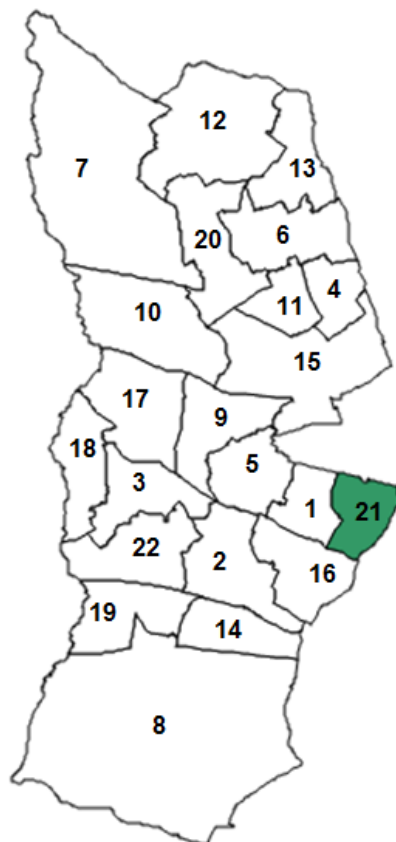

## Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- **Population** – comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** – 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- **Age** – 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- **Ethnicity** - Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%..
- **Religion<sup>1</sup>** - the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian – 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim – 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu – 22,033 (8%) and Sikh – 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' – 46,492 (17%) and other – 23,303 (8.5%).

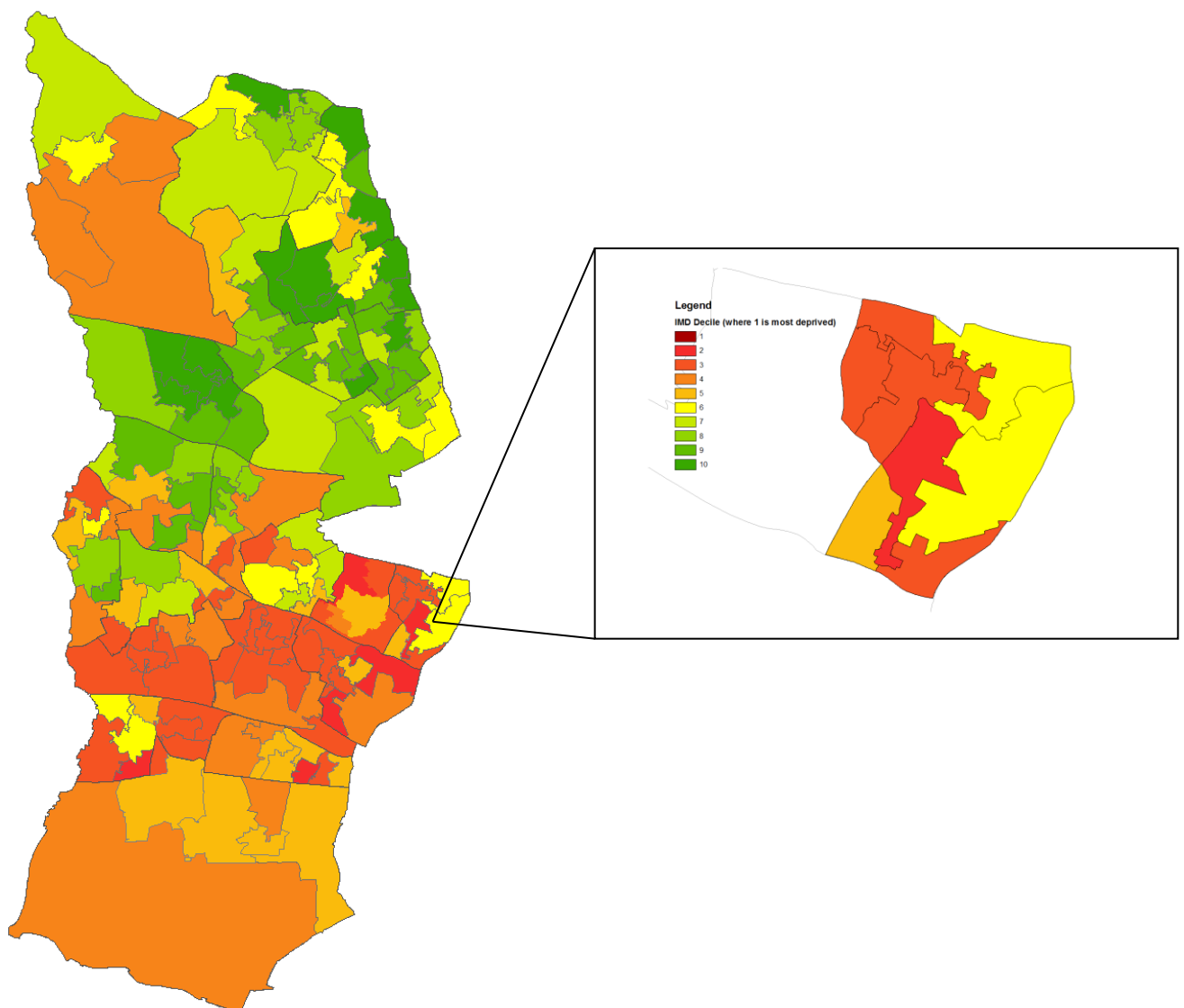
## Yeading Ward

Yeading lies in the East of Hillingdon and is bordered by Barnhill and Townfield as well as by the London Borough of Ealing.

In 2017<sup>2</sup>, Yeading population is 14,699 residents, an increase of 8.2% since 2011 (13,714); this is below the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Yeading is made up of 233.2 hectares (2.3 km<sup>sq</sup>), with 63.0 people per hectare (6,303 per km<sup>sq</sup>). The average number of people per household in Yeading is 2.5<sup>3</sup>.

## Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Yeading, which is made up of eight LSOA areas<sup>4</sup>.

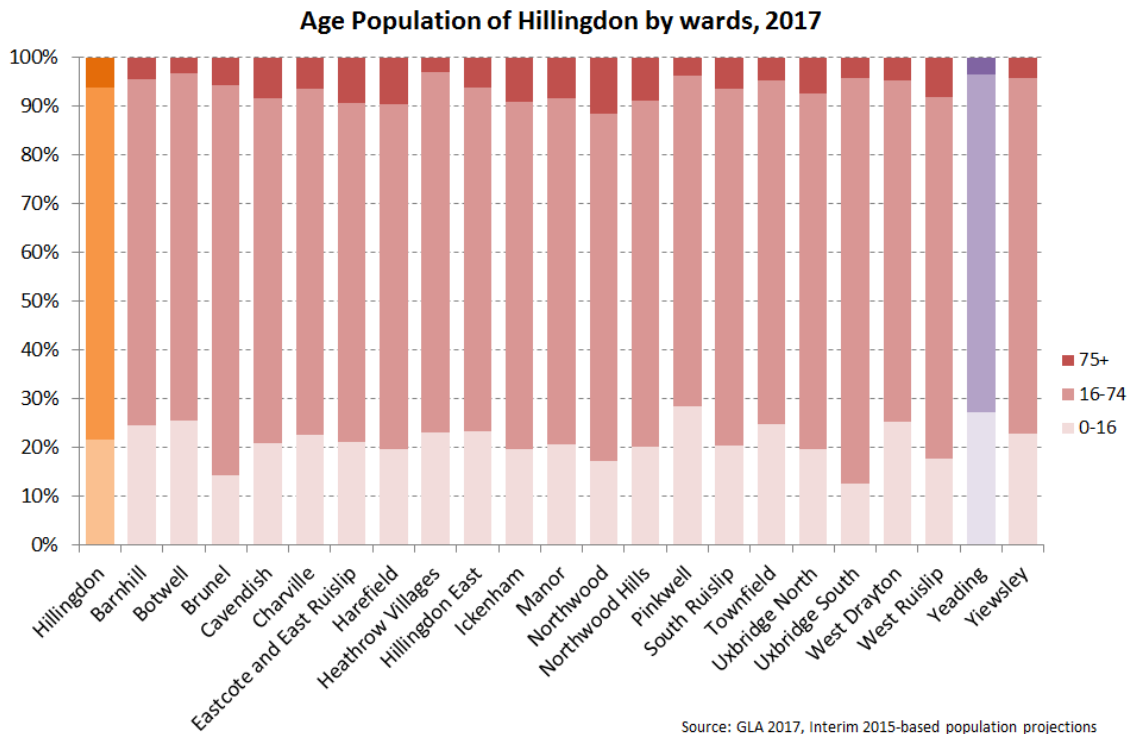

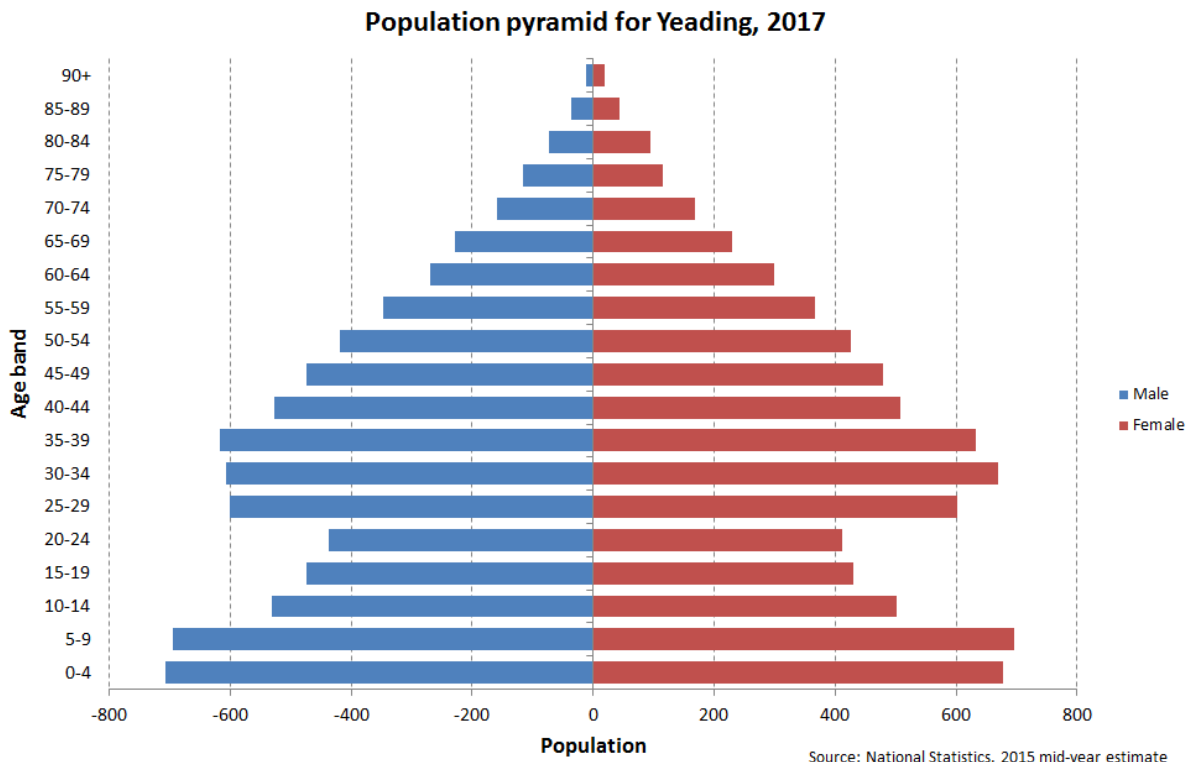

## Ward Population:



The chart above shows that 27.2% of Yeading residents are under the age of 16. 69.3% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 3.5% are over the age of 75.

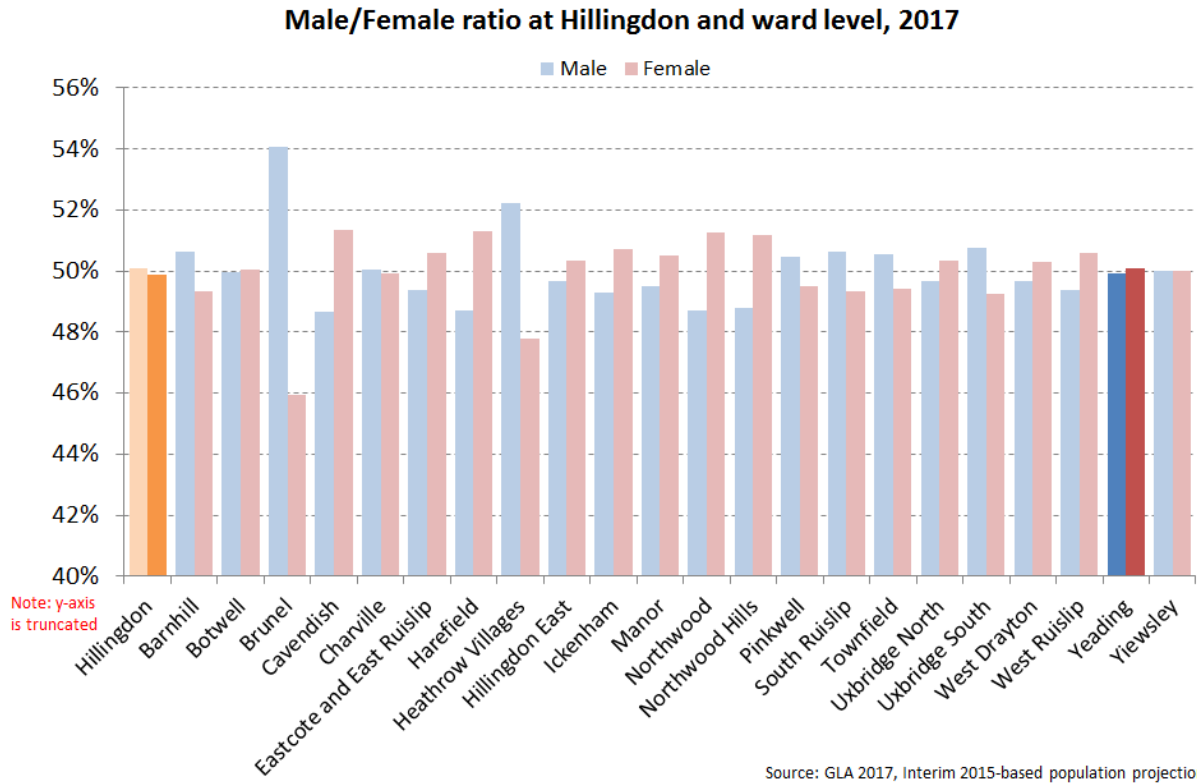
The chart below shows that in Yeading, there are higher numbers of males in the 0-4 age bracket and with females there is higher number in the 5-9 age bracket when compared to other age groups.



