



#### Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- **Population** comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- Age 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- Ethnicity Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- Religion<sup>1</sup> the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu 22,033 (8%) and Sikh 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' 46,492 (17%) and other 23,303 (8.5%).


## **Yiewsley Ward**

Yiewsley lies in the South West of Hillingdon and is bordered by Uxbridge South, Brunel, Botwell and West Drayton as well as Buckinghamshire.

In 2017<sup>2</sup>, Yiewsley's population is 14,410 residents, an increase of 11.0% since 2011 (12,979); this is similar to the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Yiewsley is made up of 401.3 hectares (4.0 km<sup>sq</sup>), with 35.9 people per hectare (3,591 per km<sup>sq</sup>). The average number of people per household in Yiewsley is  $2.5^3$ .

#### Deprivation


The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Yiewsley, which is made up of seven LSOA areas<sup>4</sup>.



The chart above shows that 22.8% of Yiewsley residents are under the age of 16. 72.9% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 4.3% are over the age of 75.

The chart below shows that in Yiewsley, there are higher numbers of males and females in the 30-39 age brackets when compared to other age groups.



# Gender

The proportion of men to women in the ward is 50.0% to 50.0%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 49.6% to 50.4% male to female ratio in the ward.




The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:


#### Ethnic make up 2011<sup>5</sup>

In the 2011 census, 66.2% of residents in the ward identify themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 3.8% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 19.3% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 7.4% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 3.4% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

#### Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:



## **Religion<sup>6</sup>**


Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 50.9% from this faith. 4.9% are Hindu, 10.4% Muslim, 3.6% Sikh with 23.2% having no religion. 5.5% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary). According to the 2011 Census figures Yiewsley has the fourth largest number of residents in the borough with no religion.

#### Yiewsley, Religion 2011:



# Country of Birth<sup>7</sup>

Of those living in Yiewsley, 80.6% were **born** in Europe (with 72.3% in the UK), 12.5% in the Middle East / Asia, 5.4% in Africa, and 1.5% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Yiewsley, 27.7% were **born** outside of the UK (with 72.3% in the UK).




Yiewsley has the second highest number of residents stating they were born in Poland (7.6% of borough residents, 322).

The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 82.0% residents stating this at their main language. Of the remaining 18.0% the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well', with 337 residents (15.2%% of those where English is not their main language) stating they cannot speak English well or at all<sup>8</sup>.

Apart from English, the most spoken languages in the ward are Polish with 332 (2.7%) and Panjabi with 521 (1.7%). Yiewsley ward is the one of the highest ranked of wards in the borough for Polish and Bengali speakers.

# Working Age Population (ages 16-74):

In Yiewsley, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 15.5% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 71.6%, the remaining 12.9% are from the 60-74 age group.


# Economic Data (statistics are for the age 16-74 group)

In Yiewsley, 71.2% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:



Of those residents in employment, this chart provides an overview of the **Occupation Types**<sup>9</sup> across Yiewsley ward:



The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Yiewsley is 19.2%, which is higher than the Hillingdon average (13.6%).




Hillingdon income deprivation %, 2015

# Households

In 2017, there were 5,860 households<sup>10</sup> in Yiewsley, an increase of 679 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**<sup>11</sup> within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 63.2%, with 36.8% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).


The diagram below shows the percentage of housing types at ward, borough and regional level.

In Yiewsley, 47.6% of ward residents own their own homes, followed by 21.8% of properties being privately rented, 27.3% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 3.2% other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.




Household Type Yiewsley

# Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Yiewsley, the life expectancy is estimated at 79.1 years for males and 83.1 years for females. This is similar to the averages for Hillingdon and England.


# **Observed Prevalence<sup>12</sup>**

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Yiewsley ward contains 3 GP surgeries (Yiewsley Family Practice, Otterfield Medical Centre and Yiewsley Health Centre).



#### Coronary Heart Disease prevalence, 2017/18




Atrial Fibrilation prevalence, 2017/18


Cardiovascular Disease prevalence, 2017/18


Heart Failure prevalence, 2017/18




Hypertension prevalence, 2017/18








#### COPD prevalence, 2017/18







Learning Disabilities prevalence, 2017/18




Mental Health prevalence, 2017/18




Chronic Kidney Disease prevalence, 2017/18

Diabetes prevalence, 2017/18




#### Palliative Care prevalance, 2017/18

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.




Yiewsley ward contains 3 GP surgeries (Yiewsley Family Practice, Otterfield Medical Centre and Yiewsley Health Centre). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

For comparison, the observed prevalence of hypertension in Yiewsley ward is 11.84%.






#### **Undiagnosed Hypertension**

Otterfield Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 3 surgeries in the ward.







For comparison, the observed prevalence of heart failure in Yiewsley ward is 0.58%.





#### Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD)






#### Stroke


