Muslim, 2.3% Sikh with 23.8% having no religion. 7.0% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary). According to the 2011 Census figures Uxbridge South has the highest number of residents with no religion (3,324 residents). Uxbridge South also has the one of the highest number of residents in the Borough with religions Buddhist and Muslim.

Uxbridge South, Religion 2011:




Hillingdon, Religion 2011:

Country of Birth⁷

Of those living in Uxbridge South, 78.0% were **born** in Europe (with 69.1% in the UK), 15.4% in the Middle East / Asia, 5.0% in Africa, and 1.6% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Uxbridge South, 30.9% were **born** outside of the UK (with 69.1% in the UK).



Uxbridge South has the highest number of residents stating they were born in Germany (7.7% of borough residents, 105).


The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 79.4% residents stating this at their main language. Of the remaining 20.6%, the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well', with 357 residents (12.8% of those where English is not their main language) stating they cannot speak English well or at all⁸.

Apart from English, Uxbridge South has the highest number of residents speaking any European language across the Borough, with 679 residents (5.0% of ward population). The ward also has the highest number of Chinese speakers, with 314 residents (2.3%) stating this as their first language.

Working Age Population (ages 16-74):




In Uxbridge South, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 38.3% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 51.5%, the remaining 10.2% are from the 60-74 age group.

Economic Data (statistics are for the age 16-74 group)

In Uxbridge South, 60.9% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:



The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Uxbridge South is 11.8%, which is lower than the Hillingdon average (13.6%).

Households

In 2017, there were 5,968 households¹⁰ in Uxbridge South; an increase of 849 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type¹¹** within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 58.8%, with 41.2% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).



In Uxbridge South, 49.5% of ward residents own their own homes, followed by 25.4% of properties being privately rented, 22.2% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 2.9% other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.



Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Uxbridge South, the life expectancy is estimated at 79.9 years for males and 81.7 years for females. This is similar to the averages for Hillingdon and England.




Observed Prevalence¹²



The graphs show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register within the locality, recorded as having a given condition at England, London, borough and locality level.

















Dementia prevalence, 2015/16





Learning Disabilities prevalence, 2015/16






Mental Health prevalence, 2015/16





Chronic Kidney Disease prevalence, 2015/16