## Gender

The proportion of men to women in the ward is 49.9% to 50.1%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 49.4% to 50.6% male to female ratio in the ward.

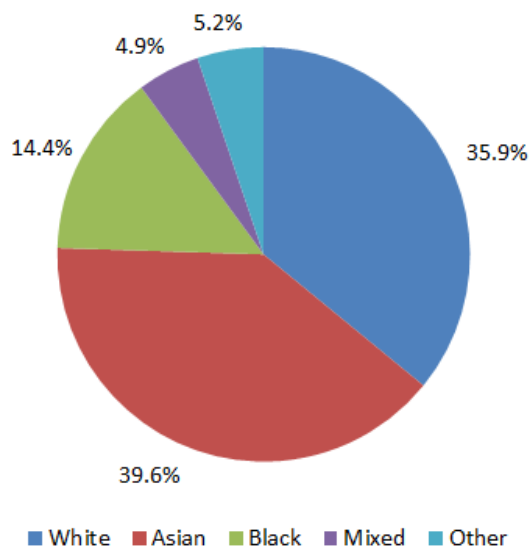
The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:



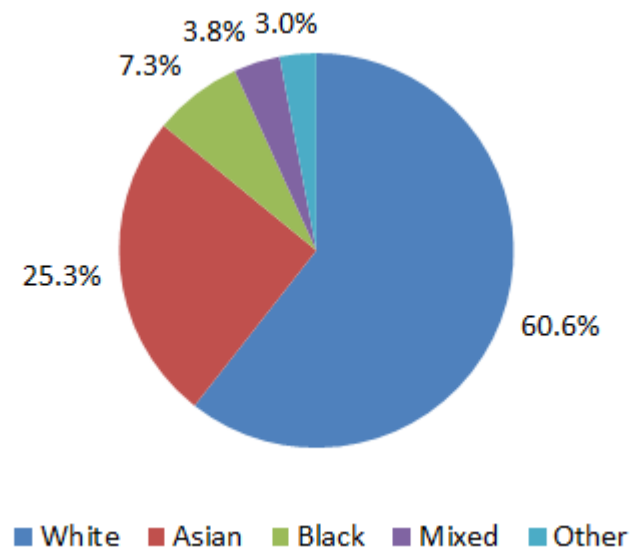
## Ethnic make up 2011<sup>5</sup>

In the 2011 census, 35.9% of Yeading residents identified themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 4.9% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 39.6% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 14.4% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 5.2% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

**Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:**



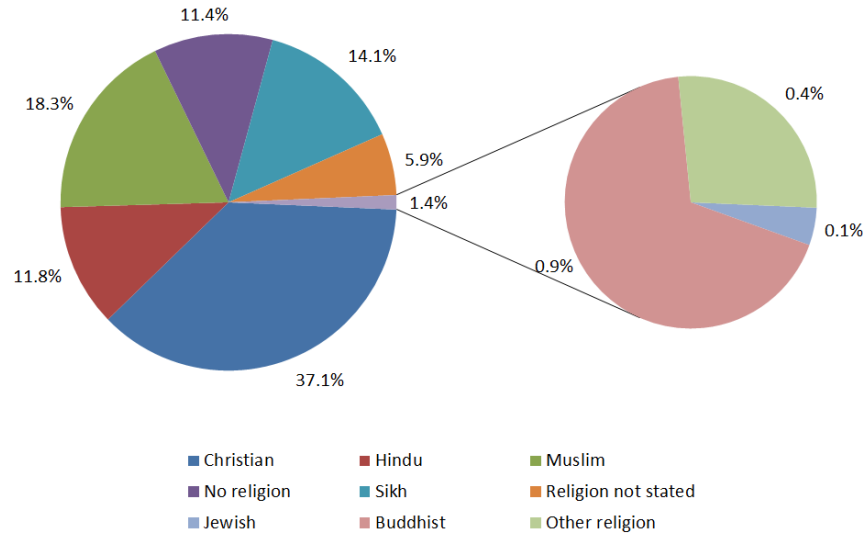

## Religion<sup>6</sup>

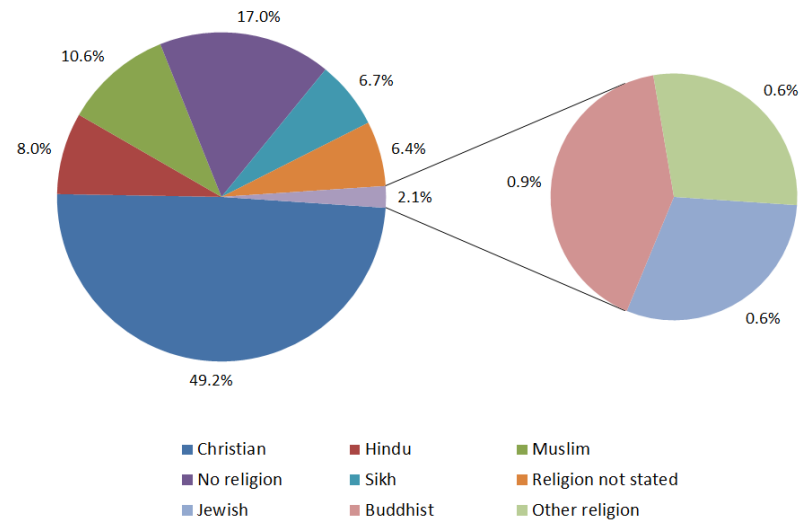
Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 37.1% from this faith. 11.8% are Hindu, 18.3% Muslim, 14.1% Sikh and 11.4% having no religion, 5.9% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary).

**Yeading, Religion 2011:**



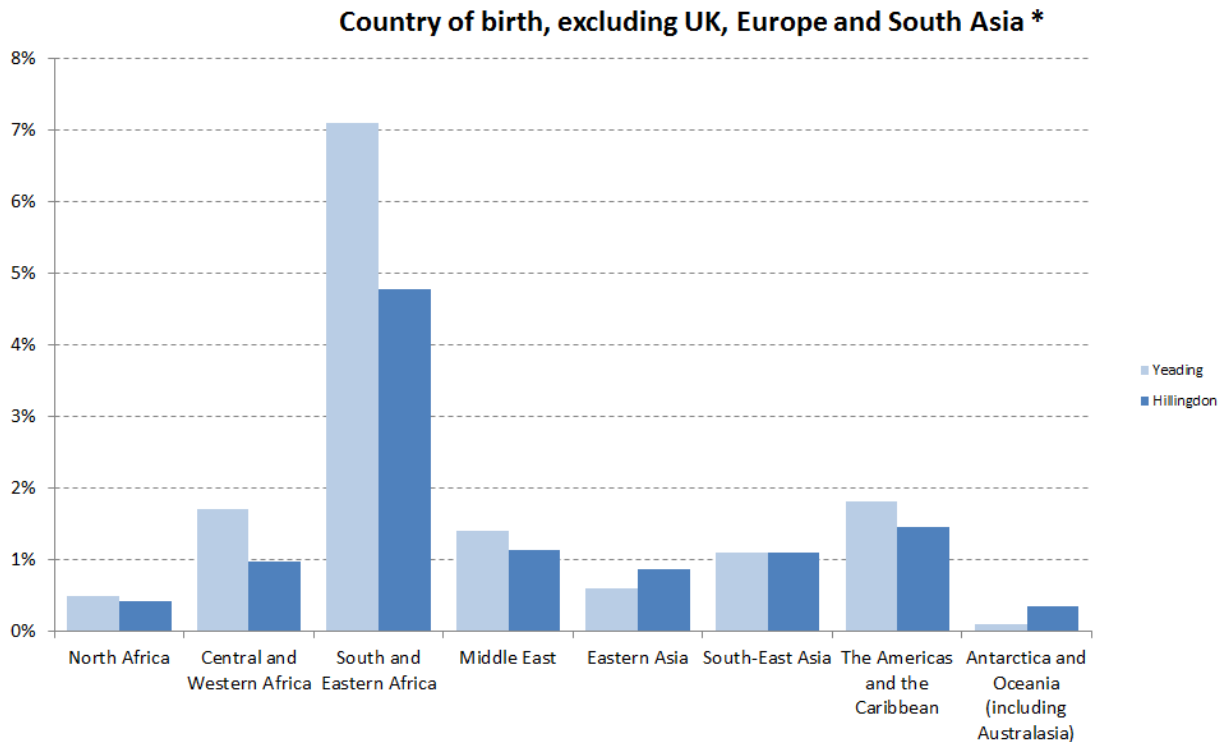
**Hillingdon, Religion 2011:**

## Country of Birth<sup>7</sup>

Of those living in Yeading, 65.0% of residents of Yeading ward were born in Europe (with 57.3% in the UK), 23.7% in the Middle East / Asia, 9.4% in Africa, and 2.0% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Yeading, 42.7% were **born** outside of the UK (with 57.3% in the UK).

The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 68.3% residents stating this as their main language; of the remaining 31.7%, the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well'. 757 residents (18.7% of those where English is not their main language) state that they cannot speak English well or at all<sup>8</sup>.

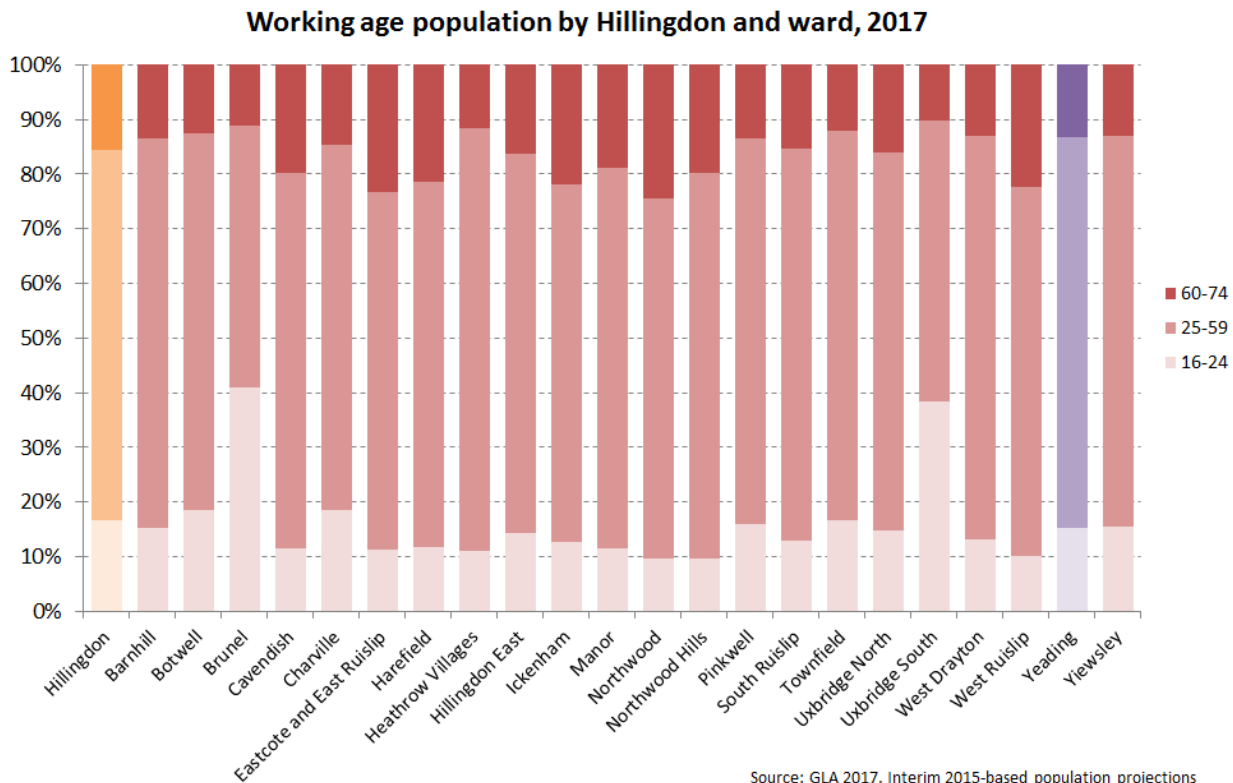
Apart from English the most spoken language in the ward is Panjabi with 8.6% (1,105) of residents speaking the language, Tamil, 3.3%, Somali, 2.5% and Polish 2.4%. 1,892 residents (14.8%) speak the remaining languages.

## Working age breakdown (ages 16-74):



In Yeadling, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 15.3% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 71.4%, the remaining 13.3% are from the 60-74 age group.

