



Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- **Population** comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- Age 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- Ethnicity Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- Religion¹ the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu 22,033 (8%) and Sikh 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' 46,492 (17%) and other 23,303 (8.5%).


Uxbridge North Ward

Uxbridge North lies in the West of Hillingdon and is bordered by Ickenham, Hillingdon East, Brunel and Uxbridge South as well as Buckinghamshire.

In 2017², Uxbridge North population is 15,482 residents, an increase of 28.5% since 2011 (12,048); this is higher than the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Uxbridge North is made up of 463.3 hectares (4.6 km^{sq}), with 33.4 people per hectare (3,342 per km^{sq}). The average number of people per household in Uxbridge North is 2.6³.

Deprivation


The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Uxbridge North, which is made up of seven LSOA areas⁴.



Ward Population:

The chart above shows that 19.5% of Uxbridge North residents are under the age of 16. 73.2% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 7.3% are over the age of 75.


The chart below shows higher number males and females aged 30-34 years in Uxbridge North compared to other age groups.





Gender

The proportion of men to women in the ward is 49.7% to 50.3%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 49.2% to 50.8% male to female ratio in the ward.




The chart below shows male/female ratios in Hillingdon and ward level:


Ethnic make up 2011⁵

In the 2011 census, 69.8% of residents in the ward identify themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 3.6% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 19.5% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 4.1% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 3.0% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:



Religion⁶


Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 53.0% from this faith. 5.4% are Hindu, 6.7% Muslim, 6.2% Sikh with 19.3% having no religion. 7.9% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary).

Uxbridge North, Religion 2011:


Hillingdon, Religion 2011:

Country of Birth⁷

Of those living in Uxbridge North, 82.6% were **born** in Europe (with 76.6% in the UK), 1.3% in the Middle East / Asia, 4.4% in Africa, and 2.2% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Uxbridge North, 23.4% were **born** outside of the UK (with 76.6% in the UK).




Uxbridge North has one of the highest number of UK born residents across all wards (9232). The next most common country of birth is India with 502 residents.

The preferred **language** in the ward is English with 88.1% residents stating this at their main language. Of the remaining 11.9% the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well', with 175 residents (12.6% of those where English is not their main language) stating that they cannot speak English well or at all⁸.

Apart from English the most spoken language in the ward is European with 3.0% (344) followed by Panjabi with 2.1% (240).

Working age breakdown (ages 16-74):


In Uxbridge North, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 14.9% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 69.1%, the remaining 16.0% are from the 60-74 age group.

Economic Data (statistics are for the age 16-74 group)

In Uxbridge North, 71.9% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:



The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Uxbridge North is 11.0%, which is lower than the Hillingdon average (13.6%).




Hillingdon income deprivation %, 2015

Households

In 2017, there were 5,977 households¹⁰ in Uxbridge North; an increase of 845 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type¹¹** within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 73.8%, with 26.2% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).


The diagram below shows the percentage of housing types at ward, borough and regional level.


In Uxbridge North, 67.3% of ward residents own their own homes, followed by 18.2% of properties being privately rented, 12.7% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 1.8% other e.g. shared ownership, living rent free.

Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Uxbridge North, the life expectancy is estimated at 81.1 years for males and 84.7 years for females. This is above the averages for Hillingdon and England.


Observed Prevalence¹²

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Uxbridge North ward contains 4 GP surgeries (The Oakland Medical Centre, Belmont Medical Centre, Uxbridge Health Centre and Acorn Medical Centre).



Coronary Heart Disease prevalence, 2017/18






Atrial Fibrilation prevalence, 2017/18




Heart Failure prevalence, 2017/18

The prevalence of **hypertension** in Uxbridge North is 12.07%, which is lower than England and Hillingdon, but higher than London and the locality:




Hypertension prevalence, 2017/18


Peripheral Arterial Disease prevalence, 2017/18



Asthma prevalence, 2017/18



COPD prevalence, 2017/18




Dementia prevalence, 2017/18




Depression prevalence, 2017/18



Mental Health prevalence, 2017/18






Cancer prevalence, 2017/18



Diabetes prevalence, 2017/18




Palliative Care prevalance, 2017/18

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.




Uxbridge North ward contains 4 GP surgeries (The Oakland Medical Centre, Belmont Medical Centre, Uxbridge Health Centre and Acorn Medical Centre). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

For comparison, the observed prevalence of hypertension in Uxbridge North ward is 11.88%.






Undiagnosed Hypertension

The Oakland Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 4 surgeries in the ward.



The Oakland Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 4 surgeries in the ward.



The Oakland Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 4 surgeries in the ward.



For comparison, the observed prevalence of heart failure in Uxbridge North ward is 0.48%.




Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD)

Estimated prevalence of Peripheral Arterial Disease Uxbridge North, 2015




Stroke

Estimated prevalence of Stroke Uxbridge North, 2015




Depression