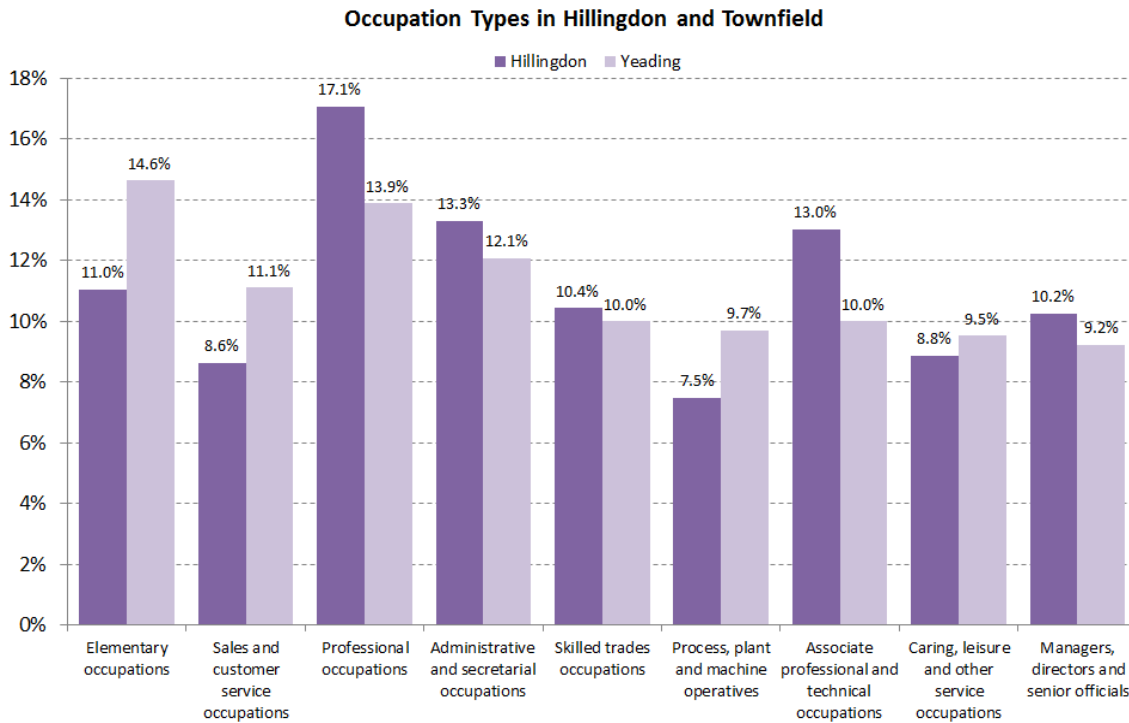
### Economic Data (statistics are for the age 16-74 group)

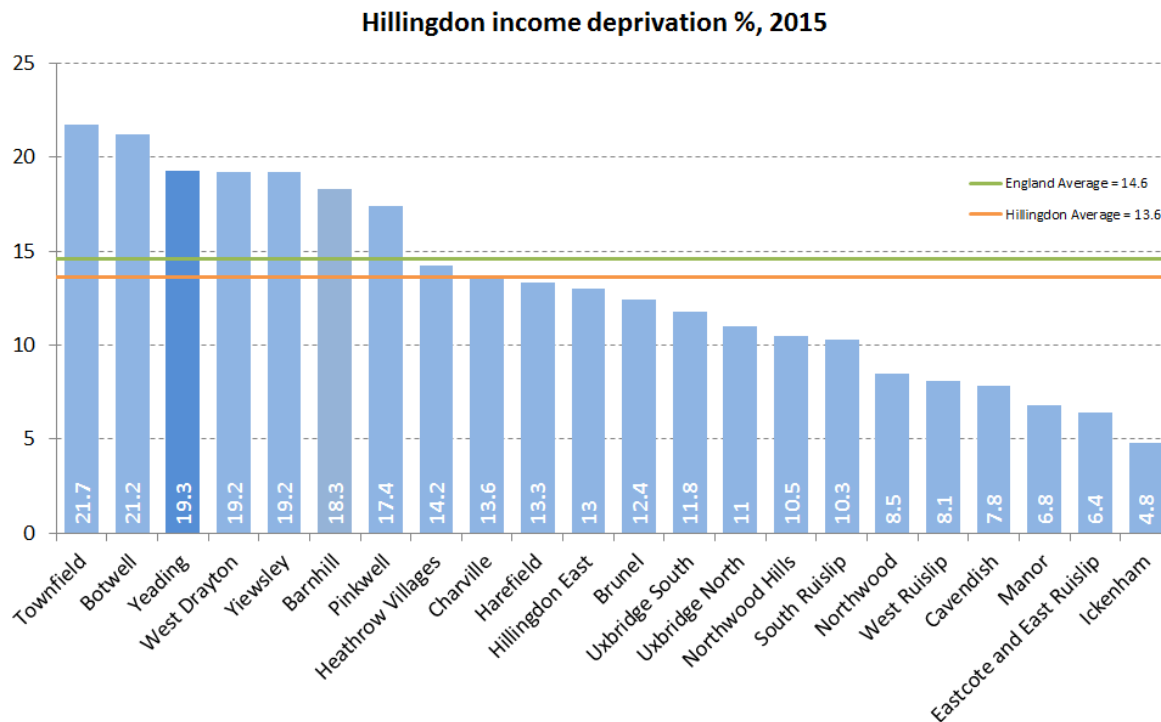

The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Yeading is 19.3%, which is higher than the Hillingdon (13.6%) and England (14.6%).

## Households

In 2017, there were 4,940 households<sup>10</sup> in Yeading; an increase of 87 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**<sup>11</sup> within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 70.1%, with 29.9% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).

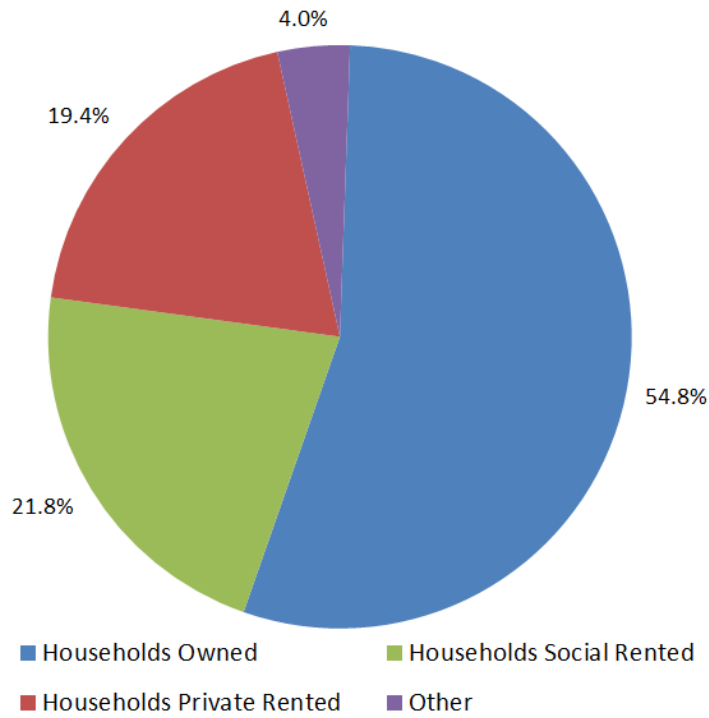

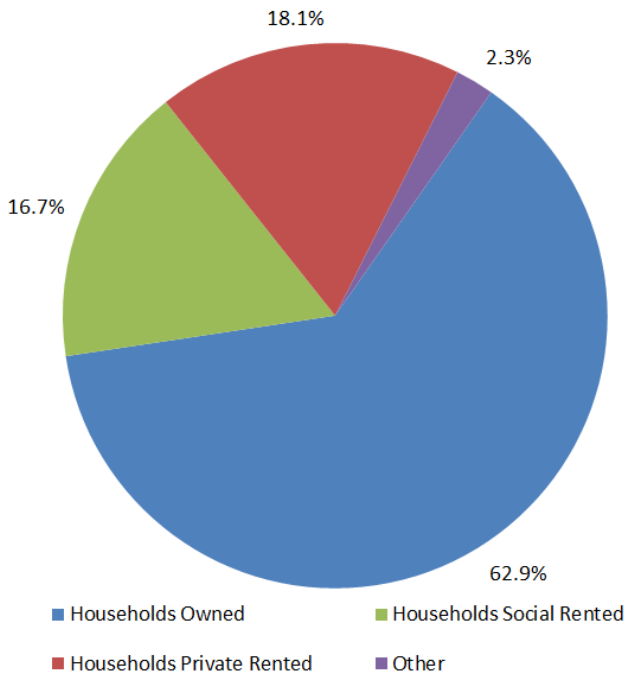

In Yeading, 54.8% of ward residents own their own homes, followed by 19.4% of properties being privately rented, 21.8% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 4.0% other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.

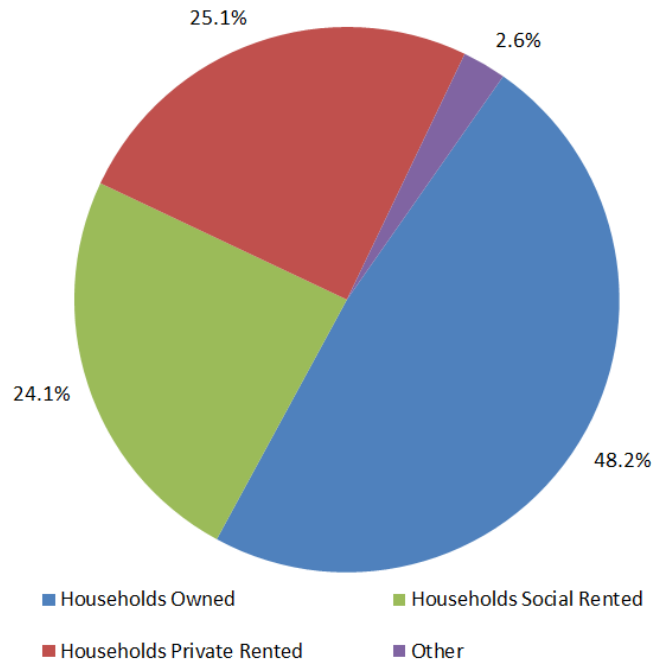
**Household Type Yeading**



**Household Type Hillingdon**



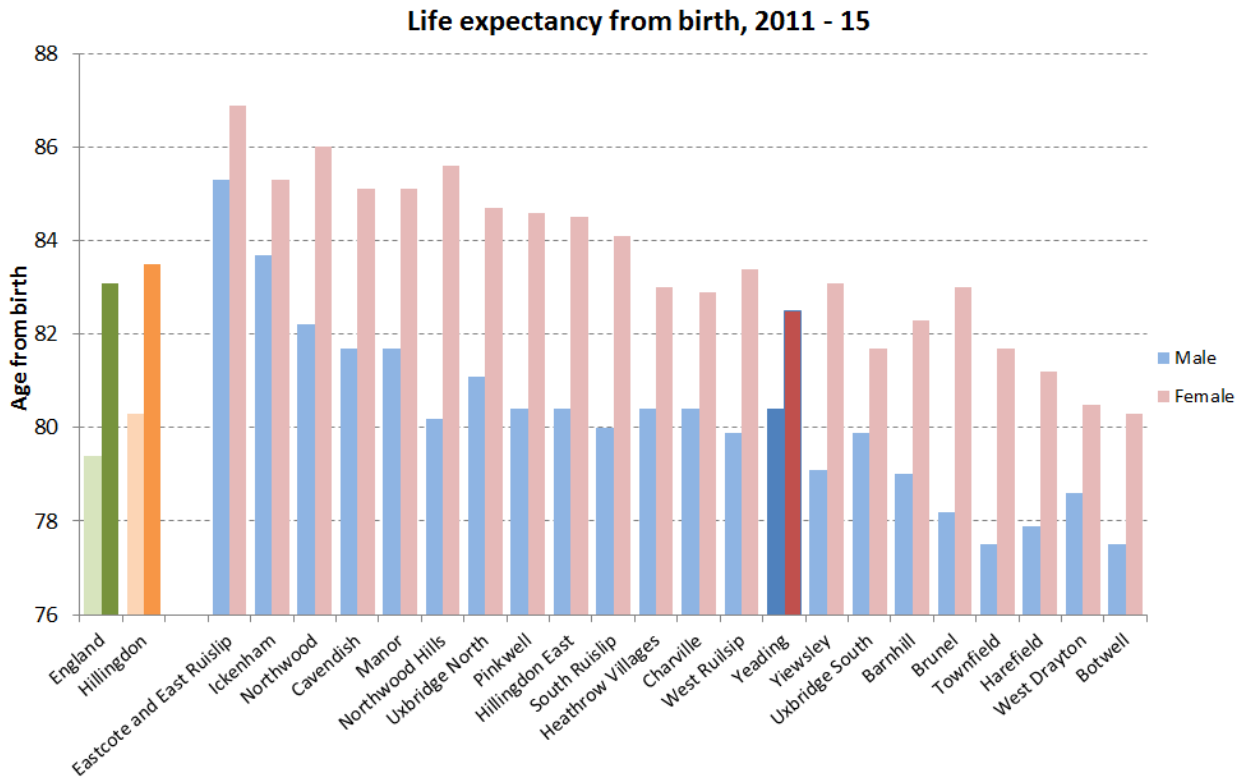
**Household Type London**

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Yeading, the life expectancy is estimated at 80.4 years for males and 82.5 years for females.



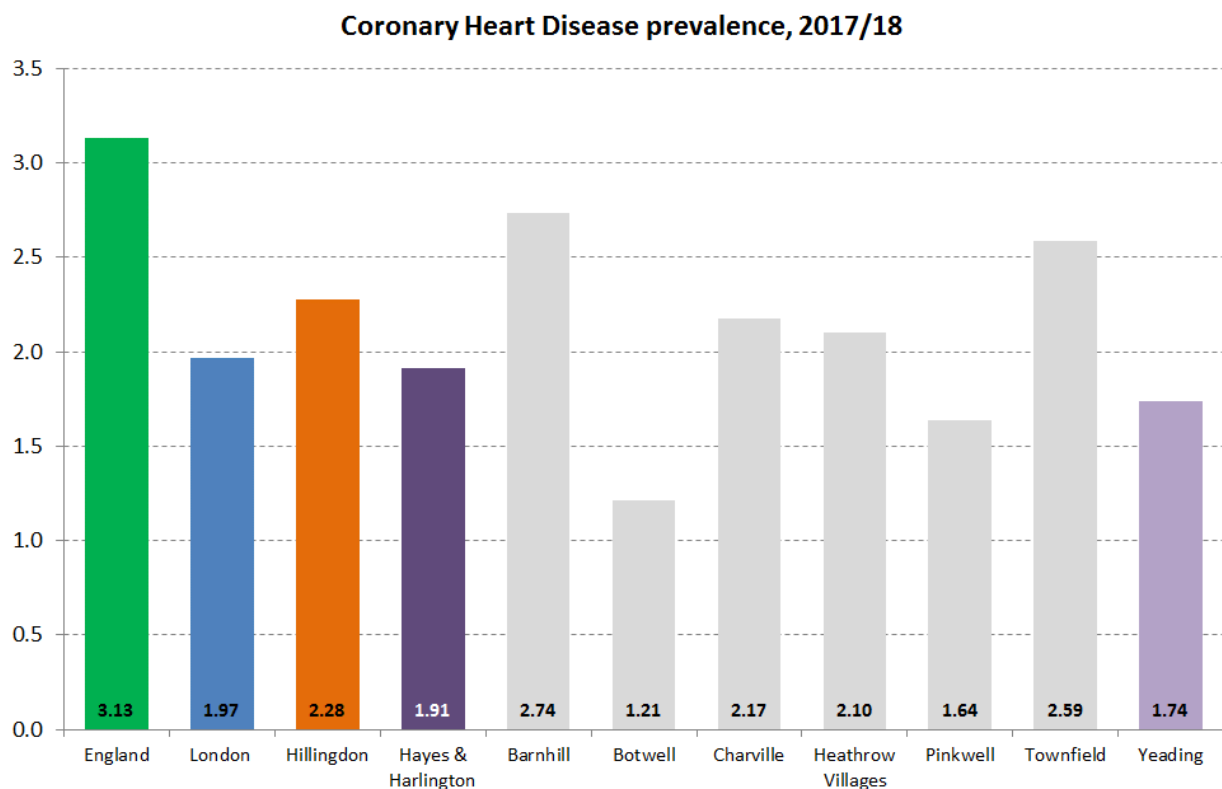
## Observed Prevalence<sup>12</sup>

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Yeading ward contains 1 GP surgeries (Willow Tree Surgery).

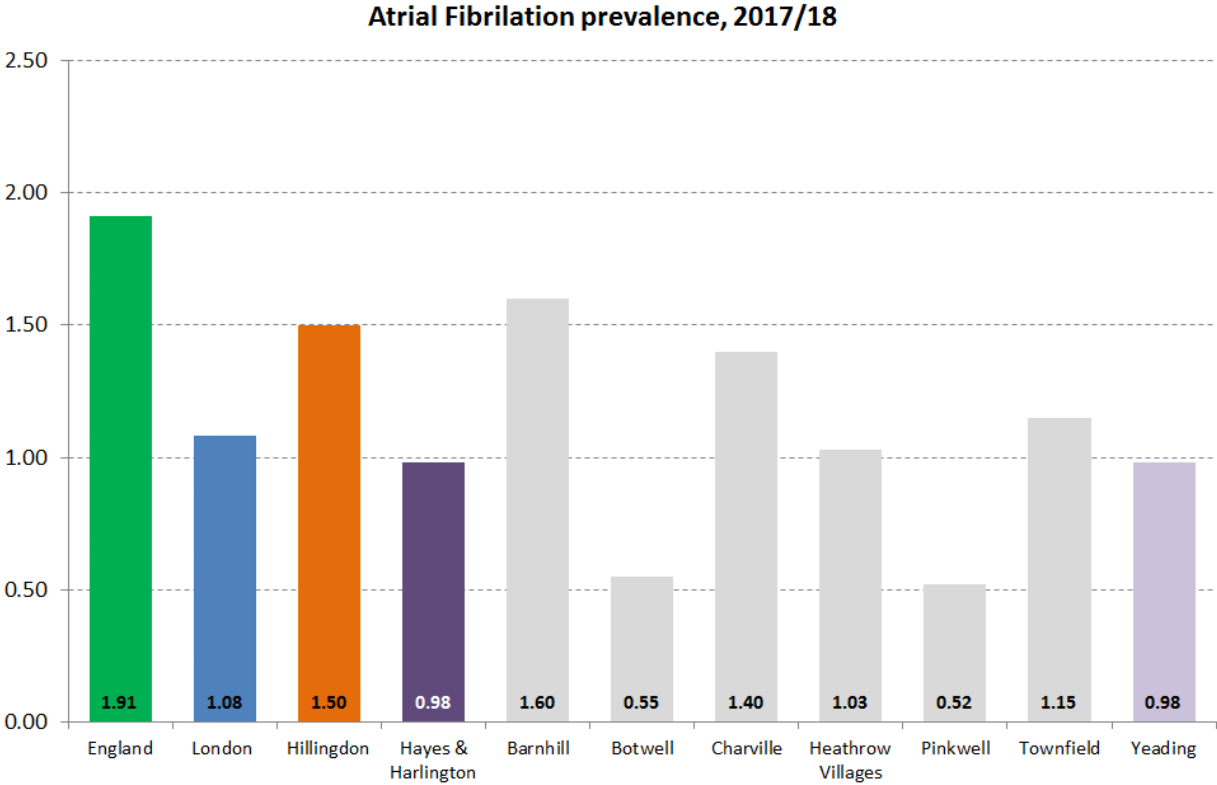

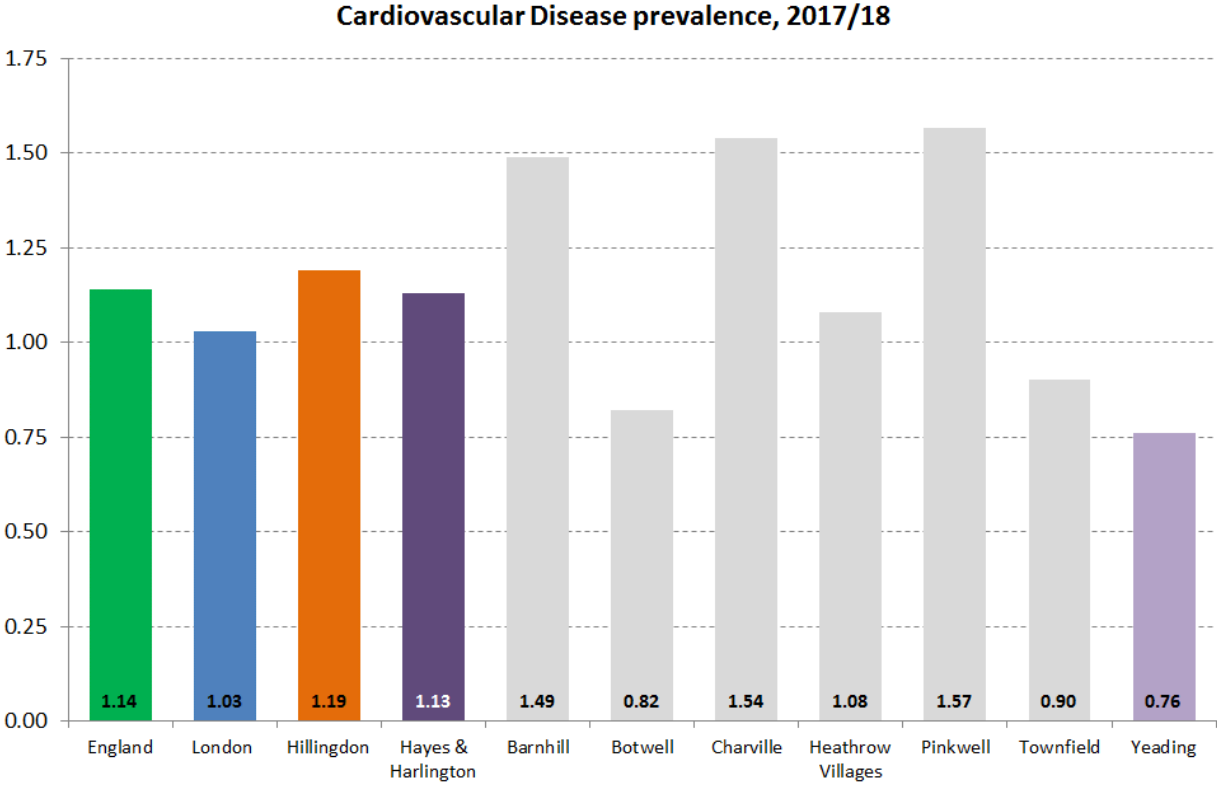

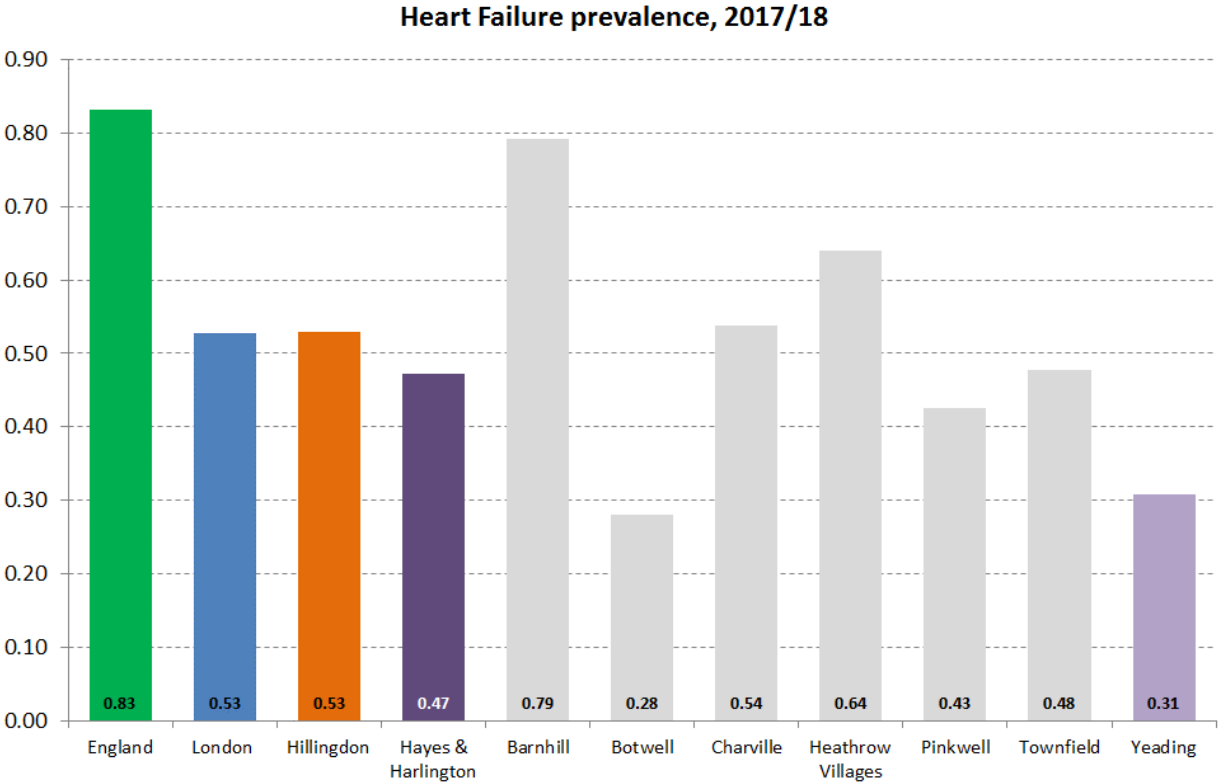

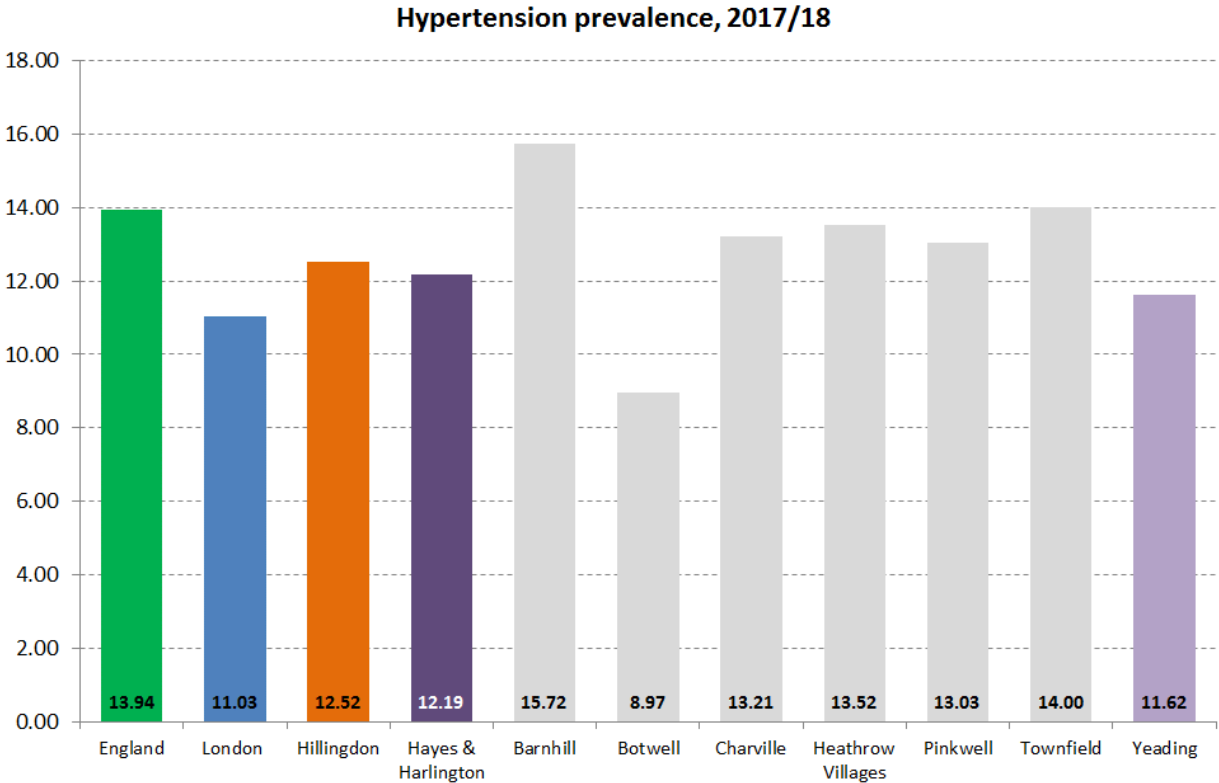
The prevalence of **cardiovascular disease** within Yeading is 0.76%; this is lower than England, London, Hillingdon and the locality.



The prevalence of **heart failure** within Yeading is 0.31%, which is lower than England, London, Hillingdon and the locality:



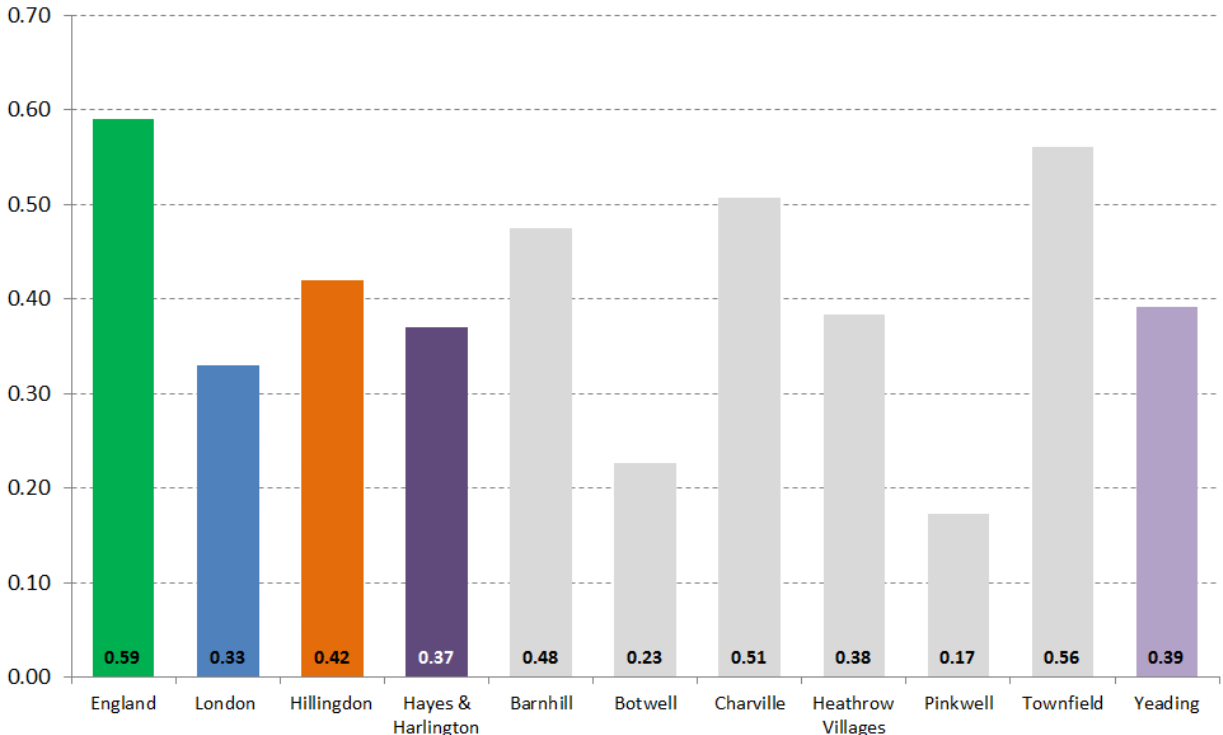
The prevalence of **hypertension** in Yeading is 11.62%, which is lower than England, Hillingdon and the locality, but higher than London:





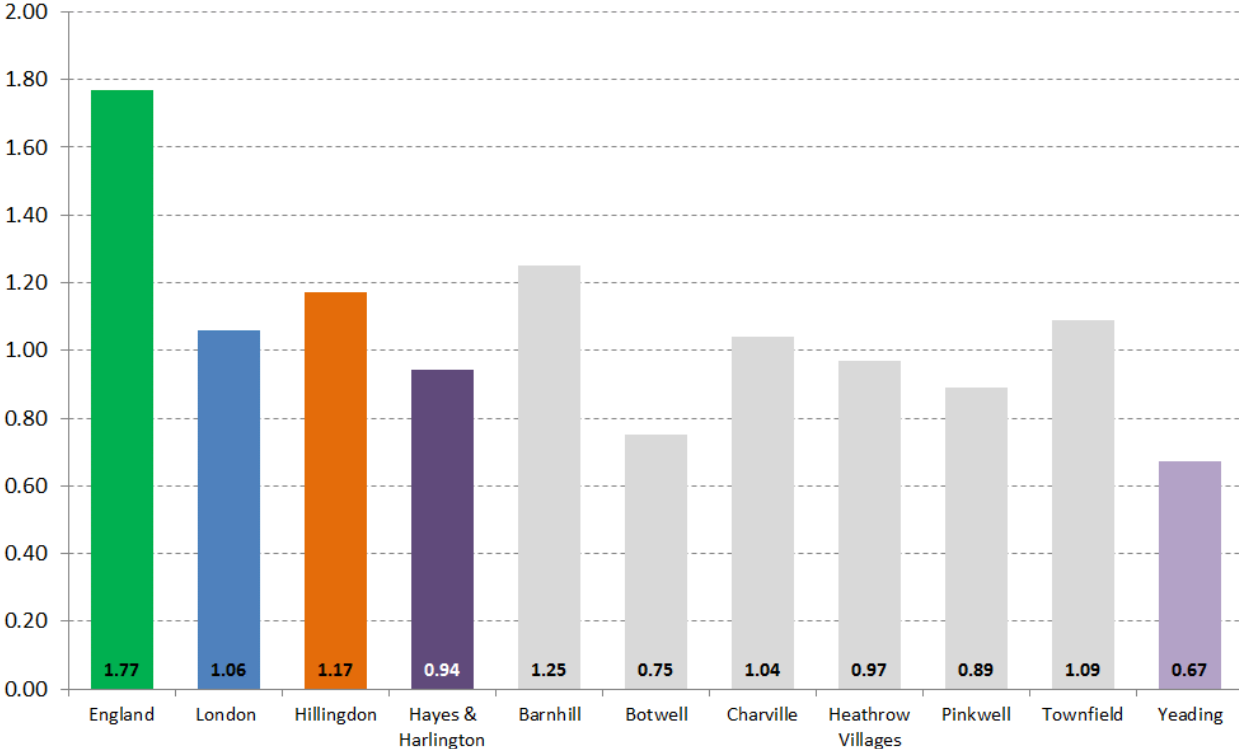
The prevalence of **peripheral arterial disease** in Yeading is 0.39%, which is lower than England and Hillingdon but higher than London and the locality:

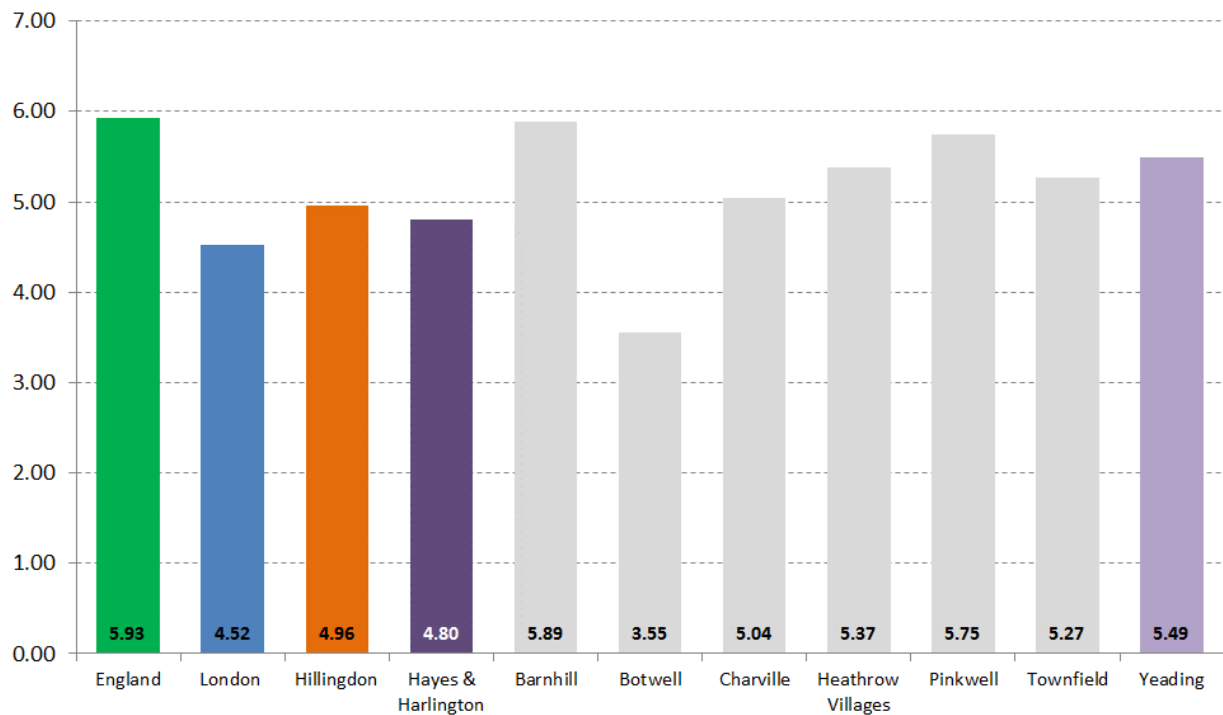
**Stroke / TIA prevalence, 2017/18**

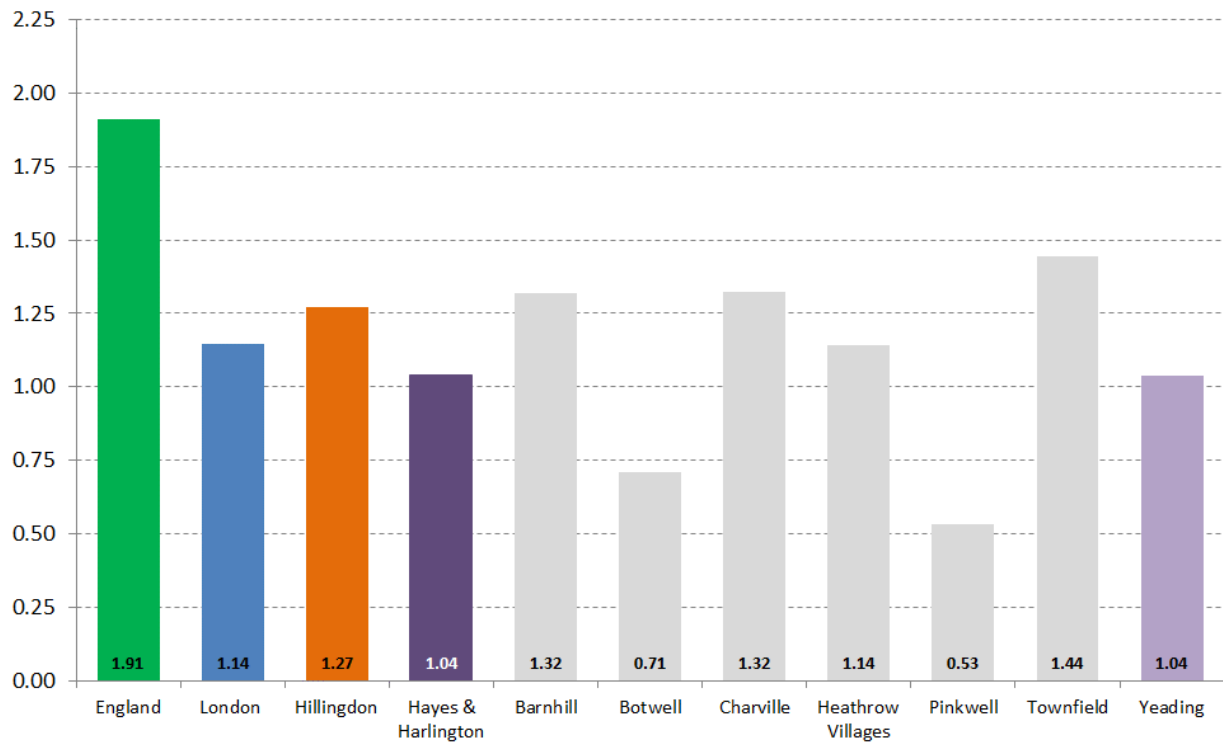

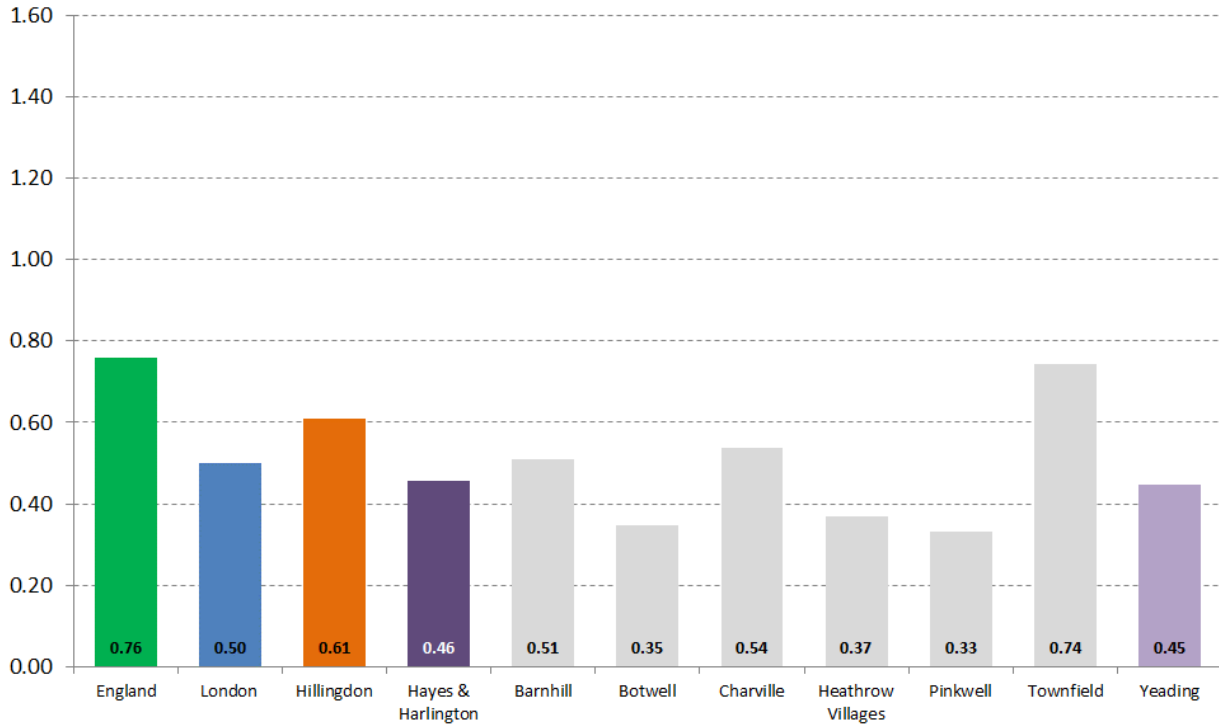
**COPD prevalence, 2017/18**

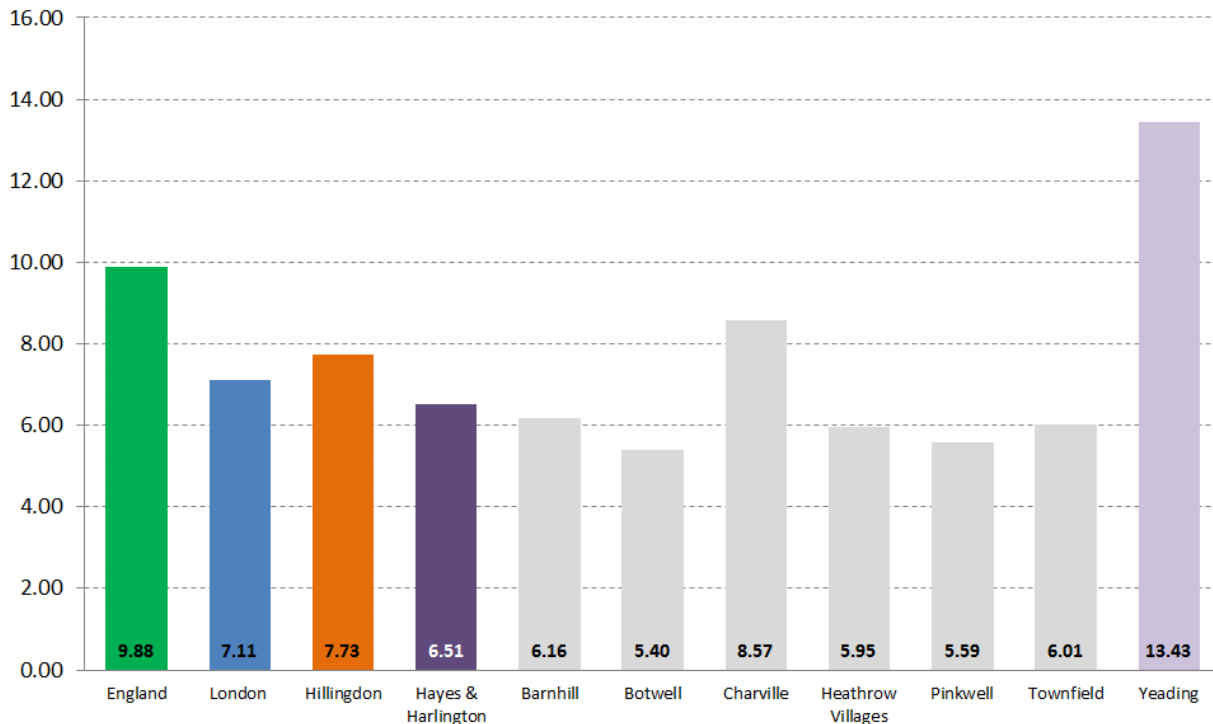

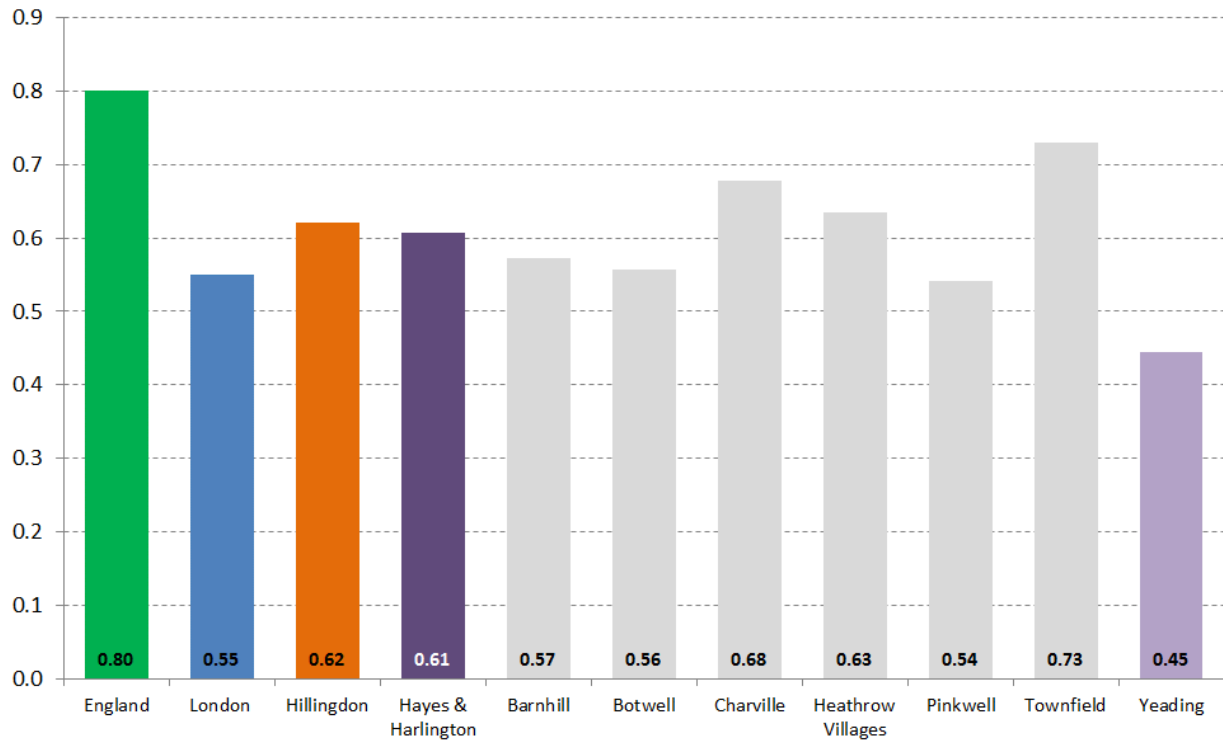
**Depression prevalence, 2017/18**

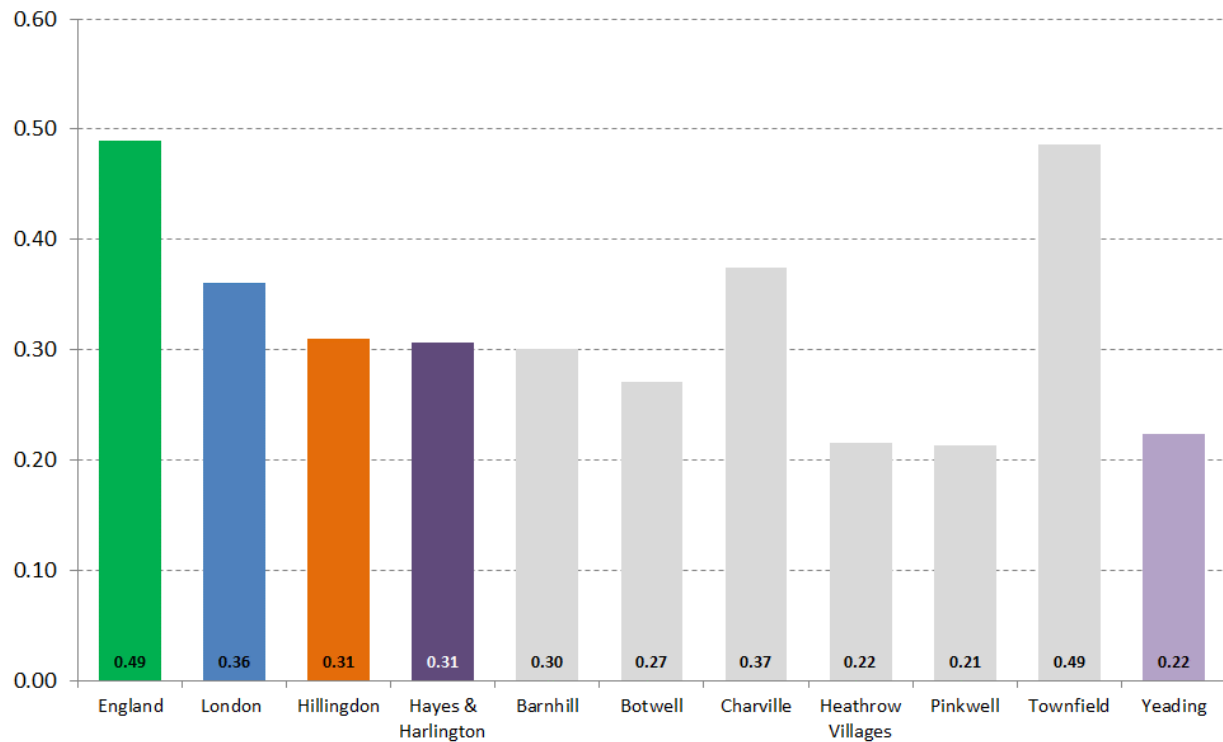

**Epilepsy prevalence, 2017/18**



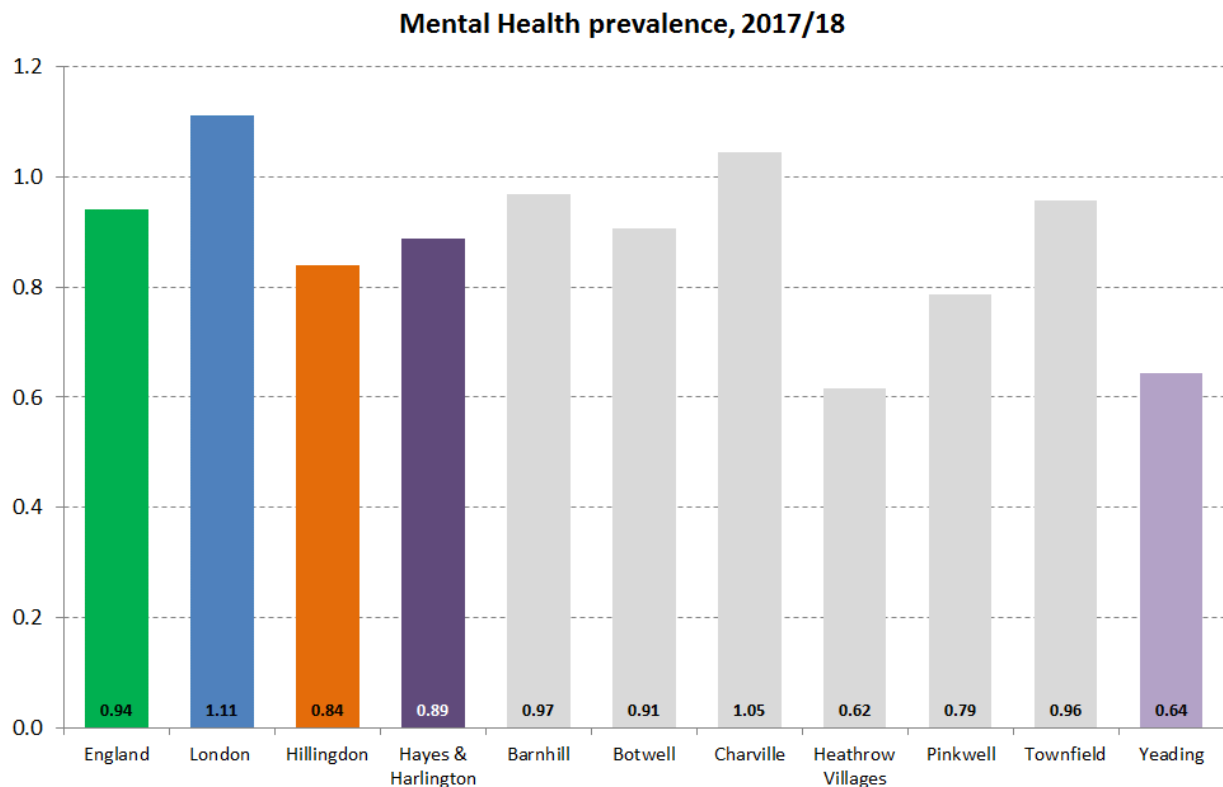

**Learning Disabilities prevalence, 2017/18**



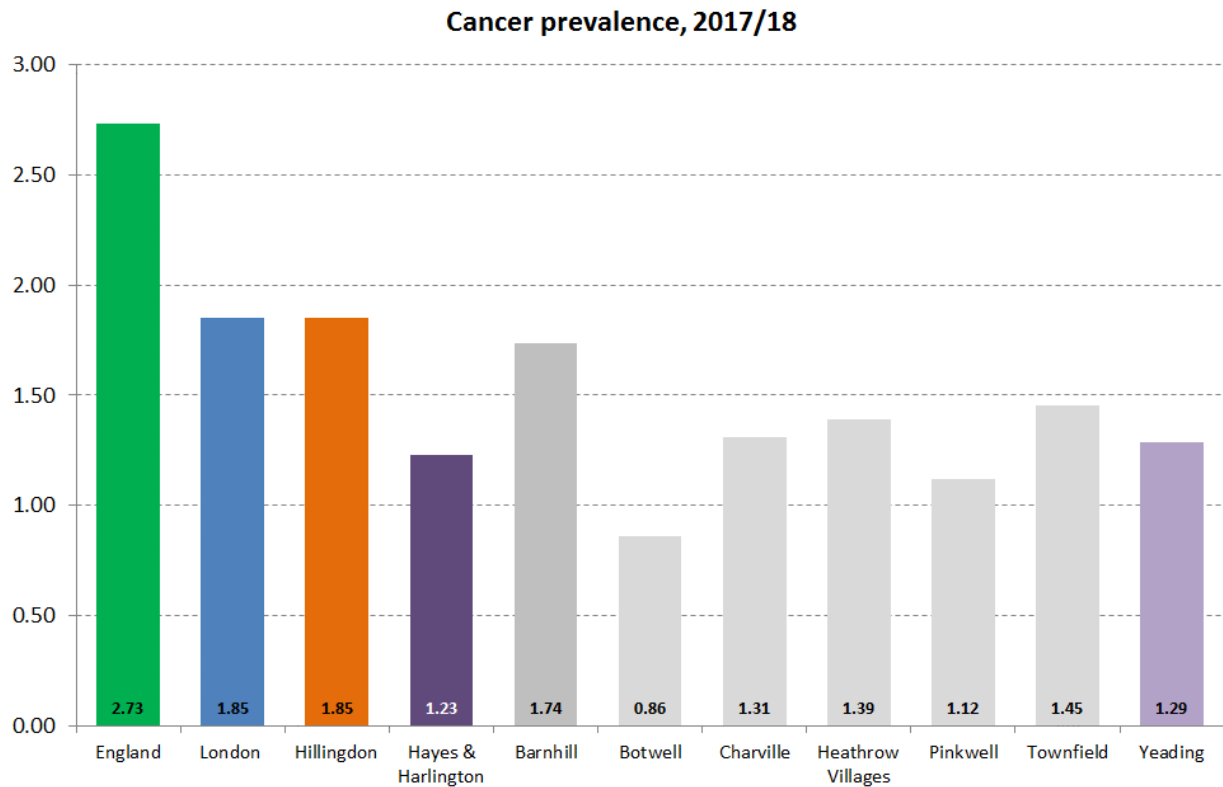

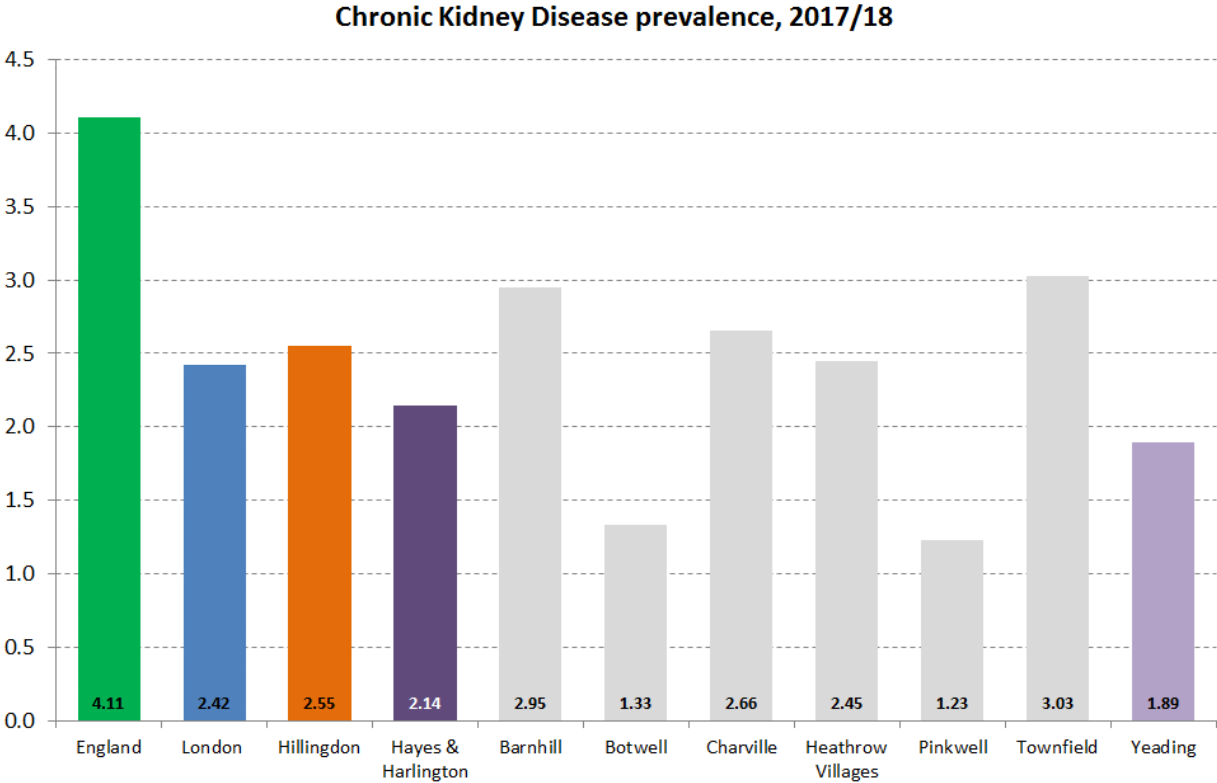

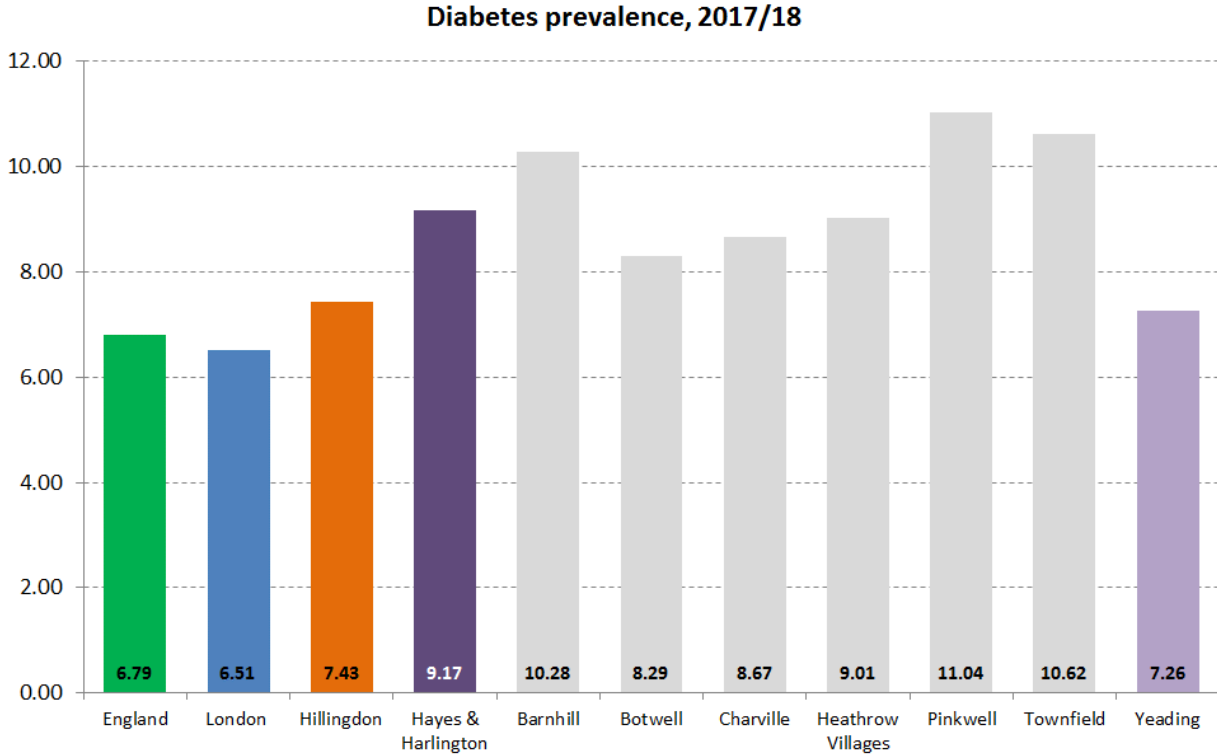

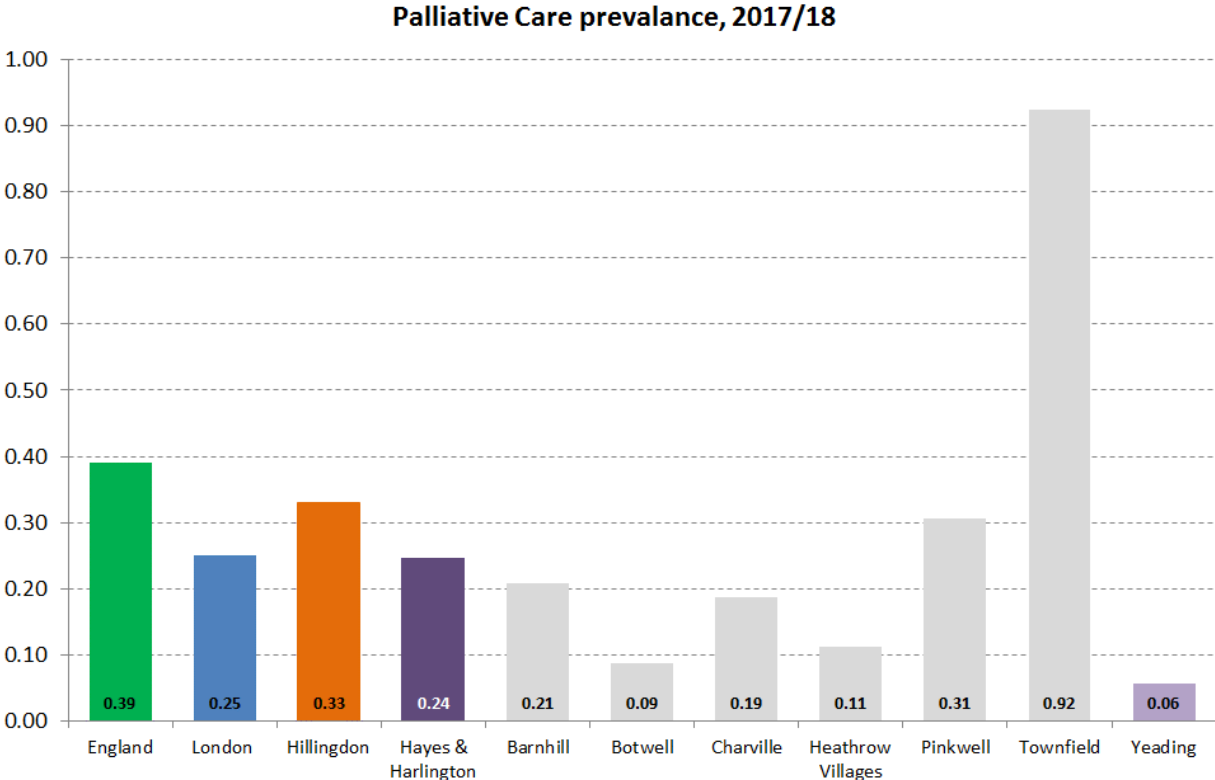

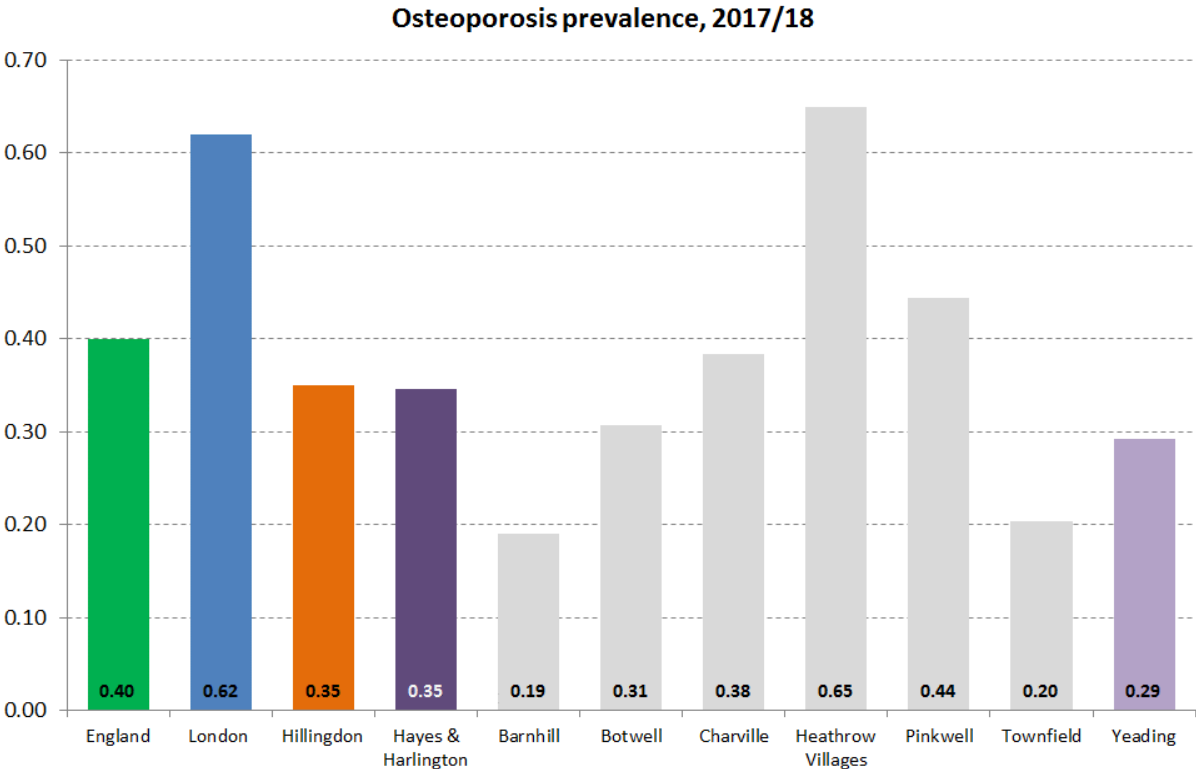

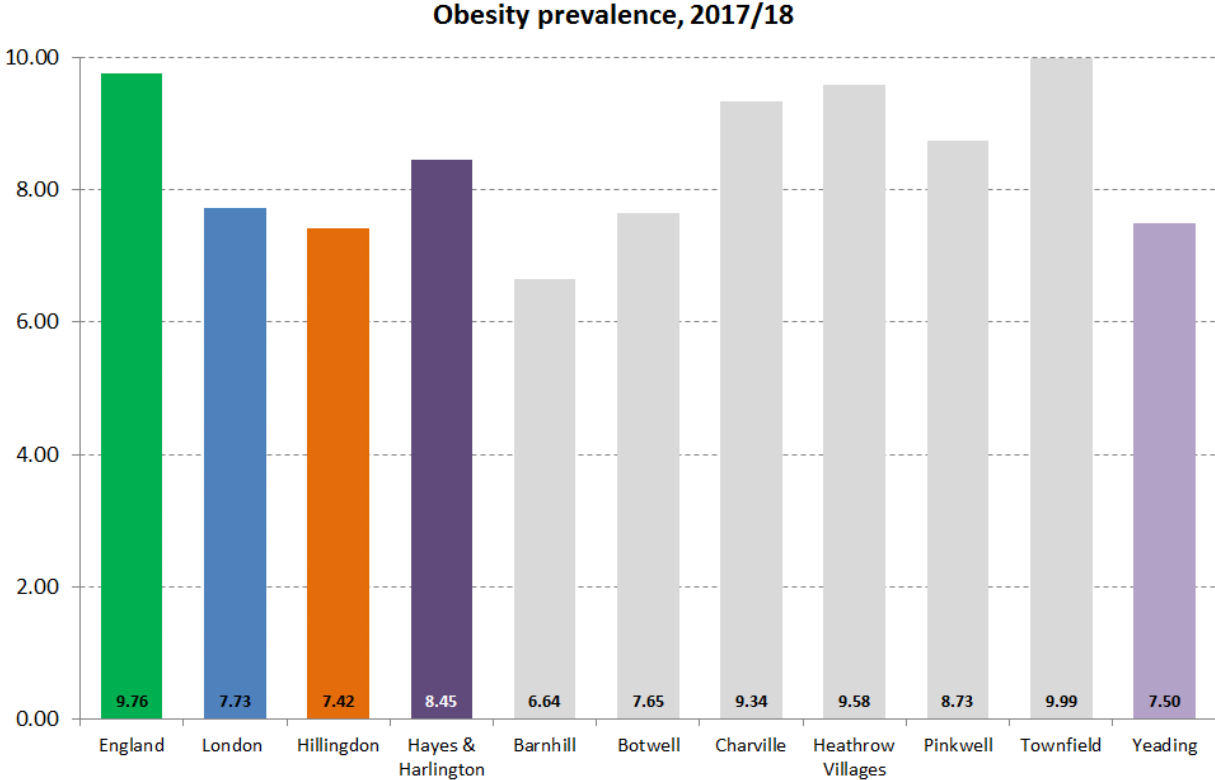

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.

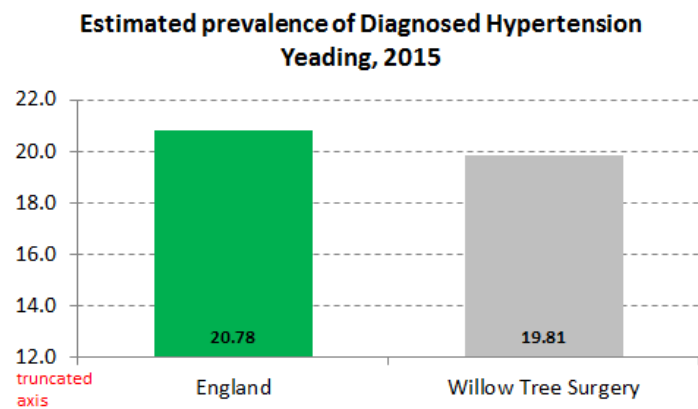
The graphs show estimated prevalence at England and GP level (data is not available at London, borough or locality level). Estimated prevalence is available on a limited number of conditions; data is taken from the latest Disease & Risk Factor Prevalence profile on Fingertips, 2015 ().

Yeading ward contains 1 GP surgery (Willow Tree Surgery). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

The estimated prevalence within Yeading is lower than England.

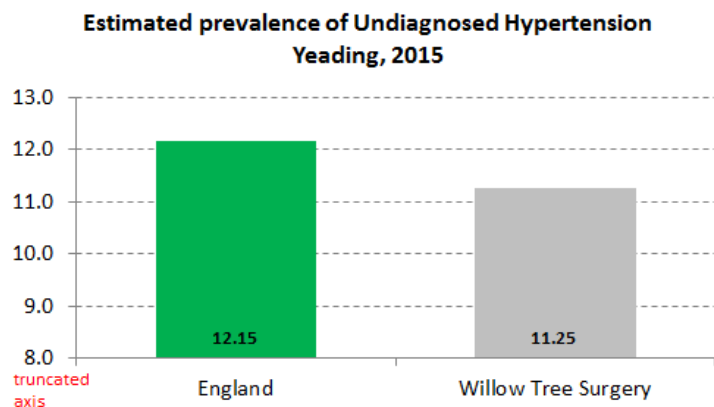

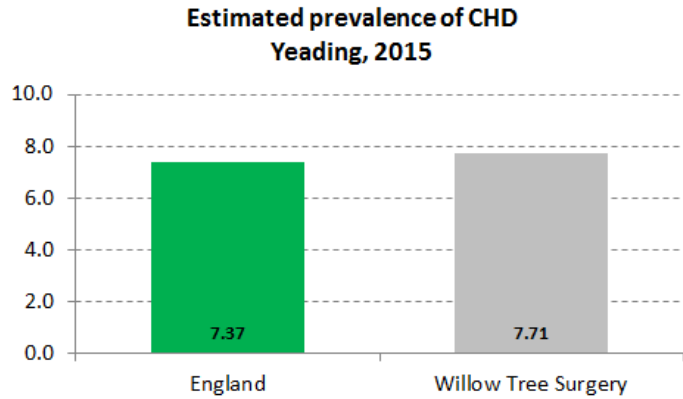

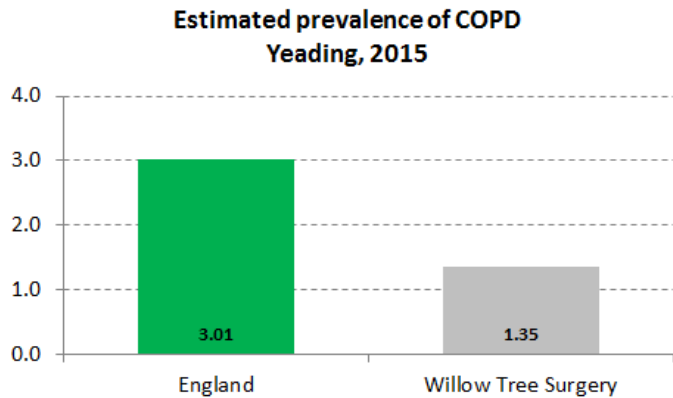

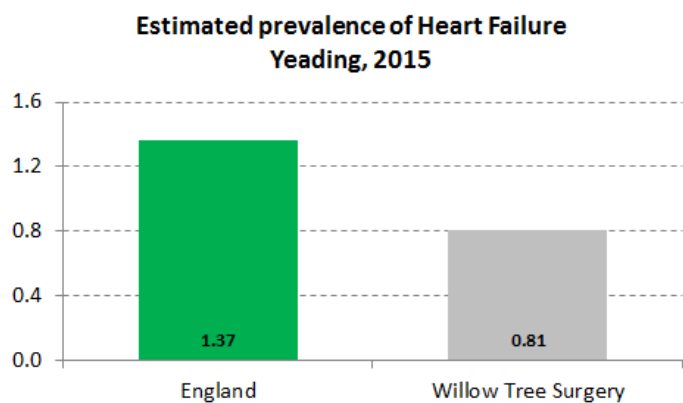

The estimated prevalence within Yeading is lower than England.

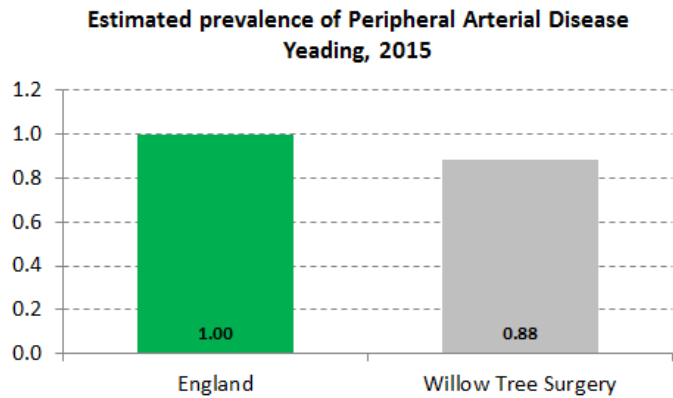

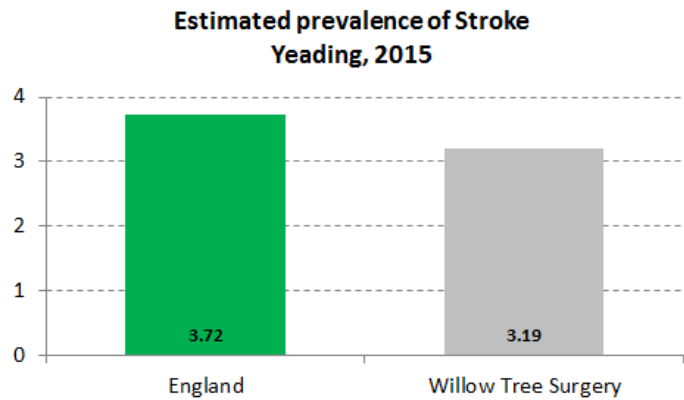

The estimated prevalence within Yeading is lower than England.

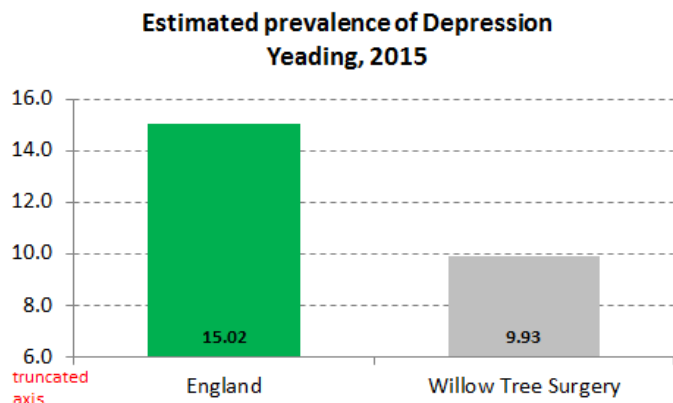
For comparison, the observed prevalence of Stroke / TIA in Yeading ward is 0.83%.
